

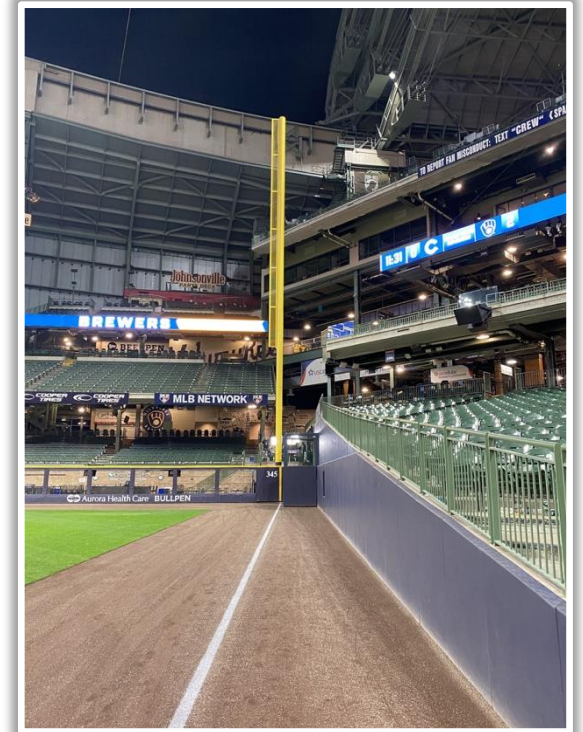
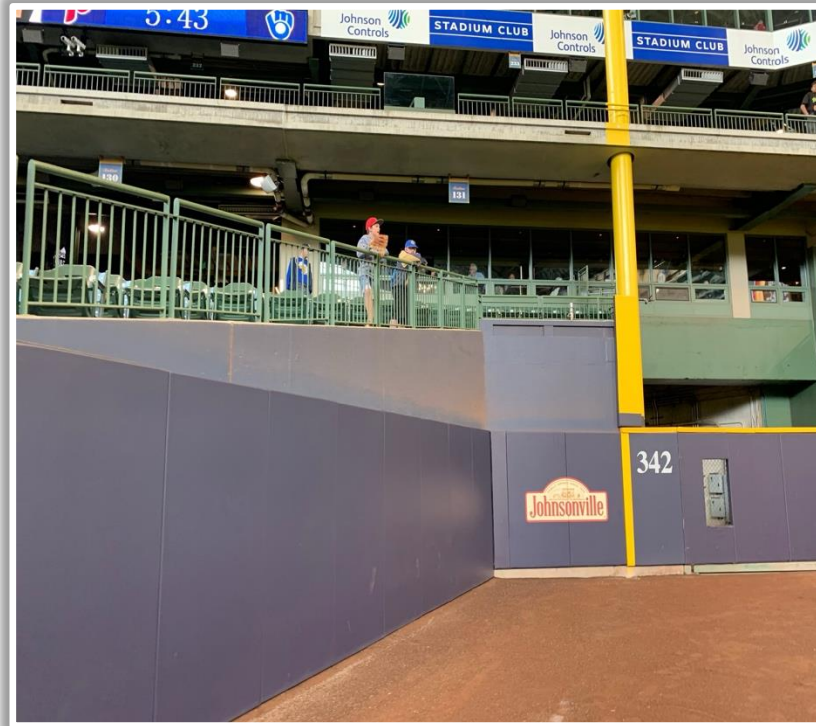
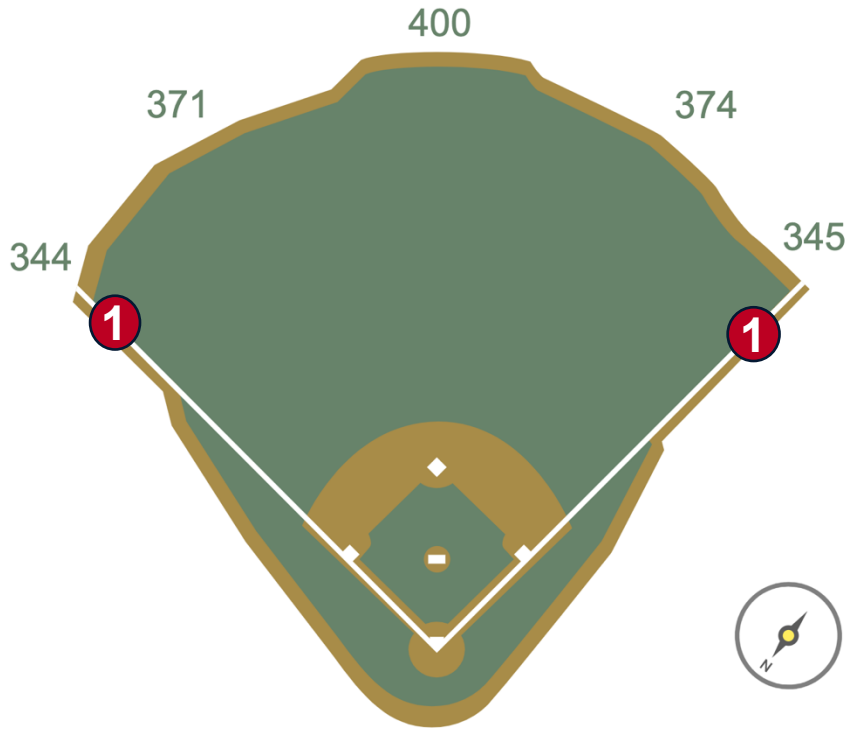

# American Family Field Ground Rules

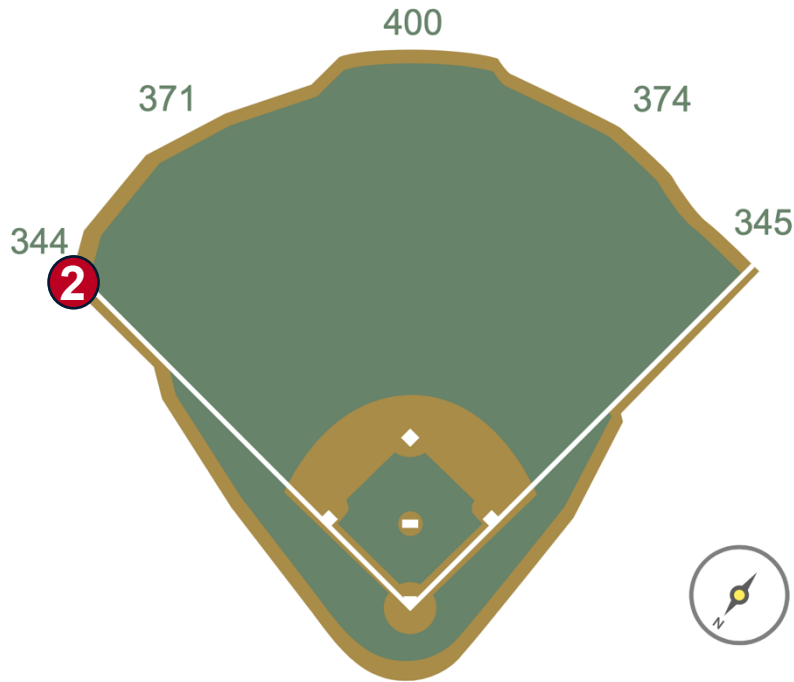
**RULE #1:** Fair batted bounding or thrown ball striking the green safety railings on the walls down the left field and right field lines in foul territory and rebounding onto the playing field: **In Play**



# American Family Field Ground Rules

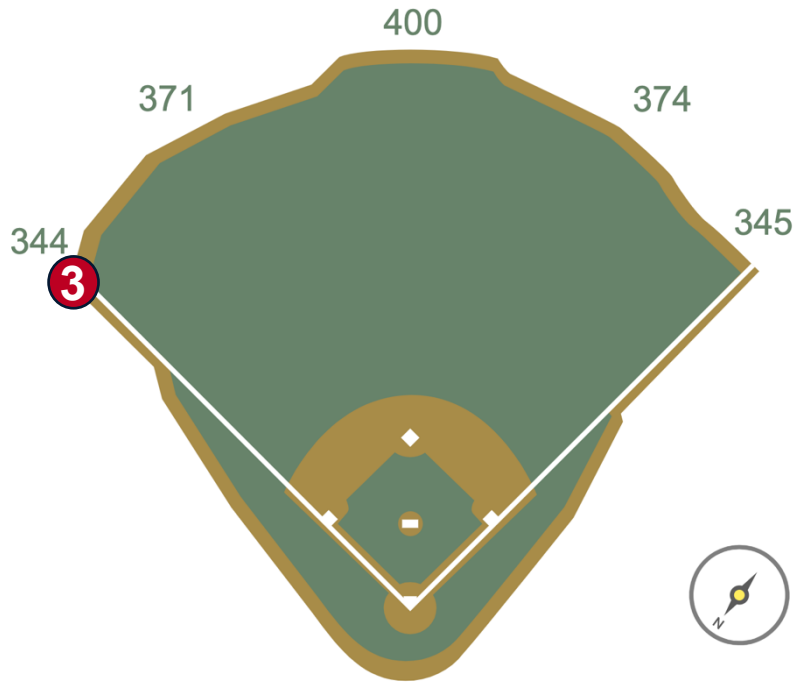
**RULE #2:** The entire pad in the left field corner is treated as part of the foul pole.

- Batted ball in flight striking the pad: **Home Run**
- Fair bounding ball striking the pad: **Two Bases**



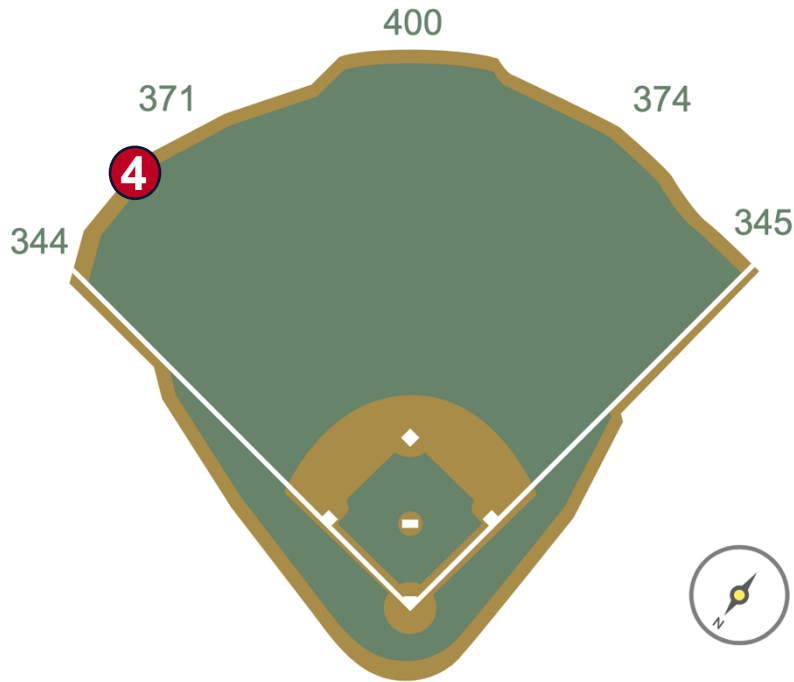
# American Family Field Ground Rules

**RULE #3:** Fair bounding ball that strikes the blue concrete wall to the left of the foul pole: **Live and in Play**

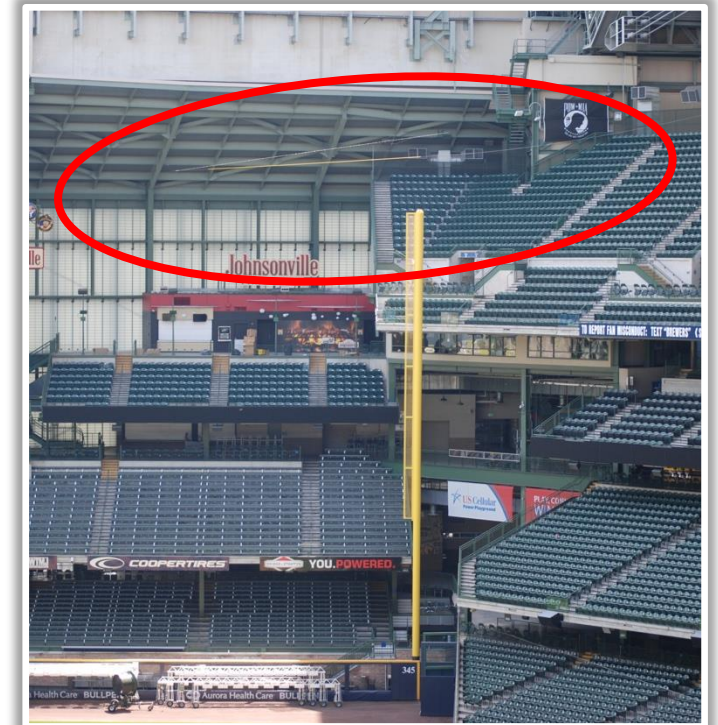
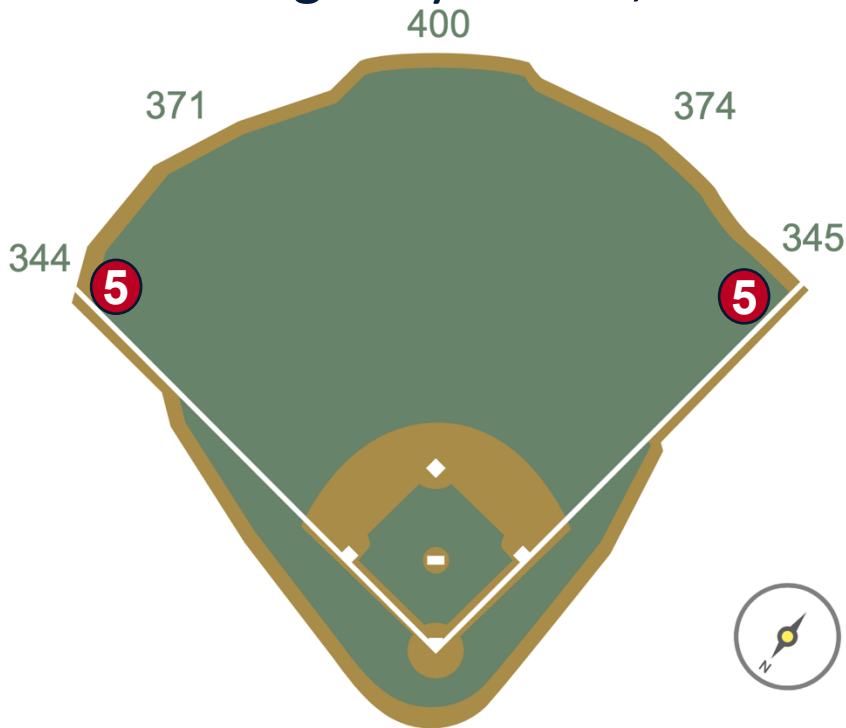
**RULE #4:** Batted ball in flight striking the blue portion of the top of the wall, beyond the yellow padding, regardless of whether the ball bounces back onto the playing field or continues into stands: **Home Run**

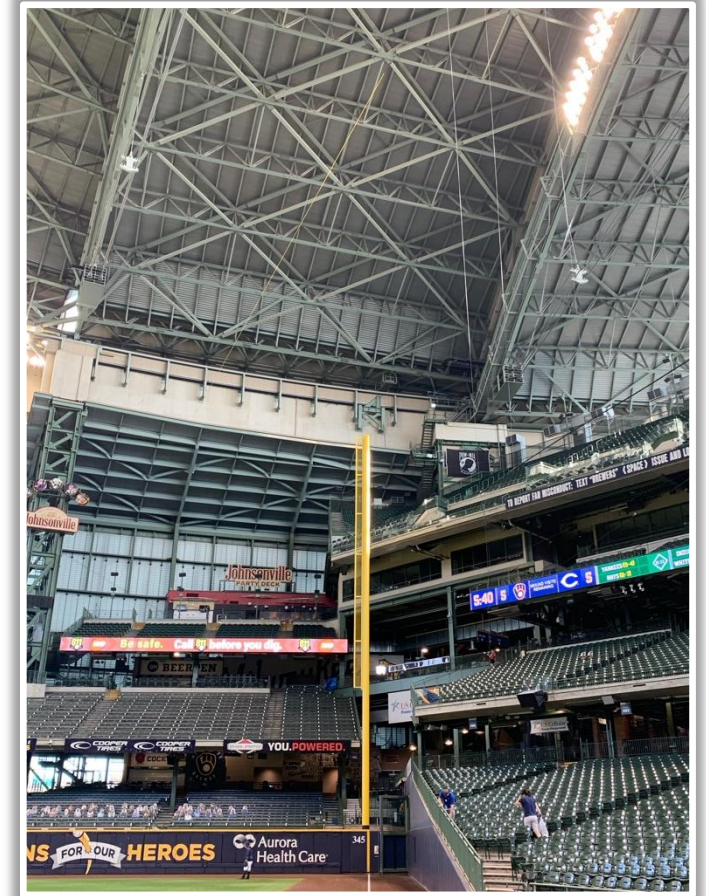
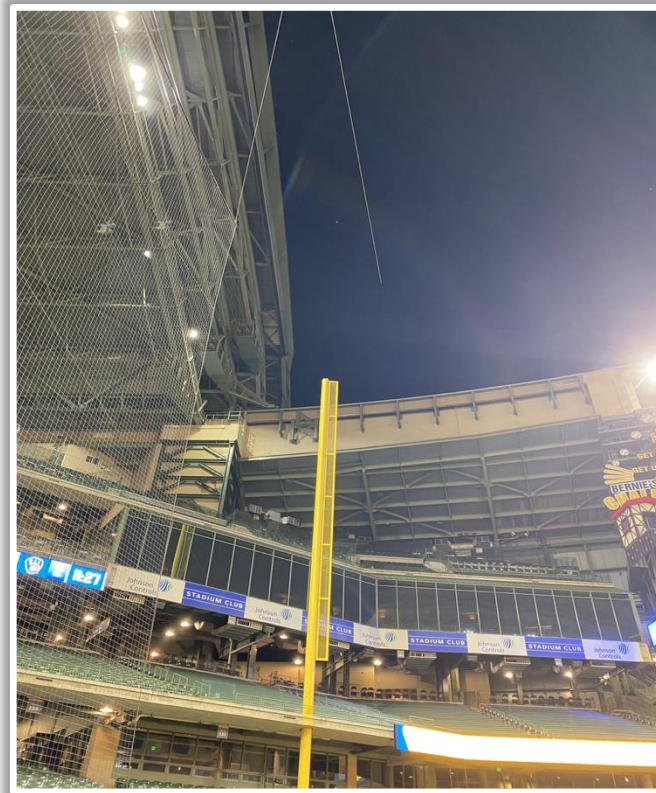
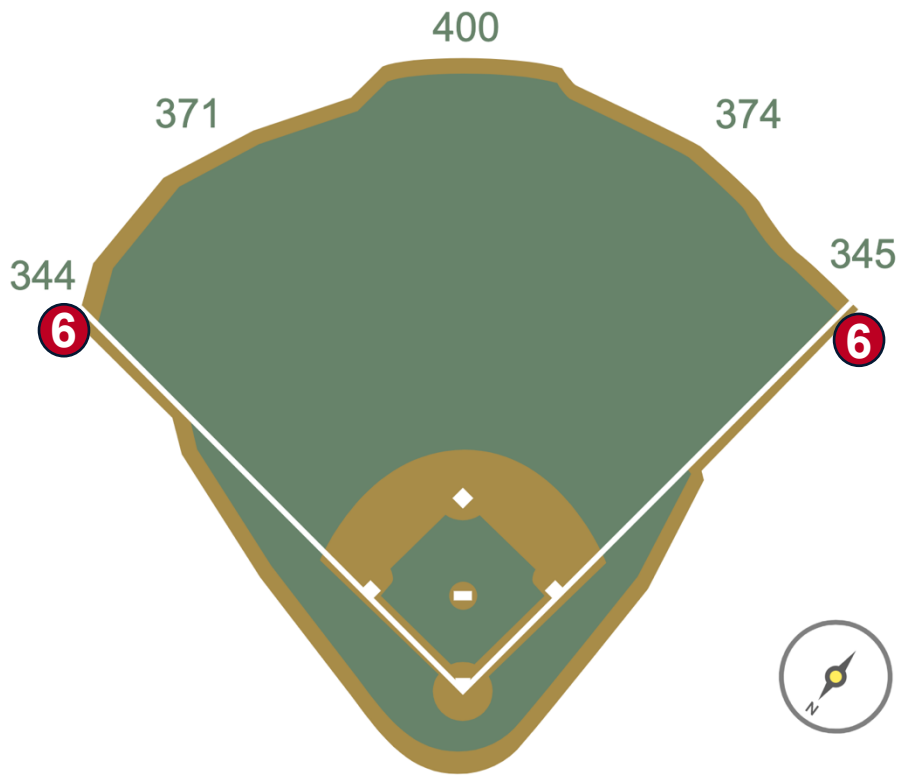
**RULE #5:** Batted ball strikes roof, roof truss, roof cable, or any cabling over fair territory: **In Play**

- If caught by fielder, batter is out, and runners advance at own risk.



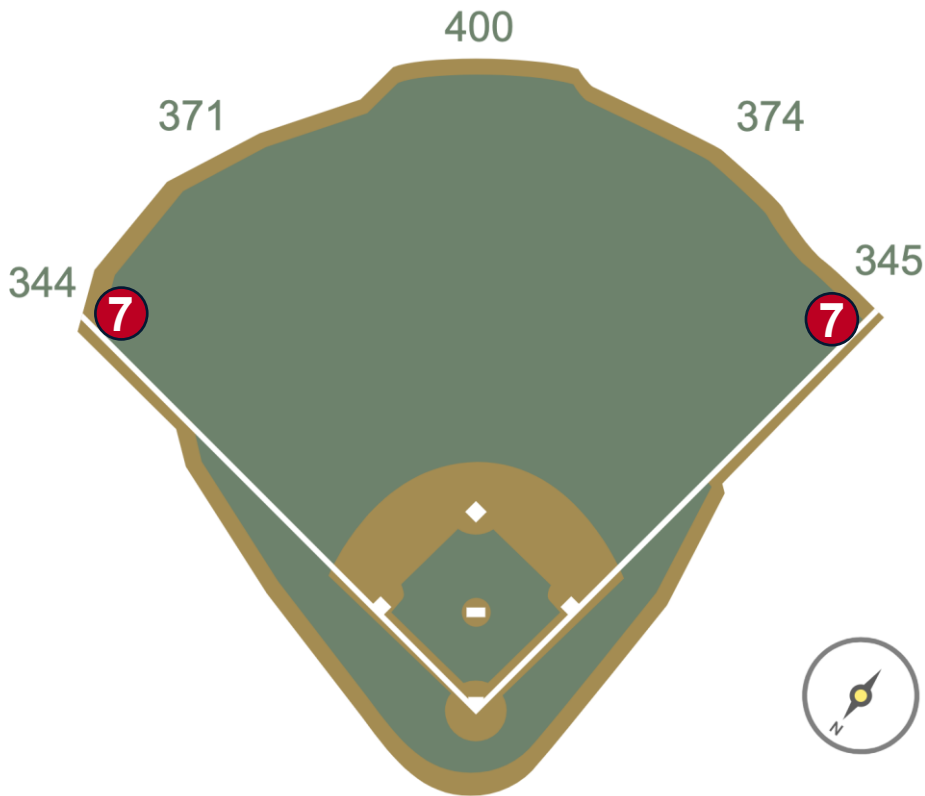

**RULE #6:** Batted ball strikes roof, roof truss, roof cable, or any cabling over foul territory: **Dead Ball**



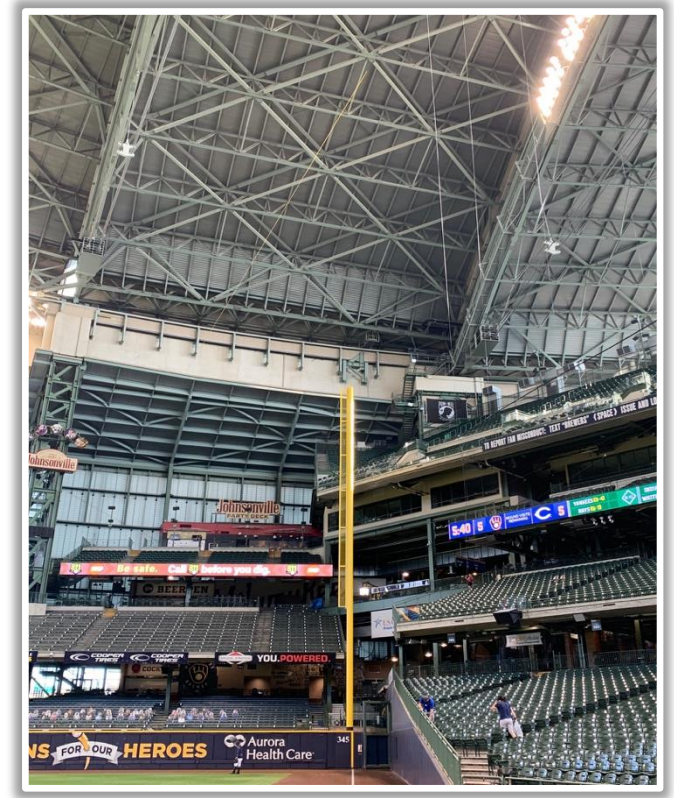
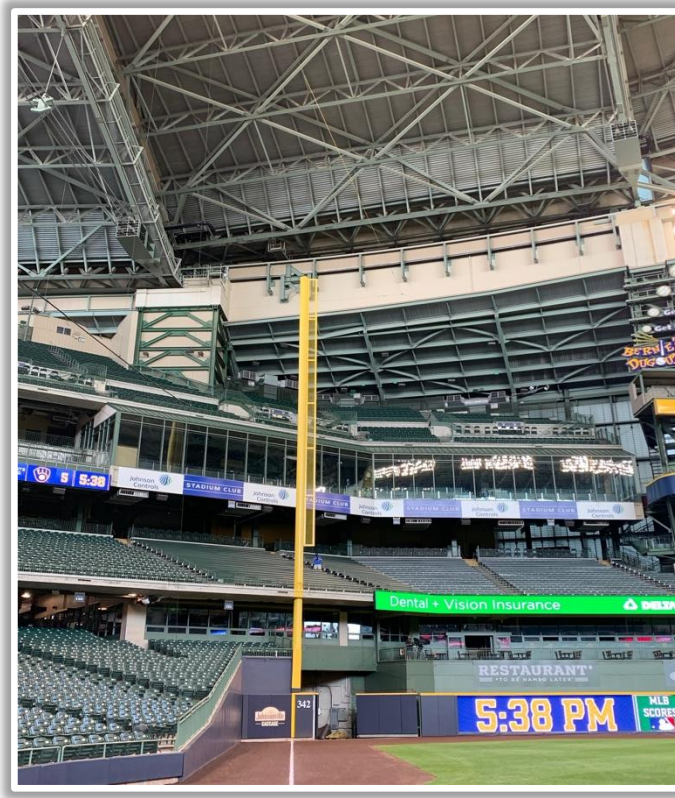
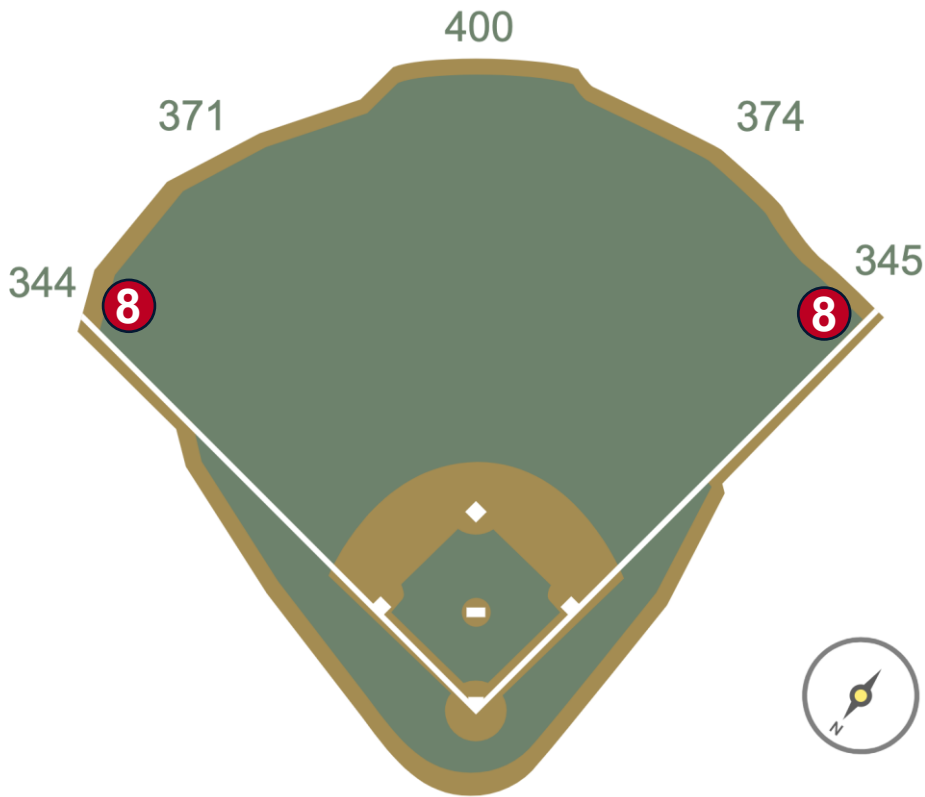
# American Family Field Ground Rules

**RULE #7:** Batted ball striking the roof, roof truss, roof cable, or any cabling over fair territory and landing foul: **Foul Ball**



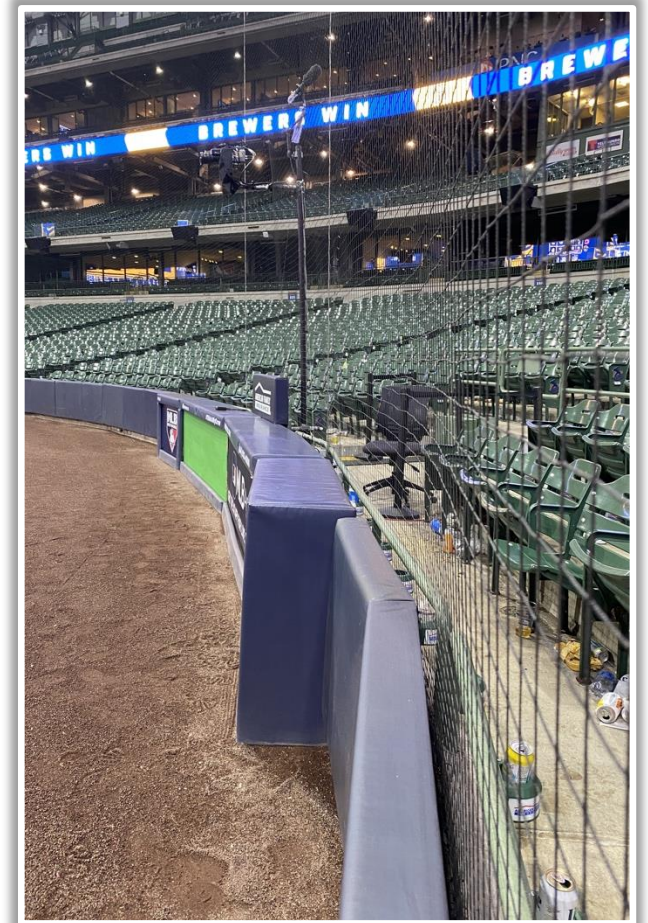
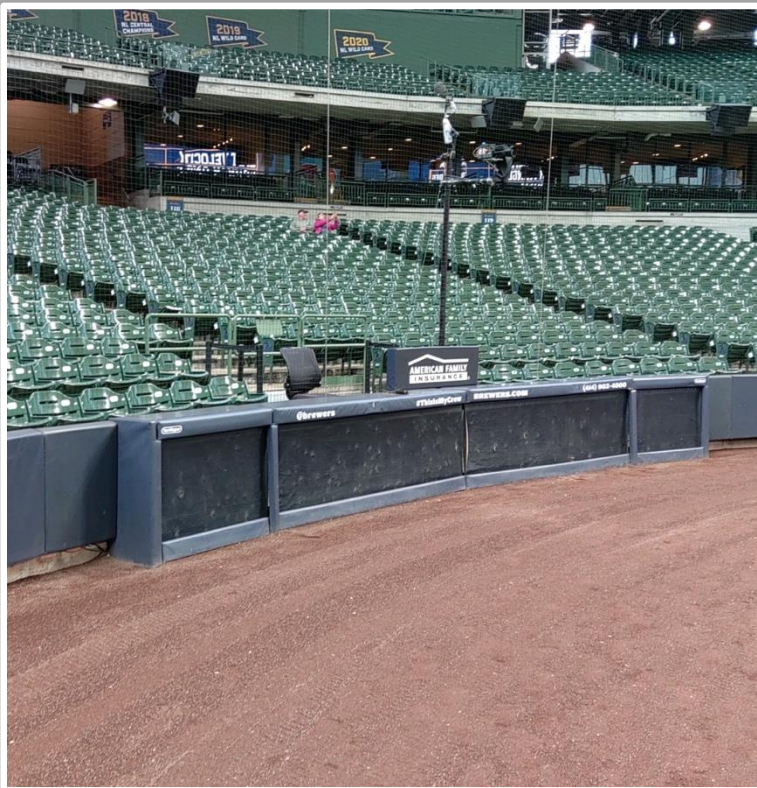
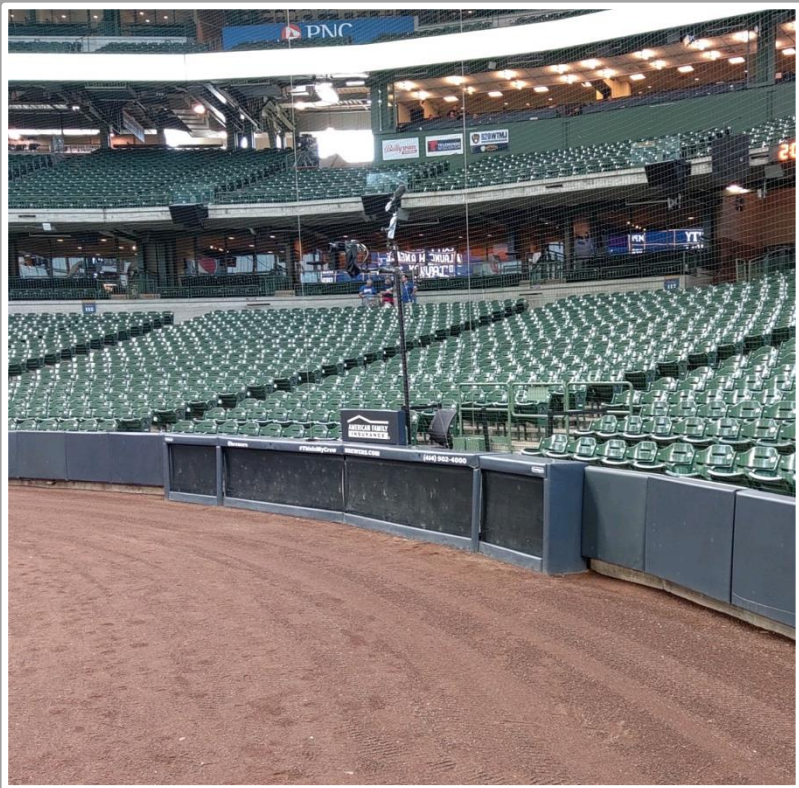

**RULE #8:** Batted ball striking the roof, roof truss, roof cable, or any cabling over *fair territory and landing fair*: **Fair Ball**



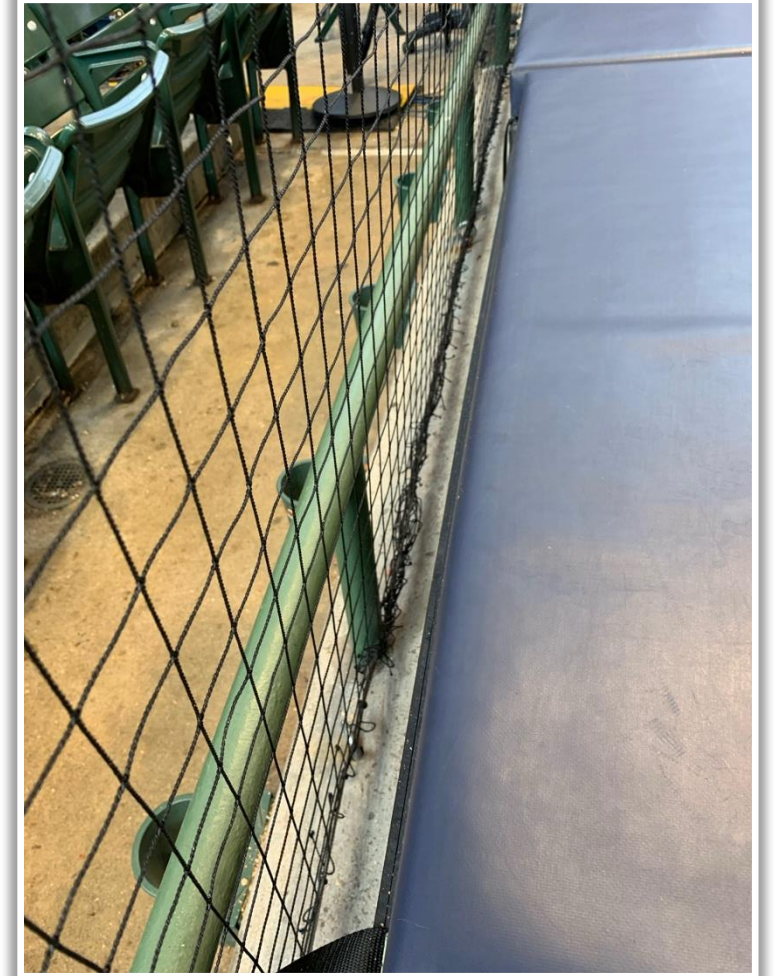
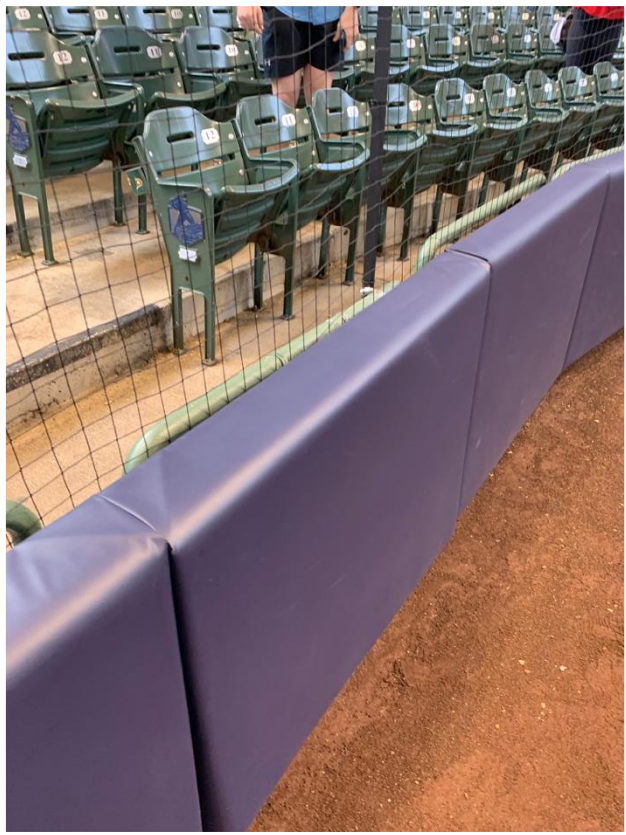
