NATIONALS NEWS

WELCOME HOME

Following a 3-3 road trip, the Washington Nationals will open a seven-game homestand on Friday night against the Baltimore Orioles in the first installment of the Beltway Series in 2026.

- The Nationals are 7-3 (.700) against the Orioles since the start of the 2024 season...Washington has outscored Baltimore 55-32 and has pitched to a 2.74 ERA during this 10-game stretch.
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati...Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home.

ROSTER MOVE

The Nationals recalled left-handed pitcher **Andrew Alvarez** from Triple-A Rochester on Friday and optioned right-handed pitcher **Zak Kent** to Triple-A Rochester on Thursday.

- Alvarez returns for his second Major League stint of the season...HE is 2-1 with a 1.95 ERA, 25 strikeouts, a .194 opponents' average and a 1.08 WHIP in six career Major League games (5 GS) since his big league debut on Sept. 1, 2025.
- Washington's 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year, Alvarez is tied for first among Nationals Minor Leaguers with 45 strikeouts in seven outings (34.0 IP) with Triple-A Rochester...His 11.9 strikeouts per 9.0 innings leads the system and ranks third in the International League. Alvarez is 2-1 with a 5.29 ERA for the Red Wings in 2026.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals have won five of eight, six of 10 and 10 of 17 games since April 25...They have won four of their last six series...Prior to the road trip, the Nationals won three of their last four home games.

- Washington leads Major League Baseball with 14 wins (14-15, .483) against teams with records of .500 or better...Washington's 29 games against teams with a record of .500 or better lead the league.
- Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team.

HOMER HAPPY

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 15 home runs in eight games since May 6, ahead of the Philadelphia Phillies (13) and Seattle Mariners (12)...The Nationals have homered at least once in six of the eight games.

- Daylen Lile's** three homers are tied for third in the National League over this stretch.

SPEAKING OF DAYLEN...

Daylen Lile is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with a .697 slugging percentage (3 2B, 3 HR) with eight RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and seven runs scored in his last nine games...He's hit safely in seven of the nine and has reached safely in eight of the nine.

- Thanks to this stretch, Lile is now tied for seventh in the National League with 11 doubles.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 19-for-57 (.333) with five doubles, a triple, two homers, 15 RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 10 runs in his last 15 games...He's reached safely in 12 of the 15 (.406 OBP) and is slugging .561 during the stretch.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (3rd, 36), on-base percentage (4th, .390), OPS (6th, .922), wRC+ (6th, 158), wOBA (6th, .401) and slugging percentage (7th, .532).

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.1 MPH ahead of **Murakami Munetaka** (95.9).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 52 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for fourth in Major League Baseball.
- Six of his last eight hits have gone for extra bases (4 2B, 2 HR).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 236 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 87 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 26 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

ACE OF BASES

The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams as a club, according to Baseball Savant...They are tied for the Major League lead with five baserunning runs (*A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths.*)...The Nationals are tied with the Boston Red Sox (5).

- Nasim Nuñez** is tied for the Major League lead with three baserunning runs...His 17 stolen bases are the most in the National League and tied for the most in baseball with Cleveland's **Jose Ramirez**.

FARM REPORT

STREA-KING

Harrisburg shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 32 games this season, tied for the third-longest streak in Minor League Baseball and tied for the third-longest active streak...He ranks among Nationals farmhands in triples (1st, 3), average (2nd, .333), hits (2nd, 42), doubles (T2nd, 10), RBI (T3rd, 26), extra-base hits (4th, 18), slugging percentage (4th, .579), OPS (4th, .995) and on-base percentage (7th, .416).

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 26 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 60 starts and maintain an ERA under 4.05 since the beginning of 2024, entering the 2026 season.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST APPEARANCE

Littell allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits (1 HR) and one walk against the Miami Marlins at on May 9 loanDepot park.

vs. BALTIMORE

Littell is set to make his ninth career start against the Orioles...He is 2-3 with a 2.77 ERA with 33 strikeouts and just six walks in eight previous starts.

- He went 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts and two walks against them in 2025.

Littell is 1-0 with a 3.52 ERA (3 ER/7.2 IP) in his last two outings...On May 3 vs. Milwaukee, he allowed just one earned run on one hit with one walk and one strikeout in 3.2 innings of work.

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.

- Led the Rays in wins (11st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (11st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
- Went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (10 ER/49.1 ER) over his final nine starts from July 27 on and ranked second in the AL (4th in MLB) in ERA.
- Received two or fewer runs of support in 22 of 29 starts, including 17 of his final 20...His 3.22 run support average was the lowest in MLB and lowest in Rays history (prev. Tony Saunders, 3.51 in 1998).
