AROUND THE HORN

THE HONDO RODEO FEST RETURNS NOV. 13-15: The Hondo Rodeo Fest returns to Chase Field for its third year from November 13-15, featuring a weekend of elite rodeo action and full-length concerts by Tim McGraw with Miranda Lambert on Friday, Nov. 13, Blake Shelton with Turnpike Troubadours on Sat., Nov. 14 and Parker McCollum with Lynyrd Skynyrd on Sunday, Nov. 15...tickets go on sale Monday, June 1 at 12:00 p.m. AZ.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs' 14 wins (14-5) are tied for most in the Majors (also: Brewers).

- The D-backs are 10-2 in their last 12 games and 11-3 in their last 14 games.
- Since May 10, **Ketel Marte** (1.140 OPS) and **Corbin Carroll** (1.070 OPS) rank second and sixth in MLB, respectively,...no other club features multiple players in the top 10 OPS leaders in that span.
- **Nolan Arenado's** season-high 18-game on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Majors...has reached base 30 times (16 H, 10 BB, 4 HBP)/.943 OPS with 8 doubles, 2 homers and 10 RBI in that span.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, hitting .371 (23-for-62)/1.134 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 12 walks, including 13 games reaching 2+ times.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-6 @ Mariners in 10 innings to snap their 5-game winning streak...the D-backs overcame deficits of 3-0 and 5-1 to tie the game at 6-6 in the ninth inning.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** recorded his 500th career hit and came a triple shy of the cycle with his fourth 3-hit game of the season (3-for-3, 2B, HR, RBI).
- **Gabriel Moreno** had his second 3-hit game of the season (2B, 2 RBI).
- **Jose Fernandez** had his third career 3-hit game (2 2B, RBI).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** had 2 RBI, including the game-tying ninth-inning RBI.

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 6 series, including 2 sweeps (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants).

1-RUN AFFAIRS: The D-backs (20 G, 11-9) and Mariners' (20 G, 8-12) have played the most 1-run games.

- The D-backs' 11 1-run wins are tied for most in MLB with the Cardinals, Phillies and White Sox.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: The D-backs are 9-7 in Interleague play this season.

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 11 games, is hitting .419 (18-for-43)/1.177 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 triples, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 5 walks, including 7 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 16 games, is hitting .327 (18-for-55)/1.126 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 15 walks, including 12 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- **Nolan Arenado**, in his last 14 games, is hitting .388 (19-for-49)/1.140 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI, 3 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch, including 8 games reaching base safely 2+ times.

COMEBACK WINS: The D-backs have won after trailing in 3 of their last 4 games...their 19 comeback wins are tied for most in the Majors, along with the Braves.

DOMO TO 500: **Geraldo Perdomo** became the fifth infielder or catcher in D-backs history to reach 500+ hits within their first 615 career games (also: Paul Goldschmidt 663, Stephen Drew 629, Chad Tracy 602 and Miguel Montero 541).

KETEL KILLIN' IT: Since May 16, **Ketel Marte** leads the Majors in OPS (1.341), AVG (.471), hits (24), RBI (17), total bases (42) and extra-base hits (10)...ranks among leaders in time on base (2nd, 30), OBP (3rd, .517) and SLG (3rd, .824).

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 17 quality starts in their last 23 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 15 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in wins innings (1st, 148.2), IP/G (1st, 6.1), OBP (1st, .264), WHIP (2nd, 1.02), (T-3rd, 15), ERA (3rd, 2.72) and OPS (5th, .621).
- The D-backs' 17 quality starts in May are 1 shy of tying the club's all-time May record of 18 set in 2002.
- It is only the D-backs' second season all-time with 17+ quality starts in May (last: 18 in 2002) and ninth time with 16+.

BULLPEN FOCUS: **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in his last 13 games (9.1 IP) and boasts an opponent .100 AVG (3-for-30)/.252 OPS, 0.54 WHIP, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.

• **Jonathan Loaisiga** is scoreless in his last 8 games (7.0 IP) and owns an opponent .130 AVG (3-for-23)/.304 OPS, 0.43 WHIP, 0 walks and 1 strikeout.

ERROR-FREE: Since May 17 (ninth inning) @ Rockies, the D-backs are errorless in 100.1 consecutive innings, the Majors' longest active errorless streak...second streak of 80.0+ errorless innings (also: 84.0 innings from April 13-25).

UPCOMING MILESTONES: The D-backs are 2 wins shy (2,198) of 2,200 regular-season wins as a franchise.

- **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** is 1 game shy of 500 career.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 5 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** is 1 win shy of 100 career.

VS. MARINERS: The D-backs swept the last series (3-0) June 9-11, 2025 at home...outscored Mariners 23-9.

- Are 4-1 in their last 5 games since April 28, 2024.
- Are 7-5 in their last 12 games and have taken 2 of their last 3 road series (July 27-29, 2015 and Sept. 10-12, 2021).

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 4 games vs. Mariners is batting .313 (5-for-16)/1.006 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 games vs. Mariners (11 H, 8 BB)/.413 OBP with 1 double and 2 RBI.
- **Corbin Carroll** has a 4-game hitting streak vs. Mariners, batting .333 (6-for-20)/.983 OPS with 2 triples, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 1 walk.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (5-3, 5.25)

- Has won 4 straight starts, going 4-0 with a 2.17 ERA (7 ER in 29.0 IP), 0.83 WHIP, 5 walks and 17 strikeouts.
- In his last 2 road bids, is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER in 16.0 IP), 0.63 WHIP, 2 walks and 7 strikeouts.
- Will make his fourth career start vs. Mariners...in his lone career start @ Mariners last season, went decisionless after tossing 5.2 innings (2 ER, 0 BB, 6 K).
