THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
SEPT. 25

1986 - RHP **Mike Scott** clinches the NL West Division title for the Astros in historic fashion by hurling a 2-0, no-hit victory over the Giants in the Dome. Scott, who tallied 13 strikeouts in the win, would go on to win the NL Cy Young Award later that season, finishing with an 18-10 while leading the Majors in both ERA (2.22) and strikeouts (306)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Houston Astros will continue their final road trip of the regular season with the third game of a four-game series against the Athletics at Sutter Health Park in West Sacramento, CA...**RHP Hayden Wesneski** (5-2) will be on the mound for the Astros, opposite **RHP Jack Perkins** (3-12) and the Athletics.

BIG WES: Tonight will be the 11th Major League start of the season for **RHP Hayden Wesneski**, who rejoined the Astros rotation on July 29 after missing 14 months while recovering from Tommy John surgery...since his return, he's been one of the Astros best starters, leading the club in wins (5) and ranking second in innings (54.0), while pitching through the 5th inning in eight of his 10 starts.

THE POSTSEASON CHASE: The Astros and Rangers are locked in a tight race down the stretch for the AL West with the two teams having the same record with two games left to play...the Astros own the tiebreaker over the Rangers with a season series victory (9-4 record).

NEXT GAME

CLINCH SCENARIO: The Astros can clinch the AL West division tonight with a win against the Athletics and the Rangers losing to the Twins.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: This is the final series between the Astros and Athletics this season, with the two clubs last seeing each other from Aug. 21-23 at Daikin Park...the Astros have gone 5-6 vs. the Athletics this season...the Astros also own an overall regular season record of 125-112 against the Athletics, including a 60-61 record on the road.

ROAD WARRIORS: Tonight is the fourth game of a six-game road trip for the Astros...since going 1-9 on the first road trip of the 2026 season, the Astros have gone 39-30 (.565) on the road since April 14, which ranks third in the AL in that span, behind the Red Sox (43-28) and the Yankees (42-30).

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Astros were defeated by the Athletics, 5-6, last night at Sutter Health Park...**RHP Hunter Brown** allowed two runs (one earned run) on two hits and four walks with four strikeouts in 5.1 innings...**C Yainer Diaz** (2x4, 2B, RBI), **1B Christian Walker** (1x3, HR, RBI) and **RF Cam Smith** (1x3, HR, RBI) each drove in a run for the Astros.

GOIN' DEEP: The Astros have hit 220 homers as a team this year and have hit 200-plus homers in a single season for the 10th time in franchise history (last, 222 HR in 2023)...the Astros rank second in the AL in home runs this season behind only the Yankees (223).

TWO-OUT MAGIC: The Astros lead the American League in two-out runs with 315 on the season, trailing only the Cubs (332) in the Majors...**3B Isaac Paredes** leads this effort, as he holds the Major League lead with 45 two-out RBI, directly ahead of **CHC Pete Crow-Armstrong**, **DET C Dillon Dingler** and **STL 1B Alec Burleson** (44 RBI).

THE CASE FOR THE MVP: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award...Alvarez leads the American League in OPS (1.037), slugging percentage (.599), OBP (.433), batting average (.315), total bases (334), walks (109), IBB (33), wRC+ (180), OPS+ (.190) and extra-base hits (75)...he also ranks tied for second in home runs (41), second in RBI (102), second in hits (176), tied for third in doubles (33) and fourth in runs (102).

TRIFECTA: **CF Lucas Spence** went 3x4 with three home runs and five RBI on Thurs. night vs. the Athletics...he became the third player in Major League history to hit their first three career home runs in the same game, joining **STL OF Joshua Baez** (Aug. 15, 2026) and **CWS C Seby Zavala** (July 31, 2021)...Spence is the second rookie in Astros franchise history to record a three-homer game, joining **DH Yordan Alvarez** (Aug. 10, 2019 at BAL)...it was the first three-homer game by an Astro this season (last, **IF Jose Altuve** on Sept. 5, 2023 vs. TEX).

ANNUAL HOUSTON BBWAA AWARDS: On Thursday, the Houston BBWAA Chapter Chairman Chandler Rome (The Athletic) announced the 2026 Houston BBWAA Awards:

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: Thurs. night's victory was the 254th win for Astros Manager **Joe Espada** tying him with **Hal Lanier** for the ninth-most managerial wins in Astros franchise history...Espada owns a 254-229 record with the Astros.

STRONG SEPTEMBERS: **3B Isaac Paredes** has a .979 OPS this month to go along with a team-leading 20 RBI, which ranks tied for third in the AL...**C Yainer Diaz** is also having a strong September, as he's hitting .351 (26x74) with four homers, 11 RBI and a .971 OPS in 21 games (18 starts) this month.

POSTSEASON CREDENTIALS: All media who wish to cover potential Astros postseason home games in the Wild Card Series and ALDS must apply for credentials on MLB's credentialing system...the events are now open with a deadline set for Sunday, Sept. 27...ALCS and World Series credential applications are also live online.

RACKING UP K'S: RHP **Bryan Abreu** has posted 528 career strikeouts, which ranks fourth among relievers in Astros history...he's closing in on third-place **RHP Dave Smith** (529), needing only one strikeout to match the Astros reliever from the 1980s...**LHP Billy Wagner** (694) and **RHP Brad Lidge** (557) sit atop that all-time list.

THE FIREMAN: LHP **Josh Hader** has converted 26 consecutive save chances to open his season, which is the Astros record...should Hader finish the season without a blown save, he would become the seventh pitcher in MLB history to post 26-plus saves without a blown save...the last Major Leaguer to do so was **RHP Ken Giles** in 2018 (26 SV).

LAST START, SEPT. 19 vs. ATL: Had a strong start his last time out last Saturday vs. ATL, working 5.1 innings, allowing 1 run on 4 hits and 3 walks...tossed 79 pitches (50 strikes) in the outing...left the game carrying a 2-1 lead, which ended as a 6-3 Astros loss.

RETURN OF THE WEZ: In his return from Tommy John surgery, he's posted a 5-2 record and a 3.50 ERA (21ER/54IP), a 1.15 WHIP and a .219 (43x196) opponent batting average through his first 10 Major League starts of the year...the Astros are 7-3 in his starts...leads the Astros in wins and ranks 2nd in innings pitched since his season debut on July 29.

WINNER, WINNER: Has set his single-season career high with his 5 winning decisions this season, surpassing 3 wins each season from 2022-24.

VS. ATH: Has faced the A's twice in his career, going 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1ER/12IP) in those outings...earned one of those wins this season on Aug. 21 in Houston (0ER/5IP)...allowed just 1 hit in that start, a single to **Donovan Walton**.

ON THE CHASE: Has induced a 34.3-percent chase rate, which would mark a career high...his previous high was a 30.2-percent rate with the Cubs in 2024.

ON THE WAY BACK: Underwent Tommy John surgery on May 23, 2025...returned to the mound to begin his rehab appearances on June 30, 2026, with the FCL Astros (3IP)...advanced to Double A Corpus Christi for 1 start, then made 3 starts for Triple A Sugar Land...combined to post a 2.25 ERA (5ER/20IP) in his 5 rehab appearances...struck out 21 in his 20.0 innings, allowed a .211 opponent average, and posted a 1.00 WHIP...walked just 4 hitters across his 5 rehab starts.

WESNESKI IN 2025: Began last season in the Astros starting rotation and went on to make 6 starts, going 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA (16ER/32IP) prior to his injury...had a couple strong starts, tossing a career-high-tying 7.0 innings on April 7 at SEA, and fanning a career-high 10 hitters on April 13 vs. LAA.

THE WESNESKI TRADE: Acquired by the Astros from the Cubs on Dec. 13, 2024 as part of the return for All-Star **OF Kyle Tucker**...the Astros received Wesneski, **3B Isaac Paredes** and **RF Cam Smith** in that trade.

HOUSTON'S OWN: Wesneski was born in Houston, TX, and raised in Cypress, TX, which is about a 25-mile drive northwest of downtown Houston...grew up an Astros fan with **RHP Roy Oswalt** as his favorite player...he graduated from Cy Fair HS, then went on to nearby Sam Houston State, where he pitched for 3 seasons...was selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2019 MLB draft...was traded twice after his selection, first by the Yankees to the Cubs, then by the Cubs to the Astros.

WHAT'S A BEARKAT ANYWAY?: Is one of the most-accomplished pitchers in Sam Houston State history...went 25-9 with a 3.56 ERA and 224 strikeouts (288.0 IP) in 3 years with the Bearkats (2017-19)...his 224 career strikeouts rank 4th all-time in program history...other notable Bearkats include Astros radio broadcaster **Steve Sparks** and Astros 2024 first-round pick **C Walker Janek**.

LAST APPEARANCE (9/24 at ATH): Recorded his 9th save of the season on Thursday night, tossing 1.1 scoreless innings while working around 1 hit and 1 walk...was his 6th career multi-inning save, including his 3rd this season (last, July 29 at LAA)...his 9 saves are his most in a single season, surpassing 7 saves in 2025.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 6-2-8 with a 2.19 ERA (13ER/53.1IP)...also has recorded 64 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP and a .181 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...among AL relievers since May 3 (min. 50 IP), he ranks 7th in opponent batting average and 8th in SO/9 (10.80).

ASTROS RANKINGS: Has posted 528 career strikeouts and is 1 strikeout from matching RHP Dave Smith (529) for the 3rd-most by a reliever in Astros history...the two trail only LHP Billy Wagner (694) and RHP Brad Lidge (557) on that all-time list.

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 97th percentile in whiff perc. (33.8%), 91st percentile in K rate (29.9%) and 92nd percentile in xBA (.197) per Baseball Savant.

THE WAY BACK: Missed nearly the first 4 months of the 2026 season after undergoing right elbow surgery in June of 2025...was reinstated from the Injured List on July 20...since then, has combined to make 9 appearances between the Major league and minor league levels.
