**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles notched their second shutout of the season to beat the Athletics, 7-0...**Cole Irvin** fired 7.0 innings, tied for the longest outing of the year by an Oriole, to extend his scoreless streak to a career-high 14.1 innings...**Adley Rutschman** and **Ryan Mountcastle** hit back-to-back solo homers in the fifth inning, while **Gunnar Henderson** launched his team-leading ninth of the year with a two-run shot in the seventh.  
 ⚡ Rutschman and Mountcastle went deep on back-to-back pitches, the first time the O's have done that since Trey Mancini and Mountcastle did so on July 3, 2022 at Minnesota.

**BURNING RUBBER:** The O's and A's square off in a rubber game in today's series finale...The O's are 3-1 in rubber games this year and went 12-8 in rubber matches in 2023.

**KIMBREL COUNT:** **Craig Kimbrel** recorded the 424<sup>th</sup> save of his career Wednesday afternoon in Anaheim, tying John Franco for sixth in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (425) has more among active players...Kimbrel has 1,209 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever behind Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225); the 1,209 punch outs by Kimbrel are the most by a player in MLB history who never started a game.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 41 home runs, the most homers through the first 26 games in O's history; the most homers through Baltimore's first 27 games of a season is also 41 by the 2020 team.

⚡ The Orioles are one of two MLB teams (also Los Angeles-NL) with four players who've hit at least five home runs: **Gunnar Henderson** (9), **Colton Cowser** and **Cedric Mullins** (6), and **Jordan Westburg** (5).

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** has scored in a run in seven straight games since April 20 and in 11 of 12 since April 14; his current seven-game stretch is the longest by an Oriole since **Colton Cowser** scored in each of his first eight career games from July 5-17, 2023, and is the second-longest by a Major Leaguer this season behind Philadelphia's Trea Turner (8) from April 13-21... Henderson has hit in 11 of 13 games since April 13 while slashing .389/.443/.796 (21-for-54) with two doubles, one triple, six home runs, 14 runs scored, 14 RBI, two walks, four hit-by-pitches, and three stolen bases; during that time, he leads MLB in home runs, slugging percentage, and total bases (43), leads the AL in batting average, OPS (1.239), and runs scored, and is tied for the AL lead in hits and extra-base hits (9).

⚡ Henderson's eight home runs this month are tied for the fifth-most in April in O's history (since 1954); only **Brady Anderson** (11, 1996), Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Frank Robinson** (10, 1969), **Manny Machado** (9, 2018), and **Chris Davis** (9, 2013) have more, while Anderson and Robinson are the only Orioles with 10+ homers before May 1.

**THEY'VE GOT POP:** The O's lead the AL and are second in MLB with a 90.4 mph average exit velocity, per *Statcast* (see box at right)...The O's lead MLB with 72 barrels, and also lead the AL and are second in MLB with 317 hard-hit balls (95+ mph)...**Gunnar Henderson** ranks second among all hitters with a 95.6 mph average exit velo (see box at right).

**RUN IT UP:** The Orioles lead the AL and rank tied for third in MLB with 145 runs scored...Their +35 run differential is third in the AL, while their 5.58 runs per game leads the AL and ranks second in MLB behind the Braves (5.80).

**DOWN BUT NOT OUT:** The Orioles are slashing .189/.240/.347 (89-for-470) in two-strike counts...They lead MLB in slugging, OPS (.586), and extra-base hits (39) with two strikes, and are second in home runs (16)...**Jordan Westburg** leads MLB with a .622 slugging percentage in two-strike counts while **Gunnar Henderson** ranks third with a .600 slugging with two strikes.

**WESTY AND HIS BESTY:** **Colton Cowser** and **Jordan Westburg** have been named AL Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks, with Cowser winning for the period of April 8-14 and Westburg for the period of April 15-21...The O's are the first team to win consecutive Player of the Week honors since the Braves for the weeks of August 14 and 21, 2023 (Olson/Rosario), and the first AL team since the Astros for the weeks of August 7 and 14, 2023 (Valdez/Altuve)...The last time the Orioles earned back-to-back Player of the Week honors was 1981, when Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray** won two straight for the weeks of September 13 and 20...Overall, it is the third time Baltimore earned back-to-back weekly honors after **Don Baylor** won on August 10, 1975, followed by Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Jim Palmer** and **Ken Singleton** winning co-honors on August 17.

**ELECTRIC AVENUE:** **Cedric Mullins** earned his MLB-leading seventh career Electric Play of the Week award for his *diving catch* on April 15 vs. Minnesota...Mullins went full extension in center field to rob Kyle Farmer for the last out of the top of the first inning...The Orioles have an MLB-best 13 Play of the Week awards since 2019.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles are in the middle of a seven-game homestand against the A's (3 G) and Yankees (4 G)...The O's are 9-5 at home to start the year...Last season, the Orioles went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617) at Camden Yards...Marked the third-best home record in the AL in 2023 behind Tampa Bay at 53-28 (.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

**WAR OF THE VOWELS:** The O's and A's wrap up their first of two three-game, regular-season series with today's game...The Orioles will travel to Oakland from July 5-7...The Birds went 6-1 against the Athletics last year, taking three out of four in Baltimore from April 10-13 before completing a three-game sweep in Oakland from August 18-20.

**O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO:** The Birds went 4-2 on their six-game road trip against the Royals (2-1) and Angels (2-1) from April 19-24...Their next trip will be a five-gamer in Cincinnati (3 G) and Washington (2 G) from May 3-8...The club has scheduled off days on May 6 and May 9...The O's are off to an 8-4 road start this year...Last season, the Orioles went 52-29 (.642) away from Camden Yards, tied with the Braves for the best road record in MLB and tied with the 1997 O's squad for the best road record in club history (since 1954); marked the third time an O's team reached 50 road wins, joining 1997 (52) and 1980 (50).

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** The Orioles have now gone 100 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)... Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72... The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

⚡ The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 332 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his third start of the season and second career start against the Athletics...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances...Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League before signing with the O's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits(3 HR) and 24 strikeouts in 11 starts...Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023...Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Secured the win on April 22 at Los Angeles-AL, allowing four hits with five strikeouts across 5.2 shutout innings; marked his first major league win since June 23, 2016 at Pittsburgh (w/SF)...Became the first pitcher with an outing of five or more innings and no runs allowed in each of his first two appearances after not appearing in MLB for five or more years since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*... Threw 89 pitches, 52 strikes.

**AGAINST THE ATHLETICS:** Making his third career appearance and second start against Oakland...Pitched in relief in his last matchup against the Athletics on August 2, 2017 (w/SF)...Allowed two runs on five hits and one walk with five strikeouts and one hit batter across 3.0 innings.

**AGAINST THE AL WEST:** Owns a lifetime 1-0 record and a 3.14 ERA (5 ER/14.1 IP) in three career appearances (2GS) against the AL West...Opponents are slashing .226/.317/.321(12-for-53).

**DAY 'N' NITE:** Owns a 2-2 record with a 3.18 ERA (16 ER/45.1 IP) in 14 lifetime appearances (6 GS) during the day, compared to a 2-6 record with a 4.63 ERA (42 ER/81.2 IP) in 28 career night appearances (8 GS).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Has posted a 2-3 record with a 2.92 ERA (20 ER/61.2 IP) in 22 career appearances (6 GS) at home...Opponents are slashing .230/.281/.365 (53-for-230).

**MR. WORLDWIDE:** Pitched three seasons with the Yakult Swallows in Nippon Professional Baseball from 2019-2021...Owns a lifetime 10-8 record with a 3.00 ERA (54 ER/162. IP) and 134 strikeouts in 40 appearances with the Swallows... Also played for Samsung in the KBO for the 2022 and 2023 campaigns; posted a 3.04 ERA (95 ER/281.2 IP) across 49 appearances (48 GS) with the Lions.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Spent the season with Samsung...Did not allow a run in three straight starts (19.0 IP) from July 4-25...Tossed 8.0 scoreless innings on four hits and four walks with four strikeouts on July 25 vs. Kia.
