THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2 (2-1 vs. Boston and 3-1 vs. Seattle), the Twins began their three-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in Toronto this weekend...today, they will play the three-game series finale at Rogers Centre...after today's game, they will travel back to Minneapolis for an off-day tomorrow then play a three-game homestand/series against New York-AL.
 ☞ Twins have won 16 of their last 19 games...since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (16-3), ahead of the Dodgers (14-3) and Phillies (14-4).
 ☞ The Twins are 0-1 in rubber games this season (3 game series April 19-21 vs. DET).

TWINS BLOW BIG LEAD NORTH OF THE BORDER: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays yesterday afternoon by a score of 10-8 at Rogers Centre, blowing a 7-1 lead...the loss snapped a seven-game road winning streak, one short of tying the club record...it marked their first loss away from Minnesota since April 17 at Baltimore...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on eight hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow five runs on eight hits and three walks in 3.2 innings of relief...the offense recorded 13 hits, led by Carlos Santana, who went 2-for-4 with a home run (5), two runs scored and three RBI...Ryan Jeffers added a home run, his team-leading ninth of the season.

NORTH STARS AND MAPLE LEAFS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the third of six meetings in 2024...Minnesota will host Toronto for three games from July 30-August 1.
 ☞ In 29 regular season games vs. Toronto, Carlos Correa is hitting .325 (37-for-114) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 24 RBI and a .982 OPS in 29 games...he has reached base safely against the Jays in the regular season in 14 consecutive games.
 ☞ Edouard Julien is 8-for-21 (.381) with four doubles, one home run, six walks, a .519 on-base percentage and a 1.233 OPS in seven career regular season games against Toronto.
 ☞ Manager Rocco Baldelli homered in his first career game at Rogers Centre on May 13, 2003, a solo shot off Trevor Miller, while playing for the Devil Rays...he hit safely in each of his first 11 games at the Rogers Centre from May 13, 2003-June 22, 2004.

POUTINE POP: Twins have homered in 19-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 39 total homers in those 19...below are the longest homer streaks in an opposing park in Twins history (since 1961):

SHAKE HANDS WITH PERK: In his last 16 games, Carlos Santana has posted a .988 OPS with three doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI and just a 9.7 strikeout percentage...in his previous 20 games, he posted a .407 OPS with two doubles, no home runs, three RBI and a 23.0 strikeout percentage...additionally, he has a .929 OPS in 36 career regular season games at Rogers Centre.

KEP ON KEPPING ON: Max Kepler enters today with a career-high 13-game hitting streak (previous best was 10 G)...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .424 (25-for-59) with eight doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 15 RBI, a .478 on-base percentage and a 1.189 OPS (MLB-best in that span) in 18 games.
 ☞ Kepler's streak is the longest by a Twin this season and longest by a Twin since Ryan Jeffers hit in 14 straight from July 15-August 9, 2023.

☞ Kepler's 13-game hitting streak is the longest active hitting streak in baseball...just five MLB players have reached hitting streaks of at least 14 games this season: Alec Bohm (18), Marcell Ozuna (17), Ozzie Albies (15), Willson Contreras (14) and Amed Rosario (14).

MAX POP: Max Kepler hit another double yesterday, giving him six in his last seven games...he is tied with Vinnie Pasquantino for most doubles in the AL this month (6)...he needs one double to tie César Tovar for 13th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

LET'S TRY THIS AGAIN: The Twins are looking for their seventh series win this season (6-4-2)...2024 series results to the lower right...Minnesota's last series win in the regular season over Toronto came June 9-11, 2023 at Rogers Centre, taking two of three.

☞ Twins are looking for six consecutive series wins for the first time since August 27-September 16, 2010, when they won series at Seattle, vs. Detroit, vs. Texas, vs. Kansas City, at Cleveland and at Chicago-AL.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita outfielder Carson McCusker and Wichita right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews as Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ McCusker, 25, played in five games for the Wind Surge this week, hitting .526 (10-for-19) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.819 OPS...the 6-foot-8, 250-pound outfielder went 5-for-5 on Tuesday vs. Arkansas...the Sparks, Nevada native was signed by the Twins in June of 2023 and originally selected by the Brewers in the 26th round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Folsom Lake College in California.
 ☞ Matthews, 23, made his Double-A debut on Thursday vs. Arkansas, allowing two unearned runs on three hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with no walks and nine strikeouts...the Cullowhee, North Carolina native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Western Carolina University.

DID YOU KNOW?: Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins appeared in 20 career games (3 starts) against the Blue Jays, going 0-2, 3.38 ERA (34.2 IP, 13 ER), with one save, three holds, nine walks and 26 strikeouts...Toronto was the only AL opponent in which he did not get multiple saves against...his second career major league start was against the Jays on May 15, 2008 at the Metrodome facing this lineup: 1) Brad Wilkerson, RF 2) Aaron Hill, 2B 3) Alex Rios, CF 4) Scott Rolen, 3B 5) Kevin Mench, LF 6) Shannon Stewart, DH 7) Lyle Overbay, 1B 8) Rod Barajas, C 9) Marco Scutaro, SS...Perk allowed two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched (ND), with two walks and six strikeouts in a Twins 3-2, 11 inning loss.

- ☞ Making eighth start of season and 65th of career...has allowed 10 earned runs in 35.1 innings (2.55 ERA) across six starts since eight-run season debut March 31 in Kansas City.
- ☞ Last pitched on May 7 vs. Seattle, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and tying a season-high seven strikeouts...earned a no-decision in the Twins' 10-6 win.
- ☞ Has made three career starts vs. Toronto Blue Jays, going 1-2 with a 4.40 ERA (14.1 IP, 7 ER), three walks and 16 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced Seattle on May 7 and did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 10-6 win...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...generated 13 whiffs in 46 swings (28.3%)...allowed both runs in the second, on Mitch Haniger's home run and Dylan Moore's RBI double...had a pair of strikeouts in the third and fourth innings before concluding with a 1-2-3 final inning...in his last six starts since eight-run season debut March 31 in Kansas City, has gone 3-0 with a 2.55 ERA (35.1 IP, 10 ER), seven walks and 34 strikeouts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Faced Chicago-AL on May 1 for the first time this season, earned his third consecutive win of the season (tied for team lead), one shy of his career high...allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR), no walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...gave up two runs in the first inning; Tommy Pham doubled to plate Robbie Grossman and an Andrew Vaughn single drove in the second run...allowed a third-inning home run to Tommy Pham, the first home run he allowed since March 31 at Kansas City where he allowed three...longest streak of his career since April 28-September 21, 2022 (19.0 innings)...made four-straight starts of 6.0-plus innings from April 14-May 1.

HITTING HIS STRIDE: Since April 8, Ober has gone 3-0, 2.55 ERA (35.1 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 34 strikeouts...since that date, he leads the AL in opponent batting average (.165), WHIP (0.76) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.13); is also eighth in fielding independent pitching (2.57) and tied for eighth in ERA.

VS. TORONTO: Has made three career starts vs. Toronto, going 1-2, 4.40 ERA (14.1 IP, 7 ER), three walks and 16 strikeouts...Toronto hitters have hit .241 (13-for-54) with a .418 slugging percentage and a .762 OPS.

- ☞ In his last start against the Blue Jays on May 28, 2023, Ober allowed two runs on five hits, one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...his third career loss came against the Blue Jays on September 19, 2021 at Rogers Centre — his only start in this ballpark.
- ☞ Only win vs. Toronto came on September 24, 2021...tossed 5.1 innings, allowing just one run on four hits (1 HR), no walks and six strikeouts.

ROAD TRIPPIN': Making his fifth road start of the season today...in previous four, has gone 2-1 with a 6.10 ERA (20.2 IP, 14 ER), four walks, 15 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP and a .259 (21-for-81) opponent batting average...compared to three home starts, he is 1-0, 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 20 strikeouts, a 0.75 WHIP and a .151 (8-for-53) opponent batting average

- ☞ Has gone 8-9 with a 3.98 ERA (165.0 IP, 73 ER) in 32 career road starts, compared to 8-4 with a 3.45 ERA (164.1 IP, 63 ER) in 32 career home starts.
- ☞ After his outing at Kauffman Stadium, Ober is 2-0, 2.79 ERA (19.1 IP, 6 ER) in his last three road starts.
- ☞ Since 2022, Ober is tied for third with teammate Griffin Jax with seven road wins.

REVERSE SPLITS: On May 7, Seattle left-handed hitters went 1-for-5 with one strikeout against Ober, while righties went 2-for-12 with one double, one home run and six strikeouts...through six games this season, lefties have hit .193 (11-for-57) with a .610 OPS and a 24.5 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .246 (18-for-77) with a .761 OPS and a 27.2 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Lefties have a 25.7 percent whiff rate and 85.1 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 22.4 percent whiff rate and 89.9 mph average exit velocity.
- ☞ In three career starts, Blue Jay left-handed hitters have hit .231 (3-for-13), with one extra-base hit (2B), seven strikeouts and a .593 OPS, while righties have hit .244 (10-for-41) with six extra-base hits, three doubles, three home runs, nine strikeouts and an .816 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seamer and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through six starts:

- ☞ Allowed three hits against Seattle hitters on May 7...all came against the 4-seam fastball going 3-for-6, with one double, one home run and two strikeouts.
- ☞ Ranks in the 94th percentile in MLB in offspeed run value (3).

ONE WIN AWAY: With a win in today's game, he will tie his career high with four consecutive wins dating back to April 20 against Detroit...his last four-game win streak was from September 27, 2022- May 16, 2023...during the three-game win-streak he has beaten Detroit, Los Angeles-AL and Chicago-AL.

SUN'S OUT: In four day games this season, he is 2-1, 6.05 ERA (19.1 IP, 13 ER), two walks, 13 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .260 (20-for-77)...compared to 1-0, 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 22 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .158 (9-for-57) in three night games.

2023 RECAP:

- ☞ Was Triple-A St. Paul's Opening Day starter and pitched in four games for Saints to begin the season, posting a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings.
- ☞ Recalled by Twins on April 23 and made season debut that day against Washington, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings, earning the win.
- ☞ Posted a 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 24 strikeouts over his next four starts with the Twins.
- ☞ Pitched 7.0 shutout innings twice: May 5 at Cleveland and July 1 at Baltimore.
- ☞ Allowed three earned runs or fewer in 15 of first 16 starts with Twins from April 23-July 23.
- ☞ Posted career-best four-start stretch (July 18-August 4) without issuing a walk.
- ☞ To limit innings, returned to Triple-A from August 28-September 15 and started once in that span.
- ☞ Set career highs in wins (8), innings pitched (144.1), starts (26) and strikeouts (146).
- ☞ Ranked fourth on Twins staff in starts, innings and strikeouts.
- ☞ Left off AL Wild Card Series roster vs. Toronto but added to ALDS roster vs. Houston.
- ☞ Made Postseason debut and started Game 1 at Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 3.0 innings...was dealt the loss in a 6-4 Twins defeat.
- ☞ Made second appearance in relief in Game 3 vs. Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 1.1 innings of Minnesota's 9-1 defeat.
