RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals visit Milwaukee this week for a short three-game series before returning home for an eight-game home stand with Cincinnati (4 games) and San Francisco (4), as they approach September...the Cardinals are in a stretch of 15 of 18 games at home...the Cardinals have won 4-straight since losing to the Brewers last Wed. (8/21) in a rain-shortened game and went 6-1 on their recent home stand (2-1 vs. MIL, 4-0 vs. COL)...tonight is the Cardinals' 14th of 16 straight games without an off-day (Aug. 13-28).

TIME TO FLY: Winners of seven of eight and 13 of their last 16, St. Louis sports the best record (13-3) across Major League Baseball since August 9 and the National League's 2nd-best winning pct. (.659, 27-14) since the All-Star break. The Cardinals enter today a season-high 13 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central, 2.5 games ahead of Chicago & 4.5 in front of Milwaukee.

BEER BASHER: Paul Goldschmidt has hit 13 home runs in 30 career games played at Miller Park, and is batting .414 (48-116) over his career...he tops all players including Brewers (min. 125 PA's) in OPS (1.338), SLG (.845) OBP (.493) and BA at the ballpark...Goldy matched his career single-game high in both HR's (3) and hits (4) on March 29...it was his 2nd career 4-hit game at Miller Park (also 6/29/12)...with six games left in the Cardinals-Brewers series in 2019, Goldschmidt's six home runs against Milwaukee rank T2nd among all Cardinals in a single season with **Jhonny Peralta**, who hit six home runs in 19 games in 2014. Only **Albert Pujols**, who hit eight home runs in 15 games in 2010 has hit more in a single year. The Cardinals single-season mark for RBI vs. MIL is 18 by **Scott Rolen** over 13 games in 2003, with Goldschmidt currently at 13 in 13 games.

TWO-OUT TERROR: Dexter Fowler had 3 two-out RBI yesterday, raising his season total to 23, which matches **Kolten Wong** for 2nd on the team, one back of **Marcell Ozuna** (24).

CARPENTER'S TOOLS: For the sixth time in his career, **Matt Carpenter** yesterday compiled 3 or more runs, 3+ hits, 2+ RBI & HR in a single game.

MONDAY FUNDAY: The Cardinals (10-2) are one of just three teams in the majors with 10 wins on Monday, joining the Yankees (10-3) and Tampa Bay (10-4).

THE GOLDY STANDARD: With his next home run, **Paul Goldschmidt** will reach 30 on the season, doing so for the 5th time since 2013...only four other players have had five or more 30-homer seasons since 2103: **Edwin Encarnacion** (7), **Nelson Cruz** (6), **Nolan Arenado** (5) and **Mike Trout** (5).

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Cardinals starters **Jack Flaherty** (23 yrs, 8 wins) and **Dakota Hudson** (24 yrs, 13 wins) have posted a combined 21 wins this season, the majors' top duo among starting pitchers 24 years & younger...the Rockies' **German Marquez** and **Antonio Senzatela** are 2nd with 20 combined wins...the last 24 & younger starting duo for St. Louis with as many as 20 combined wins was **Carlos Martínez** (14) and **Michael Wacha** (17), who combined for 31 wins in 2015.

POWER IN THE PEN: Cardinals relievers **John Brebbia** (78) & **Giovanny Gallegos** (79) are the first pair of Cardinals relievers with 70+ strikeouts in a season since **Trevor Rosenthal** (83) and **Kevin Siegrist** (90) did so in 2015.

WELCOME TO THE WINNER'S CIRCLE: Rookie **Ryan Helsley** gained his first ML win yesterday, as did lefty **Tyler Webb** last Tue...there have been 10 different Cardinals relievers who have recorded wins this season, one shy of the club record (11 relievers) in both 2018 & 2002.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Cardinals are 10-1 (.909) at home in August, with only Houston (.917, 11-1) sporting a higher home win pct in MLB. Overall this season, St. Louis is 40-24 at Busch Stadium with a .624 home win pct. (3rd in NL).

MOLINA MILESTONES: On Saturday, **Yadier Molina** caught his 150th career shutout, 4th-most all-time in MLB history since 1900, trailing **Carlton Fisk** (157), **Gary Carter** (168) and **Yogi Berra** (184). Molina made his 1,917th appearance at catcher this yesterday to tie **Benito Santiago** for 11th all-time in MLB history, and is now one career RBI from 900, two career walks from 500, and 15 hits from tying **Ozzie Smith** (1,944) for 7th all-time in Cardinals history.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Marcell Ozuna was a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder **Christian Yelich** (2013-17).

Dexter Fowler and **Jordan Lyles** were traded for each other during the 2013-14 offseason (Dec. 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler to Houston for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (Sept. 23, 2004).

Tyler Webb pitched for Brewers in two games in 2017...claimed off waivers by San Diego (April 2018).

Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was First Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American as a senior at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the University of Missouri before being selected by Milwaukee in the 2nd round of the 2013 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Hall of Famer, broadcaster and Special Assistant **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and 1980 Silver Slugger Award winner...later traded by St. Louis with pitchers **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** to Milwaukee for outfielders **David Green** and **Sixto Lezcano** and pitchers **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).
