RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers wrap up a four-game weekend series at American Family Field with this today's series finale ... The Cardinals visit Angel Stadium tomorrow for the first time since 2016 for a three-game Interleague series with the Los Angeles Angels. FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 9.0 games behind division-leading Milwaukee, and 4.5 games back in the NL Wild Card ... St. Louis is trying to snap a season-high seven-game losing streak (May 4-present), MLB's longest active and its longest since an eight-game skid last season (April 28-May 6,2023 ) ... St. Louis (0-6) is the only winless team on Sunday this season.
MOLDY CHEESE AND SKUNK BEER: With a win today, the Cardinals will have avoided their third four-game series sweep to the Brewers in franchise history (July 21-24, 2008 at Busch Stadium III and April 18-21, 2002 at Miller Park) ... The last time any team swept St. Louis in a four-game series was June 3-6, 2021 vs. Cincinnati at Busch III, and the last time on the road occurred June 5-8, 2017 at Great American Ball Park, which was part of an 0-7 road trip through Wrigley Field and Cincinnati.

HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY: The Cardinals will be wearing pink articles of apparel today in honor of Mother's Day throughout Major League Baseball, raising awareness to reduce rates of Breast Cancer ... Since Mother's Day became an official holiday in 1914, the Cardinals are 54-67-2 on this day (27-32-2 on the road) .... The Redbirds are 1-1 vs. Brew Crew on Mother's Day, winning 3-1 in 2011 at Busch III and losing 5-3 in Milwaukee in 2008.
WELL, WELL, WELL, HOW THE TURNTABLES: The Cardinals have lost 11 of their last 12 games and a franchise-record eight straight to the Brewers (Sept. 27, 2023-present) ... For the first time in club history, St. Louis has dropped the first six games of the season series to the Brew Crew ... The last time the Cardinals lost each of the first seven games to any opponent

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Happy 37th birthday to Cardinals starting pitcher Lance Lynn \#Bronco ... Also born today 99 years ago in St. Louis was Hall of Famer Yogi Berra (born May 12, 1925)
LEADING OFF: Matt Carpenter leads off for St. Louis today for the first time since May 30, 2021 at Arizona (2-for-4, 2 2B) ... Carp's 24 leadoff home runs are the most in Cardinals history, while his 25 career leadoff blasts rank T-8th among active Major Leaguers Carpenter's last leadoff homer was June 2, 2022 (G1) as a member of the Yankees off Shohei Ohtani at Yankee Stadium, while his last leadoff long ball in a Cardinals uniform was June 4, 2019 off Cincinnati's Luis Castillo at Busch Stadium ... Carp has three Ieadoff dingers vs. the Brewers: June 21, 2018 at Milwaukee off Brent Suter; April 10, 2018 at Busch III off J.J. Hoover; and August 8, 2015 at Milwaukee off Wily Peralta ... Carpenter has hit 111 career homers from the \#1 spot in lineup, most in Cardinals history (Lou Brock is 2nd with 95).
I WANNA BE LIKE MIKE: Michael Siani is riding a career high seven-game hitting streak (9-19, .474) since April 30, tied for the 4th-longest active hitting streak in Major League Baseball ... Siani is batting . 444 (8-17) in month of May, 6th-highest in MLB.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: The Cardinals and Orioles are tied for 2nd in MLB in fielding pct. (.990) behind the Braves (.991) ... Masyn Winn leads MLB shortstops in defensive runs saved (8), T-4th most in MLB ... Nolan Arenado leads MLB third baseman in outs above average (4), while Michael Siani ranks among MLB outfielders in Outs Above average (4, T-3rd) \& Runs Prevented (4, T-2nd).
THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 12, 1969): Bob Gibson records the first "immaculate inning" in franchise history, striking out Len Gabrielson (swinging), Paul Popovich (swinging), and pinch hitter John Miller (looking) on nine pitches in the 7th inning of a 6-2 win against the Dodgers at Busch Stadium II ... Gibson threw a complete game and fanned six that evening.

Ryan Helsley (Aprii 16, 2019) and Brandon Crawford (May 27, 2011) made their MLB debuts at Milwaukee.
Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo.. was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013
Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.
Cardinals AGM/Player Development Gary LaRocque was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB Draft.

Hall of Famer Ted Simmons played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a twotime AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with Rollie Fingers and Pete Vuckovich in exchange for David Green, Sixto Lezcano, Dave LaPoint and Lary Sorensen.

Bryan Hudson graduated from Alton (III.) High School, where he set school records for career wins (25) and strikeouts (324)...committed to the University of Missouri prior to being drafted by the Cubs in the 3rd round. of 2015.
Joe Ross's older brother Tyson Ross, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.
Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (199496) with the Brewers.

Chris Roycroft pitched for the Joliet Slammers (2021-22) in the independent Frontier League.
Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.
Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster Tim Dillard, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder Oliver Marmol.

Cardinals Hall of Famer \& broadcaster Jim Edmonds played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010. Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement Matt Slater is a Marquette Univ. graduate... started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).
Brewers broadcaster Bob Uecker played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis....won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for Jimmie Coker and Gary Kolb (Apr. 9, 1964).
Brewers broadcaster Jeff Levering previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).
KMOX broadcaster Matt Pauley hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team. Cardinals Dir. of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer Adam Olsen is a native of Green Bay ... graduate of The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

## TODAY'S GAME

NL Rankings: Games Started (8, T-1st), Losses (5, T-3rd), Hits (55, 1st), Runs (30, 3rd), Home Runs Allowed (8, T-3rd)

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 9th start of the season and his 159th career (187th appearance).
- Has a 7-2 record with a 2.93 ERA in nine career starts at American Family Field, opposing his 2-4 record against the Brewers away from Milwaukee. His 2.93 ERA at Am-FamField is the 3rd-lowest among active opposing pitchers at the ballpark.
- Has the highest qualifying ERA (6.43) in the National League and 2nd-highest opponent BA (.316) in the NL behind Patrick Corbin (.341).
- Did not walk a batter for the 4th straight start vs. NYM (5/7), a new career-high. Tied with Zack Littell for most consecutive starts without a walk in the 2024 season. The last Cardinals pitcher to pitch five starts without a walk was Mike Leake in 2016. The Cardinals record is six by Bob Tewksbury (6/20-7/17/1993) in the Live Ball Era (Since 1920).
- Leads the team with seven decisions, but is still seeking his 1st home win of 2024.
- Has enjoyed career success in the month of May, posting an 11-8 mark with a 3.13 ERA, his lowest monthly ERA. Went 3-0 with a 1.89 ERA in six starts last May
- In his 148 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is $59-30$ when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings, while the Cardinals are 22-37 when he works 5.2 innings or less.
- Is $23-25$ in his 73 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal, with 42 Quality Starts. The Cardinals are $40-33$ in those games.
- Mikolas is an amazing 44-5 (.898 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals $58-14$ in those 72 games). He's just 8-47 (.145) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 23-54).
- His loss vs. MIL (4/20) was his 1 st ever as a Cardinal when receiving $4+$ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Has entered his 7 th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (875.1), wins (52), strikeouts (643) and games started (148) for St. Louis; trailing only Lance Lynn in all categories.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since Jhoulys Chacin (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since Chris Carpenter had 35 in 2009 to do so.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is one of two pitchers (Erick Fedde) with $100+$ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018 (min. 100 TC).


## LAST TIME OUT

- Threw 4.0 scoreless innings vs. NYM (5/7) then allowed six consecutive hits in the 5 th inning accounting for a season-high six runs as the Cardinals fell to the Mets 7-5.
- Did not walk a batter for the 4th straight start, a new career-high. Tied with Zack Littell for most consecutive starts without a walk in the 2024 season.

- Surrendered a season-high six runs in a loss vs. NYM (5/7). Did not walk a batter for the 4th straight start.
- Earned his first career win against the Mets $(4 / 26)$ at Citi Field, his 17 th different active Major League stadium with 5.2 innings allowing two runs. His second straight start without a walk issued, first time in consecutive starts since July 8-17, 2023.
- Notched his 1st win of the season, besting the Padres and Yu Darvish by a 5-2 score on April 2 at PETCO Park. It was his 1st win in San Diego since May 10, 2018, and marked the 6th quality start among seven career starts against his former team.
- His loss on $4 / 20$ vs. MIL was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Was 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA in five Grapefruit League starts this spring. He led the staff in IP (21.0) and starts (5) and co-led in wins (2) and strikeouts (15).

- Has a 2.93 ERA over his career at Am-Fam-Field, 9th among active pitchers with 50 or more innings pitched, 3rd-lowest of pitchers who have not played for the Brewers.
- His 9 career wins against MIL are his most against any team, and he has 9 Quality Starts amongst his 16 career starts vs. the Brewers (7 in 10 career starts at MIL).
- After his first out will make Milwaukee the 3rd team in his career he has pitched over 100 innings against (Pittsburgh 111.0 \& Cincinnati 102.2).
- With win today, he would join Lance Lynn (11) and Kyle Hendricks (10) as lone active pitchers with $10+$ career wins vs. Milwaukee.
- Split his season series in 2023 vs. MIL, making a pair of starts in a 5 -day period; Lost $6-0$ on $9 / 21 / 23$ at Busch Std., then turned around and tossed a $4-1$ win at Milwaukee on $9 / 26 / 23$.
