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BOSTON RED SOX (17-22) vs. TAMPA BAY RAYS (25-13)

STATE OF THE SOX: The Red Sox have won 4 of their last 5 games...They're 8-5 in their last 13 games, since 4/25, and 15-14 in their last 29, beginning on 4/7.

- 🔥 Boston swept Detroit in a 3-game road series from Monday-Wednesday...It was the Sox' first sweep of 2026 (previous: 8/25-28/25 at BAL).

YELLOW SOX: The Sox today will wear their yellow alternate jerseys...They're 43-23 all-time when wearing them, but 0-3 in 2026.

- 🔥 The uniform adopts blue and yellow colors that honor the spirit of Patriots Day weekend, and features "Boston" in a stencil font across the chest paying tribute to the Boylston Street finish line.
- 🔥 They've outscored opponents 328-255 in the jerseys.

RUNNIN' RED SOX: The Red Sox have stolen a base in a season-high 7 consecutive games (11 total SB), their longest streak since 8/7-8/14/2018 (8 games, 9 total SB).

- 🔥 Boston has an MLB-leading 19 SB in its last 14 games, since 4/24, after recording 13 SB in its first 25 games of the season.

SLUGGING SOX: The Red Sox have hit .254 (122-for-480) with a .721 OPS in their last 14 games, beginning on 4/24, after hitting .223 (184-for-825) with a .636 OPS in their first 25 games.

- 🔥 They've homered in 11 of their last 15 games, since 4/23, hitting 15 HR in that span...They homered in just 5 of their previous 17 games (5 total HR).

D-FENSE: The Red Sox lead the Majors in defensive runs saved (32)...No other AL team has more than 14 DRS (NYY).

- 🔥 The Sox have committed just 4 errors in their last 23 games, beginning on 4/14...They lead the Majors in that span with a .995 fielding percentage (823 total chances).

AT THE HELM: Interim Manager Chad Tracy has led the Red Sox to a 7-5 record since making his Major League managerial debut on 4/26 in Baltimore.

- 🔥 Their .583 winning percentage in that span ranks 4th in the AL and 10th in MLB.
- 🔥 Boston has committed 0 errors in 11 of those 12 games.
- 🔥 Red Sox pitchers during that span rank 2nd in the AL in ERA (3.03) and 3rd in WHIP (1.16) and opponent AVG (.227).

HOME COOKING: The Red Sox on Thursday began a 7-game homestand vs. TB (4 games) and PHI (3 games).

- 🔥 They're playing at Fenway Park in 10 of their 13 games from 5/1-14.
- 🔥 From 5/1-7/1, 32 of the Sox' 56 games (57%) will be played at Fenway Park, after just 13 of the Red Sox' first 31 games (42%) were at home.

SOX & RAYS: The Red Sox and Rays have split the first 2 of their 13 matchups this season...The Sox will travel to Tampa for a pair of 3-game series from 6/8-10 and 9/18-20, and will host the Rays at Fenway Park for 3 games from 7/17-19.

- 🔥 The Sox are 9-2 in their last 11 games vs. TB, beginning on 6/10/25...They're 16-8 in their last 24 games against the Rays, dating back to 5/20/25, after going 3-14 in their previous 17 meetings.
- 🔥 Boston is 7-1 in its last 8 home games vs. TB.

GETTING BUSY: The Red Sox are 5-3 so far during a stretch of 10 consecutive days with a game from 5/1-10.

- 🔥 The Sox are set to play 23 games in 24 days from 4/17-5/10 (off on 4/30).
- 🔥 Starting with next Monday, 5/11, they'll have 3 off days in a 15-day span through 5/25 (also 5/21, 5/25).

PITCHING IN: The Red Sox last night shut out their opponent for the 2nd time in their last 3 games (also Wednesday at DET).

- 🔥 It was their 6th time doing so this season, most in MLB.
- 🔥 The Sox have allowed 3 ER or fewer in 10 of their last 13 games, since 4/25, posting a 2.79 ERA (36 ER/116.0 IP) during that span...They own the AL's 2nd-lowest ERA in that stretch behind TB (1.40).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Connelly Early earned the win last night with 7.0 scoreless innings (4 H, BB, 8 SO, HB).

- 🔥 He's the 1st pitcher in the Modern Era (since 1900) to start and allow 3 or fewer runs and 5 or fewer hits in as many as 11 of their first 12 career games.
- 🔥 Along with Payton Tolle's start on Monday at DET (see note below), the Sox this week have had 2 pitchers under the age of 25 toss 7.0 innings while allowing 0 ER...Prior to that, their last such start was in 2017 (Eduardo Rodriguez on 9/23/27 at CIN).

TOLLE TIME: In his last start, on Monday at DET, today's starter Payton Tolle allowed just 1 hit over a career-high 7.0 innings while allowing 2 unearned runs.

- 🔥 He is the 6th Red Sox pitcher ever with 7.0+ IP, 0 ER, and 1 or 0 H within their first 10 career games (previous: Clay Buchholz' no-hitter on 9/1/2007 vs. BAL).
- 🔥 Tolle retired each of his first 12 batters faced...He joined Henry Owens (9/22/15 at TB) as the only Red Sox pitchers in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to do so in a start within their first 10 career games (source: Elias).

TO THE LEFT: The Red Sox tonight will start a left-handed pitcher for the 7th time in their last 8 games (since 5/1) and 14th time in their last 17 games (since 4/21).

- 🔥 The Sox' 27 starts by LHP entering today are the most in MLB...The only other club with more than 18 is KC (22).
- 🔥 The only other season in which lefties started as many as 28 of the Red Sox' first 40 games was 2018 (30).
- 🔥 Boston's left-handed starters have posted a 3.77 ERA (59 ER/140.2 IP).

CUBAN MISSILE: Aroldis Chapman last night converted his 23rd consecutive save opportunity, dating back to 7/26/25.

- 🔥 In save opportunities during that span, Chapman has allowed 0 runs and 2 hits in 21.0 IP (.031 AVG).
- 🔥 It is the longest active streak in the AL and 2nd longest in the Majors (1st: ATL's Raisel Iglesias-24).
- 🔥 He's the 1st Red Sox pitcher to convert 23 straight save chances since Craig Kimbrel from 5/10-7/23/2018 (23)...The last longer streak was also Kimbrel (25), from 6/4/2016-4/17/2017.

EASTERN STANDARD: These 4 games vs. TB are the Red Sox' only vs. AL East opponents in a span of 33 days (28 games), from 4/30-6/1...Following that stretch, the Sox will face AL East clubs in 3 straight series (9 games) from 6/2-10 (vs. BAL, at NYY, at TB).

25 SEASONS OF STEWARDSHIP

John Henry, Tom Werner, and their partners are in their 25th season as stewards of the club. Since 2002, the Red Sox have won a Major League-best four World Series Championships, claimed five American League East titles, and made 12 postseason appearances. In the 24 seasons from 2002-25, the Red Sox recorded the fourth-highest winning percentage in baseball (.546), notably setting a franchise record with 108 regular-season wins in 2018.

- 🔥 Since 2002, nearly half a billion has been invested in the preservation and improvement of Fenway Park.
- 🔥 The ballpark has generated nearly \$14 billion in visitor spending in Boston and the surrounding region.
- 🔥 The Red Sox Foundation has directed more than \$140 million to support communities across New England.

 Entered 2026 ranked by *Baseball America* and MLB.com as the Red Sox' No. 1 prospect...Is also ranked among MLB's top-20 overall prospects by each publication (No. 17, No. 19)...Is BA's No. 5 overall pitching prospect.

 Was named the organization's 2025 Minor League Player of the Year in his 1st professional season...Also named 2025 Red Sox Minor Leaguer of the Year by the Boston BBWAA chapter.
