THE TWINS: Have gone 0-5 on their six-game roadtrip, getting swept in Houston over the weekend, followed by consecutive losses in Cincinnati...today, they will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Great American Ball Park...after this afternoon's game, Minnesota will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Brewers this weekend followed by four against the Mariners from Monday-Thursday.

⌘ The Twins have lost six-straight and looking to avoid losing seven-straight for the first time since May 14-20, 2024 (also 7).

⌘ Minnesota's last victory was eight days ago, Wednesday night, June 11 vs. Texas (6-2).

TWINS WASHED OUT OF CINCY: The Twins lost to the Reds last night at Great American Ball Park by a score of 4-2 in a rain-shortened 5.2-inning game...the game experienced a two hour and seven minute weather delay to start with first pitch at 9:17 pm (ET)...Bailey Ober (4-4) was the starter and issued the loss, allowing four runs on nine hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits...Willi Castro and Brooks Lee each singled and Byron Buxton homered to lead off the game, his second leadoff homer this season and 11th of his career...Lee's single extended his hitting streak to 17 games.

BATTLE OF THE WISHBONE Cs: Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 40th time in their history today...the Twins are 18-21 all-time against the Reds, going 7-12 in Cincinnati (6-7 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 11-9 in Minnesota (4-7 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome).

⌘ Harrison Bader is hitting .289 (52-for-180) with seven doubles, 10 home runs, 28 RBI, 31 runs scored, 27 walks, a .390 on-base percentage and an .885 OPS in 71 career games vs. Cincinnati...10 home runs and 27 walks are his most against any opponent...in his last 17 games at Great American Ball Park, he is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with five home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.030 OPS.

⌘ Willi Castro is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and a .996 OPS in nine career games vs. the Reds.

⌘ Carlos Correa has nine hits in 14 career at-bats against Nick Martinez, including three doubles and three home runs...only C.J. Cron (3) has as many career home runs.

NATIONAL, GO LIKE A PRO: Twins have gone 7-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18) and 0-2 at Cincinnati...Twins are 5-3 vs. NL teams after starting the season 2-7...their next series against an NL opponent will be three against the Brewers at Target Field this weekend...their next after that will be three games in Miami during their next roadtrip (May 1-3).

BUCK GOES NATIONAL: In his last 10 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with one double, two triples, three home runs, six RBI and a 1.016 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fourth time this season...the other three were in three games at St. Louis to open 2025, from March 27-30, three games from April 18-20 at Atlanta and three games at Houston to start this roadtrip...other than those three sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep twice this season: April 13 vs. Detroit and June 8 vs. Toronto.

⌘ The Twins have been swept by the Reds just once in their history, that coming in three games from June 2-4, 2000 at Cinergy Field.

⌘ Twins are looking to avoid being swept in back-to-back series for the first time since May 14-19, 2024, when they lost three at Target Field to the Yankees and three at Progressive Field to the Guardians.

SIMP-LEE THE BEST: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 17-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was by Brian Dozier, who hit in 24-straight from September 22, 2017-April 23, 2018 — covering two seasons...the last by a Twin as long in a *single season* was also Dozier for 24 games, from August 27-September 22, 2016...the longest streak in baseball this season was 22 by Bobby Witt Jr. from April 8-May 1.

⌘ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .348 (23-for-66) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and an .883 OPS.

WILLI WORLD: In his last 28 games, Willi Castro is hitting .355 (33-for-93) with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, 18 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .434 on-base percentage, a .624 slugging percentage and a 1.058 OPS.

⌘ In his last 12 road games, since May 30, he is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with five home runs, seven RBI, an .750 slugging percentage and a 1.201 OPS.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 33 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .309 (38-for-123) with four doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 31 RBI, 17 walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .569 slugging percentage and a .958 OPS.

⌘ His leadoff home run last night was the 11th of his career, one short of tying Dan Gladden (12) for fifth-most in Twins history (since 1961)...the top four in front of Gladden are: Brian Dozier - 28, Jacque Jones - 20, Max Kepler - 15 and Chuck Knoblauch - 14.

BREAKING BAD GOOD: Twins have posted a .301 wOBA against breaking pitches this season, the sixth-highest in baseball (league avg. .282)...additionally, they rank fourth in baseball in slugging percentage (.409) vs. breaking pitches.

⌘ Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with a .673 slugging percentage against breaking pitches...the slugging percentage ranks sixth-highest in baseball (min. 250 pitches).

⌘ Kody Clemens has a .647 slugging percentage, ninth-best in baseball (min. 100 pitches).

ANALYST ANALYSIS: Reds-related notes on Twins.TV analyst LaTroy Hawkins and Twins Radio analyst Justin Morneau:

⌘ Hawk pitched in 44 career games against the Reds, going 1-1, 1.94 ERA (51.0 IP, 11 ER) with six saves, 10 walks and 35 strikeouts...he never allowed a run at Great American Ball Park in 9.2 innings pitched here, the only ballpark in baseball in which he never allowed a single run (minimum 10 games).

⌘ Morry hit one home run in this ballpark on May 10, 2014, a two-run shot off Alfredo Simon, while playing for Colorado...his first hit in this ballpark came on September 28, 2013, singling off Bronson Arroyo, while playing for Pittsburgh...he reached base in 11 of 12 career games against the Reds.
