**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles continue a stretch of 15 games in 14 days this afternoon which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros...The Birds will play each of the next four days, including a three-game set opposite the Yankees before enjoying an off-day on May 14.

⚾ With yesterday's 6-2 setback, the Birds fell to a season-high six games below .500.

⚾ **Taylor Ward** drew a season-high-tying three walks yesterday (3x, last: 5/6 at MIA) and enters play today with an MLB-best 38 free passes...He is one of four players in MLB to have at least three games with 3+ walks in 2026, joining LAA's Mike Trout (4 G) and ATH's Nick Kurtz/DET's Gleyber Torres (both 3 G).

⚾ O's pitching has allowed 3+ runs in 25 straight games since April 13, their longest streak since a 25-game stretch from July 24-August 19, 2019...They have not done so in 26 straight since a franchise-record 32-game run from June 11-July 18, 2011.

⚾ Today, the O's look to avoid being swept for the third time this season (4/3-5 at PIT & 5/1-4 at NYY)...They have not been swept by the Athletics since dropping three straight from June 17-19, 2019.

**ROSTER MOVE:** Prior to today's game, the Orioles recalled **RHP Jose Espada** from Triple-A Norfolk and designated **RHP Lou Trivino** for assignment.

**CAMDEN CONFINES:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his 13 games at Camden Yards this season, slashing .396/.442/.771 (19-for-48) with six doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, and four walks against five strikeouts...It is the fourth-longest active season-opening, home on-base streak in MLB this season behind CHC's Ian Happ (23 G), LAD's Shohei Ohtani (18 G), and ATH's Nick Kurtz (16 G).

⚾ His 1.213 OPS at home is fifth-highest in MLB (min. 50 PA) behind NYY's Ben Rice (1.302), NYY's Cody Bellinger (1.259), COL's Mickey Moniak (1.255), and HOU's Yordan Alvarez (1.252).

⚾ Rutschman owns a 15-game home on-base streak dating to September 24, 2025, marking the third-longest such stretch of his career behind runs of 35 games (6/21-9/9/22) and 25 games (6/24-8/25/23).

**GARCIA'S GREATNESS:** **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.53 ERA (1 ER/17.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts across 18 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

⚾ His .020 (1-for-51) opponent average and 0.41 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.059, 3-for-51) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

⚾ Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 18 outings of a season was four (**Jesse Orosco**, 1997).

⚾ He has not allowed a hit in each of his last six outings, tied with teammate **Ryan Helsley** for the third-longest active run in MLB behind SEA's Matt Brash (8 G) and ATH's Scott Barlow (7 G).

⚾ He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

**BASALLO BREAKING OUT:** **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .407/.448/.648 (22-for-54) with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven runs, and 11 RBI over his last 16 games since April 20.

⚾ During this period, he is 12-for-27 (.444) with two doubles, one triple, and one home run off fastballs.

**POLAR BEAR PETE:** Despite seeing his season-high nine game hitting streak come to an end yesterday, **Pete Alonso** is batting .297 (11-for-37) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 runs, and 10 RBI over his last 10 games.

⚾ He has reached base safely in 12 of 14 career games opposite the Athletics, including hits in 10 of the contests, slashing .345/.431/.800 (19-for-55) with four doubles, seven home runs, 15 runs, 18 RBI, eight walks, and one hit-by-pitch...His career 1.231 OPS against the Athletics is the second highest of any player in MLB history (min. 50 PA), behind Barry Bonds (1.258).

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** has reached base safely 76 times through his first 39 games with the O's (37 H, 38 BB, 1 HBP), tied with **Albert Belle** (76 TOB, 1999) for the third-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Roberto Alomar** (85 TOB, 1996) and **Frank Robinson** (78 TOB, 1966)...The record through 40 games is 86, held by Alomar.

⚾ Ward's .425 on-base percentage ranks third in MLB...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2<sup>nd</sup>, .410).

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** The O's have drawn 162 walks this year, the sixth-highest clip in MLB behind the Cubs (191), Yankees (181), Guardians (168), Brewers (167), and Pirates (163)...The Birds are averaging 9.33 plate appearances per walk, fifth best in the majors behind the Cubs (8.33), Yankees (8.38), Brewers (8.63), and Guardians (9.17).

⚾ **Taylor Ward** is averaging an MLB-best 4.71 plate appearances per walk, ahead of ATH's Nick Kurtz (4.78) and LAA's Mike Trout (4.92).

⚾ Baltimore has 17 games with 5+ walks, tied with Milwaukee and New York-AL for second most in MLB behind Chicago-NL (22)...The 2025 Orioles had 34 such games.

**TWO'S ARE WILD:** Baltimore pitching has allowed a .776 opponent OPS with two outs, the fifth-highest mark in the majors ahead of Houston (.815), Chicago-AL (.798), Texas (.787), and Cincinnati (.787).

⚾ With two strikes, the opposition owns a .566 OPS, fourth highest in MLB ahead of Colorado (.608), Washington (.589), and Houston (.577).

**'PEN PALS:** **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 34.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 39.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

⚾ The O's 15.4 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/52 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.
