TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to earn the series win with a victory in today's finale.

- ▶ A win today would also clinch SF a winning record at San Diego for the first time since 2021 when the Giants went 5-4.
- ▶ The Giants lead the season series with San Diego 5-4 with four games remaining (one today in San Diego and three at Oracle Park)...SF has been outscored by SD 44-38 (-6).
- ▶ SF has lost 15 of its last 24 games since August 11, falling three games below .500...SF can snap its four-series losing streak with a win today.

L'OUVREUR: RHP **Spencer Bivens** will make his second career start...Bivens is 3-1 with a 2.86 ERA (11er, 34.2ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in 19 games this season...it will be his first career outing vs. San Diego.

- ▶ In his one career start in the Majors, June 30 vs. Los Angeles-NL, Bivens struck out three while allowing one run on four hits and no walks across 5.0 innings to earn the win.
- ▶ Bivens, who debuted on June 16, began his professional career with the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020.
- ▶ He was 5-1 with a 2.92 ERA (16er, 49.1ip) in 27 games at Triple-A, striking out 42 with a .231 opponents average.

MCCRAY DAY: Rookie OF **Grant McCray** powered the SF offense yesterday, plating all six runs (five RBI) with his first career multi-homer game.

- ▶ He is the second SF rookie with a multi-homer game this season, joining IF/OF **Tyler Fitzgerald** (July 26 vs. Colorado).
- ▶ McCray is one of five in Giants history to record at least 5 homers through his first 19 career games joining **Jarrett Parker** (six homers, 2015), **Willie McCovey** (seven homers, 1959), **Orlando Cepeda** (six homers, 1958) and **Dusty Rhodes** (eight homers, 1952).
- ▶ He is the only player in Giants history to hit five home runs and steal three bases through his first 19 career games.
- ▶ McCray is the eighth Giants hitter in the SF era (since 1958) to have a multi-homer game prior to his 20th career game (*Sarah Langs*) as shown in the chart below.

BUILDING BLOCKS: Giants rookies have played big roles on both sides of the ball for the Giants in 2024.

- ▶ SF's rookie pitchers have thrown 459.0 innings so far in 2024, which is second-most in MLB behind Oakland (465.2ip)...the 459.0 innings by SF rookies this season is the franchise's most since 541.1 innings pitched by rookies in 1975.
- ▶ On the other side, SF's rookie position players have appeared in 174 games this year, 14th most in the Majors, but have combined for a .766 OPS...the .766 OPS from rookies ranks second-best in MLB behind San Diego's rookies with a .770 OPS (Philadelphia's rookies have an .897 OPS but have only amassed 36 games played entering play today).

OL' RELIABLES: RHP **Tyler Rogers** is currently tied with HOU's Bryan Abreu for most games pitched in MLB with 70, RHP **Ryan Walker** is tied for third with 69 games pitched.

- ▶ They would be the first Giants pitchers to finish inside MLB's top-3 in games pitched since RHP **John Brebbia** in 2022 finished third with 76 games pitched.
- ▶ The last Giant to lead the Majors in games pitched was LHP **Scott Eyre** with 86 games pitched in 2005.
- ▶ The SF bullpen as a whole has pitched 575.2 innings, which is second-most in MLB behind Detroit (590.0), and has 589 strikeouts, which lead the Majors.

LEADING OFF: The Giants have put a lot of pressure on opposing pitchers to start innings as shown in the chart below.

ROAD WOES: The Giants are 30-41 (.423) in road games this season...the .423 winning percentage is 23rd in MLB, and is the third-lowest road winning percentage in the NL ahead of only Miami (26-42, .382) and Colorado (21-53, .284).

- ▶ Since the All-Star Break, SF is 11-13 on the road, going 2-4-1 in the seven completed series.
- ▶ By the numbers, SF has a .697 OPS (T-16th in MLB) on the road while averaging 4.25 runs per game (21st in MLB)...on the pitching side, SF has a 4.69 road ERA (26th in MLB).

CONGRATS, CARTER!: Giants Home Clubhouse Assistant **Carter Pierce** was named one of two scholarship recipients by the MLB Clubhouse Managers Association...the scholarship is voted on by the MLB Clubhouse Managers Association board of directors with the money coming from the association's funds...winners are selected on the basis of school grades, accomplishments, leadership and financial needs...since 1993, the association has awarded over \$500,00 in scholarships.

#43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

Last Game: 9/3 vs. ARI; 3.1ip, 2h, r, er, 2bb, 4k, hr (61 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first appearance of the season with SF on Tuesday... was activated off the 60-day IL on September 1.
- ▶ Made five rehab starts for Triple-A Sacramento, logging a 7.90 ERA (12er, 13.2ip) with 17 strikeouts and three walks.
- ▶ Was on IL for first 137 games of 2024 undergoing surgery to remove an aneurysm from his upper right arm on March 4 at Stanford Medical Center...the surgery was performed by Dr. Jason Lee.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games (making three starts) for the Giants last season and logged a 3.92 ERA...entered Spring Training this year with a chance to be a mainstay on SF's Major League roster.

#76 SPENCER BIVENS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Two-Seam FB, Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Sweeper

Last Game: 9/4 vs. ARI; 4.0ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, bb, 3k, hr (54 pitches)

- ▶ Slated to open today's game, his second start this season.
- ▶ Has allowed seven runs (six earned) in his last seven games (11.0ip) dating to August 17 for a 4.91 ERA.
- ▶ Opponents are just 5-for-31 (.161) off him with RISP.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut on June 16.
- ▶ Went 5-1 with a 2.92 ERA in 27 relief outings for Triple-A Sacramento...struck out 42 in 49.1ip with opponents hitting .231 off him.
- ▶ Began his professional career with the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 9/7 at SD; 1.0ip, 2k (13 pitches)

- ▶ In seven outings since returning from AAA, Doval has a 4.05 ERA (3er, 6.2ip), 11 strikeouts and five walks.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on August 24...appeared in 5g for the River Cats and allowed two runs on two hits in 5.2ip.
- ▶ Is 22-for-27 in save opportunities w/SF...posted a 8.59 ERA (7er, 7.1ip) and a 1.91 WHIP over last eight ML outings before he was optioned to Triple-A on August 9 (first time in AAA since 2021).
- ▶ Has walked 34 batters in 50.2ip (6.04 BB/9.0) w/SF this year.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve

Last Game: 9/6 at SD; 1.1ip, 2h, 2k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed six runs on 11 hits in his last eight games (12.1ip) dating to August 14 for a 4.38 ERA.
- ▶ Walked just 10 batters in 49 outings (70.1ip) this season...his 3.5% walk rate ranks in the top 2% of the league.
- ▶ Batters are just 18x103 (.175) with 41 K's off his knuckle curve.
- ▶ Has a 60.1% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Has recorded at least four outs in 27 of his 49 games.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 9/5 vs. ARI; 1.0ip, 2k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed seven runs (six earned) on six hits over his last 10 outings dating to August 14 (6.00 ERA)...had allowed a total of three runs in 17.0ip (1.59 ERA) over his previous 18 games.
- ▶ His 60.0 innings this year are the second-most he's thrown in a single season in his pro career...is approaching his career high of 62.1 innings from last year (54 games between AA and AAA).
- ▶ His 63 appearances are most among NL rookies.
- ▶ Lefties are 12-for-80 (.150) off him and righties are 30-for-134 (.224) with seven home runs (one inside the park) and 19 RBI.
- ▶ Has walked 33 batters in 60.0 innings this season...his 13.3% walk rate ranks in the bottom 2% of the league.
- ▶ His 31.3% strikeout rate is also in the top 7% of the league while his xBA (expected batting average) of .182 is in the top 2%.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 9/4 vs. ARI; 1.1ip, bb (22 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 3.52 ERA (6er, 15.1ip) in 16 games since the All-Star break... had a 2.15 ERA in 40 games before the break.
- ▶ Had a 4.00 ERA (4er, 9.0ip) in 10 August games.
- ▶ LHB are 23-for-80 (.288) off him...RHB are 26-for-118 (.220).
- ▶ His 31.4% hard hit rate this season is well under his 45.2% mark from last season.
- ▶ Has stranded 21 of his 28 inherited runners (75%) in 2024.

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 9/7 at SD; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ His 70 games pitched this year are tied for most in the Majors with HOU's Bryan Abreu.
- ▶ Owns a 0.82 ERA (3er, 33.0ip) in 35 games at home this year...has not been charged with a run at home since May 15 vs. LAD, a span of 23 games and 21.1 innings...on the road, he is 0-4 with a 5.28 ERA (18er, 30.2ip) with a 1.27 WHIP.
- ▶ Has allowed just four walks (one was intentional) in 62.2 innings pitched...his 1.5 BB% is lowest in MLB (min. 200 BF).
- ▶ Opponents' 85.5 mph avg exit velo off him is tied for 7th-best in MLB.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (332 games).

#65 LANDEN ROUPP ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter

Last Game: 9/5 vs. ARI; 4.0ip, h, 2bb, 5k (61 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on August 27.
- ▶ Pitched a career-high 4.0 innings and had a career-best five strikeouts on Thursday vs. Arizona.
- ▶ Over his last eight MLB games, he has given up just one run on seven hits (.135 avg) with 18 strikeouts over 15.1 innings (0.59 ERA).
- ▶ Had a 1.13 ERA (1er, 8.0ip) in his last three outings for Sacramento, striking out eight, before being recalled on Aug. 9.
- ▶ Has a 3.41 ERA (12er, 31.2ip) with 33 strikeouts in 19 MLB games... has a 3.80 ERA (9er, 21.1ip) with 30 K in eight outings at AAA.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 9/7 at SD; W, 1.0ip, h (10 pitches)
