**DAY AT A TIME, I SUPPOSE:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game homestand over 10 days with the second opponent of three, the Baltimore Orioles. The Cardinals are 3-1 on the homestand after a 6-3 win over the Orioles last night, their 3rd straight series opening win. Following an open date on Thursday, the Chicago Cubs will come to St. Louis for the first time this season for a three-game series, May 24-26.

**...LIFE OF KINGS:** The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the National League Central, one-half game behind 3rd place Pittsburgh and 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (26-19). St. Louis has won six of their last eight games and are tied for the best record among National League teams since May 12 at 6-2 (Miami & Philadelphia).

**ALL THE PIECES MATTER:** Of the Cardinals six runs last night, the entire lot of runs were driven in by **Masyn Winn** (2 RBI) and **Michael Siani** (4 RBI) who occupy the No. 8 and No. 9 positions in the lineup. Since the Live Ball Era began in 1920, no Cardinals team has received 100% of their RBI total from the starting bottom two slots in the order when scoring six or more runs. In 1970, the Cardinals received seven RBI from the 8-and-9 slots but came from pinch-hitters and relief pitchers. -Elias Sports Bureau

**YOU COME AT THE KING, YOU BEST NOT MISS:** The Cardinals have posted the best winning percentage against American League East Division opponents since the start of 2023 with an 14-5 mark (.737). They are 3-1 against the Baltimore Orioles, winning a series 2-1 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards last September 11-13. The Cardinals are 5-1 against Boston and 2-1 against the Blue Jays, Rays and Yankees. Under third-year manager **Oliver Marmol**, the Cardinals are 21-14 (.600) against A.L. East opponents, his best record against any division with the N.L. Central (70-65, .519) ranking second.

**GAME'S THE SAME, JUST GOT MORE FIERCE:** The Cardinals extended their 2024 season high by homering in an eighth straight game yesterday as **Michael Siani** hit the first home run of his Major League career. It marks the longest streak by the Cardinals since homering in 12 straight games from Aug. 23-Sept. 4, 2022. St. Louis is currently tied with the Orioles and Red Sox for the longest active home run streak in MLB.

**THIS IS ME, YO, RIGHT HERE:** Cardinals rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** went 2-for-4 with 2 RBI last night extending his career-best hitting streak to 11 games (13-38, .342). Winn leads all Cardinals qualifying batters with a .288 average (15th in the N.L.), has the 4th-longest active hit streak in Major League Baseball and the 2nd-longest by a Cardinal behind **Willson Contreras** (14) this season. Cardinals rookies have posted four 10-game hitting streaks over the past two seasons with **Jordan Walker** running off streaks of 17, 12 & 12 in 2023.

**WE AIN'T GOTTA DREAM NO MORE:** Cardinals outfielder **Alec Burleson** extended his hitting streak to six games (12-25, .480) with a multi-hit effort last night. He has tallied five multi-hit games over the streak and leads the Cardinals with 19 hits in the month of May, ranked T-4th on the club overall with **Paul Goldschmidt** (37). Burleson's .333 (19-57) batting average in the month of May ranks 8th in the National League while his OPS is 13th (.906).

**ALL IN THE GAME, YO...ALL IN THE GAME:** Four different Cardinals recorded a stolen base last night, tying their season-high for stolen bases in a game with four and was the 3rd time since the start of 2022 that at least four different Cardinals stole a base in a single game. **Alec Burleson** (#2), **Paul Goldschmidt** (#3), **Nolan Gorman** (#1) and **Michael Siani** (#5) each recorded a theft. Last Sept. 6, 2023, five different Cardinals recorded a theft at Atlanta (**Nolan Arenado**, **Alec Burleson**, **Tommy Edman**, **Nolan Gorman** & **Richie Palacios**).

#### BALTIMORE CONNECTIONS

**Lars Nootbaar's** older brother, **Nigel Nootbaar**, was a 12th round selection of the Orioles in 2014...pitched two professional seasons in the minors with Aberdeen and Delmarva (2014-15).

**Kyle Gibson** made 33 regular season starts for the Orioles last season...pitched in one postseason game for Baltimore.

**Ramón Urias** played two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2018-19) ... claimed off waivers by Baltimore (Feb. 11, 2020).

**Drew Rom** was originally selected by Baltimore in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...pitched parts of five minor league seasons in the Orioles organization... traded to St. Louis with **César Prieto** and **Zack Showalter** from Baltimore in exchange for **Jack Flaherty**.

**Danny Coulombe** was born in in St. Louis.

Orioles EVP & GM **Mike Elias** spent five seasons as a scout with St. Louis, including over a year as the club's Manager of Amateur Scouting.

Orioles Co-Hitting Coach **Matt Borgschulte** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Parkway Central High School in Chesterfield in 2009...Played collegiately at Western Kentucky & Drury University in Springfield, MO...began pro coaching career with Palm Beach in the Cardinals organization in 2017...Prior to joining the Cardinals, coached at Southeast Missouri State Univ. in 2015-16 and spent 2014 as a volunteer coach at Drury Univ.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **Bill DeWitt, Jr.** has been a prior owner of the Baltimore Orioles...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, began his baseball career in 1916 as a 14-year-old office boy with the St. Louis Browns, and later rejoined the organization as an executive and team owner, in the early 1940s...was majority owner of the Browns (1949-51) when Bill, Jr. served as the team's bat boy...DeWitt Jr.'s uniform (#1/8) was worn by **Eddie Gaedel** during his famous pinch hitting appearance on August 19, 1951.

Orioles Assistant Pitching Coach **Mitch Plasmeyer** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby DeSmet Jesuit High School in 2014...worked as MIZZOU Pitching Coach (2022) and Director of Baseball Player Development (2021-22).

The **St. Louis Browns** played 52 seasons in the American League (1902-53), playing at Sportsman's Park and sharing the same ballpark with the Cardinals from 1920-53...Coinciding with the sale of the Cardinals and Sportsman's Park to Anheuser-Busch, the Browns relocated to Baltimore and were rebranded as the Orioles in 1954.

The Baltimore Orioles of the National League went 72-30 against the St. Louis Browns/Perfectos from 1892-99 before being eliminated by the NL... Upon the foundation of the American League in 1901, a reorganized Baltimore Orioles franchise competed as a charter member, before relocating to New York City after two seasons, where they ultimately became known as the New York Yankees.

Late Hall of Fame Manager **Whitey Herzog** played 212 games as an outfielder for the Orioles over the 1961-62 seasons.

Orioles VP & AGM, Analytics **Sig Mejdal** worked for St. Louis for seven seasons (2005-11), spending his final year as the team's Director, Amateur Draft Analysis...began pro baseball career as a Quantitative Analyst for the Cardinals in 2005.

**Matt Slater**, Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement, was a member of the Orioles front office from 1995-99.

Bally Sports reporter **Alexa Datt** was born in Derwood, Md...graduated from Col. Zadok Magruder High School and the University of Maryland.

In the only all-St. Louis World Series, Sportsman's Park hosted the 1944 Fall Classic as the Cardinals defeated the Browns, 4-2, for their 5th World Series title...dubbed the "St. Louis Showdown," "Trolley Series," and "Streetcar Series" as many fans used that mode of travel to and from the ballpark...third World Series in which both teams had the same home field (1921 & 1922 at New York City's Polo Grounds)...remains one of four World Series to feature teams from the same city (1906 Chicago & 1921-22 in New York).

The Cardinals defeated the Orioles, 4-1, in the 40th Hall of Fame Game at Cooperstown (Aug. 1, 1983)...St. Louis minor leaguer **Danny Cox**, who started and earned the win, would make his big league debut five days later against the Phillies.

- Makes his 10th start of the season and the 327th of his career (351st appearance).
- Seeking his first win at Busch Stadium III since Sept. 12, 2017 vs. Cincinnati (13-4).
- The Cardinals have lost each of his last four starts (April 28-present) after having won four of the first five to begin the season.
- His 962 strikeouts as a Cardinal are 17 back of **Jesse Haines** (979) for 7th all-time in franchise history.
- St. Louis has played extra innings in three of his 10 starts this year and co-leads MLB starters with six no-decisions in his 10 starts.
- Is 49 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 65.2 innings from 2,000.
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee when he fanned Brice Turang to lead off the 1st inning.
- Ranks T-4th in MLB with team-leading with eight batters faced with the bases loaded (allowing no hits). Lynn leads MLB pitchers with 6 strikeouts with the bases loaded.
- Has returned to his original drafting/signing team (1st round, 2008) for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).

LAST TIME OUT

- Suffered his 2nd loss in a row last Wednesday at Anaheim, yielding eight hits and allowing four 1st-inning runs in a 7-3 defeat to the Angels. Threw a season-high 106 pitches.

- Has never pitched at Busch Stadium as a visitor. Before the 2024 Home Opener (April 4), his last appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- Trails **Adam Wainwright** and ranks 2nd in Busch Stadium III history in starts (81), innings pitched (503.2), strikeouts (468), and wins (40).
- His 81 career starts at are 2nd-most in stadium history (2006-present) behind only (214).
- His last win at Busch Stadium III came on Sept. 12, 2017 vs. Cincinnati (13-4).

2024

- Made his 200th career appearance in the National League at NYM (April 28) and 1,000th NL strikeout on May 10 at MIL.
- Passed **Steve Carlton** (951) in his May 4 start vs. White Sox for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history for strikeouts.
- Has passed **Carlos Martinez** (927, 11th), **Bill Doak** (939, 10th) and **Steve Carlton** (951, 9th) for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history in strikeouts with 957.
- Recorded his first win as a member of the Cardinals since 2017 at Oakland on April 4/16, firing a season-high 7.0 innings allowing two runs (1 earned) and one strikeout. Marked the first time in his career throw 7.0+ innings in a start and with one strikeout or fewer.
- Was Cardinals Home Opening starter for the first time in his career (April 4 vs. Miami).

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals.
- Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).
- Won a career-high 18 games with St. Louis in 2012, his first full season as a starting pitcher.
