#### SNAKEBITES

**THE NL CHAMPS:** The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 7-5 vs. Braves with a 2-run eighth inning on **Christian Walker's** go-ahead, bases-loaded walk and **Geraldo Perdomo's** sac fly.

- ◆ Eugenio Suárez had 3 RBI on a 2-run homer in the second inning (a 452-foot blast into Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers that was the third-longest homer at Chase Field this season) and RBI double in the seventh inning.
- ◆ Geraldo Perdomo was 3-for-3 with 1 single and 2 doubles plus a sac fly.
- Ketel Marte hit a solo homer in the third inning.
- Joe Mantiply (1.0 IP), Kevin Ginkel (1.0), Justin Martinez (1.0) and Paul Sewald (1.0) each had scoreless outings.
- ◆ Slade Cecconi allowed 3 runs over 4.0 frames.

**D-BACKS ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs reinstated RHP **Miguel Castro** (right shoulder inflammation) from 15-day injured list and optioned RHP **Slade Cecconi** to Triple-A Reno following last night's game.

WHAMO WHACKO: Last night's tape-measure roundtrippers by Eugenio Suárez (452 ft.) and Ketel Marte (444 ft.) were the D-backs' fifth time in the Statcast Era (since 2015) with multiple home runs of 440+ feet in a game.

**GOOD VIBES GENO:** Eugenio Suárez has hit safely in 6 of his last 9 games at a .323 clip (10-for-31)/1.062 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 5 walks.

• Has hit 9 in his last 14 games (.298, 14-for-47, .942 OPS).

LG2: Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has hit safely in 7 of 8 games (.257 AVG/.749 OPS), including 7 straight from July 2-9. ♦ Has reached base safely in 17 of his last 19 games, hit-

- ting safely in 16 games, with a .333 average (26-for-78)/.897 OPS, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 13 RBI, 2 walks and 1 hit by pitch.
- Has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 home games at a .310 clip (9-for-29)/.870 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 6 RBI, 2 walks and 1 hit by pitch.

**GABI THRIVING IN JULY: Gabriel Moreno**, since being reinstated from the injured list on July 2, has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 games at a .393 clip (11-for-28)/1.076 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 home runs, 5 RBI and 4 walks.

WIN THE SERIES: The D-backs have won or split 9 of their last 11 series overall since May 30, going 6-2-2, including 3-1-2 on the road (splits @ Mets and Padres, win @ Nationals, loss @ Phillies, win @ Dodgers, win @ Padres).

**THE WALK SHOW:** Christian Walker has reached base safely in 8 of his last 10 home games, batting .289 (11-for-38)/.500 SLG/.841 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The D-backs' 17 home runs in July are third in the Majors behind the Pirates (19) and Tigers (18) and ahead of the Reds (16), Braves (15) and Twins (15).

MARTE VS. SOUTHPAWS: Ketel Marte's 11 home runs vs. lefties leads the Majors, ahead of Aaron Judge/NYY (8), José Ramírez/CLE (8) and Teoscar Hernández/LAD (8).

**EL PIKE: Ketel Marte's** 122nd homer moved him into sole possession of sixth on the club's all-time, passing **Mark Reynolds** (121)...next up is **Chris Young** (132).

- Has reached base in 15 straight home games since June 11 and batting .340 (18-for-53)/.446 OBP/1.088 OPS with 11 walks.
- His 5 strikeouts since June 24 are third fewest in NL, behind Keibert Ruiz/WSH (3), Miguel Rojas/LAD (4) and Luis Arraez/SD (4).

**GINKS LOCKED IN:** Kevin Ginkel has a 9-game, 9.1-innings home scoreless streak, since June 4, with opponents batting .182 (6-for-33) with 0 walks and 12 strikeouts.

♦ Has not issued a walk in 8 straight games since June 25 (33 BF) and 20 of his last 21 games since May 18 (85 BF; 2 BB on June 21 @ Phillies).

MILESTONES: D-backs approaching career milestones:
 Lourdes Gurriel Jr.: 699 games are 1 games shy of 700 career games...391 RBI are 9 shy of 400 career RBI.

• **Christian Walker**: 693 hits are 7 shy of 700 career hits...795 games are 5 shy of 800 career games.

**ON DECK - TORONTO BLUE JAYS:** The D-backs host the Blue Jays for just the fifth time ever (also: 2002, '10, '13, '16) and first time since July 19-20, 2016.

- ♦ The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 home games vs. Blue Jays (4-7 all-time).
- The D-backs were swept last July 14-16 @ Blue Jays and prior to that swept the Blue Jays in Toronto June 7-9, 2019.
