THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 24

1994 - In an 8-0 shutout vs. ATL, **RHP Doug Drabek** has a career day. In addition to hurling a 3-hit, shutout, Drabek also adds 3 hits and 2 RBI as a hitter.

1981 - In a 2-1 loss vs. SF in the Dome, Art Howe triples off Vida Blue to set a then, club-record 23-game hitting streak.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Cubs will wrap up their 3-game series this afternoon at Wrigley Field...**RHP Peter Lambert** (2-4) will start for the Astros vs. Cubs **LHP Shota Imanaga** (4-4).

SWEEPSTAKES: A win today would give the Astros their 2nd series sweep of the season and 1st on the road...their other sweep in 2026 came March 30-April 1 vs. BOS at Daikin Park...**At Wrigley:** The last time that the Astros swept the Cubs at Wrigley Field was in a 3-game series, May 30-June 1, 2011.

IN THE DAYTIME: Today is the 4th of 4 consecutive scheduled day games for the Astros...Wednesday's series finale at MIN had a 12:40 p.m. start and all 3 games this weekend at Wrigley Field had 1:20 p.m. start times...the last time that the Astros played 4 consecutive day games was April 2-6 of last season (source: Elias).

ROADIES: Today is the 6th game (3-2 thus far) of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for HOU...HOU went 1-2 at MIN on the 1st stop of the trip and are 2-0 with 1 game left to play in CHC...after today's game, they will travel back to Texas for a 4-game series vs. the Rangers at Globe Life Field (Mon.-Thurs).

VS. THE CUBBIES: Dating back to last season, the Astros have won 4 of their last 5 games vs. the Cubs...they took 2 of 3 vs. CHC, June 27-29 of 2025 at Daikin Park...prior to the current series, the Astros last visit to Wrigley Field was a 3-game series in April of 2024 (3-gm sweep by CHC)...the Astros are 9-5 vs. the Cubs since 2019...**All-Time:** The Astros are 387-338 all-time vs. the Cubbies...Their 387 wins vs. them are their 2nd-most vs. any opponent (404-455 vs. CIN)...**First Game Ever:** The very first official game of the Houston franchise was vs. the Cubs...on April 10, 1962, the Colt .45s defeated the Cubs, 11-2, at Colt Stadium, behind a CG win by **LHP Bobby Shantz**.

RARE VISIT TO WRIGLEY: The current series marks just the 2nd visit to Wrigley Field for the Astros since 2013...the 2013 season is when the Astros were moved to the American League.

THE LAMMA: **RHP Peter Lambert** will make his 7th start of the season this afternoon...in his 2 previous road starts, Lambert is 1-1 with a 1.74 ERA (2ER/10.1 IP)...**vs. CHC:** Lambert is 2-0 in 3 career apps. (2 GS) vs. the Cubs with a 2.57 ERA (4ER/14IP) with 14 K's...**Where It All Started:** Lambert's Major League debut came in a start at Wrigley Field on June 6, 2019 while with COL...in that start, he had a ND, but pitched well (7 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 9 SO) in a 3-1 Rockies win...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in three appearances) before being called up to join the rotation on April 17.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Astros topped the Cubs yesterday, 3-0, behind the strong pitching of starter **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** and a 2-HR day from **1B Christian Walker**...Teng hurled 6.0 shutout innings to earn the win while Walker went 3x3 with 2 HR and 3 RBI...**LHP Bryan King** hurled a scoreless 9th to earn his 6th save of the season.

BLANKINGS: Yesterday's 3-0 win was the Astros 5th shutout of the season, which is T-3rd in the AL.

FOR STARTERS: Astros starters have a combined ERA of 2.56 (13ER/45.2IP) over the last 8 games... yesterday was the 3rd time in the last 4 games that an Astros starter did not allow a run in their start... additionally, Astros starters have allowed no runs 4 times in the last 8 games.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** had his 17th career 2-HR game in yesterday's 3-0 win...for the season, he has been one of the top hitting 1st basemen in the AL...overall, he currently ranks 4th the AL in RBI (34), 6th in TB (100), T-6th in HR (13) and 7th in SLG (.521).

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Since making his season debut on April 15, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has been one of the top starters in the Majors...with Friday's win, he is now 6-1 in just 7 starts with a 1.32 ERA (6ER/41IP) and a miniscule .169 batting avg. (24 H allowed in 41.0 IP)...since April 15, Arrighetti's 6 wins are tops in the AL in that span...**Model of Consistency:** Arrighetti has allowed 1 ER or less in 6 of his 7 starts and 2 ER or less in all 7 starts... in May, Arrighetti is 3-1 in 4 starts with an 0.78 ERA (2ER/23IP).

RECENT STROS: The Astros are 5-3 in their last 8 games and 6-4 in their last 10 games.

CLOSE CALLS: With Friday's 4-2 win, the Astros are 9-8 in 2-run games and 4-2 in 1-run games.

THROWING SOME LEATHER: The Astros 19 errors as a club are T-2nd fewest in the AL this season... the Astros had the fewest errors in the AL prior to committing 2 errors in Friday's 4-2 win.

PEN PALS: As a group, the Astros bullpen has had a decent run of success recently...since May 8, they have a combined ERA of 3.35 (18ER/48.1IP)... individually, several relievers are currently pitching well:
-**RHP Bryan Abreu: 0.00 ERA in last 7 outings (6.2 IP, 0 R).**
-**RHP AJ Blubaugh: 2.18 ERA in last 8 outings (12.1 IP, 3 ER).**
-**LHP Bryan King: 1.42 ERA in last 10 outings (12.2 IP, 2 ER)**
-**LHP Steven Okert: 8 K's in his last 4.2 IP (5 apps.)...3.24 ERA in his last 9 outings (8.1 IP, 3 ER).**

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 35...they are 35-for-59 (59%) in their challenges...individually, **Jose Altuve** is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 9 succesful challenges (9-for-13, 69%).

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros have been one of the AL's top hitting teams on the road in 2026... entering today's game, HOU leads the AL in road batting avg. (.264) and rank 3rd in OBP (.334), SLG (.410) and OPS (.744).

BRYAN'S SONG: After a slow start to his season, **RHP Bryan Abreu** has not allowed a run in his last 7 outings, covering 6.2 IP (3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 5 SO)...in his last 9 appearances, Abreu has posted a 1.04 ERA (1ER/8.2IP) with 9 K's.

THERE IS A SANTA: **RHP Alimber Santa**, who was selected by the Astros from Triple A Sugar Land on Friday, has been outstanding for Sugar Land this season...in his 18 relief appearances, Santa is 4-2 with a 1.42 ERA (3ER/19IP), allowing just 10 hits in his 19.0 innings of work for a .159 opp. avg...he had not allowed a run in his last 6 app. (5.2 IP).

LAST START - MAY 17 vs. TEX: Last pitched last Sunday vs. the Rangers in Houston...was handed the loss after allowing 5 runs on 3 hits and 2 walks in 6.0 innings pitched...pitched better than his final line indicated, as he worked 6.0 innings of 2-run ball before running into trouble in the 7th...allowed a walk, a double and a HBP in the 7th before being pulled...all 3 runners came home to score after he left the game...marked his 3rd straight game to toss 6.0+ innings in a start, the first time he's done this in his MLB career (41 career starts).

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has been a stabilizer in the Astros rotation amid a flux of injuries...has recorded a quality start in 3 of his 6 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 4 of his 6 starts...among AL pitchers with 35.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks 7th in H/9IP (6.11) and 7th in opponent batting average (.189)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

THE REPERTOIRE: Has been greatly successful mixing his pitches this year, tossing 30% four-seamers, 23% changeups, and 16% sliders, while mixing in slurve (10%), cutters (10%) and sinkers (7%).

SAVANT SAYS: Among Major League pitchers, is in the 81st percentile of Major League pitchers in xBA (.213), the 76th percentile in barrel % (5.4) and the 72nd percentile in whiff % (28.3).

VS. CHC: Has 3 career appearances (2 starts) against the Cubs, in which he's gone 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (4ER/14IP)...last faced them in relief on April 1, 2024 in Chicago, allowing 2 runs in 2.0 innings...made his Major League debut at Wrigley Field on June 6, 2019 in a start for the Rockies...tossed 7.0 innings of 1-run ball on 4 hits in 9 strikeouts en route to the win in his debut.

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Notched the best the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory...matched his career high with 7.0 innings, which he's now accomplished 4 times.

SWING & A MISS: Made his Astros debut on April 17 vs. STL...opened eyes by inducing 23 whiffs by Cardinals hitters...that total ties as the 4th-highest by an AL pitcher in 2026...only **LHP Cole Ragans** (27), **RHP Dylan Cease** (24) and **RHP Gavin Williams** (24) have had more whiffs in a game than Lambert this season.

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE: After signing with the Astros as a minor league free agent this offseason, was an NRI at Major League Spring Training...impressed this Spring, making 5 appearances, including 2 starts with the Astros in Major League Spring Training...recorded a 2.92 ERA (4ER/12.1IP) with 8 strikeouts.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/22 at CHC): Walked 1 in 0.2 of a scoreless inning Friday at CHC to record his 3rd hold of the season.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-2 through 7 consecutive scoreless appearances (6.2 IP), dating back to May 3, also posting a .143 opponent average (3x21) and 1.05 WHIP over that span...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season...his 7-appearance scoreless streak is the longest active streak (in terms of games) among Astros pitchers.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing RHP Octavio Dotel for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (335) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on RHP Ryan Pressly (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).
