YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Yankees, 6-1, extending their losing streak to a season-high-tying five games (also 6/21-25)...The loss snapped a streak of 22 consecutive sets against AL East opponents without a series loss...**Ryan O'Hearn** hit his second triple of the year and later scored on a groundout...**Colton Cowser** recorded two hits.

ALL-STAR: Five Orioles have been selected to the All-Star Game: **Corbin Burnes**, **Gunnar Henderson**, **Adley Rutschman**, **Anthony Santander**, and **Jordan Westburg**...Head Athletic Trainer **Brian Ebel** will also represent the O's on the AL staff...Henderson (SS) and Rutschman (C) won the fan vote and will start for the AL, marking the first time the Orioles have had multiple starters in a Midsummer Classic since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014...Burnes earned his fourth consecutive selection as a result of the Player Ballot...Santander and Westburg were added to the roster as replacements for Houston's Kyle Tucker and Boston's Rafael Devers, respectively...This marks the first time the O's have had five representatives at a Midsummer Classic since 2016, when they sent **Brad Brach**, **Zack Britton**, **Manny Machado**, **Mark Trumbo**, and **Matt Wieters**...Henderson, Santander, and Westburg each earned their first career All-Star nod.

- 👉 Rutschman received 70 percent of the vote to defeat Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's an All-Star for the second time (2023) and earned his first starting assignment; he'll become the third O's backstop (fourth occurrence) to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).
- 👉 Henderson beat Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of the vote; he is the first Orioles shortstop sent to the Midsummer Classic since Machado started in 2018.
- 👉 Burnes becomes the first Orioles starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since **John Means** in 2019.
- 👉 Santander joins **Austin Hays** (2023) and **Cedric Mullins** (2021) as outfielders to represent the O's at the All-Star Game in the last four seasons.
- 👉 Westburg is the first Orioles third baseman to be selected to the All-Star Game since Machado in 2016.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 147 home runs, nine more than the second-place Yankees (138) and 18 more than the Dodgers (129), who rank third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

- 👉 Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (27), **Anthony Santander** (23), **Adley Rutschman** (16), **Jordan Westburg** (15), **Colton Cowser** and **Ryan Mountcastle** (12), and **Ryan O'Hearn** (11).
- 👉 Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramírez (23) and Josh Naylor (22), and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (33) and Juan Soto (22).
- 👉 The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).
- 👉 The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.
- 👉 **Anthony Santander** led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history; he tied with **Nelson Cruz** (13 in May 2014) and **Frank Robinson** (13 in July 1966), and finished behind **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a month by an Oriole.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** will participate in the 2024 T-Mobile Home Run Derby in Arlington...He will be the third Oriole in the last four seasons to hit in the derby, joining **Adley Rutschman** (2023) and **Trey Mancini** (2021)...Two Orioles have won a Home Run Derby, both shortstops: **Cal Ripken, Jr.** at Toronto's SkyDome in 1991 and **Miguel Tejada** at Houston's Minute Maid Park in 2004.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles complete a six-game homestand today with the series finale against the Yankees...After being swept by the Cubs and dropping the first two games against the Yanks, the Orioles are guaranteed their first losing homestand since September 11-17, 2023, when they went 3-4...The O's have lost six straight games at home for the first time since losing 10 straight from August 6-24, 2021...Since the start of 2023, the Birds have gone 78-54 (10-1) at Oriole Park, the best home record in the AL and the fifth-best home record in MLB behind the Brewers (.611, 77-49), Dodgers (.633, 81-47), Braves (.638, 81-46), and Phillies (.647, 86-47).

- 👉 Baltimore is looking to avoid being swept on a homestand for the first time since August 6-12, 2021 when they lost three games each to the Rays and Tigers.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: The Orioles and Yankees continue the third of four series with the 10th of 13 overall matchups this season tonight in Charm City...The O's and Yanks are in a virtual tie atop the AL East, though the Birds have a higher winner percentage due to playing two fewer games...The Orioles took three out of four in Baltimore from April 29 to May 2 and two of three in the Bronx from June 18-20, including a 17-5 win in the rubber game of that series...The O's will travel to Yankee Stadium to conclude the season series from September 24-26 (3 G)...The Orioles won the season series (7-6) against the Yankees last year for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2014-16...The Orioles are 12-10 (.545) against New York since the start of last season.

AL BEAST: Entering the current series, the Orioles had gone 22 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, going 16-0-6 in series during that time and 49-23 (.681) overall...That was the longest streak by a team against its own division without a series loss since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

- 👉 The O's are 19-9 (.679) against the AL East this year and have gone 51-29 (.638) against division opponents since the start of 2023.
- 👉 The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014; the Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

IN THE SPOTLIGHT: Today's game will air on Roku MLB Sunday Leadoff, with **Matt Vasgersian** doing play-by-play, **Ben McDonald** and **Jeff Nelson** as analysts, and **Brett Hollander** as the field reporter.

POPULARITY CONTEXT: MLB announced the most popular player jerseys for the first half of the 2024 season...Orioles catcher **Adley Rutschman** - who finished last year at No. 20 - has climbed to No. 16 on the list.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles made several moves yesterday, including two right before the game...Outfielder **Kyle Stowers** was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk after outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** was placed on the 7-day concussion Injured List...Earlier in the day, the team selected the contract of right-handed pitcher **Vinny Nittoli** from Norfolk, optioned left-handed pitcher **Cade Povich** to Norfolk after Friday's game, and left-handed pitcher **Danny Coulombe** (left elbow surgery) was transferred to the 60-day Injured List.

THANK YOU, LD: Today marks the final game for **Liam Davis** working for the Orioles...We thank him for his eight seasons with the organization, including the last six as part of the Public Relations team, and wish him the best of luck in the future.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 12th start of the season this afternoon against the Yankees...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) prior to the game on July 3; placed on the IL on May 24 (retroactive to May 21)...Made three rehab starts with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to an 11.42 ERA (11 ER/8.2 IP) with nine strikeouts and four walks...Did not factor in the decision in his final rehab appearance with the Tides on June 27 vs. Charlotte; allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts in 4.1 innings...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his 2023 campaign... The O's went 24-8 in his starts and his career-high 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, OF Yussniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Dealt the loss on July 9 vs. Chicago-NL after allowing seven runs (5 ER) on seven hits (2 HR), three walks, one hit batter, and three strikeouts across 4.0 innings...Tied for his shortest start of the year (3x, last: 5/20 at STL)...Surrendered two home runs for the fourth time this season and for the first time since April 30 vs. New York-AL...Marked his second start since returning from the Injured List with a right triceps strain...Threw 85 pitches, 53 strikes.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Owns a lifetime 3-3 record with a 4.70 ERA in his 10 prior starts against New York-AL...Secured the win in his sole start against the Yankees this season on April 30 at Oriole Park after allowing two runs on four hits (2 HR) and four walks with four strikeouts...Faced the Yankees in his MLB debut on September 6, 2020 in Baltimore.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Making his 34th career start and second of the season against the AL East...Owns a 9-1 record with a 4.66 ERA (88 ER/170.0 IP) in his 34 career outings (33GS) against the division...His only prior start against the AL East this season came on April 30 vs. New York-AL.

HOME SWEET HOME: Has gone 1-3 with a 6.58 ERA (19 ER/26.0 IP) in five starts at Oriole Park this season...Opponents are slashing .267/.344/.562 (28-for-105) in home games compared to .162/.227/.265 (19-for-117) in six road outings.

DAYMAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHTMAN: Is 2-2 with a 3.54 ERA (11 ER/28.0 IP) in five day starts this year, compared to 2-3 with a 5.23 ERA (18 ER/31.0 IP) in six night starts.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: In his last eight starts since April 19, Kremer has held right-handed hitters to a .147/.216/.205 (11-for-78) slash line with one home run, seven walks, one hit batter, and 25 strikeouts...Has held right-handers to a .593 OPS on the season.

GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS: Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...He went 8-4 with a 5.04 ERA (51 ER/91.0 IP) and seven quality starts in his first 17 starts to open the year, allowing 105 hits (19 HR) and 24 walks with 82 strikeouts.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Earned the win on September 28 vs. Boston, clinching the AL East...Collected his 300th career strikeout on September 17 vs. Tampa Bay, matching Chuck Estrada and Daniel Cabrera as the fifth-fastest Orioles by appearances (69) to reach the mark...Logged four straight quality starts from August 10-29, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic; made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12, 2023 at loanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K).

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Kremer made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS against the Texas Rangers on October 10...Allowed six runs on seven hits and one walk in 1.2 innings...The six earned runs marked the most amount that Kremer had given up in a game since June 30 vs. Minnesota (7 ER)...It was his shortest outing since June 24, 2021 at Toronto (0.1 IP).
