SNAKEBITES

APPROACHING 2.3 MILLION: The D-backs are on the verge of back-to-back seasons of 2.3+ million in attendance, having drawn 2,272,722 through 78 home games, and are expected to pass 2007’s 2,325,413 then last season’s 2,341,876 for the largest home attendance since 2008, fourth largest since 2003 and ninth all-time.

- Saturday’s attendance of 35,498 was the D-backs fifth straight home Saturday crowd of 35,000+ – also: 42,817 on July 19 vs. Cardinals, 38,337 on Aug. 9 vs. Rockies, 36,567 on Aug. 23 vs. Reds and 35,679 on Sept. 6 vs. Red Sox – and their 10th home Saturday crowd of 35,000+ fans.
- Sunday’s crowd of 37,105 was the fourth-largest Sunday home crowd.

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs — who trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 — are fifth, 1.0 game behind the tied-for-third-place Reds and Mets (Reds own the tiebreaker over the Mets and D-backs)... the sixth-place Giants are 3.5 games behind, 2.5 games behind the the D-backs.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 games.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has an 11-game hitting streak, since Sept. 9, batting .410 (16-for-39)/1.267 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 6 RBI, 9 walks (3 K) and 3 hit by pitches.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 11 straight games, hitting .381 (16-for-42)/1.051 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 8 walks (4 K).
- **Corbin Carroll**, on Sunday, became the first D-back with 30+ homers and 30+ stolen bases in a season.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 9-2 vs. Phillies.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** tossed 6.0 shutout frames (6 H, 3 BB, 5 K), his fifth game with 6.0 or more scoreless innings.
- The D-backs 1-4 hitters - **Ketel Marte**, **Geraldo Perdomo**, **Corbin Carroll** & **Gabriel Moreno** - were a combined 9-for-19 (.474) with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 7 RBI.
- **Corbin Carroll** went 2-for-5 with a double, 3-run homer and 4 RBI.
- **Jorge Barrosa** went 3-for-4 with his first career home run.

IF YOU DON’T MIND, IT DON’T MATTER: The D-backs’ current roster’s 8,890 big league games are second-fewest among teams in the pennant race behind the Guardians (6,721)...next closest are the Reds (9,107), Giants (9,322), Tigers (9,701) and Brewers (9,718).

THE RESURGENCE: Since August 1, the D-backs’ 28-19 (.587) record is third in the NL and tied for fifth in the Majors: Phillies (31-17, .646), Brewers (31-18, .633), Mariners (29-17, .630), Guardians (30-18, .625), **D-backs (28-19, .596)**, Yankees (28-19, .596) and Braves (28-21, .571).

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation is among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27 ranking first with 15 quality starts, tied for first with 12 starter wins, third with a 2.67 ERA, fourth with 44 runs allowed, and fifth with 135.0 innings and an opponent .636 OPS.

- The D-backs are 15-8 @ Brewers, @ Dodgers, vs. Rangers, vs. Red Sox, @ Giants, @ Twins, vs. Giants and vs. Phillies.

1-2-3-WHEEEEE: Over the last 6 games, since Sept. 15, **Geraldo Perdomo**, **Ketel Marte** and **Corbin Carroll** are hitting a combined .347 (26-for-75)/1.012 OPS with 9 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 14 RBI, 6 walks (9 K) and 2 hit by pitches...Perdomo and Carroll have hit safely in all 6 games and Marte has hit safely in 4 of 6 games.

1 OF 10: Corbin Carroll (31 2B, 17 3B, 31 HR) is the 10th player (12th time) in Major League history to reach 30+ doubles, 15+ triples and 30+ homers in a season: Babe Ruth (1921), Lou Gehrig (1927), Jim Bottomley (1928), Lou Gehrig (1930), Al Simmons (1930), Lou Gehrig (1931), Chuck Klein (1932), Hank Greenberg (1935), Joe DiMaggio (1937), Stan Musial (1948), Jimmy Rollins (2007), **Corbin Carroll (2025)**

CUATRO: Ketel Marte has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 games at a .348 clip (8-for-23)/.984 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 home runs and 5 RBI.

- Last season, reached base safely in 9 of his final 10 games, from Sept. 19-29 (.324 AVG, 11-for-34, 1.213 OPS, 2 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI, 9 BB-6 K.
- In 2023, reached base safely in 8 of his final 10 games, from Sept. 17-30 (.333 AVG, 11-for-33, 1.075 OPS, 1 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 7 BB-7 K).

HOME SWEET HOME: Corbin Carroll has hit safely in 10 straight home games at a .368 clip (14-for-38)/1.116 with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 10 RBI and 5 walks.

- **James McCann** has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 home games (.321 AVG, 9-for-28, .845 OPS, 2 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 5 of his last 7 home games (.318 AVG, 7-for-22, .788 OPS, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 1 BB).

YEAR OF THE SNAKE: Geraldo Perdomo’s 6.8 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is third in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (9.0) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (6.9) and ahead of Julio Rodríguez/SEA (6.5), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.5), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (6.5).

- **Perdomo’s** 6.9 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.2) and ahead of Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.3).

DEFENSE RULES (h/t FIELDING BIBLE): Blaze Alexander’s 9 defensive runs saved (DRS) lead the team, ahead of Corbin Carroll (8 DRS) and Tim Tawa (7)...the Major’s Top 3 are Ceddane Rafaela/BOS (23), Patrick Bailey/SF (20), Ernie Clement/TOR (20) and Ke’Bryan Hayes/CIN (20).

- Since 2024, Alexander’s 9 DRS are shy of the most behind 2024’s Gabriel Moreno (10), Geraldo Perdomo (10), Ketel Marte (10) and Kevin Newman (10)...2023’s Top 3 were Gabriel Moreno (20), Lourdes Gurriel, Jr. (13) and Christian Walker (9).

HOME SERIES STREAKIN’: The D-backs’ 7 straight home series wins, since Aug. 8, are tied for the second-longest streak in club history with 7 straight from Aug. 8-Sept. 25, 2011 behind 8 straight from Aug. 3-Oct. 4, 2001.

EXTRA BASES: Corbin Carroll’s 79 extra-base hits are fourth in the Majors to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (85), Aaron Judge/NYY (80) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (80) and ahead of Kyle Schwarber/PHI (77) and Pete Alonso/NYM (76).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (7-3, 3.34)

- Has quality starts in 5 of his last 6 starts, since Aug. 22, going 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA (10 ER in 35.0 IP), an opponent .208 AVG (26-for-125)/.616 OPS, 11 walks and 24 strikeouts.
- In 6 career games (3 starts) vs. Dodgers, is 2-0 with a 1.55 ERA (5 ER in 29.0 IP), an opponent .190 AVG (20-for-105)/.538 OPS, 9 walks and 20 strikeouts.

Snakebites

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in May 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: His career-high 13 wins are tied for sixth among NL starters with Matthew Boyd/CHC, Zac Gallen/AZ, Adrian Morejon/SD, Nick Pivetta/SD, Quinn Priester/MIL and Cristopher Sánchez/PHI, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (17), Sonny Gray/STL (14), Jesús Luzardo/PHI (14), Brady Singer/CIN (14) and Logan Webb/SF (14).

- Making his 31st career start, 1 start shy of his career-high 32 starts in 2024.
- His 2.75 ERA (3 GS; 6 ER in 19.2 IP) in September is currently a career second-best in any month, behind his 2.31 ERA in July 2024 (4 GS).
- In his last 5 starts (3 quality), is 3-0 with a 2.20 ERA (8 ER in 32.2 IP), opponent .228 AVG (28-for-123), 5 walks and 25 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 13 wins have come when the D-backs scored 6+ runs.
- Is homerless in his last 9 home starts (227 BF), going 4-1 with a 2.57 ERA (17 R-16 ER in 56.0 IP), an opponent .226 AVG (48-for-212), 10 walks and 51 strikeouts.

LAST START: Tossed 9.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts in the no-decision on Sept. 17 vs. Giants...D-backs lost 5-1 in 11.0 innings.

- Became the eighth D-back (ninth time) to work 9.0 scoreless innings with 1 or fewer hits.
- Was the third D-backs starter, first at home, to throw 9.0+ shutout innings and not be credited with a complete game shutout (also: Miguel Batista on May 28, 2002 @ Giants; Edwin Jackson on June 2, 2010 @ Dodgers).

VS. DODGERS: Making his eighth career start, fourth @ Chase Field.

- Has won 4 of his last 5 starts (3 quality), going 4-0 with a 3.81 ERA (13 R-12 ER in 28.1 IP), opponent .241 AVG (27-for-112)/.658 OPS, 8 walks and 28 strikeouts.
- In 3 career home starts (1 quality) vs. Dodgers, is 2-1 with a 3.78 ERA (7 ER in 16.2 IP), 7 walks and 21 strikeouts.
- In 7 career starts (3 quality), is 4-2 with a 5.11 ERA (23 R-21 ER in 37.0 IP), 12 walks and 37 strikeouts.

VS. NL WEST: In his last 6 home starts vs. NL West dating back to Sept. 29, 2024, is 4-1 with a 2.41 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 37.1 IP), 10 walks and 36 strikeouts.

- Over 11 starts this season, is 5-4 with a 4.13 ERA (30 ER in 65.1 IP), 17 walks and 50 strikeouts.

30+ STARTS: Is the 12th D-backs starting pitcher all-time with 2+ consecutive 30+-start seasons.

- Brandon Webb holds the franchise record with 5 straight seasons (2004-08) followed by Randy Johnson's 4 straight (1999-2002), Ian Kennedy's 3 straight (2010-12) then 2 straight seasons by Brandon Pfaadt (2024-25), Merrill Kelly (2022-23), Zac Gallen (2022-23), Zack Greinke (2017-18), Patrick Corbin (2017-18), Wade Miley (2013-14), Dan Haren (2008-09), Curt Schilling (2001-02) and Andy Benes (1998-99).

HOME COOKIN: In 16 home starts (9 quality), is 9-3 with a 3.15 ERA (34 R-32 ER in 91.1 IP), 18 walks and 80 strikeouts...3.15 home ERA is a career low, ahead of 5.09 in 2024 (16 GS) and 6.46 in 2023 (10 GS).

- His 9 home wins are tied for third most among NL starters with Freddy Peralta/MIL, behind Matthew Boyd/CHC (11) and Sonny Gray/STL (10).
- Has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 12 of his 16 home starts.
- Has only allowed 3 home runs at home (0.30 HR/9.0 IP)...last allowed 2 home runs on June 10 vs. Seattle.
- Over 4 home starts from April 9-May 8, went 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER in 24.1 IP), opponent .236 AVG (21-for-89) /.584 OPS, 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.
 - Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on April 19 vs. Baltimore and 6.1 scoreless innings on May 8 vs. Dodgers.
- Posted 5 straight quality starts in his first 5 home starts from March 29-May 8, going 4-1 with a 1.78 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 30.1 IP), opponent .239 AVG, 7 walks and 25 strikeouts.

NO WALK PFAADT: Among NL starting pitchers (min. 25 GS), his 35 walks are second lowest to Nick Lodolo/CIN (28).

- His 1.89 walks per 9.0 innings ratio is fifth-lowest in the Majors behind Tarik Skubal/DET (1.43), Zack Littell/CIN (1.48), Bryan Woo/SEA (1.74) and Sonny Gray/STL (1.85).
- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 17 starts with no walks are third in the NL, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (22) and Shota Imanaga/CHC (18).
- Has held opponents to 1 or fewer walks in 22 of his 31 starts.

BY INNING: In each of his last 9 starts, in innings 5-6, has limited opponents to 1 or fewer runs, including 5 starts with 0 runs allowed.

- In innings 2-5 in his last 12 home starts, since May 8, has held opponents to 9 runs in 44.0 innings (35 H – 0 HR, 4 BB, 41 K).

WINNING WAYS: Secured his 10th victory in 7-3 win vs. Cardinals on July 18 to become the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165), behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013), and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season.

APRIL WAS NO JOKE: Had a career-high 5-game win streak from April 4-April 27.

- Is scoreless in 9 of his last 12 home games, since Aug. 5, with a 3.14 ERA (7 R-5 ER in 14.1 IP).
- On Sept. 20 vs. Phillies, became the 17th different D-backs player to record a save in 2025, extending their Major League record (previous record was 14 by the 2024 Dodgers and 2021 Rays).
