**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue an eight-game homestand into the All-Star Break against first place teams in the National League Central (Milwaukee) and East (Atlanta). The Cardinals were swept in a doubleheader yesterday (4-3 & 10-2) by the Milwaukee Brewers and have lost seven straight contests to their N.L. Central rivals, dropping the season series with five games to play. Tonight is the 4th game of their five-game series. The homestand concludes with a three-game series against Atlanta beginning on Friday.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters play in 3rd place in the National League Central, 10.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 3.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are now at their furthest mark from first place this season at 10.5 games. The 'Birds are in a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in play-off position (2-1 at Braves; 2-1 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers 0-3; and 3 vs. Braves).

**GASTELUM SELECTED; SHUSTER OPTIONED:** Following last night's game, the Cardinals designated LHP **Jared Shuster** for assignment. Today, the Cardinals selected RHP **Luis Gastelum** from the Memphis (AAA) roster. He will be making his Major League debut when he enters a game. Gastelum was signed by the Cardinals as an international free agent out of Mexico in 2023. He's posted a 7-1 record with a 2.27 ERA and two saves in 36 appearances. He has not been scored upon in his last 18 appearances dating back to May 21.

**A FEW GOOD MEN:** Entering tonight's game the Cardinals have had 39 players appear in a game, fewest in Major League Baseball. When **Luis Gastelum** appears, the Cardinals will tie the New York Yankees with 40. The Atlanta Braves have the most this season with 52.

**O'BRIEN SELECTED TO ALL-STAR GAME:** The St. Louis Cardinals were informed yesterday that RHP **Riley O'Brien** would replace Brewers' RHP **Jacob Misiorowski** at the All-Star Game in Philadelphia. He will join Cardinals OF **Jordan Walker** and manager **Oliver Marmol**. At 31, O'Brien is the oldest Cardinals first time all-star since RHP **Pat Neshek** (33) in 2014.

**GET SHORTY:** The Cardinals closed out last night's 10-2 loss by pitching position player **Bryan Torres**, who tossed 2.0 scoreless innings to finish the game. Torres, listed at 5-foot-7, became the shortest Cardinals pitcher to appear in a game since 5-foot-6 **Bobby Shantz** in 1964. His 2.0 scoreless innings was the longest scoreless outing by a Cardinals position player since C **Cody McKay**, also against Milwaukee, on April 8, 2004. Torres featured a curveball/slider combo averaging 39.8 MPH on the curveball and 47.7 MPH on the slider. A 32.2 MPH curve to **Cooper Pratt** was the slowest Cardinals recorded pitch in the StatCast Era (since 2008) besting **Yadier Molina's** 42.9 MPH unknown pitch on May 22, 2022 at Pittsburgh.

**GO SHAWTY, IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY!:** Tonight's starting pitcher **Michael McGreevy** will be making his 18th start which will set a new single-season high for appearances and it comes on his 26th birthday. This will be McGreevy's first MLB appearance on his birthday and first Cardinals pitcher to start on his birthday since **Kwang Hyun-Kim** who celebrated his 33rd birthday vs. Chicago-NL on July 22, 2021. **Todd Worrell** and **Adam Wainwright** hold the Cardinals records for most birthday appearances with four. **Justin Bruihl** is the only other Cardinals pitcher to pitch on his birthday this season (June 26).

**FOUR SCORES AND 24 GAMES AGO:** The magic number for the Cardinals is four when it comes to the Milwaukee Brewers. During manager Oliver Marmol's tenure, the Cardinals are 19-5 against the Brewers when scoring four or more runs with a 10-2 mark at Busch Stadium. St. Louis is 8-34 when scoring three runs or less vs. Milwaukee since 2022.

#### MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

**Riley O'Brien's** grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

**Bryan Torres** originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

**Matthew Liberatore** earned his first MLB win on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium.

**Andre Pallante** struck out **Christian Yelich** (April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee) for his first career strike-out, and **Matt Svanson** fanned **Isaac Collins** for his first strikeout (April 27, 2025 at St. Louis).

**Jacob Misiorowski** played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

**Steve Dillard**, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops & 2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Yadier Molina** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 23, 2004 at Milwaukee off **Matt Wise**.

**William Contreras's** older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Brewers Sr. Special Asst to the GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for St. Louis in 2015.

**Trevor Megill** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

**Drew Rom** was acquired by the Cardinals from the Orioles in the four-player Jack Flaherty trade in 2023. He earned his first MLB win with St. Louis at Baltimore on Sept. 13, 2023.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

## TONIGHT'S START:

- Makes his single-season career high 18th start of the season tonight. It's his 37th career start (39th career game).
- Celebrates his 26th birthday today. The last Cardinals starting pitcher to start on his birthday since **Kwang Hyun-Kim** turned 33 birthday vs. the Cubs at Busch III on July 22, 2021 ... **Todd Worrell** and **Adam Wainwright** share the Cardinals record for most birthday appearances with four ... **Justin Bruihl** is the only other Cardinal to pitch on his birthday this season (turned 29 on June 26).
- **Allowed two runs or fewer in 12 of his 17 starts this season; his 12 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2 or fewer runs allowed tie Arizona's Eduardo Rodriguez for 2nd in MLB behind Philly's Christopher Sanchez (12).**
- Since making his MLB debut (July 31, 2024), leads qualifying Cardinals starting pitchers in opponent BA (.247), and WHIP (1.14), Hits/9 (8.41), and is 2nd in ERA (3.57).
- Held his opposition to 3 runs or fewer in all 8 home starts this season (1-2, 1.96 ERA, 46 IP); ranks 6th among MLB starters in home ERA ...
- Has made 19 career appearances (17 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-5 with a 3.40 ERA (106.0 IP).
- Seeking his 1st win since May 8 at San Diego; has gone 0-5 along with four no-decisions since his last win.
- The Cardinals are 22-16 (.579 win pct.) in his 38 career games started.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 36 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active leaders with 129.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 23 of 36 career starts (20 quality starts).
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 17 of his starts - three shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.

**LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, July 1 at Atlanta's Truitts Pak):** L, 3-7; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO; 87 pitches

- Hurlled a quality start but came away with losing decision in the Cardinals 5-1 loss to the Braves last Wednesday.
- Marked his 11th start this season of 6.0+ innings and 2 runs or fewer, tying Arizona's **Eduardo Rodriguez** for 2nd in MLB behind Philly's **Christopher Sanchez** (12).
- Also was his 5th start receiving one run of support or fewer since May 20.

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Induced 10 ground into double plays, matching his single-season high.

**THOU SHALL NOT STEAL:** Earned his first career pick-off, getting Estuary Ruiz (6/26) at first base.

**HELLO SUNSHINE:** His 2.21 ERA (40.2 IP/10 ER) in Day games is tops among all Cardinals pitchers with 26-to-5 strikeout to walks ratio, however has 6 HR's allowed in his 7 afternoon starts.

**EMPTY HANDED:** The Cardinals have given him 2 runs of support or fewer in 8 of his starts. The Cardinals have been shut out five times this season, four of which when McGreevy starts.

**FAITH IN FIELDERS:** Has the NL's 2nd-lowest percent (26.0) of Swing & Miss and 8th-best BABIP (.252) ... His difference in Opponent BA (.237) vs. xBA (.292) leads all MLB qualified starting pitchers (-.055).

**NESTING:** Has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in seven of his eight home starts this season, and did so in each of his 1st four starts before allowing three runs in his 5/20 start vs. PIT.

**HAPPY IT HAPPENED:** Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

**ONE-HIT WONDER:** Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

**DODGE BALL:** Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

**CURLY W:** Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

**"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS:** Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

**RARE BIRD:** In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

**McGREEVY vs. MILWAUKEE:**

- Makes his 2nd career start against Milwaukee. Previously faced the Brewers on May 26, 2026 at American Family Field in a 6-0 loss.
- Career 4-3 with a 3.96 ERA (52.1 IP) in nine games (eight starts) vs. the NL Central. Won his first four starts, but lost his last three.
- Lifetime 5-3 with a 6.31 ERA (51.1 IP) and 42 strikeouts in 10 starts vs. Nashville (AAA-Brewers) from 2023-25.
