TONIGHT'S TILT... the Mariners continue a 9-game homestand with the 2nd of 3 games against the Baltimore Orioles (0-1)...Seattle opened the homestand with a 3-game series vs. the Minnesota Twins (1-2)...the Mariners will wrap-up the homestand with 3 games against the Toronto Blue Jays (July 5-7)... tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** on the call... the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Aaron Goldsmith**.

<u>ODDS AND ENDS</u>...the Mariners dropped last night's series opener to the Orioles 2-0...despite the loss, the Mariners are 20-14 (.588) over their last 34 games (5/26-c).

- First Place Seattle (47-40) is in 1st place in the American League West Division by 3.0 games over the 2nd place Houston Astros (43-42)...the Mariners have held 1st place for 52 consecutive days (5/12-c).
- Home Field Advantage Seattle's 28-15 (.651) record at T-Mobile Park is the 4th-best in the Majors and trailing only the Cleveland Guardians (27-9/.750) in the AL...the Mariners are 13-5 (.7222) over their last 18 home games since May 27.
- Six Plus The Mariners are 40-16 (.714) when their starting pitchers go 6.0+ innings this season.
- Greatest Hits Seattle is 35-4 (.897) when out-hitting its opponent this season.
- Men of Steal The Mariners are 32-for-36 (88.9%) in stolen base attempts since May 27, tied for the
 best stolen base percentage in the Majors during that span (also: Chicago-NL, New York-NL, Oakland
 and Pittsburgh).
- Rehab Update RHP Gregory Santos began a rehab assignment with Triple-A Tacoma yesterday, tossing a scoreless inning with 1 strikeout and 1 hit on 13 pitches, 9 strikes.

PITCHING AT HOME...Seattle's pitching staff has allowed 125 runs at T-Mobile Park this season, the fewest runs allowed at home in the Majors (next: Texas, 135 R allowed)...the Mariners lead the Majors in home ERA (2.62), WHIP (0.93), hits-per-9 innings (6.50), walks-per-9 innings (1.86) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.99), tied for the lead in opponent batting average (.198) ranking 5th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (9.26)...Seattle's 4.95 strikeout-to-walk ratio this year is currently the highest home SO/BB ratio in Major League history, ranking ahead of Cleveland (4.81 in 2017).

GEORGE AND LOGAN'S BRILLIANT JUNE...Logan Gilbert went 2-1 with a 1.51 ERA (6 ER, 35.2 IP), 1 walk and 31 strikeouts in June, while **George Kirby** went 3-0 with a 1.74 ERA (6 ER, 31.0 IP), 3 walks and 31 strikeouts during the month...they became the first pair of teammates in Major League history to each post a sub-2.00 ERA with 30+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer walks in the same month.

THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT...the Mariners had 4 players in their minor league system earn monthly awards for June...pitchers **Emerson Hancock** (AAA Pacific Coast League), **Danny Wirchansky** (AA Texas League) and **Brandyn Garcia** (A+ Northwest League) each earned the Pitcher of the Month Award for their respective leagues, while OF **Jared Sundstrom** (A+) earned Northwest League Player of the Month...additionally, it was announced yesterday that INF **Cole Young** and C **Harry Ford** will represent the Mariners at the SirusXM Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Texas.

THE RECIPE...the Mariners are 36-6 (.857) this season when scoring 4+ runs in a game, as opposed to 11-34 (.244) when scoring 3-or-fewer runs...Seattle's .857 winning percentage when dialing up 4+ runs is best in the Majors...it is also on pace to be the 2nd-best record when scoring 4+ runs in franchise history, trailing only the 2001 Mariners (.886/101-13).

<u>ALL-STAR(TERS)</u>...the Mariners starting rotation has several All-Star candidates...Logan Gilbert <u>leads</u> the <u>American League</u> in WHIP (0.88), tied for the AL lead in quality starts (14) and 2nd in innings pitched (112.1), 3rd in opponent batting average (.195) and 6th in ERA (2.72)...George Kirby <u>leads</u> the <u>Majors</u> in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.10) and ranks 2nd in MLB in fewest walks-per-9 innings (0.85)...Luis Castillo's 103 strikeouts rank 11th in the AL, while **Bryce Miller** ranks 6th in the AL in opponent batting average (.208).

QUALITY ASSURANCE...the Mariners pitching staff <u>leads the Majors</u> in quality starts (51), with Seattle going 39-12 (.765) when its starter goes 6.0+ innings while allowing 3-or-fewer earned runs...the Mariners have 4 starters with 8+ quality starts this season: **Logan Gilbert** (14 QS), **Geore Kirby** (11), **Luis Castillo** (10) and **Bryce Miller** (8)...Gilbert's 14 QS are tied for most in MLB with Seth Lugo-KC...the Mariners and Phillies (Aaron Nola, Cristopher Sánchez, Ranger Suárez and Zack Wheeler) are the only teams in the Majors with 4 pitchers recording 8+ QS this season.

THREE WINNING MONTHS...the Mariners are coming off of their 3rd consecutive winning month, going 15-12 during June...Seattle went 17-13 in March/April and 15-14 in May...Seattle has started the season with 3 winning months for the 5th time in franchise history (2001-03, '18, '24)...with a winning month of July, the 2024 Mariners would become the 3rd team in franchise history to begin the season with 4 consecutive winning months (also: 2001 and 2002).

ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: WORTHY OF BEING AN AL ALL-STAR...right-hander Andrés Muñoz has 13 saves and a 1.64 ERA (6 ER, 33.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 13 walks in 33 appearances this season...his next save will set a career-high, after he recorded 13 saves in 2023...this season, Muñoz has posted a 1.03 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a .179 batting average...the 25-year-old is 1 of 2 American League pitchers with 13+ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE...Muñoz is 1 of 2 MLB pitchers with 10+ saves and 5+ holds this season, along with José Alvarado-PHI.

<u>YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVES</u>...the Mariners yesterday selected C **Seby Zavala** from Triple-A Tacoma and optioned LHP **Jhonathan Díaz** to Triple-A Tacoma...additionally, Seattle signed RHP **Chris Devenski** to a Major League contract and optioned him to Triple-A Tacoma.

<u>ON THE HOMESTAND</u>...the remaining promotions on the current 9-game homestand include **Patriotic Fireworks** tonight and **Patriotic Cap** on July 4...the Mariners will welcome the Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, 7/5-7) for a weekend series to close out the final homestand before the All-Star Break.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Cal Raleigh ranks 3rd among qualified Major League catchers in catcher ERA (3.28) while leading catchers in caught stealing (23) and catcher caught stealing (18), after nabbing 2 baserunners in last night's game, his 2nd game this season where he has thrown out multiple runners attempting a stolen base (also: May 20 at NYY), but...DID YOU KNOW?...that Cal has 12 defensive runs saved at catcher this season, the most in the Majors at any single position?...Daulton Varsho-TOR leads the Majors in DRS (15) but has done so playing both left field (9 DRS) and center field (6 DRS).

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- The 27-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 18th start of the season and 1st against Balti-more..he will also make the 106th start of his MLB career and 2nd career start against the Orioles.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Was named the 2022 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.

LAST TIME OUT...ND on 6/28 vs. Minnesota...he pitched 6.0 innings and only allowed 2 runs on 4 hits (1 home run) with 0 walks and 3 strikeouts...earned his 14th quality start of the season...leads the team in quality starts (next: George Kirby, 11).

AMONG THE AL's BEST...among qualified AL pitchers this season, Gilbert ranks T-1st in quality starts (14), 1st in WHIP (0.88), 2nd in innings pitched (112.1), 3rd in Opp. AVG (.194), 6th in ERA (2.72) and T-13th in strikeouts (102).

FEELING SUPPORTED...Gilbert is 34-0 in his career when the Mariners score 3 or more runs while he is in the game...in those games the Mariners are 42-9.

SHUTDOWN STARTER...made back-to-back starts with 8.0 scoreless innings pitched from 6/16-6/22...since the beginning of the 2020 season, only Nathan Eovaldi-TEX (3 G, 4/29-5/11/21) has gone 8.0+ scoreless innings in consecutive starts...he became the first Seattle pitcher since Mike Montgomery (6/23-6/30/15) to do so...Randy Johnson (5/28-6/8/97) was the last Mariners pitcher to do so in 3 consecutive outings.

MID-SEASON FORM...over 5 starts in June, he posted a 2-1 record with a 1.51 ERA (6 ER, 35.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts to 1 walk...his ERA marked the 2nd-lowest of his career during a single month (March/April 2022, 0.40 ERA)...Gilbert's 0.62 WHIP was the best mark in the Majors during June...his WHIP was also the lowest during a single month in his career.

EATING INNINGS...in each of his last 9 outings (5/14-c), he has gone 6.0+ innings...this the 3rd-longest active streak in the Majors...during that span he has 8 quality starts.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD...he is posting a 68.7% 1st pitch strike rate, the highest of his career...among pitchers with 80.0+ IP, this is the 3rd-highest in the AL behind Tarik Skubal-DET (71.6%) and Joe Ryan-MIN (70.7%).

MARINERS MILESTONES ... currently is 13th in franchise history with 593 strikeouts...Matt Young is 12th in the ranking with 597 strikeouts...he moved into the top-15 after striking out 5 batters on 6/5 at OAK.

100 AND COUNTING...made his 100th career start on 5/30 vs. HOU...he had the 4th-most strikeouts (562) in a players' first 100 games with the franchise...behind only James Paxton (603), Randy Johnson (593) and Félix Hernández (575)...only 14 pitchers in franchise history have had each of their first 100 appearances be starts.

FAR FROM HOME...has gone 6.0+ innings in 7 of his 9 away starts this season...in those 9 starts, he has a 2.75 ERA (18 ER, 59.0 IP) with 7 quality starts and 47 strikeouts...7 quality starts on the road is the 3rd-most on the road this season in MLB, trailing only Jake Irvin-WSH (10) and Seth Lugo-KC (8).

ALL I DO IS WIN ... over his career has made 55 starts away from T-Mobile Park...in those starts he is 25-7 for a .781 win percentage, the best in MLB history (min. 50 GS)...the next closest is Shane Bieber-CLE (37-14, .725).

STRONG BEGINNINGS...Gilbert was the 4th pitcher in Major League history to have recorded 500.0+ innings, 550+ strikeouts and 140-or-less walks in their first 100 career games...the list includes Noah Syndergaard-NYM, Masahiro Tanaka-NYY and Michael Pineda-NYY/SEA.

QUALITY MIDSET...14 of his 17 starts have been quality starts...he has gone 6.0+ innings in 15 of his 17 starts...the Mariners are 10-5 when he pitches in 6.0+ innings.

SITTING THEM DOWN...recorded 6+ strikeouts in each of his first 7 starts this season (3/30-5/4), tied for a career-best streak (also: 4/1/23-5/8/23)...has 4+ strikeouts in 15 of 17 starts this season...the only other Mariners pitcher to do so this season is Luis Castillo who has 15 in 18

GOOD STRETCH...went 3-0 with a 1.02 ERA (4 ER, 35.1 IP), 11 walks and 35 strikeouts over 5 starts (4/10-5/4)...recorded a quality start in each outing during the span and limited opponents to a .137 (16x117) average and a .442 OPS.
