THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
SEPT. 22
2019 - The Astros clinch their third straight AL West division title on a Sunday afternoon with a 13-5 victory over the Angels at Minute Maid Park... CF George Springer (3x5, 4RBI) led the way, as he smashed his way to just the 14th three-homer game in club history... RHP Justin Verlander picked up his 20th victory of the year by tossing 5.0 innings, allowing just two runs.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Houston Astros will begin their final road trip of the regular season with the first game of two-game series against the Seattle Mariners...**RHP Cristian Javier** (2-6) will be on the mound for the Astros, opposite **RHP Logan Gilbert** (12-10).

EL REPTIL: RHP Cristian Javier is making his 12th start and 17th appearance of the season tonight...in his last three starts, he's recorded a 2.20 ERA (4ER/16.1IP) with 15 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .161 opponent batting average...has also had success against the Mariners in his career, posting a 2.87 ERA (12ER/37.2IP) with 37 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .165 opponent batting average. .

THE POSTSEASON CHASE: The Astros and Rangers are locked in a tight race down the stretch for the AL West with the two teams separated by just one game with six left to play...the Astros own the tiebreaker over the Rangers with a season series victory (9-4 record).

VS. THE M'S: This is the final series between the Astros and Mariners this season, with the two clubs last seeing each other from Aug. 14-16 at Daikin Park...the Astros have gone 2-9 vs. Seattle this season...the Astros also own an overall regular season record of 134-106 against the Mariners, including a 64-48 record at T-Mobile Park.

ROAD WARRIORS: Tonight is the first game of a six-game road trip for the Astros...since going 1-9 on the first road trip of the 2026 season, the Astros have gone 37-28 (.569) on the road since April 14, which ranks third in the AL in that span.

SUNDAY RECAP: The Astros were defeated the Braves, 4-2 at Daikin Park on Sunday afternoon...**RHP Hunter Brown** allowed three hits and two walks with a season-high tying 10 strikeouts in five scoreless innings...**DH Jose Altuve** (2x4, HR, RBI) and **C Yainer Diaz** (2x4, HR, RBI) provided the offense for the Astros with both of them recording a solo home run.

GOIN' DEEP: The Astros have hit 209 homers as a team this year and have hit 200-plus homers in a single season for the 10th time in franchise history (last, 222 HR in 2023)...the Astros rank second in the AL in home runs this season behind only the Yankees (217).

TWO-OUT MAGIC: The Astros lead the American League in two-out runs with 307 on the season, trailing only the Cubs (329) in the Majors...**3B Isaac Paredes** has led this effort, as he is tied for the Major League lead with 44 two-out RBI, with **CHC CF Pete Crow-Armstrong**.

FOR THREE!: **2B Jose Altuve** went 3x4 on Saturday night for his 226th career three-hit game, which is the Astros franchise record...he surpassed Hall of Famer **2B Craig Biggio** (225 three-hit games).

THE CASE FOR THE MVP: DH Yordan Alvarez is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award...Alvarez leads the American League in OPS (1.027), slugging percentage (.597), OBP (.430), batting average (.313), total bases (324), walks (105), IBB (32) and extra-base hits (73)...he also ranks second in home runs (40), second in RBI (99), third in hits (170), tied for fourth in runs (98), and tied for fourth in doubles (32).

ROSTER MOVES: OF Jorge Barrosa has been outrighted to Triple A Sugar Land...he was designated for assignment on Saturday...also **RHP Mike Burrows** was returned from his rehab assignment yesterday.

THE FIREMAN: LHP Josh Hader has converted 26 consecutive save chances to open his season, which is the Astros record...should Hader finish the season without a blown save, he would become the seventh pitcher in MLB history to post 26-plus saves without a blown save...the last Major Leaguer to do so was **RHP Ken Giles** in 2018 (26 SV).

RACKING UP K'S: RHP Bryan Abreu has posted 527 career strikeouts, which ranks fourth among relievers in Astros history...he's closing in on third-place **RHP Dave Smith** (529), needing only two strikeouts to match the Astros reliever from the 1980s...**LHP Billy Wagner** (694) and **RHP Brad Lidge** (557) sit atop that all-time list.

MOVIN' ON UP: On Sunday, **C Yainer Diaz** went 2x4 with a solo home run...marked his 57th career home run as a catcher, surpassing **C Martin Maldonado** for the third-most home runs as a catcher in Astros franchise history.

STRONG SEPTEMBERS: 3B Isaac Paredes has a .950 OPS this month to go along with a team-leading 17 RBI, which ranks tied for second in the AL...**C Yainer Diaz** is also having a strong September, as he's hitting .357 (20x56) with three homers, seven RBI and a .961 OPS in 17 games (14 starts) this month.

TUVE VS. THE MARINERS: 2B Jose Altuve has hit .312 (255x818) with 49 doubles, 21 homers, 99 RBI and an .827 OPS in 201 career games against the Mariners...he already ranks third all-time in hits vs. SEA, trailing only **Cal Ripken Jr.** (261) and **Michael Young** (259).

STARTING STRONG: In the Astros 18 games in September, their starters have combined for a 2.90 ERA (28ER/87IP), which is the third-lowest ERA in the American League for the month behind only the Yankees (2.64 ERA) and Rays (2.81 ERA) rotations.

POSTSEASON CREDENTIALS: All media who wish to cover potential Astros postseason home games in the Wild Card Series and ALDS must apply for credentials on MLB's credentialing system...the events are now open with a deadline set for Sunday, Sept. 27...ALCS and World Series credential applications are also live online.

LAST START, SEPT. 16 vs. KC: Continued with his strong run by tossing 5.1 innings last Wednesday vs. the Royals at Daikin Park in Houston...allowed 2 runs on 5 hits and 3 walks on 85 pitches (53 strikes)...handed the loss in the Astros 5-2 defeat.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican hurler is in his 7th MLB season with the Astros...has pitched as both a starter (11g) and reliever (5g) this year, while pitching around a midseason, 3-month IL stint.

REPTIL ON A RUN: Over his last 5 starts (since Aug. 18), he's posted a 3.33 ERA (9ER/24.1IP) with 28 strikeouts, a .202 opponent batting average (18x89) and a 1.15 WHIP.

SINCE HIS RETURN: Is making his 14th appearance since being reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3...has posted a 4.01 ERA (23ER/51.2IP) with 53 strikeouts (17 walks) in his 13 total appearances since returning from the IL.

SAVANT SAYS: Has induced a 34.4-percent chase rate this season, which would set his single-season career high and ranks in the 86th percentile among MLB pitchers...would surpass a 29.0-percent chase rate from 2023...also ranks in the 84th percentile in hard-hit percentage (33.5) and in the 80th percentile in whiff percentage (29.3).

VS. SEA: Is facing the Mariners tonight for his first start against the division rival in nearly 3 years...last pitched against the Mariners in a start on Sept. 26, 2023 at SEA (3ER/4.2IP)...is 3-2 with a 2.87 ERA (12ER/37.2IP) in 9 career games (6 starts) against Seattle.

AS A STARTER: Began the season as the Astros' No. 3 starter and made 3 turns in the rotation before being placed on the IL with his right shoulder strain...has worked predominantly as a starter since the 2022 season, making 82 of his 92 total appearances in that span as a starter...has gone 35-25 with a 3.94 ERA (226ER/515.2IP), a .211 opponent batting average, and a 1.18 WHIP in his 101 career regular-season starts.

KEEP IT 100!: Became the 34th pitcher in franchise history to make his 100 career starts with the club on Sept. 10 at PHI...also became just the 11th pitcher to do so for the franchise since 2000, the first year of Daikin Park.

A CUT ABOVE: Has begun to mix a cutter into his repertoire, tossing it at a single-game career-high 17.4-percent rate in his start on Aug. 9 at SD...had not thrown a tracked cutter in his MLB career prior to his appearance on July 27 at LAA.

IN RELIEF: Has posted a 2.70 ERA (4ER/13.1IP) with 17 strikeouts, a 1.20 WHIP and a .245 opponent batting average through 5 relief appearances this season...his relief appearance on July 4 vs. TB was his 1st regular-season relief outing since Aug. 26, 2022 vs. BAL.

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3 after missing 76 games (April 9-July 1) due to a right shoulder strain...has battled a multitude of injuries the past few seasons, also missing most of the 2024 and '25 seasons due to Tommy John surgery (underwent the procedure in June 2024)...returned from Tommy John surgery on Aug. 11, 2025, going 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP) in eight starts to close out the season.

LAST APPEARANCE (9/19 vs. ATL): Surrendered a go-ahead grand slam to Ronald Acuña Jr. and was handed his 2nd blown save of the season in Saturday's loss to ATL...allowed 1 run on 2 hits through 0.2 of an inning, also allowing all 3 of his inherited runners to score.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 6-2-7 with a 2.29 ERA (13ER/51IP)...also has recorded 63 strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .178 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...among AL relievers since May 3 (min. 50 IP), he ranks 5th in SO/9 (11.12) and 6th in opponent batting average.

ASTROS RANKINGS: Enters today with 527 career strikeouts and is 2 strikeouts from matching RHP Dave Smith (529) for the 3rd-most by a reliever in Astros history.

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 97th percentile in whiff perc. (34.5%), 94th percentile in K rate (30.5%) and 92nd percentile in xBA (.197) per Baseball Savant.

A CUT ABOVE: Began throwing a cutter this season in his outing on June 2 vs. PIT and has tossed the pitch at a 10.8 percent rate on the season...has held opponents to a .200 batting average (4x20) vs. his cutter this year.
