



## San Francisco Giants (45-36) at New York Mets (36-45)

RHP Alex Cobb (5-2, 3.09) vs. RHP Carlos Carrasco (2-3, 6.19)

**GOSSIP GIRL HERE...:** After a 4 a.m. arrival into New York City, the Giants venture to Citi Field to open up a series tonight with the New York Mets...SF lost a 2-1 contest last night in Toronto and lost the series 2-1 after winning the first game on Tuesday...the series loss snapped a four-series win streak for the Giants and it was SF's first road series loss since May 11-14 at Arizona...the Giants have also lost consecutive road games for the first time since losing three straight May 12-14.

**DID YOU MISS ME?:** RHP Alex Cobb (#38) will be activated from the 15-day IL and start today's game for the Giants...a corresponding move will be announced prior to the game.

**SEND ME ALL THE DEETS:** Despite losing two straight, the Giants are still 13-4 over their last 17 games dating to June 11...in that time they have averaged 6.0 runs per game with a +37 run differential in the stretch...however, since June 22, SF has gone 3-4 in their last seven games.

**SPOTTED...:** The Giants are 17-8 (.680) in June, the fourth-best winning percentage this month behind the Braves (20-4, .833), Marlins (19-7, .731) and Philadelphia (18-7, .720).

**WE MAKE OUR OWN FAIRYTALES:** SF has reached the halfway point of the season at 45-36 with a 68.5% chance of making the playoffs according to Fangraphs...when the season started they had the Giants with a 40.3% chance of reaching postseason play...the 45 win mark through 81 games has been a good indicator of future postseason play for the Giants since 2012.

**YOU AREN'T BORN AT THE TOP, YOU CLIMB YOUR WAY UP:** The Giants have been one of the best teams in baseball over the last two months, posting a 34-20 record since May 1...SF's .630 winning percentage in that stretch is the second-best in the Majors behind the Braves (35-18, .660) and ahead of the Rangers, D-Backs and Marlins (all at 32-21, .604)...this recent success is in part due to the bullpen, who's sporting a MLB-best 2.60 ERA with an MLB-high 253 strikeouts in that stretch.

**A SOURCE INTO SF'S ELITE:** Much of the Giants recent success has come on the road, where they've won 10 of their last 12 and 15 of their last 19 games...since May 22, SF's .833 (15-4) winning percentage on the road is second-best in the Majors behind Cincinnati (15-3, .833)...overall, the Giants have a 22-17 (.564) record on the road this season, fifth-best in MLB behind Atlanta (26-12, .684), Arizona (24-14, .632, Baltimore (23-15, .605) and Texas (23-17, .575).

**YOU KNOW YOU LOVE ME:** IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. owns a .424 on-base percentage on the road this season and has reached base safely in 32 of his 38 road games this year...Wade's .424 road OBP is third-best in the Majors behind SD's Juan Soto (.429) and OAK's Ryan Noda (.429)...Wade's .416 overall OBP this year is third-best in MLB behind MIA's Luis Arraez (.444) and Soto (.424).

**THE MET STEPS:** This is the final regular season series between the Giants and Mets this season...the two clubs split a four-game set in San Francisco in mid-April with New York winning the first two games and the Giants swiping the last two...SF lost its series here in New York in 2022, going 1-3...in fact, the Giants have gone 1-4-1 in series here since 2016 (the two teams did not play in 2020)...the Giants are 9-11 in their last 20 regular season games here since 2016 with a -14 run differential.

**WELCOME BACK, UPPER EAST SIDERS: OF Michael Conforto** and **IF J.D. Davis** are returning to Citi Field for the first time since no longer playing for the New York Mets...Conforto helped the Mets to a World Series berth in his rookie season in Flushing in 2015 and was a Met from 2015-2021...Davis donned the blue and orange from 2019 until being acquired last season by the Giants at the Trade Deadline...this series also marks another return for **IF Wilmer Flores** to Flushing...Flores, like Conforto, began his career with the Mets.

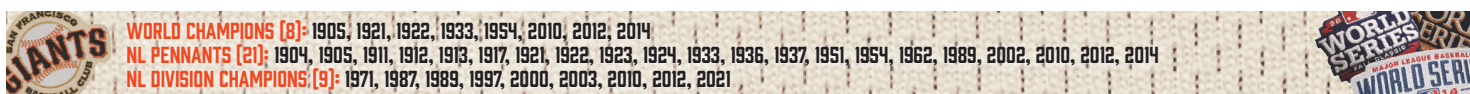

**YOU'RE NO ONE UNTIL YOU'RE TALKED ABOUT: C Patrick Bailey** is riding a career-best 10-game hitting streak entering tonight's contest...he's the first Giants rookie to record a 10-game hitting streak since **Buster Posey** in 2010...Bailey's 10-game hitting streak is the third-longest active such streak by a rookie, trailing STL's Jordan Walker (17) and COL's Ezequiel Tovar (12) (Stats, LLC).

**A SECRET I'LL NEVER TELL...:** With last night's defeat, the Giants dropped to 1-20 (.048) this year when scoring two runs or fewer...SF's .048 winning percentage when failing to reach the three-run threshold is tied for the lowest in MLB with Colorado (1-20, .048)...in contrast, the Giants are 44-16 (.733) when scoring at least three runs this year, sixth-best in MLB and ranking third in the NL behind the Braves (52-13, .800) and Brewers (40-11, .784).

## JULY IN THE PNW SOUNDS BEAUTIFUL

The Giants did not have any players advance to the second phase of this year's All-Star voting and thus do not have any players starting this year's Midsummer Classic. However, the six players below remain in the conversation for reserve or pitching roles. Full All-Star rosters will be announced at 5:30 p.m. ET on Saturday, July 2 on ESPN.

### J.D. DAVIS

- ★ Is seeking his first All-Star nod.
- ★ Owns an .829 OPS in 75 games this season, tops among qualified National League 3Bs.
- ★ Davis' .286 batting average is tops among NL third basemen ahead of STL's Nolan Arenado (.274) and ATL's Austin Riley (.265).
- ★ The Elk Grove, CA native's .365 OBP is first among NL third basemen.
- ★ According to Fangraphs, Davis has a 128 wRC+, best among NL third basemen... his 2.0 fWAR this year is second-best among NL third basemen behind WSH's Jeimer Candelario (2.4).
- ★ His 44 RBI are most on the team and third-most among NL third basemen behind Arenado (54) and LAD's Max Muncy (48).

### THAIRO ESTRADA

- ★ Is seeking his first All-Star nod.
- ★ Has been worth a team-best 2.6 fWAR this season according to Fangraphs, tied with MIA's Luis Arraez for best among all NL second basemen.
- ★ His .770 OPS is fifth-best among NL second basemen behind Arraez (.929), ARI's Ketel Marte (.888), ATL's Ozzie Albies (.809) and STL's Nolan Gorman (.780).
- ★ Estrada's 18 stolen bases are most in the NL among second basemen and tied for tops in MLB...his 18 steals are tied for fourth-most in the NL overall.
- ★ His 111 wRC+ is fifth-best among NL second basemen.
- ★ Is the first Giant since 1974 (eighth overall in franchise history) to have 25+ extra-base hits and 15+ stolen bases in his first 60 games.

### LAMONTE WADE JR.

- ★ Is seeking his first All-Star nod.
- ★ Owns a 146 wRC+ according to Fangraphs, second in the National League among first basemen behind LAD's Freddie Freeman (152)...his 146 wRC+ is seventh best in the NL overall.
- ★ Wade's 17.1% walk rate is second-best in the National League behind Juan Soto (21.2%)...his .416 OBP is third-best in the NL overall.
- ★ Wade's .426 OBP in the leadoff spot is fourth-best in MLB while his .893 OPS out of the leadoff spot ranks fourth. (min. 200 PA).
- ★ His 2.0 fWAR is fifth-best among NL first basemen.
- ★ Wade has been worth +5 defensive runs saved at first base, second in the NL behind PIT's Carlos Santana (seven).

On the pitching side of the diamond, the Giants also have a few worthy candidates that should be in some consideration if they continue to perform at the level they have so far this season. Starters **RHP Alex Cobb** and **RHP Logan Webb** have been two of the better starters in the National League while **RHP Camilo Doval** has been one of the more dominant closers in the National League this season.

### ALEX COBB

- ★ Is seeking his first All-Star selection in what is his 12th season at the Major League level...Cobb is coming off the IL today and will likely make two more starts before the break.
- ★ His 3.09 ERA is seventh-best in the NL (min. 75.0 innings).
- ★ Owns a 58.9% groundball rate, third-best in MLB behind teammate **Logan Webb** (61.0%) and CHC's Marcus Stroman (59.3%).
- ★ Has six starts this year of at least 7.0 innings pitched and three or fewer runs, tied for second-most in the National League behind only his teammate **Logan Webb**, who has eight such outings.
- ★ SF has gone 10-4 in his 14 starts this season.

### CAMILO DOVAL

- ★ Has been one of the best closers in the National League during the first half of the season.
- ★ Is seeking his first All-Star appearance and is trying to become the first Giants reliever named to an All-Star team since **Sergio Romo** in 2013.
- ★ Doval's 23 saves are most in the National League ahead of CIN's Alexis Díaz (22)... he's also appeared in 37 games this year, tied for seventh-most in the NL.
- ★ Was the NL's Reliever of the Month in May after going 11-for-11 in save opportunities while logging a 1.32 ERA in 14 games.
- ★ Since April 23, Doval has a 1.55 ERA (5er, 29.0ip) and has converted 22-of-24 save opportunities in that stretch.
- ★ Has struck out 34.0% of the batters he has faced this season, in the top 5% in the Majors.

### LOGAN WEBB

- ★ After a tough four-start stretch to begin 2023, Webb has been one of the NL's best starters since April 22...his 3.01 ERA in that time is fifth-best in the NL.
- ★ Entering play today Webb ranks among the NL's best in innings pitched (110.1, 1st), ERA (3.43, 10th), strikeouts (106, 6th) and WHIP (1.12, 8th).
- ★ Has been worth 2.0 WAR according to Fangraphs, ninth-best in the National League.
- ★ Webb's 61.0% groundball rate is best in the NL behind.
- ★ Has eight starts this year of at least 7.0 innings and allowing three runs or fewer, most in the National League ahead of Kershaw and teammate **Alex Cobb** (six).

**WITH THE GIANTS:** Is in his 12th Major League season and his second with the Giants...he's in his second year of a two-year contract (with a third-year team option) with the Giants that he signed on November 30, 2021.

**BACK IN THE ROTATION:** Will be activated from the IL prior to tonight's game...he was placed on the Injured List on June 18 with a left oblique strain and missed the minimum 15 days (13 games)...his spot in the rotation would have come on Monday, June 19...Cobb's IL placement was SF being cautious as he felt some tenderness in his left side after his start at STL and in his bullpen in Los Angeles...he made a rehab start on June 24 with Single-A San Jose and struck out nine batters over 3.2 innings of work, while allowing one earned run on three hits and no walks.

**ELITE STATUS:** Before landing on the Injured List, Cobb had been one of the Giants most reliable pitchers...he's allowed two runs or less in 10 of his 14 starts...the Giants have a 10-4 record when Cobb takes the mound.

**LAST TIME OUT:** His last Major League start came on June 13 at St. Louis...threw 4.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits and five walks with five strikeouts in the Giants 11-3 victory over the Cardinals.

**VS. THE METS:** Will face the Mets for the fifth time in his career and his third career start at Citi Field...owns a 1-2 record with a 5.87 ERA (15er, 23.0ip) over his four previous outings...his last start here was April 19, 2022 when he threw 4.1 innings, allowing four runs (three earned)...has struck out 11 batters over his 10.1 innings of work at Citi Field.
