TODAY'S GAME: After salvaging the final game of a three-game series in Boston yesterday afternoon, the Giants continue their east coast swing with the first of four here tonight at Citizens Bank Park.

- ▶ SF is in the midst of their longest road trip of the season, a 10-game trek through Boston (1-2), Philadelphia (today-Monday) and Colorado (Tuesday-Thursday).
- ▶ The Giants had an off-day in Boston on Monday before the series began Tuesday night...the Giants are in the midst of 16 consecutive scheduled games before their next off day on May 16...the 16 consecutive days without a day off is the Giants longest span of the season.

BANK'S OPEN: SF has won two of its last three series here at Citizens Bank Park dating to 2021 with the series loss coming last August (the Giants dropped two-of-three).

- ▶ **OF Michael Conforto** has strong numbers in this ballpark from his days with the Mets...he has a .913 OPS with 12 doubles and 15 homers in 56 career games here...Conforto's 15 homers here are his second-most in any ballpark behind his 66 at Citi Field, the park he called home from 2015-2021.
- ▶ Furthermore, Conforto has 73 career RBI against the Phils overall, third-most among active players behind Freddie Freeman (130) and Marcell Ozuna (77)...Conforto's teams are 29-13 in his career when he drives in a run vs. the Phils.
- ▶ **IF Wilmer Flores**, another former Met, owns a .296 average with an .847 OPS in 41 game at this ballpark...he went 4-for-11 with a homer in three games here last year.
- ▶ Also making a return to Citizens Bank Park is Giants hitting coach **Pat Burrell**, who was the first overall pick by the Phils in the 1998 draft and went on to play nine years here from 2000-2008...he helped the Phillies to a World Series title in 2008.
- ▶ Former Giant **Hunter Pence**, who is in town calling this series on television and radio for SF, also is returning to South Philly...Pence appeared in 155 games for the Phillies between 2011 (after arriving from Houston in a trade) and 2012 (before being traded to San Francisco).

AIR GROUND JORDAN: RHP Jordan Hicks takes the hill for his seventh start of the season tonight...last time through, Hicks allowed one run on five hits with a career-best nine strikeouts last Saturday vs. the Pirates in a 4-3 Giants loss in 10 innings.

- ▶ In fact, SF has lost each of Hicks' last three starts despite the fact that he's logged a 2.25 ERA (4er, 16.0ip) in those outings.
- ▶ Hicks' 1.59 ERA is fourth-best in the National League (sixth-best in the Majors) entering play today.
- ▶ His 58.9% groundball rate is fifth-best in the Majors among qualified pitchers just behind fellow starters **RHP Keaton Winn** (60.7%, 3rd) and **RHP Logan Webb** (4th, 59.7%).
- ▶ According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Hicks' splitter continues to be his go-to out pitch...in his last start against the Pirates he threw 26-of-37 splitters for strikes, recorded eight of his nine strikeouts on the split and had Pirates hitters go 2-for-11 in at-bats that ended with the pitch.

NO REPEATS PLZ: Giants pitching walked 15 batters in the Red Sox series (three games) after walking a total of 14 batters in their last two series against the Mets & Pirates (six games).

PUSH TO START: With 5.0 innings of one-run ball yesterday from **LHP Kyle Harrison**, the Giants starters have a 1.70 ERA (9er, 47.2ip) over their last 10 games...they've struck out 45, walked 17 and allowed one homer in those 47.2 innings.

- ▶ Over their last 25 games dating to April 5, Giants starters have logged a 3.22 ERA (47er, 131.1ip), fourth-best in the Majors...in the National League specifically, it's the second-best starter's ERA behind the Phillies (2.32).

A PITCHER'S BEST FRIEND: With two more groundball double plays yesterday, the Giants have forced 33 this season, which is third-most in MLB behind the A's and Cardinals, who both have turned 34.

- ▶ A major reason for the high volume of double plays is that Giants pitchers have forced an MLB-leading 428 ground balls with a 51.8% ground ball rate, which decimal points behind the league-leading Braves at 51.8%.

BUCKET OF CHICKEN?: Over their last seven games the Giants offense is slashing .201/.263/.315 and has scored a total of 16 runs...they are averaging 2.3 runs/game in that span but have gone 3-4 as a team in the win-loss column.

- ▶ They haven't scored more than three runs in any of those seven games.

MUSTACHE MAY: The calendar flipping to May has meant a handful of Giants players and staff growing out their mustaches...that trend is expected to continue in 2024 with **OFs Austin Slater** and **Mike Yastrzemski** once again leading the charge...you can find a link to a 2023 article on it [here](#).

- ▶ Slater and Yastrzemski are both selling merchandise to benefit charity...Yastrzemski is supporting Heart & Armor, which works to reincorporate military veterans into society and help them manage post-traumatic stress disorder...Slater is working with Bring Change to Mind, which seeks to end the stigma and discrimination surrounding mental illness.

WELCOME TO SF: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Is transitioning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 14 career starts entering today, six of which have come this season...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

THIRD TIMES A CHARM: So far this season, he's done well when pitching longer into the game with opponents going 2-for-22 (.091) the third time through the lineup.

LAST OUTING: Threw 6.0 innings and allowed one run on five hits with a career-high nine strikeouts on April 27 vs. Pittsburgh...he has started his Giants career with six straight games recording at least 5.0 innings pitched, allowing two-or-fewer runs and five-or-fewer hits...the only other player to start his Giants career with such a streak was **Matt Cain** in 2005 (also first six) (*Stats, LLC*).

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Has posted a 1.59 ERA over his first six outings, which currently ranks as the sixth-best ERA in the Majors...his 0.91 WHIP is tied for the sixth-best figure in the NL.

VS. THE PHILLIES: Has made 12 career relief appearances against the Phillies and posted a 3-0 record with a 2.25 ERA (3er, 12.0ip) and a .159 opponents average...he's also gone 1-2 in save opportunities...Hicks has made four appearances at Citizens Bank Park and has held the Phillies scoreless over 5.2 innings of work...today marks his first career start against Philadelphia.

LEFT, LEFT, LEFT, RIGHT, LEFT: Right-handed hitters have gone 9-for-64 (.141) versus Hicks thus far in 2024...however they were 5-for-15 off him in his last start...lefties, on the other hand, are 12-for-52 (.231), but are just 1-for-their-last-14 off him over his last two starts.

SWEPT AWAY: Opponents are hitting just .095 (2-for-21) off his sweeper, compared to a .238 (15-for-63) off his sinker.

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,533 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (36.4%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

2023 SEASON: Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/2 at BOS; S, 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 6-for-6 in save opportunities over his last 11 outings.
- ▶ Has struck out 15 batters over 11.2 innings of work (11.6 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 12 of his 15 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are just 2-for-19 (.105) off him, while lefties are 7-for-25.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season and wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/30 at BOS; 1.1ip, h, hb, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...made his season debut on April 21, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/1 at BOS; 1.1ip, 2h, 2k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made three appearances since being reinstated (3.1ip, 4h, 0r, bb, 2k).
- ▶ Batters are 6-for-14 (.429) with two walks and two strikeouts vs. Jackson in his four appearances at the MLB level this year.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/2 at BOS; 1.0ip, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Was used as an opener on May 1 at BOS...was his first start since June 2, 2022 with Double-A Reading.
- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in nine of his last 10 outings, while striking out 14 batters and posting a 0.60 WHIP.
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-18 off him and RHBs are 4-for-31.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 27 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 4/30 vs. TAC (w/AAA); 1.0ip, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento yesterday and is on a Major League roster for the first time...is seeking his MLB debut.
- ▶ Is SF's 28th-best prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ In 10 appearances at Triple-A (all in relief), Rodríguez had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2ip) with 10 strikeouts and four walks...batters were hitting .184 off him to start the year.
- ▶ Had a 4.37 ERA in 45 appearances last year between Double-A Richmond (2.97 ERA in 16 games) and Triple-A Sacramento (5.73 ERA in 27 appearances).
- ▶ Has allowed only 13 homers in 261.2 career minor league innings.
