### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON (11g, 5gs, 2-1, 2.65

WILSON AT A GLANCE: Bryse Wilson, 26, will be making his 12th appearance and sixth start of the season.....Wilson last pitched last Sunday in a start vs. St. Louis and had no decision in the Brewers' 4-3 loss (4ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 5bb, 1k, 1hr, 80 pitches).....his 5 walks marked a career high.....he has gone 0-1 with a 1.88 ERA as a starter (24ip, 5er) and 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA in relief (10ip, 5er).....opponents are batting .192 (23-for-120, 5hr).....the team is 2-3 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....his last start prior to this season came on 9/28/22 vs. Cincinnati.....he made 59 straight relief appearances between starts.....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

LAST SEASON: Wilson went 6-D with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee.....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA.....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career.....he held opponents to a .211 batting average, marking a career best.

**CAREER:** Is 17-18 with a 4.59 ERA and 4 saves in 120 games/48 starts (343ip, 175er)....is in his seventh Major League season with Atlanta (2018-21), Pittsburgh (2021-22) and Milwaukee (2023-24)....is 9-17 with a 5.11 ERA as a starter (222ip, 126er) and 8-1 with a 3.64 ERA in relief (121ip, 49er).....Wilson was selected by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Orange (NC) High School.....he committed to the University of North Carolina prior to being drafted.....Wilson was traded by the Braves to the Pirates, along with RHP Ricky DeVito, in exchange for RHP Richard Rodríguez on 7/30/21.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: IS 4-3 with a 3.22 ERA in 36 games/6 starts (72.2ip, 26er)....is 0-1 with a 2.50 ERA in 5 games/3 starts this season (18ip, 5er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 9-11 with a 4.54 ERA in 57 games/24 starts (160.2ip, 81er)....is 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA in 6 games/2 starts this season (16ip, 5er).

CAREER vs. ASTROS: Has made 2 scoreless relief appearances vs. Houston, both coming last season (2ip, 1h, Obb, Ok).
