BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals arrived in Southern California on Sunday evening and had Monday as an open date before beginning a nine-game road trip through the National League West playing consecutive three-game series at Los Angeles (Sept. 1-3), Colorado (Sept. 4-6) and San Francisco (Sept. 7-9). This marks the first time since Aug. 2015 the Cardinals have played three N.L. West opponents on the same road trip (at SD, at ARI, at SF); going 7-3 on that trip en route to a 100-win season.

HAPPY HOMECOMING: When the Cardinals return home from this road trip, they will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 2006 World Championship squad on Sept. 11 and induct **Albert Pujols**, **Yadier Molina** and **Bill Sherdel** into the Cardinals Hall of Fame on Sept. 12.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters September in 3rd place in the National League Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 10 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are 5.0 games behind San Diego (and hold the season tie-breaker) for the 3rd Wild Card. St. Louis has 15 road games remaining and nine home games.

CARDINALS CALL UP BERNAL, RINCÓN & SCOTT II: With expanded rosters in September, the Cardinals have selected RHP **Hancel Rincón** and recalled C **Leo Bernal** and OF **Victor Scott II**. C **Jimmy Crooks** was optioned to Memphis (AAA) following Sunday's game.

OLIVER AND DODGER(S): The Cardinals enter this series winning their last three series against the Dodgers dating back to August 2024, currently the longest active series win streak against the Dodgers in MLB. -*Elias Sports Bureau*

DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS: Starting pitcher **Michael McGreevy** is 5-0 with a 3.12 ERA in seven career road starts against National League West opponents, while the Cardinals have gone undefeated (7-0) as a team in those starts. McGreevy fired 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at San Diego earlier this season (May 8) and held Arizona to two runs (1 earned) over 6.1 innings at Arizona (July 17).

BROKEN WINGS: Since August 18, the Cardinals have placed seven players on the Injured List with RHP **Andre Pallante** (right elbow), RHP **Hunter Dobbins** (right forearm), SS **Masyn Winn** (left thumb), OF **Everson Pereira** (left hand), RHP **Peter Strzelecki** (right forearm), INF **Blaze Jordan** (left ankle) and INF **JJ Wetherholt** (right wrist) all currently out with injuries. Winn is eligible to return today and Pallante tomorrow.

C-NOTE GOAT: Cardinals 1B **Alec Burleson** recorded his 100th RBI on Sunday, becoming the first Cardinals player to achieve the century mark since **Paul Goldschmidt** (115) and **Nolan Arenado** (103) in 2022. He is the first Cardinals homegrown player to achieve 100 RBI since **Albert Pujols** in 2010 (118). Teammate **Jordan Walker** is 3 RBI short of 100 and would be the first Cardinals homegrown outfielder to knock in 100 runs since **Ray Lankford** (103) in 1998.

20/20 VISION: Cardinals All-Star OF **Jordan Walker** (27 HR/18 SB) needs two stolen bases to become the 11th instance a Cardinals player has achieved 20 HR and 20 SB in a single season and the first since **Tommy Pham** in 2017. Walker would join a Cardinals list that includes Pham, **Ray Lankford** (5x), **Lou Brock** (1967), **Brian Jordan** (1995), **Fernando Tatis** (1999), **Reggie Sanders** (2004). Lankford ran off four consecutive seasons (1995-98).

LOS ANGELES CONNECTIONS

Andre Pallante was born in Mission Viejo and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the Univ. of California, Irvine (2017-19).

Michael McGreevy was born in and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).

Justin Bruihl pitched parts of three seasons with the Dodgers (2021-23) where he made his MLB debut...played college baseball California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.

Tommy Edman played parts of five seasons with St. Louis (2019-24)...won a Gold Glove at second base in 2021...selected by the Cardinals in the 6th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Brant Brown previously served as Dodgers Assistant Hitting Coach and Minor League Hitting Coordinator for five seasons (2018-22).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Calif.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was born in Pomona and resides in San Clemente, Calif... graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, Calif...played college baseball at the University of Southern California...served as Dodgers Hitting Coach for three seasons (2013-15).

Victor Scott II made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (March 28, 2024)...is the only Cardinal (since 1900) to steal a base in his Major League debut on Opening Day.

Dean Kiekhefer made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (May 14, 2016)...struck out career-high four of six total batters faced, including first batter, Joc Pederson (looking).

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Albert Pujols** played in 85 games for the Dodgers in 2021.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 35 games over parts of two seasons (1988-89) for the Dodgers between stints with St. Louis...member of 1988 World Series champion Dodgers.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played his two final MLB seasons with the Dodgers (2007-08)...Was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 39th round of the 1990 MLB draft, but did not sign.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 27th start of the season, extending his career-high in starts and appearances.
- Is 5-0 with a 3.12 ERA in seven career road starts against National League West opponents, while the Cardinals have gone 7-0 as a team in those starts.
- Leads the Cardinals with a career-high 142.1 innings. Pitched a career-best 173.0 innings between Memphis-AAA (150.0) and St. Louis (23.0) in 2024.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in 15 of his 26 starts this season, while his 13 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer runs allowed lead the Cardinals and rank T-6th in MLB.
- Ranks among NL leaders in Pct. Pitches Taken (55.3%, 4th), Pct. Pitches Put in Play (19.4%, 5th) and Pct. Swings Put In Play (43.5%, 2nd).
- The Cardinals are 26-19 (.578 win pct.) in his 45 career starts, and since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 23 of his starts - most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 45 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active pitchers with 138 starts.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 27 of 45 career starts (23 quality starts), including 9 of his last 15 since June 1.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, August 26 vs. Baltimore): ND, L 8-7; 5.0 IP, 10 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 3 SO, 84 pitches

- Matched career highs in hits (10) and runs allowed (7) in the Cardinals last at-bat loss to the Orioles at Busch Stadium last week.
- Surrendered home runs to Leody Taveras (3-R) , and Pete Alonso (2-R) in the first two innings.
- Exited with Baltimore leading 7-1 as St. Louis erased a six-run deficit to give McGreevy a no-decision.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Is 1 of 5 qualified NL with a perfect 1.000 fielding pct and ranks among NL pitchers in total chances (34, T-5th), assists (19, T-4th), and double plays (4, T-1st) ... Boasts 5 Defensive Runs Saved, 2nd-highest in MLB to **Nolan McLean** (6).

RUN PREVENTION: Shares NL lead among pitchers this season w/ 8 Net Bases Prevented (*a sum of advances prevented and outs added*) ... Since McGreevy's MLB Debut (July 31, 2024), he has conceded 3 SB on just 6 attempts, 3rd-fewest SB in MLB over timespan, while his 50% SB rate ranks 4th-best in MLB (min. 250 IP) ... Out of 1,535 SB career opportunities, McGreevy's SB attempt pct. (0.3%) is 3rd-best in MLB to **Mitchell Parker** (0.2%) and **Ryne Nelson** (0.2%).

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's lowest percent (19.1) of Swing & Miss. His difference in Opponent BA (.258) vs. xBA (.282) ranks 10th among qualified MLB starting pitchers (-.024) ... **The Cardinals have provided McGreevy with a 12 Fielding Run Value, highest for any MLB pitcher this season.**

ONE FOR THE ROAD: Posted a 3.66 ERA in 13 road starts this season, with a team-high six quality starts.

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE: Has induced a career-high 15 groundball double plays.

HERE COMES THE SUN...: Is 2-2 with a 2.81 ERA (20 ER/64.0 IP) in day games this season with a team-leading 1.09 WHIP and a team-high 7 quality starts; however, has allowed 9 of 20 HR in his 10 afternoon starts.

EMPTY HANDED: St. Louis has supplied 2 runs of support or fewer in 13 of his starts ... The Cardinals have been shut out 7 times this season, 4 of which were when McGreevy has started ... Has been in position for 8 wins this season when the game was blown by the bullpen, most of any MLB pitcher.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!: Celebrated his 26th birthday on July 8 vs. Milwaukee with a 5-1 win, limiting the Brew Crew to 1 run in a season-high 6.1 innings.

McGREEVY vs. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- Is making his 3rd career start and appearances against the Dodgers, but first at Dodger Stadium.
- Is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP) and eight strikeouts in a pair of starts at Busch Stadium.
- Southern California native from San Clemente grew up a fan of the San Diego Padres. Is an avid fan of the LA Chargers.
- Pitched at the University of California-Santa Barbara (2019-21).
- The Dodgers handed McGreevy the first loss of his Major League career on June 8, 2025 after allowing four runs over 5.0 IP, opposite of **Clayton Kershaw**.
- Lifetime 6-3 with a 4.61 ERA in 14 career starts against National League West Division opponents, including a sparkling 5-0 record and 3.12 ERA (43.1 IP) in seven starts at NL West Ballparks.

LAST APPEARANCE vs. DODGERS (May 2, 2026 at Busch Stadium): W, 3-2, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K, 88 pitches.

- Blanked the Dodgers in a 3-2 win as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.
- Became the first Cardinal to throw at least 6.0+ scoreless IP with 3-or-fewer hits allowed against the Dodgers since **Adam Wainwright** (6.0 IP 2 H) on Sept. 16, 2018 at Busch Stadium
