BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game homestand tonight against Chicago-AL after dropping two of three against Washington over the weekend...The Orioles enter play today 3.0 games back in the Wild Card and 11.0 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East.

- 👉 **Pete Alonso** and **Jackson Holliday** both homered in the loss yesterday...For Holliday, eight of his 19 hits this year have gone for extra bases (2 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR).
- 👉 **Grant Wolfram** tossed 1.0 scoreless inning and hasn't allowed a run seven straight games (5.2 IP) since June 11.
- 👉 **Colton Cowser** tallied his third outfield assist yesterday, tied with **Tyler O'Neill** for the team lead...Since the start of 2025, O's outfielders have combined for 40 assists, tied for third in the AL and tied for fifth in MLB.
- 👉 The Orioles fell to 4-8 in their last 12 games decided by two or fewer runs since June 6.

HIGH SOX: The O's have won nine games in a row against the White Sox, 15 of the last 16 meetings between the teams since 2024, and 24 of 29 since 2022...Baltimore's current winning streak is tied for the longest in franchise history against Chicago, joining September 4, 1977-September 2 (G2), 1978 and June 13-September 1, 1969.

- 👉 The current nine-game winning streak is tied for the fourth-longest active streak by one team against a single opponent with the Phillies vs. Rays, behind Yankees vs. Royals (13 G), Dodgers vs. Mariners (12 G), and Braves vs. Twins (11 G).
- 👉 Baltimore has won nine straight series against Chicago...A series win this week would tie the team's longest winning series streak against a single opponent all-time, done vs. the Washington Senators from 1963-64.
- 👉 **Gunnar Henderson** has slashed .333/.450/.580 (27-for-81) with five doubles, five homers, 24 runs, 11 RBI, and 18 walks in 22 career games against the White Sox...The 1.030 OPS is his second highest against one team behind the Angels (1.165).

START ME UP: Over the last 27 games since May 30, Baltimore starters have posted a 3.67 ERA (62 ER/152.0 IP), ranked fifth in the AL and 10th in the majors...Prior to this stretch, the rotation had a 4.76 ERA (154 ER/291.1 IP) in the first 58 games of the year, ranked 14th in the AL and 26th in MLB.

- 👉 Overall, O's pitching owns a 3.82 ERA in 44 games at Camden Yards compared to a 4.98 ERA over 41 road games.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** is tied for second in the majors with 58 RBI with DET's Dillon Dingler, LAD's Andy Pages, and STL's Jordan Walker, behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (64)...He is batting .289/.400/.589 (26-for-90) with three doubles, eight homers, 19 runs, 22 RBI, 16 walks, and two hit-by-pitches in 25 games since June 1...Among AL leaders during that time, he is seventh in OPS (.989) and eighth in slugging percentage.

- 👉 He is one home run shy of becoming the 28th player in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and **Anthony Santander** (24) in 2024...Henderson, **Jackson Holliday**, and **Jordan Westburg** tied for the team lead with 17 long balls for the entire 2025 season.
- 👉 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on Saturday, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (865 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .367/.412/.542 (44-for-120) with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 runs, 24 RBI, eight walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 46 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

- 👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 80 PA) in batting average (1st), on-base percentage (7th), and OPS (10th, .954).
- 👉 His seven games with at least three hits since May 4 are tied for the major league lead with NYM's Carson Benge, PHI's Bryce Harper, and PHI's Brandon Marsh.
- 👉 Alexander is batting .372 (16-for-43) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, and 22 RBI with runners in scoring position...His average with RISP ranks eighth in MLB (min. 40 AB).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-2nd, 66), times on base (4th, 150), and is eighth in the AL in on-base percentage (.388)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

- 👉 He's batted leadoff in 61 of his 84 games this season, including in each of the last 39 games since May 17.
- 👉 Prior to Ward, the only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June.
- 👉 Ward recorded 64 walks and 76 hits through 80 career games with the Orioles...The only other players to have at least 60 walks and 75 hits through 80 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) were Albert Belle (63 BB, 82 H), Bob Nieman (62 BB, 89 H), and Ken Singleton (68 BB, 89 H).
- 👉 His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19). Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 76 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors...St. Louis had an 80-game stretch snapped yesterday.

- 👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 17th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second consecutive loss on June 23 at Los Angeles-AL after throwing 5.0 innings, allowing five runs on eight hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts...Threw 91 pitches, 61 strikes.

👉 Has issued at least one walk in 15 straight starts after not walking a batter in his Orioles debut on March 29 vs. Minnesota.

FLIP THE SCRIPT: Baz is set to make his second career start against the White Sox...Faced Chicago-AL last season on July 21 at Tropicana Field and took the loss after allowing a career-high eight runs on eight hits (2 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts over 4.0 innings.

👉 Is 2-6 with a 6.75 ERA (45 ER/60.0 IP) in 11 career starts against AL Central opponents, his highest ERA against any division in MLB.

FIRST INNING STRUGGLES: Baz owns a 6.75 ERA (12 ER/16.0 IP) in the first inning while allowing nine walks and a .942 opponent OPS.

👉 From innings 2-4, he has posted a 2.81 ERA (15 ER/48.0 IP) with 10 walks and a .628 opponent OPS.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 22 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted nine home runs over 122.1 innings (0.66 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

👉 He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 22 outings, the fifth-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind KC's Kris Bubic/STL's Andre Pallante (both 29 G), NYY's Cam Schlichtler (27 G), and AZ's Michael Soroka (23 G).

👉 The only other Orioles in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 16 starts with the team are Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68) and Zack Britton (17 GS, 2011).

NEED SOME HOME COOKING: Opponents are batting .303 (40-for-132) off Baz across six starts at Camden Yards...The .303 opponent average is the eighth-highest home opponent batting average in the majors (min. 30.0 IP), including third highest in the AL ahead of TOR's Patrick Corbin (.338) and HOU's Mike Burrows (.311).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed 29 doubles, tied with COL's Tomoyuki Sugano for the MLB lead...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

👉 He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 16 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

👉 Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

TEERING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .382/.393/.655 (21-for-55) with nine doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.047 opponent OPS on the first pitch is fourth highest in MLB (min. 50 BF), ahead of TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.215), AZ's Ryne Nelson (1.146), and KC's Seth Lugo (1.063).

THE TOTEM POLE: Opposing leadoff hitters are slashing .333/.583/.968 (16-for-48) with seven doubles, one triple, one home run, and four walks off Baz.

👉 Five hole hitters are slashing .381/.422/.619 (16-for-42) with seven doubles and one home run.

👉 Baz has found greater success against the bottom three hitters, limiting them to a combined .206/.263/.336 (22-for-107) line with eight doubles and two long balls.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Baz was one of three Rays starters in 2025 to remain active all season, along with Ryan Pepiot and Drew Rasmussen...Five of his 31 starts last year went 7.0+ innings, tying Zack Littell for the club lead...That included a start on June 26 at Kansas City, when he tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in a winning effort...Marked the first start of 8.0 scoreless innings or more by a Rays pitcher since Tyler Glasnow on May 26, 2021 vs. Kansas City.
