CINCINNATI REDS (20-11) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (16-16)

May 1, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 6:45 EDT - Game #33/Home #18

RHP Brady Singer (2-1, 4.97 ERA) vs. RHP Mitch Keller (2-1, 3.18 ERA)

THE PIRATES: lost, 10-5, on Thursday vs. St. Louis and have dropped the first four games of this seven-game homestand...Will embark on a six-game, seven-day road trip to Arizona (May 5-7) and San Francisco (May 8-10) following this homestand...Are in the eighth game of a stretch of 10 straight games against the National League Central.

SEEING RED: The Pirates are hosting the Reds for the first time this season (they took two of three games from Cincinnati from March 30-April 1 at Great American Ball Park, during their first road trip)...Pittsburgh is 43-21 (.672) against the Reds at PNC Park since the start of 2018 (the Pirates have won every season series at home during that span except for 2020, when they went 2-2).

MAKE IT A DOUBLE: Bryan Reynolds was 2-for-4 with two doubles, two RBI, a walk and a run scored on Thursday vs. St. Louis (he reached base safely in three consecutive plate appearances in the fourth, fifth and seventh innings)...It marked his 19th career multi-double game (first since last season on August 26 at St. Louis) and his first here at PNC Park since last season on May 22 vs. Milwaukee...He is now one double shy of 200 for his career (25 Pirates during the Modern Era [since 1901] have 200 doubles in their career).

PICK SIX: Pirates pitchers have at least six strikeouts in 69 consecutive games (since last year on August 18 vs. Toronto)...That is the fourth-longest streak by any Major League team during the Modern Era (since 1901), behind New York-AL (77 games, August 4, 2018-April 23, 2019), Miami (76 games, April 5-June 29, 2023) and Cincinnati (71 games, August 2 [G2], 2020-April 23, 2021)...Pittsburgh's 301 strikeouts this year lead all of Major League Baseball.

GOOD GONZO: Nick Gonzales walked and was hit by a pitch on Thursday vs. St. Louis, extending his on-base streak to 11 straight games (since April 19 vs. Tampa Bay)...He is batting .429 (18-for-42) with two doubles, five RBI and six runs during the streak...The only longer on-base streaks in Gonzales' career came from September 8-22, 2024 (13) and last year from August 12-25 (12).

THE MORE YOU YO: Yohan Ramirez pitched a scoreless inning on Thursday vs. St. Louis and now has a 1.83 ERA (19.2ip/4er) and 22 strikeouts in 14 games this season...His 22 strikeouts are tied with Chicago (NL)'s Ben Brown and Cleveland's Erik Sabrowski for the seventh-most among Major League relievers...Only Colorado's Chase Dollander (32), San Diego's Mason Miller (29), Toronto's Jeff Hoffman (27), Milwaukee's Aaron Ashby (26), Toronto's Louis Varland (26) & New York (NL)'s Sean Manaea (23) have more strikeouts.

THE TIME IS LOWE: Brandon Lowe went 2-for-5 with a double and a solo home run on Thursday vs. St. Louis...It was his fifth multi extra-base hit game this season and first since April 17 vs. Tampa Bay...Lowe's 16 extra-base hits (eight doubles and eight home runs) are tied with Baltimore's Gunnar Henderson and Houston's Christian Walker for the eighth-most in Major League Baseball, behind Atlanta's Matt Olson (22), Houston's Yordan Alvarez (21), New York (AL)'s Ben Rice (18), Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber (18), New York (AL)'s Aaron Judge (17), the Athletics' Shea Langeliers (17) and Washington's James Wood (17)...They are also tied with Ke'Bryan Hayes (2020-21) and Connor Joe (2023) for the fourth-most by a Pirate through his first 27 games with the team in the Modern Era (since 1901), behind only Smokey Burgess (20, 1959), Garrett Jones (19, 2009) & Reb Russell (18, 1922).

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2014 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller had a no-decision after allowing three runs (he had six strikeouts) over 5.0 innings in Pittsburgh's 6-3, 10-inning win on April 25 at Milwaukee.

AGAINST THE REDS: Keller is 3-6 with a 5.59 ERA (93.1ip/58er) in 19 career starts against Cincinnati, including a 3.59 ERA (57.2ip/23er) in 11 starts at PNC Park...Keller, who made his Major League debut on May 27 (G2), 2019 at Great American Ball Park, has not earned a win against the Reds since June 25, 2024 in Cincy...He earned his only win over Cincinnati at PNC Park after allowing two runs in 6.0 innings on April 21, 2023.

K IS FOR KELLER: Keller enters tonight's start vs. Cincinnati with the ninth-most strikeouts (862) in Pirates history...He surpassed Rick Rhoden (852) in his start on April 19 vs. Tampa Bay and Deacon Phillippe (861) during his last start on April 25 at Milwaukee...Keller is eight strikeouts shy of surpassing Dock Ellis (869) for eighth place.

CENTRAL PARKED: Keller's 62 starts against the National League Central since making his Major League debut on May 27 (G2), 2019 at Cincinnati's Great American Ball Park are the second-most among all Major League pitchers, trailing only Miles Mikolas (68).

RIGHT PLACE, RIGHT TIME: Keller has limited right-handed hitters to a .122 batting average against (6-for-49) and a .311 OPS...The last extra-base hit he allowed to a righthander came last year on September 12 at Washington (a homer by Brady House).

LIMIT THE LONG BALL: Keller has allowed one home run in 34.0 innings this season (solo shot to CJ Abrams on April 14 vs. Washington)...He is one of eight Major League pitchers to allow one home run (minimum 34.0 innings), along with New York (AL)'s Max Fried (47.1ip), New York (AL)'s Cam Schlichter (41.2ip), Kansas City's Seth Lugo (37.2ip), Cleveland's Parker Messick (36.1ip), San Francisco's Landen Roupp (35.1ip), Los Angeles (AL)'s Jack Kochanowicz (35.0ip) and Cincinnati's Rhett Lowder (34.0ip).

HOME SWEET HOME: Keller is currently PNC Park's all-time strikeouts leader (425)...He surpassed Paul Maholm (383) in a start last season on July 2 vs. St. Louis...His 87 games started at PNC Park are second in stadium history, behind Maholm (100 starts).

SIX PACK: Keller pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in each of his first three starts this season (March 28 at New York-NL, April 3 vs. Baltimore, April 8 vs. San Diego)...He was the first Pirate to toss at least 6.0 innings while allowing two or fewer runs in each of his first three starts of a season since Joe Musgrove (April 5-16, 2019).

CONSISTENT KELLER: Keller pitched 6.0 scoreless innings during his start on April 8 vs. San Diego, marking his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings through his first three starts of the 2026 campaign (also March 28 at New York-NL)...He joined Salomon Torres (2002), Zach Duke (2005), Jeff Karstens (2008), Wandy Rodriguez (2013) and Jameson Taillon (2018) as the only Pirates during the 21st century with two scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings through their first three games of a season...Keller's 17 starts of at least 6.0 scoreless innings during his career (since 2019) are the 10th-most by a Pittsburgh pitcher in the Live Ball Era (since 1920)...Bob Friend, who ranks first among those pitchers, made 37 such starts from 1951-65.

DAZZLING DEBUT: Keller scattered three hits without issuing a walk (had three strikeouts) over 6.0 scoreless innings, but had a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 4-2, 11-inning loss on March 28 at New York (NL)...Keller left with the game scoreless after six frames...The Pirates took a short-lived, 1-0 lead into the bottom of the 10th before the Mets tied it...Pittsburgh also added a run in the top of the 11th before New York's Luis Robert Jr. hit a walkoff, three-run home run off Hunter Barco in the bottom half...Keller joined Vance Worley (June 15, 2014 at Miami), Nick Kingham (April 29, 2018 vs. St. Louis) and Joe Musgrove (May 25, 2018 vs. St. Louis) as the only Pirates in the 21st century to toss at least 6.0 scoreless innings without allowing a walk in a season debut.
