METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets returned to action yesterday and defeated the Diamondbacks, 4-3, in 10 innings...The Mets are now 3-1 in the first game of a series...New York is a season-high three games above .500...The Mets are seeking their third series victory win of the season...The Mets are in a stretch of nine straight games (1-0)...New York is in the midst of six-game homestand (1-0) against Arizona (1-0) and the A's (three games).

40 YEARS AGO: On April 8, 1986 the Mets opened up their season with a 4-2 victory over the Pittsburgh Pirates...Doc Gooden tossed a complete game, allowing both runs on six hits with one walk and six strikeouts...Keith Hernandez recorded two hits, a double, a walk and drove home a pair in the victory...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions New York Mets...The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 World Champion Mets on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information regarding programming for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration will be available at a later date at [Mets.com/1986](https://mets.com/1986).

TIME CHANGES: The New York Mets announced that the game time against the Arizona Diamondbacks for today has been moved to 4:10 p.m. due to expected cold weather and windy conditions.

HOW SWEET 16: Today, the Mets will honor the St. John's Men's Basketball team as Dylan Darling will throw out a ceremonial first pitch to former St. John's pitcher John Franco...Darling hit the game-winning shot to sent the Johnnies to the Sweet Sixteen

IN A PINCH: The Mets have recorded an MLB leading seven RBI from their pinch-hitters this season...In 2025, the Mets recorded a total of nine RBI from their pinch-hitters...Overall this year, Mets pinch hitters are batting .444 (4-9) with two runs, one double, one home run and seven RBI...Their .444 average leads the Majors.

EXTRA-EXTRA! The Mets have played four extra-inning games through their first 11 games of the 2026 season...2026 marks this first time in franchise history that the club has played four extra-inning contests through their first 11 games of a season (previous high: 3, 10x, last, 2014)...The last team to play four extra-inning games through their first 11 games of a season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians...The last time the Mets played four extra inning games in an 11-game span was from May 16-28, 2024...Courtesy of *Elias*.

GOT TO GO TO MOES! Ronny Mauricio laced a walk-off pinch-hit RBI single in the 10th in his first plate appearance of the season...It was his first career walk-off RBI and the first walk-off RBI by a Mets pinch-hitter since Jesse Winker's pinch-hit walk-off home run on August 21, 2024 vs. Baltimore...The last Met to record a walk-off hit in their first plate appearance of the season was Alberto Castillo, who hit a pinch-hit walk-off RBI single in the 14th inning on Opening Day in 1998 (3/31)...Courtesy of *Elias*...It marked Mauricio's first career pinch-hit RBI.

LET'S GO STREAKING: The Mets are on a season-high four-game winning streak...The team has posted a 1.70 ERA (7 ER/37.0 IP) in that span with 10 walks and 31 strikeouts...They are batting .320 (48-150) in that span with 28 runs, nine doubles, four home runs, 25 RBI, 14 walks, a .373 OBP, a .460 SLG and an .833 OPS...They have outscored their opponents 28-8 during the winning streak.

SNAKES-METS NOTES: The Mets are 33-22 against the Dbacks at Citi Field...New York has not last the season series against Arizona each season since 2017.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: Over the last four games, the Mets have scored 28 runs on 48 hits with nine doubles, four home runs, 25 RBI, 14 walks, five steals, a .373 OBP, and a .460 SLG...This compares to a total of 25 runs on 49 hits over their first seven games of the season.

HERE'S THE PITCH: The Mets are third in the Majors and second in the National League with a 2.54 ERA (29 ER/102.2 IP)...The Mets bullpen has posted a 1.45 ERA (7 ER/43.1 IP), which is second in the Majors and in the National League...Only the Braves have a lower ERA at 0.86 ERA (4 ER/41.1 IP).

DREAM WEAVER: Luke Weaver earned his victory with the Mets yesterday...He has not allowed a run, surrendering only one hit, tow walks and striking out three over 5.0 innings.

BROOKS AND DONE: Brooks Raley has yet to allow a run through his first five appearances of the season (4.2 IP)...Since returning from "Tommy John" surgery on July 19 2025, has pitched to a 2.08 ERA (7 ER/30.1 IP)...Has not allowed a home run over his last 51.2 innings dating back to August 15, 2023...His streak of 51.2 innings without allowing a home run is the third-longest active streak in the Majors...Only the Pittsburgh's Carmen Mlodzinski (55.2 IP) and Boston's Garrett Whitlock (54.2 IP) have a longer streak...Courtesy of *Elias*.

HOME, SWEET HOME: The Mets return home for their second homestand of the season...The team is 3-1 in New York this year...The team has posted a 2.93 ERA (13 ER/40.0 IP) at Citi Field in 2026.

RISPY BUSINESS: Over the last four games, the team is 18-46 (.391) with RISP, recording one home run and 19 RBI...This compares to going 11-71 (.155) with one home run and 19 RBI over their first seven games.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the club will wear a memorial "Davey" patch on the sleeve of their home and road uniforms during the 2026 season...Johnson passed away on September 5, 2025 at the age of 82...He finished his Mets career with the most managerial wins in franchise history (595) and the best winning percentage (.588)...In 1986, Johnson guided the team to a franchise-record 108 regular season victories and capped the year off with a dramatic World Championship...From 1984-1990, under his helm, the Mets averaged more than 95 wins.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 4.1 innings, allowing five runs, four earned, on nine hits with five strikeouts in the 7-2 loss to San Francisco on April 2.

IN THE CITI: Dating back to last season, Peterson has recorded eight starts where he's completed at least 5.0 innings and allowed one or zero runs...He has allowed one or fewer earned runs in seven of his last 16 starts at Citi Field.

VS. ARIZONA/NATIONAL LEAGUE: Has recorded two runs or fewer in five of his seven career appearances vs. the Diamondbacks...He has recorded a 4.20 ERA (14 ER/30.0 IP) and a 6.60 SO/9.0 IP...Made 25 appearances vs. the National League last season, posting a 4.53 ERA (70 ER/139.0 IP)...The Mets were 14-11 last year when Peterson started against a National League team.

SPRING TRAINING: In three Spring outings (three starts), Peterson recorded a 4.15 ERA (6 ER/13.0 IP) with nine strikeouts...Held Spring batters to a .235 (12-51) average...Last pitched on March 22 at Miami, tossing a spring-high 5.0 innings (1R, 5H, 1BB, 4K).

2025 YEAR IN REVIEW: Over a career-high 30 starts in 2025, he went 9-6 with a 4.22 ERA (79 ER/168.2 IP), 65 walks and a career-high 150 strikeouts...He allowed three earned runs or less in 22 of his 30 starts this season and one or zero earned runs in 10 starts...He picked up at least eight strikeouts in five of his 30 starts this season...Allowed four or more earned runs in eight of his last 16 starts after not allowing more than three earned runs through his first 14 starts of the season...Among qualified Major League pitchers this season, finished third in HR/9.0 IP ratio (0.59), tied for fourth in opponent GIDP (20) and sixth in groundball percentage (54.7).

GOING THE DISTANCE: Completed at least 7.0+ innings in six of his 30 starts last season...Mets starters completed 7.0 innings 10 times in 2025, six of those starts came from Peterson...Him and Nolan McLean were the only Mets pitchers to complete 8.0 innings this season...His two 8.0+ innings pitched starts were the most by a Mets southpaw in a single season since Jon Niese (2014)...He completed pitched 5.0 or more in 24 of his 30 starts this season, and 6.0+ innings in 16 of those starts...His 24 such starts were the most on the team and his 16 such starts of 6.0 or more innings were the most on the team...He became one of 13 left-handed starters this season to record at least 16 starts with 6.0+ innings pitched...He joined Sean Manaea (16 in 2024) as the only Mets lefties to record as many 6.0+ IP starts since Steven Matz (16 in 2016 and 2019)...Peterson's 24 starts of 5.0+ innings pitched, his 16 starts of 6.0+ innings pitched, six starts of 7.0+ innings pitched and two 8.0+ innings pitched are all his most in a single season.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL STAR: On July 10, 2025, Peterson was named to his first career All-Star Game after posting a first-half career-best 3.06 ERA and 93 strikeouts (previous: 3.09 ERA in 2024 and 84 K in 2022)...He became the first Mets starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since Kodai Senga in 2023 and is the first left-handed Mets pitcher to be named an All-Star since Johan Santana (2009)...He threw 1.0 scoreless inning in the Midsummer Classic on July 15, becoming the first Met to do so since Jacob deGrom in 2019 and the first left-handed Mets pitcher to do so since Tom Glavine in 2004.

LEFTY LEADERBOARD: His 614 strikeouts are the seventh-most by a left-hander in franchise history...Tug McGraw is next on the list with 618 K...His 115 career starts are the eighth-most in franchise history by a southpaw...Vs. left-handers this season, he posted a .228/.275/.289 slash line (34-149) and allowed just one home run to 161 lefty batters faced...Among qualified left-handed pitchers facing left-handed batters this season, he finished fifth in groundball percentage (63.7), tied for fifth in strikeouts (48), seventh in opponents' SLG (.289), 10th in OPS (.564) and 13th in opponents' OBP...He reached 500.0 career innings pitched on May 18, becoming one of 18 left-handed pitchers to reach the milestone with the franchise...He also became the 13th Mets southpaw to reach 500 strikeouts on May 6 and was the first to do so since Steven Matz (recorded his 500th strikeout on 9/11/19).

QUALITY CONTROL: Recorded 15 quality starts in 30 total outings last season, including 12 of his last 23 starts...Recorded five straight quality starts from July 3 - August 1, which was tied for the longest such streak in his career (also: 8/14-9/3/24)...Peterson recorded 27 quality starts since his start to last season (5/29/24), with 25 of them coming in his last 46 games (since July 1)...From July 1, 2024 to the end of this season, he was one of 12 pitchers (one of five in the NL) to record at least 25 quality starts and one of five left-handers to do so (also: Tarik Skubal, Framber Valdez, Max Fried and Cristopher Sánchez).

APPLE PICKING: Last season, Peterson recorded a net bases prevented of eight (a sum of advances prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher) according to Baseball Savant, which was tied for the second-best in the majors with six others, trailing Matthew Boyd and Max Fried...Since his Major League debut in 2020, his 33 net bases prevented is the most among qualified Major League pitchers...Max Fried is next on the list at 23...Peterson has recorded 18 career pickoffs (three this season), which is tied with Sid Fernandez for the seventh-most by a Mets pitcher...He trails only Ron Darling (41), Jerry Koosman (36), Dwight Gooden (32), Al Leiter (28), Jon Matlack (24), Mike Scott (20)...According to *OPTA*.

CAREER NOTES: Set new career highs in strikeouts, innings pitched and starts last season...Had a career-high 15.0 scoreless inning streak from June 5-17...He threw at least 5.0 innings in 12 straight starts from April 12 - June 17, which was the longest such streak of his

career...Over parts of six Major League seasons with the Mets, the southpaw has gone 37-30 with a 4.12 ERA (285 ER/622.2 IP), 262 walks and 614 strikeouts in 131 games (115 starts)...Was drafted by the Mets in the first round (20th overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.
