# PITTSBURGH PIRATES (18-23) vs. MILWAUKEE BREWERS (24-16) May 13, 2024 at American Family Field, Milwaukee, WI - 6:40 CDT - GAME \#42/ROAD \#21 RHP MITCH KELIER (3-3, 4.41 ERA) vs. RHP COLIN REA (3-0, 3.29 ERA) 

THE PIRATES:...lost $5-4$ in 10 innings yesterday against the Cubs in the deciding game of their three-game series...Went $4-5$ on their nine-game homestand against the Rockies (2-1), Angels (1-2) and Cubs (1-2)...Are 9-21 in their last 30 games after winning nine of their first 11 to begin the year...Lost in extra innings yesterday for the first time this season after winning each of their first four games in extra frames (it was Pittsburgh's longest win streak in extra-innings games to begin a season since 2012)...Are tied with the Braves for the fourth-most games (11) decided in the last at-bat in all of MLB (the Bucs have gone $6-5$ in those games)...The only three teams in MLB to have more games decided in the last at-bat are the Tigers (16), Cubs (12) and Mets (12)...Have had three of their last four games decided by one run and seven of their last 14 decided by one run dating back to April 27.

WHAT'S BREWING: Since the beginning of the 2022 season, 22 games between the Brewers and Pirates have been decided by either one or two runs...That's tied for the most such games between any two NL teams (also Cubs vs. Brewers) in that time...The Pirates and Brewers have also both played in 13 games decided by exactly one run this season...The only NL team to have played in more are the Cubs (15)...Special thanks to StatsPerform.

GO THE DISTANCE: Mitch Keller threw a career-high 109 pitches while tossing the second complete game of his career in his last start one week ago tonight against the Angels...Prior to last Monday, Keller's other complete game came on May 8, 2023, against the Rockies at PNC Park... Keller is one of seven pitchers in MLB to toss a complete game this season...In addition, Keller and Max Fried are the only MLB pitchers to have a complete game in both 2023 and 2024...Courtesy of StatsPerform.

GIMME FIVE: Mitch Keller tossed 5.0 innings last Monday against the Angels, giving him 39 straight starts of working at least 5.0 innings in a game...It's the longest active streak in all of MLB coming into today...It's also the longest streak by a Pirate since A.J. Burnett made 49 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings from May 8, 2012, to August 10, 2013.

CENTRAL PARKED: The Pirates are $1-2$ in a stretch of 10 straight games against teams from the National League Central...The next seven games will come during this road trip with these three against the Brewers followed by four games at Wrigley Field beginning Thursday night.

BEER BATTER: Oneil Cruz has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games against the Brewers, going 16-for-43 (.372) with four doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI... Since the beginning of 2022, Cruz is tied for the third-most RBI among all players against the Brewers...The only two players with more are Nolan Arenado (22) and Paul Goldschmidt (21).

HOW MAY I ASSIST YOU: Bryan Reynolds has recorded an assist in two of the last three games and comes into today tied with Cleveland's Ramon Laureano for the most in MLB among all outfielders (five)...Last season Joshua Palacios led Pirates outfielders with five assists.

CRUZING ALONG: Oneil Cruz is hitting at a 344 clip (21-for-61) with five doubles, four home runs and 11 RBI in his last 18 games dating back to April 22...Cruz' . 344 average since April 22 is the third-highest among all National League players, trailing only Alec Bohm (.392) and Luis Arraez (.347)...Cruz has also recorded the third-best slugging percentage (.623) during that time...The only two National League players with a higher slugging percentage since April 22 are Shohei Ohtani (.672) and Bryson Stott (.625).

GO JOE: Connor Joe hit a two-run home run leading off the 10th inning yesterday after connecting for a three-run homer on Friday...Prior to this past weekend, the last time Joe had hit a homer in two straight games as a pro was for the Albuquerque Isotopes (AAA) on June 27-28, 2021...Joe is now 6 -for-16 with a pair of doubles, two home runs and six RBI in his last four games.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar has converted each of his last six save opportunities and comes into today with 68, which are the eighth-most in team history (Jose Mesa is seventh with 70)... Since the beginning of last year, Bednar has the second-most saves (46) in MLB, trailing only Emmanuel Clase (55).
