YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The O's fell to the Astros, 5-1, in the middle game of the three-game set. Have dropped their second series to an AL opponent this year, joining April 26–28 vs. Oakland (1-2)...Corbin Burnes had his streak of 10 consecutive quality starts snapped after allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR) with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings; was the longest stretch by an Oriole since **Jeremy Guthrie** also tossed 10 straight quality outings from May 8 to June 26, 2007

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won 12 of their last 19, 15 of 23, and 20 of 29...At 49-27 (.645), the Birds own the fourth-best record in MLB, behind the Guardians (.649, 48-26), Phillies (.658, 50-26), and Yankees (.658, 52-27)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 150-88 (.630), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors...The 0's are 233-167 (.583) since the start of 2022, the best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Braves (.621, 247-151) and Dedages (.647, 301, 147)

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 124 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (115) and Dodgers (108)...Have homered in 21 consecutive games, the longest streak in MLB this season and the longest such streak in team history, ahead of a 20-gamer from July 17 to August 9, 1998; the MLB record is 31 straight games with a home run by the 2019 Yankees, and the last team with a home run streak of at least 21 games was the Braves with a 28-game streak from June 10 to July 15, 2023.

① The Orioles are 42-18 this year when homering, 33-5 when hitting multiple home runs, 17-4 when hitting at least three, and 4-1 when hitting four.

② Baltimore has five players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Angels, Dodgers, and Padres for the most in MLB this season: Gunnar Henderson (24), Anthony Santander (20), Adley Rutschman (14), Jordan Westburg (12), and Ryan Mountcastle (11).

③ Henderson and Santander are the only teammates in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season.

The O's lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks second in MLB with 24 homers, trailing only New York-AL's

<u>UNN:</u> Gunnar Henderson ranks second in MLB with 24 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Judge (28)...He ranks among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right). He owns a career-best 29-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an 0's batter since Nick Markakis' 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009.
 Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an 0's batter since Anthony Santander had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

SUMMER SLUGGER: Anthony Santander leads MLB with 11 home runs this month...He is the first 0's batter with double-digit home runs in a single calendar month since he did so in September 2022 (10)...He is the first 0riole to hit 11+ homers in a single month since Manny Machado hit 12 in August 2017...The club record for home runs in a month is 15 by Jim Gentile in August 1961... The club record for home runs in June is 12 by Boog Powell (1964), Rafael Palmeiro (1998), Albert Pallo (2013)

The club record for nome runs in June is 12 by **Boog Powell** (1804), Rataer railien (1896), Anders **Belle** (2000), and **Chris Davis** (2013).

Os Santander's 81 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Álvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (127).

**ALL ADS UP: Adley Rutschman** reached base safely in 10 straight plate appearances from June 20-22, the longest streak by an Oriole since **Cedric Mullins** reached in 11 consecutive plate appearances from June 4-6, 2021.

RUNNIN' WILD: Gunnar Henderson has set a career high with 13 stolen bases this year...Prior to being caught stealing in the first inning last night, he was 13-for-13 in stolen base attempts to open the campaign, tied for the most successful stolen base attempts to start a season in 0's history with Cedric Mullins (2023) and Corey Patterson and Brian Roberts (2006)...As a team, the Birds are 59-for-70 on stolen bases attempts...Their 84.3 stolen base percentage ranks second in the AL and fourth in MLB behind the Brewers (84.7%), Cubs (84.8%), and Blue Jays (86.7%), and would be the best mark in a case and in 10 bitters wheat 61% (1 become 16.9%) in 100/4 and would be the best mark in a season in 0's history, ahead of 84.1 percent (69-for-82) in 1994.

O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO: The Orioles are 2-3 on the current six-game road against the Yankees (2-1) and Astros (0-2); the trip wraps up today with the finale of the three-game set in Houston, which the O's need to win to avoid being swept for the second time this year and a losing road trip...The Birds are 24-13 (.649) on the road this year, the second-best road winning percentage in MLB behind the Yankees (.667, 28-14)...Since the start of 2023, they are 76-42 (.644) on the road, the best road winning percentage and most road wins in MLB; no other team has a road winning percentage over .600 during that span.

**AGAINST HOUSTON:** The Orioles and Astros continue a seven-game season series with the finale of the three-game set in Houston today...The O's will host the Astros for four games from August 22-25...Baltimore split the season series against Houston last year, 3-3, going 1-2 at Oriole Park and 2-1 at Minute Maid Park.

HOMECOMING: The Orioles begin a seven-game homestand tomorrow with the first of three games against the Guardians...The O's will then host the Rangers from Thursday through Sunday for a rematch of the 2023 ALDS, including ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball on June 30...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, it will be Baltimore's 35<sup>th</sup> appearance on Sunday Night Baseball, in which though 15.1 which they are 15-19.

ALL-STAR VOTING: Last week, MLB announced the first balloting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game... The 2024 MLB All-Star Ballot, which is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App, and the MLB Ballpark App, will be accessible until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 12 p.m. ET on Thursday, June 27... The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6 p.m. on Thursday, June 27, and will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who starts for each league... As of the first update, five Orioles were on pace to advance to Phase 2 (see box at right), while two were leading their positions; the Orioles have not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014... The second Phase 1 update will be shared by MLB tomorrow, Monday, June 24.

② Adley Rutschman led AL catchers and ranked third in the AL with 792,857 votes; seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment; would become the third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry Kennedy in 1987; Matt Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).

③ Gunnar Henderson led AL shortstops and ranked sixth in the AL with 740,436 votes; vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since Manny Machado in 2018.

③ Ryan Mountcastle ranked second among AL first basemen with 693,594 votes, trailing Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (746,031); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Chris Davis in 2013.

⑤ Jordan Westburg ranked second among AL third basemen with 366,670 votes, trailing the page and the page and

Jordan Westburg ranked second among AL third basemen with 366,670 votes, trailing Cleveland's Jose Ramírez (742,910); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.

Anthony Santander ranked fifth among AL outfielders with 321,333 votes; seeking his first All-Star selection and would join Austin Hays (2023) and Cedric Mullins (2021) as outfielders to represent the 0's at the All-Star Game in the last four seasons.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his ninth start and 16<sup>th</sup> appearance of the season tonight against the Astros...Four of his eight starts this season have been scoreless; the four such starts are one shy of the American League lead The Orioles are 5-3 as a team in his starts this season...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances...Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League before signing with the 0's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits (3 HR) and 24 strikeouts in 11 starts...Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023... Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his first loss of the season on June 18 at New York-AL...Tossed 3.2 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, a career-high five walks, and one hit batter with three strikeouts...Threw a season-high 96 pitches, 49 strikes.

**AGAINST THE ASTROS AND THE AL WEST:** Making his first career start against Astros and fourth against the AL West...Is 1-0 with a 4.26 ERA (9 ER/19.0 IP) in his five prior appearances (3 GS) against the division...AL West foes are slashing .267/.337/.400 (20-for-75) off him in his career...Did not factor in the decision in his last start against an AL West opponent on April 28 vs. Oakland; allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts in 4.0 innings.

**DAY MAN:** Has gone 0-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER/20.1 IP) in seven day appearances (3 GS) this season...Opponents are slashing .189/.231/.297 (14-for-74) in afternoon outlings.

**LIFE ON THE ROAD:** Owns a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) in eight appearances (4 GS) away from Oriole Park this season; five of his eight road outings have been scoreless, including two starts.


