QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his ninth start and 16th appearance of the season tonight against the Astros...Four of his eight starts this season have been scoreless; the four such starts are one shy of the American League lead. The Orioles are 5-3 as a team in his starts this season...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances...Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League before signing with the O's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits (3 HR) and 24 strikeouts in 11 starts...Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023...Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

AGAINST THE ASTROS AND THE AL WEST: Making his first career start against the Astros and fourth against the AL West...Is 1-0 with a 4.26 ERA (9 ER/19.0 IP) in his five prior appearances (3 GS) against the division...AL West foes are slashing .267/.337/.400 (20-for-75) off him in his career...Did not factor in the decision in his last start against an AL West opponent on April 28 vs. Oakland; allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts in 4.0 innings.
