AROUND THE HORN

- HERE’S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 7-5 in their last 12 games, tied for the fourth-best mark in the NL since June 29, with the Dodgers and Pirates behind the Cubs (7-4), Brewers (9-5) and Marlins (8-4).
- The D-backs have 4 road series wins in their last 6 series @ Dodgers since 2024, with a 9-8 record.
 - With a win today, the D-backs will have won or split the road slate @ Dodgers for 3 straight seasons (2-3 in 2026, 3-3 in 2025, 4-2 in 2024).
 - Tim Tawa** in the first 2 games of this series has 6 hits, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 6 RBI and 1 stolen base.
 - Mitch Bratt** is making his second career start...debuted on June 24 @ Cardinals (3.0 IP, 1 R, 2 H, 2 BB, 3 K).
 - Ketel Marte** has reached base in all 15 starts as the designated hitter, batting .306 (19-for-62)/.848 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 6 walks.
 - Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 12 straight games and 31 straight starts.
 - Has a career-high 12 straight games reaching base safely vs. NL West.

- LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 9-2 @ Dodgers with 9 runs scored for the second straight game, their eighth time all-time with back-to-back games of 9 or more runs scored vs. Dodgers.
- Brandon Pfaadt** got the win (5.1 IP, 2 R, 6 H, 0 BB, 2 K)...opened with 5.0 scoreless frames (2 H, 0 BB, 2 K).
 - James McCann** had his fourth career 2-homer game with a 3-run homer in the sixth inning and a solo homer in the eighth inning.
 - Tim Tawa** had his second straight 3-hit game, including a RBI groundout in the fourth inning and a RBI double in the sixth inning.
 - Gabriel Moreno** tied a career high with 4 times on base (2 1B, 2 BB).
 - The bullpen worked 3.2 shutout frames (0 H, 0 BB, 4 K): **Brandyn Garcia** (0.2 IP), **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0), **Juan Morillo** (1.0) and **Philip Abner** (1.0).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled LHP **Mitch Bratt** from Triple-A Reno and placed RHP **Zac Gallen** on the 15-day injured list, retro to July 9 (right elbow inflammation).

WIN THE SERIES: The D-backs are 6-0-2 in their last 8 series vs. NL West: 2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 3-0 @ Giants, 2-2 vs. Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Giants, 2-2 @ Padres, 2-0 @ Dodgers.

- VS. NL WEST:** The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 games
- Are 8-2 in their last 10 road games @ NL West.
 - Among all teams against their own division, the D-backs' 20 wins vs. NL West are second behind the Dodgers (22 vs. NL West) and ahead of the Brewers (19 vs. NL Central) and Rays (19 vs. AL East).

- DAY GAMERS: Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 7 straight day games (.393, 11-for-28, 1.092 OPS).
- Has reached base safely in 8 straight road day games (.438, 14-for-32, 1.125 OPS).
 - Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 8 straight day games (.370, 10-for-27, 1.019 OPS).
 - Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 day games (.378, 14-for-37, 1.176 OPS).

IT STARTS WITH STARTING PITCHING: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 8 starts, have a 3.43 ERA (17 ER in 44.2 IP), an opponent .250 AVG (43-for-172)/.700 OPS, 11 walks and 35 strikeouts.

- KETEL'S DH STREAK: Ketel Marte** as designated hitter has reached base safely in 40 of 41 overall starts, since August 5, 2024 (.944 OPS, 13 2B, 8 HR, 26 RBI).
- Has reached base safely in 23 straight road starts as the designated hitter since August 5, 2024 (.990 OPS, 8 2B, 6 HR, 14 RBI, 10 BB).

- GINKEL ON THE ROAD: Kevin Ginkel** has 9 straight scoreless road appearances (9.0 IP, 7 H, 2 BB, 9 K).
- Has held NL West opponents scoreless in 11 of his last 13 road games (1.38 ERA, 2 ER in 13.0 IP, 5 H, 3 BB, 10 K).

- GARCIA HANGING ZEROES: Brandyn Garcia** has held opponents scoreless in 12 straight (10.0 IP) and held 36 batters faced to 2 hits and 3 walks with 16 strikeouts.
- Has held opponents scoreless in 26 of 28 games this season (5 R in 23.2 IP, 12 H, 6 BB, 27 K).

LOÁISIGA BLANKING FOES: Jonathan Loáisiga has 11 straight scoreless outings (11.1 IP, 38 BF, 5 H, 0 BB, 8 K)...including 6 consecutive scoreless road games (5.1 IP, 17 BF, 1 H, 0 BB, 5 K).

- MORENO'S ON-BASE STREAK: Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 31 straight starts (C: 25, DH: 6), since June 2, hitting .348 (39-for-112)/.934 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 20 walks (13 K).
- Majors' longest active streak and the third-longest streak this season behind 33 by Bryan Reynolds/PIT (May 23-June 29) and 48 by Nick Kurtz/ATH (April 3-May 25).
 - Is tied for the seventh-longest streak in club history with Paul Goldschmidt (2013), Eric Byrnes (2007) and Matt Williams (1999).

- GABI ON THE ROAD:** Among Major League leaders on the road since May 13, **Gabriel Moreno** is first with a .400 AVG and sixth with a 1.024 OPS.
- Has reached base in 23 of his last 25 road games, including 2+ times in 18 of those, hitting .393 (35-for-89)/1.033 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 14 RBI and 14 walks (14 K).

- ALL-STAR FACTS: Eduardo Rodriguez** (first career appearance in 11th MLB season) is 1 of 8 MLB players since 2022 to be named a first-time All-Star in their 10th season or later [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Corbin Carroll** (second straight appearance, third career) is 1 of 7 players who have debuted since 2017 with 3+ All-Star selections at age 25 or younger.
