SNAKEBITES

U OF A NIGHT TOMORROW: Tomorrow is U of A night @ Chase Field, which includes a special ticket package where fans will receive a co-branded D-backs x U of A cap...school mascots, Wilbur and Wilma, will take the field for a pregame celebration that also includes the University of Arizona football team, with a ceremonial first pitch from quarterback Noah Fifita and the National Anthem performed by members of the squad...the University's Vice President and Director of Athletics, Desireé Reed-Francois, will also be recognized pregame.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-3 vs. Cardinals yesterday for their fourth sweep and have won 4+ straight games for the first time since June 9-14 (5 wins)...outscored the Cardinals in the series 22-7...the +15 run differential was the D-backs' largest in a 3-game series in 2025 and largest in a 3-game series at home since July 29-31, 2024 vs. Nationals (+19).

- Eugenio Suárez** had his second consecutive multi-homer game (first time in career), third in his last 5 games (also: July 19 vs. Cardinals, July 12 @ Angels) and sixth time overall...became the sixth D-back all-time with consecutive multi-homer games (last: Christian Walker, July 3-4, 2024).
- Corbin Carroll** had his second consecutive game with 2+ hits and a leadoff triple...became the first D-back all-time to record consecutive leadoff triples, first MLB player to do so since Jazz Chisholm with the Marlins on June 26-27, 2021, and 12th MLB player overall (13th time) to do so since 1998.
- Geraldo Perdomo** had his third straight game with 1+ hits and 1+ RBI.
- Merrill Kelly** earned his second straight (ninth overall) after tossing his third quality start in his last 4 starts, allowing 2 runs over 6.0 innings on 3 hits.

SNAKEBITES: D-backs' starters are 4-0 with a MLB-second-best 1.50 ERA (4 ER in 24.0 IP) and MLB-best opponent .148 AVG in their last 4 games.

- D-backs offense, in their last 3 games with RISP, are hitting .357 (10-for-28)/.438 OBP/.536 SLG/.973 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 16 RBI and 4 walks (5 K).

SUÁREZ COLLECTS HIS FOURTH NL PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR: **Eugenio Suárez** earned his fourth career NL Player of the Week honor (all this season)...he is the first D-back to win more than twice in a season and third-ever MLB player to win 4 in a single season, joining J.D. Martinez (2017 DET/AZ) and Shohei Ohtani (2024 LAD).

- It is the first time since 2001 that Arizona has won (as a team) at least 4 awards in a season and third time overall (5 in 2001, 6 in 1999).

GENO GOING FOR 3 STRAIGHT MULTI-HOMER GAMES: **Eugenio Suárez** looks to become the fifth player in MLB history with 3 straight multi-homer games to join Gus Zernial (1951 Athletics), Frank Thomas (1962 Mets), Lee May (1969 Reds), and Jeff DaVanon (2003 Angels).

RECENT DEFENSE: The D-backs' defense has committed 1 error in their last 53.2 innings (6 games), dating back to July 11 @ Angels.

STARTING PITCHING TREND: Have held opponents to 3 or fewer runs in 4 consecutive games...first time with 4+ straight games doing so since May 21-26, 2024 (5 G).

- Since July 7 (10 G), D-backs' starting pitchers combined 3.26 ERA (21 ER in 58.0 IP) is third lowest in the NL, behind the Cubs (1.99) and Brewers (2.57).

SNAKES MLB RBI LEADERS THRU 100 GAMES: **Eugenio Suárez** (85 RBI - ahead of Cal Raleigh-SEA/83) is the second D-back all-time to lead the Majors in RBI thru the first 100 games of a season, joining Luis Gonzalez in 2001 (99 RBI - ahead of Sammy Sosa-CHC/98).

- Suárez's 85 RBI rank third by a D-back all-time thru the first 100 games of a season, behind Gonzalez (99 in 2001) and Matt Williams (91 in 1999).
- Suárez (35 HR) is 1 of 2 D-backs all-time to hit 30+ homers within the team's first 100 games of a season (also: Luis Gonzalez, 40 in 2001).

GENO IS A MON-STAR: Since July 1, **Eugenio Suárez's** 9 homers are the most in the Majors, ahead of Randy Arozarena/SEA (8), Kyle Stowers/MIA (8) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (7).

- His 6 multi-homer games are second in MLB, behind Cal Raleigh/SEA (8).
- Since the 2024 All-Star break, Suárez's 55 homers are third in the Majors, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (60) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (59).

6 HOMERS IN 5 GAMES: **Eugenio Suárez** is sixth D-back (eighth time) all-time to hit 6+ homers in a 5-game span (last: Kole Calhoun, 6 HR from Sept. 15-19, 2020)...is the first MLB player to do so in 2025 and first since Lawrence Butler/OAK from Aug. 27-31, 2024 (6 HR).

- Only 2 D-back players all-time have hit 7+ homers in a 6-game span: J.D. Martinez (7 HR from Sept. 4-10, 2017) and Reggie Sanders (7 HR from April 17-23, 2001).
- The last MLB player with 7+ homers in a 6-game span was Aaron Judge/NYY (7 from Aug. 20-25, 2024).

GENO JOINS RARE COMPANY: **Eugenio Suárez** is the first MLB player since 2013 and seventh since 1998 to hit 35+ homers with 85+ RBI in the first 100 games of a season, joining Chris Davis/BAL (37 HR/97 RBI in 2013), Luis Gonzalez/AZ (40 HR/99 RBI in 2001), Sammy Sosa/CHC (2x - 38 HR/89 RBI in 1999 and 37 HR/93 RBI in 1998), Mark McGwire/STL (2x - 36 HR/86 RBI in 1999 and 43 HR/96 RBI in 1998), Ken Griffey Jr./SEA (40 HR/91 RBI in 1998) and Greg Vaughn/SD (35 HR/85 RBI in 1998).

CORBIN BARRELS: Since 1940, **Corbin Carroll** is the eighth MLB player to reach 39+ triples within their first 430 career games...last MLB player to do so was Dexter Fowler/COL in 2009.

- Carroll is the first D-back all-time to record 10+ triples within the team's first 100 games of a season...is the seventh MLB player (eighth time) since 1998 to record 13+ triples within the team's first 100 games of a season (last: Charlie Blackmon/COL in 2017).
- Carroll is the first MLB player to have 3+ multi-triple games in a season since Jose Reyes/NYM in 2011 (3).
- Per @OptaSTATS, Corbin Carroll is the only player in MLB history to have a season with 4+ multi-homer games and one with 3+ multi-triple games.

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: Opposing starting pitchers have lasted fewer than 6.0 innings vs. D-backs in 7 straight games, tied for the second longest active MLB streak with the Guardians, behind the Angels (8).

- In those 7 games vs. starters, the D-backs are hitting .340 (48-for-141)/.1023 OPS with 11 doubles, 4 triples, 7 homers and 14 walks.
- The D-backs' 304 runs vs. opposing starting pitchers are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Yankees (295), Red Sox (289) and Tigers (287).
- Since July 1, the D-backs' offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among the NL in runs (1st, 53), times on base (1st, 125), walks (1st, 40), pitches seen (1st, 1,379), doubles (T-1st, 19 with Braves), triples (1st, 4), homers (2nd, 15), OBP (2nd, .341), SLG (2nd, .480) and OPS (3rd, .820).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (3-6, 5.94)

- Made his last start vs. Astros on Sept. 7, 2024 on the road (L; 4 ER in 4.0 IP).

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

- D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA the last 3 seasons (2022-24) and 4 of the last 5 seasons (2020, '22-'24).
- 2023 NL All-Star starting pitcher.
- Finished in Top 5 in NL Cy Young Voting in 2023 (3rd) and 2022 (5th).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: 11th home start (21st overall).

- Has allowed 1 earned run or fewer in 2 of his last 3 starts.
- Over his last 3 starts, has gone 2-1 with a 3.50 ERA (9 R-7 ER in 18.0 IP), 3 walks and 22 strikeouts.
- The D-backs have won in each of his 7 quality starts.
- Has thrown 100+ pitches in 2 of his last 3 starts...his 7 starts of 100+ pitches are third in his career, behind 2022 (9), 2023 (8) and 2021 (8).
- Is 1 of 16 active starting pitchers with 60+ wins since 2019.

APPROACHING 1,000: Is 5 strikeouts shy of 1,000 in his career.

- Among all pitchers since 2019, his 995 strikeouts are 11th...Top 3 are Zack Wheeler/PHI (1,248), Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241) and Aaron Nola/PHI (1,234)...teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079) is eighth.
- His 949 strikeouts as a D-back are fourth in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065)and Robbie Ray (998).

LAST START: Took the loss on July 12 @ Angels (6 ER in 5.0 IP).

VS. ASTROS: Sixth career start...first start @ Chase Field since Sept. 29, 2023 (L; 2 ER in 6.1 IP).

- Is 1-1 with a 3.16 ERA over 5 career starts.
- In 2 home starts (both quality), is 0-1 with a 2.92 ERA (4 ER in 12.1 IP),1 home run, 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.
- Has walked just 1 batter in each of his 5 starts (1.44 walks per 9.0 IP).

VS. AL WEST: Has gone scoreless in 2 of his last 3 starts vs. AL West opponents, going 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (6 ER in 16.0 IP), opponent .196 AVG, 1.00 WHIP, 5 walks and 17 strikeouts.

HOME COOKIN: Over his last 2 home starts (team is 2-0), is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 13.1 IP), .229 AVG, 4 walks and 16 strikeouts.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: in his last 6 interleague starts, is 3-3 with a 4.41 ERA (16 ER in 32.2 IP) and 36 strikeouts.

- From Aug. 24, 2024-April 2, 2025, had 3 straight scoreless starts (3-0), over 17.2 IP with an opponent .117 AVG, 6 walks and 29 strikeouts.

JULY, OH MY: In his last 3 home July starts, is 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 19.0 IP), opponent .222 AVG, 4 walks and 22 strikeouts.

- In his last 6 July starts (4 quality), has gone 5-1 with a 2.83 ERA (13 R-11 ER in 35.0 IP), opponent .241 AVG and 38 strikeouts.

VS. RIGHTIES AT HOME: In his last 2 home starts, has held righties to a .083 AVG (2-for-24)/.362 OPS with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.

- In his first 5 home starts, held righties to a .160 AVG (8-for-50)/.490 OPS with 6 walks and 16 strikeouts.

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: Throwing his fastball 47.8%...in his last 3 home starts, is holding opponents to a .147 AVG (5-for-34)/.176 SLG.

- Has a 92.6 exit velocity in 3 straight seasons (2023-25).

NIGHTOWL: In his last 6 night starts, since May 23, is 4-2 with a 4.79 ERA (23 R-19 ER in 35.2 IP), opponent .255 AVG (35-for-137)/.747 OPS, 9 walks and 35 strikeouts.

- 6-start stretch includes June 20 @ Rockies (7 ER in 5.0 IP) and July 12 @ Angels (6 ER in 5.0 IP).
