



2025 MINOR LEAGUE SEASON IN REVIEW



2025 MINOR LEAGUE SUMMARY

COMPOSITE RECORD: The Pirates' seven minor-league affiliates combined to go 396-319 (.554), the third-best among all Major League organizations, trailing Detroit (420-293, .589) and San Francisco (405-314, .563). It was also their highest winning percentage since 2003 (.569). Five of the seven affiliates finished with a winning record.

FUTURES GAME: **Konnor Griffin** and **Esmerlyn Valdez** were named to the All-Star Futures Game at Truist Park in Atlanta, Georgia. Griffin started at shortstop and went 1-for-2 before exiting in the fourth inning after being hit by a pitch. Valdez went 0-for-1 and played the final 3.0 innings of the National League's 4-2 victory at first base.

PLAYOFF REVIEW

ALTOONA: The Curve clinched the second-half postseason spot from the Eastern League's Southwest Division, marking their first postseason berth since 2018. They played Erie (Detroit) in a best-of-three division series, where they won the first game at Peoples Natural Gas Field before dropping the second and third games at Erie.
GREENSBORO: The Grasshoppers clinched the second-half postseason spot from the South Atlantic League's North Division, marking their second straight postseason berth and their third berth in the last five seasons. They matched up with Brooklyn (New York-NL) in a best-of-three division series, where they were bested in two games.
DSL PIRATES: Both the Dominican Summer League Pirates Black and Gold teams made the postseason, marking the first time that ever happened (had two DSL teams from 2012-13, and a second team began playing again in 2018). The Gold team advanced to a best-of-three semifinal round, losing in two games to the Padres Gold team.

DSL PIRATES: **Johan De Los Santos** (Black) and **Darell Morel** (Gold) represented the Pirates organization at the Dominican Summer League's All-Star Game on July 20. Both players entered the game as pinch hitters, with Morel singling, stealing a base and a scoring run in the seventh inning of the National League All-Stars' 10-8 loss.

(Chandler became the first Pirate to earn a save of any length in his Major League debut, as well as one of only four Major League pitchers to earn a 4.0-inning save in his big-league debut, since the stat became official in 1969. He joined Boston's Bob Stanley in 1977, St. Louis' Zack Thompson in 2022 and San Francisco's Keaton Winn in 2023).

MISCELLANEOUS HONORS AND FEATS

Konnor Griffin, who split the season between Bradenton, Greensboro and Altoona, finished the season rated by both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America as the No. 1 prospect in all of baseball. He was named Baseball America's Minor League Player of the Year, becoming the second Pirates farmhand to ever win the award, along with pitcher **Mike Bielecki** (1984). He also became one of five players to be recognized as both Baseball America's High School Player of the Year and Minor League Player of the Year, joining **Joe Mauer**, **Bryon Buxton**, **Bobby Witt Jr.** and **Jackson Holliday**. The 19-year-old Griffin was also tabbed as the South Atlantic League's "Top MLB Prospect" at the conclusion of his first professional season. His 65 stolen bases were the most by a Pirates minor-league player in a season since **Pedro Powell** (67) in 2007, while his 117 runs scored were the most by a Pittsburgh farmhand since **Robbie Grossman** (127) in 2011. He finished the season ranked second among all full-season players in Minor League Baseball in runs scored, while also ranking fourth in batting average (.333), fifth in both hits (161) and total bases (255), seventh in OPS (.942), tied for seventh in RBI (94) and eighth in stolen bases. Griffin also went 6-for-10 (.600) with two RBI in his three postseason games with Altoona.

Esmerlyn Valdez, who split the season between Greensboro and Altoona, was named the South Atlantic League's Most Valuable Player. The 21-year-old Valdez hit .303 (84-for-277) with 18 doubles, 20 home runs, 57 RBI, 31 walks, 46 runs scored and a .977 OPS in his 72 games with the Grasshoppers. Despite being promoted to the Curve on July 1, Valdez led the SAL with a .592 slugging percentage and ranked second in homers and extra-base hits (39), fourth in total bases (164) and 10th in RBI.

Edward Florentino, who split the season between the Florida Complex League Pirates and Bradenton, was tabbed as the Florida Complex League's "Top MLB Prospect" at the conclusion of the season. The 18-year-old Florentino batted .347 (33-for-95) with six doubles, two triples, six home runs, 23 RBI, 16 walks, six stolen bases, 23 runs scored and a 1.084 OPS in 29 games with the FCL Pirates before being promoted to the Marauders on June 21. When he earned his promotion, Florentino ranked second in the FCL in both home runs and total bases (61), tied for second in extra-base hits (14), tied for third in runs scored, tied for fourth in RBI and fifth in hits.

Greensboro's **Blake Butler** was named the South Atlantic League's Manager of the Year after guiding the team to an 88-43 (.672) regular-season record. The 88 wins were the most by any Greensboro team since the Greensboro Hornets (96) in 1982. They were also tied with Double-A Springfield (St. Louis) for fourth in Minor League Baseball, behind only High-A West Michigan (Detroit) with 92 wins, Double-A Binghamton (New York-NL) with 90 wins and Triple-A Jacksonville (Miami) with 89 wins.

INDIANAPOLIS INDIANS BATTERS

Chris Truby began the season as Indianapolis' manager before being added to **Don Kelly's** staff on May 16. **Shawn Bowman** took over, leading the team to an 87-62 finish. The 87 wins were Indianapolis' second-most in a season since becoming a Pittsburgh affiliate in 2005 (89-55 in 2012). The 87 wins were the most in the International League's West Division and were tied with Lehigh Valley (Philadelphia) and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (New York-AL) for the second-most in the league, behind Jacksonville (Miami), which had 89 wins. Indianapolis joined High-A Greensboro (88-43) as Pirates affiliates to each win 85 games. Pittsburgh was the only organization to have multiple affiliates win 85-plus games. Before 2025, the last time the Pirates had multiple affiliates win at least 80 games in a season came in 2015 (the Indians went 83-61, while the Class-A West Virginia Power went 87-52).

Nick Solak reached base safely in 39 straight games from June 10-August 6, going 53-for-151 (.351) with nine doubles, four home runs, 25 RBI, 21 walks, 27 runs scored and a .934 OPS during the streak, which was the longest among all Triple-A players this season. It was also the fourth-longest streak by an Indianapolis batter since the team became a Pittsburgh affiliate in 2005, trailing only **Chris Richard** (46 games) in 2006, **Ronny Paulino** (42 games) in 2005 and **Ty Wigginton** (41 games) in 2005. Solak finished the season with a .332 average, which ranked second in the International League and fifth among all full-season players in Minor League Baseball. He also finished the season with a .411 OBP, sixth-best at the Triple-A level.

INDIANAPOLIS INDIANS PITCHERS

Indianapolis' pitching staff allowed just 136 home runs, the third-fewest in the International League, behind only Gwinnett (Atlanta) with 121 home runs and Nashville (Milwaukee) with 123 home runs. The Indians won eight of their final nine games (from September 12-21), posting a 2.48 ERA in that span. Their ERA in that stretch was the best among all Triple-A teams. The next-closest team was Oklahoma City (Los Angeles-NL) with a 2.62 ERA.

Bubba Chandler was recognized as the International League's April Pitcher of the Month after going 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (20.1ip/3er), 27 strikeouts, a .106 batting average against (7-for-66) and a 0.64 WHIP. From the time of his season debut on April 3 (G1) vs. Iowa (Chicago-NL) through his final start with the Indians on August 16 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (New York-AL), he paced the International League with 121 strikeouts and 24 games started. Chandler was the first Indianapolis pitcher to win a monthly award since **Zach Duke** was named the league's Pitcher of the Month in May 2005.

Brandon Bidois began the season with Low-A Bradenton, but he finished it in Indianapolis. Over his 40 combined appearances split between Bradenton, High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis, he went 8-0 with seven saves, a 0.74 ERA (61.0ip/5er) and 69 strikeouts. From July 29 at Portland (Boston) with Altoona through September 9 vs. Iowa with Indianapolis, Bidois faced 64 consecutive batters without allowing a hit.

ALTOONA CURVE BATTERS

Altoona clinched the second-half postseason spot from the Eastern League’s Southwest Division with a win on September 7 vs. Richmond (San Francisco) at PNC Field. The Curve took on Erie (Detroit) in a best-of-three division series. They won the first game, 11-5, led by **Esmerlyn Valdez**, who finished a triple shy of the cycle after going 3-for-4 with a double, a home run, five RBI and three runs (the five RBI were a Curve playoff record).

Nick Cimillo was named the team’s Most Valuable Player after ranking tied for second in the Eastern League with 20 home runs and 50 extra-base hits, as well as fourth with 190 total bases. He had 12 home runs and 35 RBI over his 34 games from August 3 through the end of the regular season. **Mitch Jebb** was honored as Altoona’s Unsung Hero. His 118 hits were tied with teammate **Termarr Johnson** for the sixth-most in the Eastern League, while his 59 walks were tied with two others (including Johnson) for the eighth-most in the league. He also ranked sixth with 33 stolen bases.

Konnor Griffin made his Double-A debut on August 19 vs. Reading (Philadelphia). From the time of his debut through the end of the regular season, his 22 RBI were tied with Cimillo for the most in the Eastern League. He also ranked seventh in batting (.337) and tied for first in runs (20) in that time.

ALTOONA CURVE PITCHERS

Wilber Dotel finished the season with 131 strikeouts, trailing only **Ian Snell** (142) in 2004, **Justin Wilson** (134) in 2010 and **Rudy Owens** (132) in 2010 for the most by a Curve pitcher in a single season in franchise history (since 1999). Dotel's 27 games started were the most by any Eastern League pitcher and were tied with two others for the most among pitchers at the Double-A level. His 131 strikeouts were the third-most in the Eastern League.

Justin Meis, a 2018 graduate of Bethel Park High School, was named Altoona's Fireman of the Year after posting a 2.89 ERA (62.1ip/20er) and 67 strikeouts. **Alessandro Ercolani** was recognized as the Curve's Pitcher of the Year, tossing 100.1 innings and allowing one or zero runs in 11 outings. **Wilkin Ramos**, who had a 1.45 ERA (49.2ip/8er) at Altoona before his promotion to Triple-A on August 12, was an Eastern League postseason All-Star.

Hunter Barco began the season with the Curve, where he pitched 25.2 straight scoreless innings over his six starts from April 4-May 3 before earning a promotion to Indianapolis on May 6. He was recognized as the Eastern League's April Pitcher of the Month. In the stretch from April 4-May 3, the only other pitcher in Minor League Baseball to not allow an earned run was Low-A Stockton (Athletics)'s **Donny Troconis**, who pitched 22.0 innings.

GREENSBORO GRASSHOPPERS BATTERS

Greensboro clinched the second-half postseason spot from the South Atlantic League's North Division with a victory on September 7, the final day of the regular season, over Hudson Valley (New York-AL) on the road at Heritage Financial Park. The Grasshoppers' 165 home runs paced the South Atlantic League and were the second-most among all High-A teams, trailing only Everett (Seattle) of the Northwest League, which had 166 home runs.

Javier Rivas paced the South Atlantic League with 72 RBI and a .780 OPS across his 94 games, despite earning a promotion to Altoona on August 5.

Callan Moss, who was acquired from Kansas City in a three-player trade on July 31, made his Grasshoppers debut in the team's doubleheader on August 2 at Rome (Atlanta). From the time of his team debut through the end of the regular season, Moss led the South Atlantic League with a .339 average, a .422 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .993 OPS. Greensboro's 3.55 staff ERA ranked fourth in the South Atlantic League, trailing only Hudson Valley (New York-AL) with a 2.82 ERA, Brooklyn (New York-NL) with a 3.30 ERA and Hub City (Texas) with a 3.50 ERA. The Grasshoppers' 1.22 WHIP was the third-best among South Atlantic League teams.

Greensboro pitched two perfect games in a nine-game span. In the 2-0 victory on July 4 at Aberdeen (Baltimore), **Khristian Curtis** (6.0ip/10k), **Jake Shirk** (2.0ip/4k) and **Michael Walsh** (1.0ip/2k) combined to strike out 16 IronBirds. In the 4-0 victory on July 13 vs. Bowling Green (Tampa Bay), **Hung-Leng Chang** (5.0ip/5k), **Joshua Loeschorn** (2.0ip/1k), Shirk (1.0ip/1k) and **Jarod Bayless** (1.0ip) punched out seven Hot Rods. The Grasshoppers became the first full-season team in Minor League Baseball to pitch a 9.0-inning complete game since September 1, 2017, when it was done by Kane County (Arizona) of the Midwest League at Clinton (Seattle). That night, **Connor Grey** had eight strikeouts while throwing 100 pitches.

Curtis, who led the South Atlantic League with 26 games started, entered the month of July with a 5.20 ERA (55.1ip/32er). Over his next 11 starts (July 4-September 3), he went 6-1 with a 2.70 ERA (53.1ip/16er) and a .179 batting average against. Curtis earned a promotion to Altoona on September 14.

Bradenton's 103 home runs led the Florida State League, 13 ahead of second-place Palm Beach (St. Louis). The 103 home runs also led all teams at the Low-A level. The Marauders' 1515 total bases were the second-most in the Florida State League, trailing only Daytona (Cincinnati), which had 1602 total bases. **Konnor Griffin** made his professional debut with the Marauders, where he led the Florida State League with a .338 batting average, a .536 slugging percentage, 70 hits, 111 total bases and 49 runs scored during his time in Bradenton. He earned a promotion to Greensboro on June 10.

BRADENTON MARAUDERS PITCHERS

Bradenton's pitching staff was led by southpaw **Victor Cabreja**, who finished tied for the Florida State League lead with nine wins. He posted a 2.48 ERA (90.2ip/25er) over his 21 appearances (14 starts) with the Marauders. Cabreja allowed more than two earned runs in three of his 21 appearances. He recorded a 1.70 ERA (53.0ip/10er) in 11 outings (nine starts) from the start of June until the time of his promotion to Greensboro on August 12, starting with his outing on June 5 (G1) at Clearwater (Philadelphia). His 2.48 ERA was the lowest among FSL pitchers with at least 90.0 innings pitched.

Noah Takacs was charged with his only blown save of the season in his appearance on April 24 at Lakeland (Detroit). The 23-year-old righthander then went on to convert each of his final nine save opportunities, which was the longest streak in the Florida State League all season. Takacs recorded a 1.74 ERA (10.1ip/2er) across his final 10 appearances of the season, beginning with his scoreless appearance on July 31 vs. Fort Myers (Minnesota).

Inmer Lobo was named to the FSL's postseason All-Star team, posting a 1.71 ERA (31.2ip/6er) and 35 strikeouts in 13 games before his promotion to Greensboro on June 24. **Greiber Mendez'** 2.66 ERA (67.2ip/20er) in relief ranked third in the league among those with at least 55.0 innings pitched.

FCL PIRATES BATTERS

Edward Florentino finished the season ranked tied for fourth in the Florida Complex League with six home runs, despite being promoted to Bradenton on June 21. From the beginning of the FCL season through time of his promotion to the Marauders, Florentino ranked second in the FCL in home runs and total bases (61), tied for second in extra-base hits (14), tied for third in runs scored (23), tied for fourth in RBI (23) and fifth in hits (33).

DSL PIRATES BLACK BATTERS/PITCHERS

Pittsburgh's Dominican Summer League Black team went 34-20, finishing in second place in the DSL Southwest Division, one game behind the DSL Giants Orange team. The team advanced to the Dominican Summer League Cup, winning one of its two games in pool play (third game was canceled).

The Black team sent **Johan De Los Santos**, who hit .333 (26-for-78) with four doubles, two triples, 15 RBI, 17 walks, 17 steals, 25 runs scored and an .876 OPS in his first 27 games (June 2-July 17), to the league's midseason All-Star Game on July 20. He finished the season ranked fifth in the Dominican Summer League with a .353 average and tied for fifth with 34 stolen bases (his 34 steals were tied for the fourth-most among all Pirates farmhands).

The Black team's .265 average was the sixth-highest mark among all teams in the Dominican Summer League. Their 174 stolen bases were the second-most in the league, trailing only the DSL Miami team (191 stolen bases). Their .406 team OBP was the second-best in the league (DSL Rockies, .413).

DSL PIRATES GOLD BATTERS/PITCHERS

Pittsburgh's Dominican Summer League Gold team went 31-25, finishing in a tie with the DSL Cleveland Goryl team for first place in the Central Division. They advanced to the semifinal round of the DSL Cup, where they were defeated, 2-0, in a best-of-three series vs. the DSL Padres Gold team.

The Gold team sent **Darell Morel**, who batted .261 (23-for-88) with 11 extra-base hits, 13 RBI, 20 walks, 17 stolen bases and 26 runs scored in his first 30 games (June 2-July 17) to the league's midseason All-Star Game on July 20. **Yonleg Gaetano** was named to the league's postseason All-Star team after recording five saves, a 0.93 ERA (29.0ip/3er), 39 strikeouts and a .168 batting average against (17-for-101) in his 13 outings (three starts).

The pitching staff's 3.91 ERA ranked second in the entire league, trailing only the Dominican Summer League Athletics, who posted a 3.64 ERA. The team's 165 stolen bases were the seventh-most in the entire league. **Raimi Mueses** had seven wins, which were tied for the most in the entire league.

Fredderick Ovalle finished the season on a 22-game on-base streak (July 15-August 19), going 26-for-82 (.317) with 10 doubles, a triple, a home run, 12 RBI, 22 walks, 10 stolen bases, 19 runs scored and a .962 OPS during that stretch. **Iverson Allen** hit .370 (10-for-27) with two triples, a home run, six RBI, 11 walks, five stolen bases and seven runs scored during the month of August (his .561 OBP and 1.191 OPS during the month ranked sixth and seventh, respectively, in the league). He went 4-for-10 (.400) with two walks, three stolen bases and four runs scored in three postseason games. **Victor Trejo** had five saves and a 1.65 ERA (32.2ip/6er) over his 18 appearances, never allowing more than two runs or three hits in any of his outings.
