#### Hard to Handle

**Freddy Peralta** has limited opponents to a .190 batting average since the start of the 2021 season, the lowest mark in the majors in that span....opponents are batting just .164 (10-for-61) against Peralta through 3 starts this season, the second-lowest mark in the National League behind San Diego's Dylan Cease (.130).

#### By the Slimmest of Margins

The Brewers are a Major League-best 178-120 (.597) in 1-run games since 2017, which was their first of six straight full seasons with 86+ wins (not including 2020)....the team has gone 4-0 in 1-run games this season.

**MANAGER:** **Pat Murphy** was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

**COACHES:** First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....

**Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made four replay challenges this season, going 4-0....their last challenge came on 4/7 vs. Seattle as a caught stealing at second base involving Oliver Dunn was overturned.

**TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (3gs, 2-0, 2.55)**

**PERALTA AT A GLANCE:** Freddy Peralta, 27, is making his fourth start....Peralta last started last Friday at Baltimore in an 11-1 win (6ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 11k, 1hr, 90 pitches)....the team is 3-0 in his starts....he has made 2 quality starts....opponents are batting .164 (10-for-61, 2hr)....he has recorded 26 strikeouts against only 2 walks in 17.2 innings pitched....he became the third pitcher in franchise history born in the Dominican Republic to start on Opening Day, joining **Rafael Roque** (1999) and **Wily Peralta** (2016), who is of no relation....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

**LAST SEASON:** Peralta went 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA in a career-high 30 starts last season....the team went 17-13 in his starts....he made 16 quality starts....opponents batted .212 (131-for-617, 26hr)....Peralta ranked among the 2023 National League leaders in K/9IP (3rd, 11.41), WHIP (5th, 1.12), H/9IP (5th, 7.12), strikeouts (T5th, 210) and K/BB (7th, 3.89)....he became the eighth pitcher (14x) in franchise history to produce 200+ strikeouts in a season.

**CAREER:** Is 44-27 with a 3.79 ERA and 1 save in 149 games/100 starts (598.1ip, 252er)....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24)....has gone 36-25 with a 3.78 ERA as a starter (514.1ip, 216er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er)....was an All-Star in 2021.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 25-14 with a 3.41 ERA in 79 games/51 starts (318.1ip, 120er)....is 0-0 with a 4.76 ERA in 1 start this season (5.2ip, 3er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 19-13 with a 4.24 ERA in 70 games/49 starts (280ip, 132er)....is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in 2 starts this season (12ip, 2er).

**CAREER vs. CARDINALS:** Has gone 3-6 with a 5.86 ERA in 15 games/11 starts (58.1ip, 58h, 39r, 38er, 24bb, 65k, 9hr), including 1-2 with a 4.15 ERA in 3 starts last season (17.1ip, 14h, 8r, 8er, 8bb, 17k, 2hr).
