**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-3 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip, losing a three-game series 1-2 in New York at Citi Field earlier in the week, followed by a loss in Tampa Bay at the Trop last night...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three against the Rays in St. Petersburg...they will conclude the trip tomorrow afternoon then travel home to begin a seven game homestand with three against the Mariners (Monday-Wednesday) and four against the Blue Jays (Thursday-Sunday).  
 ☞ Twins are just 1-7 in their last eight, following a stretch where they went 8-1 in nine games from April 6-14.

**BAD TRIP AT THE TROP:** The Twins lost to the Rays last night at Tropicana Field by a score of 6-2...Taj Bradley (3-1) made the start against his former team, allowing six runs on seven hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with three walks, three strikeouts and four home runs (2 from Junior Caminero and 2 from Jonathan Aranda)...Twins pitchers had allowed just four home runs in eight games leading up to last night's game...the offense recorded nine hits, three coming from Brooks Lee, who hit his fourth homer of the season...Royce Lewis added the other run with a solo home run in the ninth inning, his third on the season.

**RAY AREA:** The Twins and Rays are playing the fifth of six games this season...Twins will be done playing the Rays for the 2025 regular season after tomorrow's finale.  
 ☞ Twins need to win today and tomorrow to avoid losing the season-series to the Rays and finish their head-to-head season at 3-3...last season the Twins went 3-3 vs. Tampa Bay...their last season-series loss came in 2024 (3-4) and their last season-series win came in 2022 (4-2).  
 ☞ Twins are 95-102 all-time against the Rays...they were 44-29 against Tampa from 1998-2006, but have gone 51-73 since 2007.  
 ☞ Derek Shelton spent seven seasons as hitting coach for the Rays from 2010-16 under Joe Maddon and Kevin Cash...he has a managerial record of 2-11 against Tampa Bay, going 1-9 in Tampa, the only win coming with the Pirates last season at George M. Steinbrenner Field on April 2.

**SIMPLY AUSTIN:** Austin Martin has reached base safely in 16-straight games with a plate appearance and in 19 of 21 games with a plate appearance...the 16-straight is tied for fourth-longest active streak in baseball (Nick Kurtz is the leader at 20)...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Martin's own 16-game on-base streak from September 2-20, 2025...the last Twin with a streak longer than 16 was Brooks Lee's 19-game on-base streak from May 28-June 20, 2025.  
 ☞ Martin currently leads the club with 17 walks...he has posted a .514 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 60 plate appearances.  
 ☞ Martin on MLB Savant's 2026 MLB Percentile Rankings: 93rd in batting run value (8), 91st in xwOBA (.402), 100th in chase % (9.8%), 95th in whiff % (14.0%), 100th in walk % (23.5%).  
 ☞ In 12 road games this season, Martin is hitting .417 (10-for-24) with 10 walks a .600 on-base percentage and a 1.100 OPS...he leads baseball in road OBP (min. 30 PA).

**THE LEFTORIUM:** Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 14th time in 27 games...they have gone 5-8 against left-handed starters this season...their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framer Valdez (8-6), April 11 at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and April 13 vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6).  
 ☞ Twins have dropped their last three when a lefty starts: April 15 against Boston vs. Connelly Early, April 17 against Cincinnati vs. Brandon Williamson, and April 18 against Cincinnati vs. Andrew Abbott.  
 ☞ The 13 lefty starters are the most any team has faced this season.  
 ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .369 (31-for-84) with a .476 on-base percentage and a 1.000 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average ranks fourth in all of baseball (min. 80 PA)...his OPS ranks 12th.  
 ☞ Austin Martin is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with 12 walks, a .521 on-base percentage and a 1.021 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...in his career vs. lefties, he is slashing .301/.402/.417 (.819 OPS).

**THE BOOK ON BROOKS:** Brooks Lee went 3-for-4 with one double and one home run last night at Tropicana Field...he has seven hits in his last nine at-bats...below are Lee's numbers through the first 10 games (March 26-April 8), compared to his last 14 (since April 9):

**CAUTION, WALKERS:** The Twins have now drawn 113 walks this season, fourth-most in the AL and sixth-most in baseball...their 11.3 walk percentage, ranks fifth-highest in baseball, trailing New York-AL (12.5%), Milwaukee (12.4), Los Angeles-AL (12.0%) and Chicago-NL (11.4%).

**TOP JEFF AMERICA:** Over his last 12 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with one double, one triple, three home runs, 16 RBI, nine walks, a .457 on-base percentage, a .639 slugging percentage and a 1.095 OPS...additionally, he has reached base safely in all nine road games this season.

**MAJORITY RULES:** Twins need victories today and tomorrow to earn their fourth series win of the season...they have gone 3-5-0 in series play (series results in the right margin)...they have gone 2-2-0 at home and 1-3-0 on the road.  
 ☞ Twins last series win over the Rays came July 4-6, 2025 at Target Field, winning two of three...their last series win at Tropicana Field came April 29-May 1, 2022, taking two of three.

**LONGBALL LIMITS:** Twins pitchers had allowed just four home runs in their previous eight games leading up to last night...despite the four home runs allowed last night, Twins pitchers have posted a 0.79 home runs-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio, sixth-lowest in baseball, trailing San Diego (0.64), Detroit (0.66), Pittsburgh (0.72), Seattle (0.75) and Los Angeles-AL (0.76).

**"TREAT YOURSELF A ROUND OF SAUSAGE!"** On this day in 2024, the Twins debuted the Rally Sausage...it came near the middle of what turned out to be a 12-game winning streak, where the Twins beat the White Sox four times, Angels three times, White Sox again three times and the Red Sox twice — from April 22-May 4.

**DID YOU KNOW?:** National Baseball Hall of Famer and this trip's Twins radio analyst Paul Molitor recorded back-to-back three-hit games in his first two appearances in this ballpark from April 13-14, 1998...the April 13th game was a 14-inning 13-12 loss, a game that was started by Twins bullpen coach LaTroy Hawkins...Twins recorded 22 hits in that game.

- Ober is making his sixth start of 2026 and 121st of his career; is undefeated through his first five starts of the season, matching his career-high for consecutive starts without a loss to begin a campaign.
- Is making his third career start against Tampa Bay and second this season; 0-1, 5.79 ERA (9,1 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 11 strikeouts.
- In his most recent start on April 19 vs. Cincinnati, Ober recorded a quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing one unearned run on three hits with four walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts through 6.1 innings pitched.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ober made his fifth start of the season on April 8 vs. Cincinnati opposite right-hander Brady Singer...made a quality start, allowing one unearned run on three hits with season-highs in innings pitched (6.1), walks (4), strikeouts (10) and pitches (102); he did not factor into the decision.

- His 10 strikeouts are his most since recording a career-high 12 on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland.
- Exited the game with a 3-1 lead, runners on first and second and one out in the seventh inning; left-hander Taylor Rogers took over and escaped the jam, but the bullpen could not hold the lead, as the Twins ultimately fell 7-4 in 10 innings.
- Ober has walked one-or-more batters in each of his last seven starts dating back to September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland, his longest such streak since walking a batter in seven consecutive from September 16, 2022-May 5, 2023.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ober earned his second straight win on April 13 vs. Boston, allowing four runs on seven hits through a season-high 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts in a 13-6 Twins victory.

- Threw 71.6% of his pitches for strikes, his highest strike percentage in a single start since June 28, 2025 at Detroit (71.9%).
- Received a career-high 13 runs of support from his offense, surpassing his previous high of 11 (most recently done on April 28, 2025 at Cleveland).
- His seven strikeouts are tied for his most against Boston, with the only other time coming in his first career start against the Red Sox on August 25, 2021 at Fenway Park.

**TAMPA BAY-LEY:** Ober is making his third career start against Tampa Bay and second this season; is 0-1, 5.79 ERA (9,1 IP, 6 ER) with four walks, 11 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .200 (7-for-35) BAA...in his first bout with Tampa Bay this season on April 3 in the home opener, Ober allowed three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched with two walks and four strikeouts, helping the Twins get a 10-4 victory, their first win at Target Field this season.

- Current Rays batters are hitting a combined .192 (10-for-52) against Ober with no home runs and an 8.0 K/BB ratio.
- Tampa Bay is one of just three American League teams that Ober has not beaten in his career, with the other two being Houston and New York.

**THESE GUYS, AGAIN?:** Ober is making his 22nd career start against the American League East and his fourth out of six total starts this season; is 5-8, 3.56 ERA (113.2 IP, 45 ER) with 27 walks, 108 strikeouts, a 1.07 WHIP and a .223 (95-for-426) BAA in his career against AL East opponents.

- This season in three starts against the AL East (Baltimore, Boston, Tampa Bay), Ober is 1-0 with a 6.43 ERA (14.0 IP, 10 ER), four walks, 12 strikeouts and a .268 (15-for-56) BAA.
- The start will mark his most against a single division outside of the American League Central, breaking a tie with the AL West.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In five MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 18-15 with a 4.15 ERA (336.0 IP, 155 ER), 83 walks, 333 strikeouts, a .237 (303-for-1276) BAA and a .723 OPS against in 63 starts at home compared to 15-15 with a 4.01 ERA (307.2 IP, 137 ER), 59 walks, 295 strikeouts, a .240 (280-for-1165) BAA and a .700 OPS against in 57 road starts.

- Over his last five road starts dating back to August 2, 2025 at Cleveland, Ober owns a 2-0 record with a 4.26 ERA (25.1 IP, 12 ER), four walks, 19 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .268 (26-for-97) BAA.
- The start will snap a stretch of four consecutive starts at Target Field for Ober spanning from April 3-19, his longest streak of home starts without a road outing in his career.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .214/.283/.366 (9-for-42) with four doubles, one home run, three walks and six strikeouts, while righties are slashing .237/.308/.356 (14-for-69) with four doubles, one home run, six walks and 18 strikeouts.

- His 18 strikeouts against right-handed batters are tied for sixth most by a right-handed starting pitcher in Major League Baseball and tied for fourth in the American League.
- Nine of Ober's 10 strikeouts in his most recent start on April 19 vs. Cincinnati came against right-handed batters.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- Bailey is one of six MLB pitchers to throw at least 140 changeups this season, ranking fifth in the American League in usage (34.3%).
- He is ninth among MLB pitchers with a .182 (6-for-33) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 100 pitches).
- His 50.0% strikeout percentage with his sweeper ranks fifth in Major League Baseball among starting pitchers (min. 10 plate appearances).
- His 7.1 foot extension ranks in the league's 94th percentile, which is the third highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

**CHANGING IT UP:** Since his debut in 2021, Bailey has relied heavily on his four-seamer, with it being his predominant pitch in each of his first five big league seasons...through five starts this season, Ober has slowed opposing hitters down with his changeup, making it the primary pitch in his six-pitch arsenal, throwing it at a 34.3% clip...here are how his changeup numbers in 2026 compare to prior seasons:

CAREER NOTES

- Finished 2025 second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1) and strikeouts (120).
- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
