The Brewers last night snapped a
6-game postseason losing streak and
now look to win a postseason series
for the first time since sweeping
Colorado in the 2018 NLOS.

My, Oh, Myers!
Tobias Myers tonight will become the second rookie pitcher in franchise history to start a postseason game, joining Brandon Woodruff, who recorded no decision in Game 1 of the 2018 NLOS vs. Colorado as Milwaukee won, 3-2, in 10 innings.

<u>I Got You, Babe!</u> Jackson Chourio belted game-tying home runs in both the first and eighth innings last night and joined the Yankees' **Babe Ruth** (yes, that's what we said) as the only players in MLB history to hit two game-tying homers in the same postseason game....Ruth accomplished the feat in Game 4 of the 1928 World Series at St. Louis.

Jackson Chourio (20.205) last
night became the second-youngest
player in MLB history to hit 2 HR in a
postseason game.....only the Braves'
Andruw Jones (19.180) was younger
when he hit a pair in Game 1 of the

IN THE STANDINGS [187 days]: The Brewers spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings this season: FIRST: 173, SECOND: 13. THIRD: 1, FOURTH: 0, FIFTH: 0....the team finished in first place, ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs by 10.0 games. Reds by 16.0 games and Pirates by 17.0 games.....the team was in first place every day from April 30 through the end of the season and clinched a postseason berth and the NL Central championship on Sept. 18.

AT HOME: The Brewers went 47-34 at home this season (5th in MLB), going 15-9-2 in series play.....the team had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks, coming from 5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers went 46-35 on the road this season (T4th in MLB), going 15-9-2 in series play.....went 21-10 in their last 31 road games.....the team had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks, coming from 4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullben coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers, 26, went 9-6 with a 3.00 ERA in 27 games/25 starts this season....the team went 13-12 in his starts.....he made 7 quality starts..... opponents batted .242 (126-for-520, 18hr).....he had a 2.43 ERA in his last 20 games/19 starts (111.1ip, 30er).....he had four stints with the team (4/17, 4/22-5/9, 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-end).....Myers made his Major League debut in a start on 4/23 at Pittsburgh.....he went 1-1 with a 1.45 ERA in 5 games/3 starts at Triple-A Nashville (18.2ip, 13h, 3r, 3er, 7bb, 24k, 2hr).....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: In his first season in the organization, Myers went 10-5 with a 4.93 ERA in 29 games/26 starts between Double-A Biloxi [27g, 26gs] and Triple-A Nashville [29].....he led all Brewers Minor League pitchers in wins (10), strikeouts (175) and innings pitched (140.2).....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2) and tied for second in wins (10).....also surrendered a league-leading 30 HR.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Has gone 43-37 with a 4.24 ERA in 141 games/123 starts (620.1ip, 601h, 331r, 292er, 213bb, 636k, 83hr).....has pitched for six organizations: Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022), Chicago-AL (2022) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....did not play in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....Myers committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-1 with a 2.86 ERA in 13 games/12 starts (69.1ip, 22er).....ON THE ROAD: Is 5-5 with a 3.15 ERA in 14 games/13 starts (68.2ip, 24er).
