TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Steve Grande's Astros** and the second game (0-1) of a 7-day/6-game homestand that includes an off day on Mon and a 3-game series vs the **Nationals** from Tue through Thu.

- Following Thu's game vs **Wsh**, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **Cle** (5/15-5/17) and **Phi** (5/18-5/20).
- Cin is coming off a 0-7 road trip at **Pit** (0-3) and **Chc** (0-4).

FELL ON BLACK DAYS: The Reds are in the midst of an 8-game losing streak, their longest skid since losing 8 in-a-row from 4/30-5/9, 2024.

- Haven't lost 9 straight games since 4/26-5/5, 2022.
- During this current losing streak Cin batters are slashing .211/.276/.360 and averaging 2.88 runs per game...their 79 strikeouts are the most in the majors during this time.
- During this current losing streak, Cin pitchers are allowing a .293/.404/.524 line and are pitching to a 7.64 ERA, all Major League highs.

KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON: The Reds remain a game above .500 (20-19) despite their current 8-game losing streak.

- Since 2000, there have been 25 losing streaks of 8 or more games suffered by teams who would go on to appear in the Postseason that very same year...the most recent examples being the 2025 **Tigers** (8g) and the 2025 **Guardians** (10g).
- 3 Postseason teams in 2023 suffered skids of 8 or more straight losses during the regular season, including the World Champion **Rangers** (8g).
- The 2017 National League pennant-winning **Dodgers** endured an 11-game slide in September and still finished with 104 wins.
- The 2006 World Champion **Cardinals** languished through 2 separate losing skids of 8 or more games (8g 7/27-8/4; 8g 6/20-6/27).

TRIUMPHANT RETURN: In his first Major League appearance in 759 days (since 4/7/24 vs **NYM**), **RHP Tejay Antone** worked a perfect 8th inning with 2 strikeouts in the Reds' 7-6, 10-inning loss on Wed at **Chc**.

- Antone**, who was selected from **AAA-Louisville** earlier in the day, has undergone "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow 3 times during the course of his career (April 2017, August 2021, April 2024).
- Antone** was in line to earn his third career win on Wed after the Reds plated 4 runs in the top of the 9th inning.

BLANKETY BLANK: Reds batters have been shut out 4 times this season, including last night's 10-0 loss vs **Hou**...only **SF** (7g) and **NYM** (5g) have been blanked more.

- Last night's loss also marked the seventh time this season the Reds have been held to 1 run or none, and the 16th time they've been held to fewer than 3 runs in a game.
- Last night also marked the third time this season Cin lost by 10 or more runs...all 3 of those instances occurred since 4/29.

PITCHER IS A CATCHER: During last night's 10-0 loss vs **Hou**, **C Jose Trevino** made his fourth pitching appearance of the season.

- All 4 of his pitching appearances have come since 4/29.
- Beginning 4/29, he has as many or more pitching apps (4) than anyone else on the Cin staff (**Moll** 4g, **Santillan** 4g, **Franco** 4g, **Phillips** 4g)...his 5.0 innings pitched rank T2nd among all Reds relievers during this stretch (**Franco** 7.0ip, **Mey** 5.0ip).
- His 6 career pitching apps with the Reds are second-most by any Cin position player since 1900, behind only **C Luke Maile** (7g).

ELLYTRICITY: **SS Elly De La Cruz** this season leads all Major League shortstops in homers (10), runs (27), XBH (18), and total bases (80).

- Half of his 10 HR have come off left-handed pitching (45 PA)...hit 5 HR off lefties last year (210 PA)
- Is 3 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 118 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).
- Is also 3 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career.
- Is on pace for 41HR and 33 SB...would become the fourth Red in franchise history to join the "30-30 club"...(**Brandon Phillips** in 2007, **Barry Larkin** in 1996, **Eric Davis** in 1987).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds are meeting the **Astros** for the only time in 2026.

- Hou** took 2 of 3 vs Cin last year at **Daikin Park** (5/9-5/11).
- Cin has won 10 of the last 13g vs **Hou**, 55 of the last 80 games, and 20 of the last 26 series.
- The Reds swept the **Astros** in 3 of their last 4 series, in 4 of their last 6 series, and in 5 of their last 9 series (not including this one).
- In the 3-0 win on 5/9/25, the **Astros** snapped their 9-game losing streak vs Cin dating back to 6/17/19.
- The Reds' 9-game winning streak vs the **Astros** from 6/17/19-9/5/24 was their longest against **Hou** since winning 9 in-a-row 4/29-9/26, 2009...in 1995, Cin beat Hou in 11 straight games from 5/22-9/4.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 37 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's the longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds avoided being swept at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided being swept in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Reds have grounded into just 18 double plays this season, tied with the **Mariners** for fewest in the majors...hit into 106 double plays last year, 12th-most among all Major League clubs.

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 257 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest streak of consecutive games played by a Red since 1970.

- The **Reds'** bullpen led MLB with a 2.23 ERA on 4/20...in 16 games since 4/21, they have pitched to a 8.04 ERA (62.2ip, 59r/56er), the worst mark in the majors during that time.
- In the 2nd inning on 5/2 at **Pit**, Reds pitchers tied an MLB record by issuing 7 consecutive walks, matching the mark set by the **Pirates** (5/25/83 vs **Atl**) and **Washington Nationals** (8/28/1909g1 vs **CWS**).
- On 5/2 vs **Pit** became the first team to allow 5 or more runs in an inning without surrendering a hit since the **Mariners** did so on 4/27/94 vs **NY**.
- This season, the **Reds** lead all Major League teams with 147 combined relief apps (**Tor** ranks second with 141)...last year, they ranked T6th in MLB with 550 combined relief outings.
