TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and St. Louis Cardinals today continue a three-game series to round out their season slate...The Cardinals took two-of-three games at Truist Park from June 30-July 1...The Braves need to win the final two games of this series to avoid losing the season set.

 The Braves fell to the Cardinals last night, 2-1, after a rain delay lasted 2 hours and 44 minutes...Each club's starting pitcher completed 3.0 innings before play was halted.

 Atlanta has lost the season set to St. Louis just once since 2018...They went 2-4 against the club in 2024...Since 2018, the Braves have played to a 29-18 (.617) record against the Cardinals – the best record of any National League club...Seattle (.733), Toronto (.692) and Detroit (.667) are the only clubs that have played to a better mark.

 The team is 15-6 (.714) at Busch Stadium since 2018, also the best record of any NL club in that span...MLB-wide, Seattle is the only team with a better record (5-1, .833).

 LH Matthew Liberatore has made four starts and five previous outings against Atlanta, combining to go 2-1 with a 3.26 ERA (7 ER/19.1 IP)...He faced the Braves earlier this season at Truist Park, earning the win on June 30 after 5.0 innings, one earned run, one hit and nine strikeouts...Jorge Mateo logged the only knock off of him...Excluding his start against the Braves, the 6-foot-4, 215-pound native of Peoria, AZ, has pitched to a 9.15 ERA (21 ER/20.2 IP) in his last five starts.

REYNALDO LÓPEZ: Is set to make his fourth start since rejoining Atlanta's rotation on June 26...Since doing so, the right-hander from San Pedro de Macoris has pitched to a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP)...The Braves are 2-1 in those turns.

 In his last 12 appearances overall, López is 2-0 with a 2.54 ERA (8 ER/28.1 IP) and has allowed one earned run-or-fewer in 11 of the 12...He has allowed just one home run in that span.

 The 6-foot-1, 225-pounder has faced the Cardinals three times previously and is 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) against the team...He dueled them at Truist Park on July 1 and earned the win after he pitched 5.0 innings, allowed one earned run and struck out six.

BEFORE THE BREAK: Matt Olson has collected 25 home runs and 24 doubles to this point, becoming the only Brave in franchise history to reach those totals before the All-Star break.

 Olson needs one more extra-base hit to become the first Brave to amass 50 of them before the All-Star break in multiple seasons...He had 51 extra-base hits base hits in 2022.

 In total, six Braves have hit 50 extra-base hits prior to the All-Star break: Henry Aaron (53, 1959), Darrell Evans (51, 1973), Ozzie Albies (52, 2018), Freddie Freeman (50, 2019), Austin Riley (50, 2022) and Olson (51, 2022).

MLB DRAFT: The 2026 MLB First-Year Player Draft commenced this afternoon, with the Braves holding a pair of first-round selections...The club took OF AJ Gracia with the ninth overall pick, and chose OF Carter Beck with the 26th overall...The Braves had five total selections on the first day of the draft: No. 9, No. 26, No. 48, No. 84 and No. 112.

 Gracia attended the University of Virginia and slashed .354/.489/.632 (75-for-212) with 15 doubles, 14 home runs, 48 RBI and 47 walks with just 38 strikeouts during his junior campaign in 2026...He finished his collegiate career with more walks (152) than strikeouts (129) and posted a 1.000 OPS-or-higher in each of his three seasons.

 Carter Beck attended Indiana State University and slashed .346/.446/.637 (82-for-237) during his junior season, amassing 17 doubles, 16 home runs and 59 RBI...He drew 36 walks against just 33 strikeouts...He reached base in 39 consecutive games from March 13-May 16 and recorded a team-high 28 multi-hit games. For his efforts, the left-handed hitter was honored as the Joe Carter Baseball Player of the Year, which recognizes the best player in the Missouri Valley Conference.

RILEY IN ST. LOUIS: Austin Riley went 1-for-2 with a walk last night while driving in the club's only run... This weekend he returns to Busch Stadium, the ballpark wherein he's posted his highest batting average (.344)... Across 17 career games in these confines, he's slashing .344/.408/.578 (22-for-64) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and a .987 OPS.

 Riley has hit in 15 of the 17 games he's played in Busch Stadium, including in each of the last 10... He has collected at least four hits in four of the six previous series he's played here.

 Riley's 10-game hitting streak at Busch Stadium is the second-longest active in the majors...Juan Soto is riding a 12-game hitting streak in St. Louis.

 On April 3, 2023, Riley belted the longest home run of his career here – a 473-foot shot into the left-center bleachers...Since that date, the home run is tied for the second longest by a Brave...Travis d'Arnuad hit a 474-foot homer on June 16, 2023 at Colorado, and Drake Baldwin matched Riley's distance this season on June 16.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Matthew Liberatore this evening...The team enters play 23-15 (.605) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins in such games in the majors this year.

 Dating even further to 2019, no team in Major League Baseball has been better against lefties... The Braves have gone 189-114 (.624) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .622 (212-129).

 Despite the club's overall success when facing left-handed pitchers, Atlanta has lost five of its last six games when doing so...Since May 24, the Braves are 7-11 when facing a lefty.

Today's Game

Ⓐ Makes his ninth start of the season and 132nd of his career in the middle game of a three-game series at St. Louis...The 6-foot-1, 225-pound right-hander from San Pedro de Macorís, Dominican Republic, is in his third season with Atlanta and eighth full major league season.

Will make his third career start (fourth appearance) against St. Louis...Owns a 2-0 record with a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP), 13 strikeouts and six walks against the Cardinals.

Beat St. Louis in his most recent look at the club July 1 at Truist Park, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts and one walk on a pitch limit in a 5-1 win.

Received a no-decision in his last outing July 6 against New York (NL), allowing one run on three hits over 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and two walks in a 7-6, 10-inning loss...Atlanta led 3-2 when he exited...The solo home run he surrendered to Bengie was his first long ball allowed since May 14, a span of 11 appearances and 23.1 innings.

A López's fastball has averaged 94.6 mph across his three starts since rejoining the rotation June 26, up from 93.8 mph over his final three starts before moving to the bullpen in late April.

A Has allowed three earned runs over his last seven appearances (20.1 IP), dating to June 7.

Right-handed batters are hitting .242 (24-for-99) with four homers off López this season, while left-handers are batting .212 (24-for-113) with three homers.

Owns a 2.15 ERA (28 ER/117.0 IP) at Truist Park since joining Atlanta prior to the 2024 season, a span of 27 appearances and 18 starts...That figure is the third-lowest home ERA in the majors among pitchers with at least 15 home starts over that stretch, trailing only Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (1.76) and San Francisco's Tyler Mahle (2.15).

Since joining Atlanta in 2024, López has posted a 2.42 ERA (53 ER/197.1 IP) over 48 appearances, 34 of them starts...That mark is the fifth-lowest among qualified major-league starters over that span, trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.36), New York (AL)'s Cam Schlitler (2.38), teammate Chris Sale (2.40) and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (2.42).

2026

Received a no-decision July 6 against New York (NL), allowing one run on three hits over 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and two walks on 80 pitches in a 7-6, 10-inning loss at Truist Park...Atlanta led 3-2 when he exited...Benge's second-inning home run was his first long ball allowed since May 14, spanning 11 appearances and 23.1 innings.

A Earned the win July 1 against St. Louis, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts and one walk on 69 pitches (44 strikes) in Atlanta's 5-1 victory... Surrendered two hits and a run in the first inning, then tossed 4.0 hitless innings the rest of the way while working on a pitch limit...It was his first win in a starting role since April 2 at Arizona and his first as a starter at Truist Park since July 7, 2024, versus Philadelphia.

 Tossed 3.0 innings June 26 at San Francisco, allowing one run on four hits with one strikeout on 57 pitches in Atlanta's 3-1 win...Worked on a pitch limit in his first start since April 21.

♠ Made 13 relief appearances between rotation turns from April 29 to June 21, going 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (8 ER/22.0 IP) while striking out 19 against 10 walks...Eight of the 13 outings were scoreless.

Worked 4.2 innings at Los Angeles (AL) on April 7, allowing two unearned runs on three hits with seven strikeouts and two walks on 80 pitches before being ejected following an altercation with the Angels' Jorge Soler...Served a five-game suspension following the incident...Atlanta won, 7-2.

Career Recap

Awards: NL All-Star (2024).

Has pitched for five organizations - Washington, Chicago (AL), Cleveland, Los Angeles (AL) and Atlanta - beginning his career in the rotation before transitioning to the bullpen in 2021...Signed by the Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

A In his first season with Atlanta in 2024, earned his first career All-Star selection, going 8-5 with a 1.99 ERA (30 ER/135.2 IP) over 26 games (25 starts)...His 1.99 ERA was the lowest in the majors among pitchers with at least 25 starts.

His 2.00 ERA as a starter was the lowest by a pitcher in his first stint with the franchise in the Live Ball era (min. 25 starts) and the fourth-lowest in baseball since 1920 for a pitcher with 25-or-more starts to open a stint with a new team after debuting elsewhere, trailing only Hall-of-Famer Gaylord Perry (Cleveland, 1972), Roger Clemens (Toronto, 1997) and Kevin Brown (Florida, 1996).

His 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP) through 13 starts was the lowest by a Brave over that span since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine (1.57) in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are the only Atlanta-era (since 1966) starters with lower ERAs through 13 starts.

A Made just one start in 2025, April 1 at San Diego, before undergoing arthroscopic right shoulder surgery on April 8 that ended his season.

▲ Made his major league debut July 19, 2016 with Washington, then was traded to the White Sox that December in the four-player Adam Eaton deal (alongside Lucas Giolito and Dane Dunning)...Split 2023 among Chicago (AL), Los Angeles (AL) and Cleveland - dealt to the Angels on July 26 and claimed off waivers by the Guardians on August 31 - before signing with Atlanta that November.
