Bullpen

The combination of Didier Fuentes, James Karinchak and Dylan Dodd covered 3.1 scoreless frames for Atlanta last night.

The Braves bullpen has covered at least 3.0 scoreless innings in 26 games this season, tied for the most such efforts in Major League Baseball. The Los Angeles Dodgers' bullpen has also done so.

Atlanta maintains the best relief ERA in MLB (2.84). These San Diego Padres rank second with a 3.07 mark.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Padres today continue a three-game midweek series with the second of seven scheduled games between the clubs this season...The Braves will host the Padres at Truist Park for a four-game set from July 20-23.

A Despite out-hitting San Diego last night, 7-4, the Braves were shut out in a 1-0 loss...Atlanta went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position and couldn't surmount Manny Machado's solo home run.

A The Braves went 1-6 against the Padres in 2025... Their only win, 7-1, occurred at Truist Park on May 24...San Diego outscored Atlanta 25-18 during the season.

A Prior to last year's season-opening sweep here, Atlanta hadn't lost a regular-season series to the Padres at Petco Park since 2018...Since 2019, the Braves are 4-1-1 in sets here.

A The Braves played the 2024 National League Wild Card Series in San Diego and were swept in two games...Atlanta has lost each of its last seven games within these walls, including playoffs...Regardless of venue, the Braves are 4-14 in their last 18 games against the Padres.

A LH Wandy Peralta is slated to make his 16th career appearance against Atlanta...All-time, Peralta is 2-1 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER/13.2 IP) against the Braves in outings for the Cincinnati Reds, New York Yankees and San Diego Padres...Across nine games (two starts) since June 3, Peralta is 1-0 with 0.00 ERA (0 ER/11.1 IP)...He has five strikeouts and five walks in that time.

A RH JR Ritchie is set to make his seventh start and eighth appearance as a major-leaguer...The 6-foot-2, 185-pound native of Seattle, WA, has never faced the Padres and enters play with a 1-2 record and a 4.54 ERA (18 ER/35.2 IP)...Ritchie, Atlanta's No. 2 prospect according to *MLB.com*, last started on July 17 against San Francisco and allowed five runs across 5.0 innings.

LOSS: The Braves dropped last night's game to the Padres, 1-0, and were shut out for the sixth time this season...Six offensive shutouts are tied for the seventh most in Major League Baseball.

A The Braves are just 1-4 in their last five games when out-hitting their opponent, dating to June 9 at Chicago-AL...Before that date, the Braves were 37-3 when collecting more hits than their adversary...More than half of Atlanta's losses in such scenarios have come in the team's last 11 games overall.

A The Braves are 3-8 in their last 11 games...It's their worst downturn since also losing eight-of-eleven from September 1-13, 2025.

A Through their first 66 games on June 7, the Braves averaged 5.21 runs per game and allowed only 3.45 runs per contest...In the 11 games since then, the club has scored just 3.00 runs per game and allowed 4.36.

SCORING POSITION: Dating to Saturday's game versus Milwaukee, the Braves are 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position...In that span, the New York Mets are the only other MLB team without a RISP hit.

A Prior to this spell, Atlanta hadn't been held hitless with RISP over a three-game span since March 29-April 1, 2025...Those were games against these San Diego Padres and the Los Angeles Dodgers as part of last year's 0-7 start to the season.

A The Braves' last hit with a runner on second or third was Mauricio Dubón's bases-loaded, go-ahead single off Jacob Misiorowski on Friday night.

A Atlanta has batted below its season average (.275) with RISP in each of its last eight games, and in 11 of its last 12 games overall.

A The team's .275 batting average with runners in scoring position is still the third-best in Major League Baseball behind the Minnesota Twins (.286) and Milwaukee Brewers (.278).

FACING VELOCITY: Braves batters last night saw 10 pitches that exceeded 100 mph in velocity, seven from right-hander Mason Miller and three from southpaw Adrián Morejón.

A Atlanta has seen 123 pitches over 100 mph this season, already its fourth-highest total in the pitch tracking era (since 2008)...The team saw more pitches of that velocity in 2022 (173), 2025 (133) and 2024 (129).

A Only three teams in MLB have seen more 100+ mph pitches than the Braves: the Colorado Rockies (162), San Diego Padres (143) and Philadelphia Phillies (127)...Nine teams have seen at least 75 100+ mph offerings, and Atlanta's .219 batting average against them is second-best in baseball...The Arizona Diamondbacks (.304) are the only team that has been better.

A The Braves have thrown 15 pitches 100+ mph, 14 from Robert Suarez and one from Didier Fuentes...The Milwaukee Brewers lead MLB with 544 such pitches.

AUSTIN RILEY: Tied his season high with three hits in Atlanta's loss last night...Atlanta's third baseman has two three-hit games in his last five contests, and is hitting .421 (8-for-19) in that span...Riley has raised his batting average from .204 to .219 since June 17.

A All of his hits in that time have been singles...It's just the second time in his career that he's collected eight hits in a five-game span without an extra-base knock...He also did so from April 29-May 4, 2021.

A Overall this season, the right-handed hitter is batting .457 (21-for-47) with the count in his favor, but just .124 (19-for-153) in pitchers' counts.

A Riley is in the midst of a 27-game home run drought, the longest of his major-league career, surpassing his 23-game spell that lasted from May 4-June 13, 2024...He hit his last homer on May 20 at Miami off Jansen Junk.

Today's Game

- Makes the seventh start of his career in the second game of a three-game series at San Diego.
 - Is set to face the Padres for the first time in his career...The 6-foot-2, 185-pound Bainbridge Island, Washington native has previously appeared against Washington, Detroit, Seattle, Chicago (NL), Miami and San Francisco.
- Has gone 1-2 with a 4.54 ERA (18 ER/35.2 IP) and 30 strikeouts over seven Major League appearances this season.
- Has held right-handed hitters to a .159 average (7-for-44) this season.
- Has dropped each of his last two starts, taking the loss May 18 at Miami and June 17 against San Francisco.
- Has used his sinker 30.1 percent of the time over his last two outings since being recalled June 10, after throwing it 11.4 percent of the time across his first five appearances from April 23-May 18.
- Became the seventh starter in Atlanta-franchise history (since 1966) to allow five hits or fewer in each of his first four career outings (minimum 20.0 innings), and the first since Hurston Waldrep across 2024-25.
 - Became the first pitcher in Atlanta history (since 1901) to complete at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than two runs and striking out at least seven in his Major League debut.
 - Was the first Atlanta pitcher to start his career with at least 12.0 innings pitched over his first two outings since Darius Vines (12.0 IP, 2023).
- Became the 12th Washington-state native to appear for the franchise, and the first since Dana Eveland on April 7, 2015.
- Is rated by MLB.com as the Braves' No. 2 prospect and the No. 58 prospect overall in baseball.
- Worked with a six-pitch mix this season with Triple-A Gwinnett, leading with a four-seam fastball (27 percent usage, 93.7 mph average) and complementing it with a changeup (21), curveball (18), sinker (14), sweeper (12) and cutter (8).

2026

- Took the loss June 17 against San Francisco in the nightcap of a doubleheader, charged with five earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings with three walks and four strikeouts on 90 pitches in Atlanta's 7-5 defeat at Truist Park...A leadoff solo home run by Adames, a two-run drive by Arraez and a solo shot by Eldridge all came in a four-run second inning...The three long balls set a career high, surpassing his previous mark of two...Held San Francisco hitless from the third inning on after the Giants went 5-for-10 over the first two frames.
- Worked 5.0 scoreless innings in his first Major League relief appearance June 12 at New York (NL), allowing two hits with two walks and five strikeouts on 73 pitches in Atlanta's 7-5 loss at Citi Field.
- Became the only pitcher in the Atlanta era (since 1966) to throw at least 5.0 scoreless innings while allowing two hits or fewer in his first career relief appearance within his first six career games.
- Took the loss in his fifth career start May 18 at Miami, charged with six runs (five earned) over 4.0 innings on five hits and one walk with four strikeouts on 83 pitches in Atlanta's 12-0 defeat at loanDepot park...Marked his first career loss after opening 1-0.
- Earned the victory in his Major League debut April 23 against Washington, working 7.0 innings of two-run ball with two walks and seven strikeouts on 89 pitches in the 7-2 win at Truist Park...The two runs came on solo home runs by James Wood leading off the first and CJ Abrams with one out in the fourth.

- Won the 2025 Phil Niekro Award as the Braves' Minor League Pitcher of the Year, going a combined 8-6 with a 2.64 ERA (41 ER/140.0 IP), 1.01 WHIP, .175 opponent batting average and 10 quality starts in 26 outings across High-A Rome, Double-A Columbus and Triple-A Gwinnett.
 - Led all Atlanta full-season farmhands in ERA, opponent average and WHIP, and tied for the organizational lead in starts...Also ranked second in strikeouts (140) and innings (140.0), and third in wins.
- Started for the National League in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game on July 12 at Truist Park, tossing a scoreless inning with one walk and two strikeouts.
- Promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett for the first time in 2025 and earned the club's "Most Outstanding Pitcher" Award, going 3-2 with a 3.02 ERA, 1.09 WHIP and .181 opponent average over 11 starts.
- Has compiled a 14-14 record with a 2.81 ERA (80 ER/256.2 IP), 1.06 WHIP and 271 strikeouts in 55 minor league games (54 starts) over parts of five seasons.
- Missed the majority of the 2023 campaign on the injured list.
