RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their 5-game (2-OAK, 3-LAD) west coast trip tonight when they open up a three-games series at Dodger Stadium... the Cardinals went 0-2 at Oakland this past weekend and have lost three of their last five games...the Cardinals entered play today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 1.5-games back of the Chicago Cubs and 2.5 games in front of 3rd place Milwaukee...The Cardinals, who went 16-9 in July, are tied with the Dodgers for the 3rd best winning pct. (.636; 14-8) in the National League since the All-Star break, trailing the New York Mets (15-6, .714) and San Francisco Giants (15-8, .652).

WINNING WAYS VS. LA: The Cardinals swept a four-game series from the Dodgers April 8-11 at Busch Stadium, doing so for the first time since July 15-18, 2010 also at Busch Stadium...in addition, the Cardinals recorded a three-game series sweep in their last visit to Dodger Stadium, August 20-22 of last season... the Cardinals have won five straight games against Dodgers dating to 2018 and have won 10 of their last 13 meetings, taking a 1,030-1,029 lead over the Dodgers in their all-time series since St. Louis joined the National League in 1892...with a win tonight, the Cardinals would have 4-straight wins at Dodger Stadium for the first time since a 6-game win streak at Chavez Ravine from 2005-06.

SHORTSTOP SLUGGER: Paul DeJong belted his 19th home run yesterday, and with his next round-tripper, would become the first ever Cardinals shortstop to produce multiple 20-homer season (25, in 2017)...the only other Cardinals shortstops with 20 or more homers was **Jhonny Peralta** with 21 in 2014.

REDBIRD ROSTER RESET: The Cardinals yesterday activated infielder **Matt Carpenter** from the 10-day Injured List (right foot contusion) and on Saturday activated outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** from the Injured List (finger fractures, right hand)...catcher **Yadier Molina**, out since July 8 due to a right thumb tendon strain, is currently on an injury rehabilitation assignment with Memphis.

PUTTING THE BARK IN DOG DAYS: Since 2000, the Cardinals have sported a winning August record in 16 of 19 seasons (excluding 2006, '08, & '10), with a combined .587 win pct. (316-222) that is highest in Major League Baseball over that time span. Last season, St. Louis (.786, 22-6) led MLB in August victories and winning percentage, marking the team's first 22-win August since 1946 (22-9; .710).

MANAGER MILESTONE: Skipper **Mike Shildt** piloted the Cardinals to his 99th career win last Thursday and he's 99-80 (.553) overall since taking the helm of the Redbirds last July...he's 23-8 in August games.

THOMAS' PINCH POWER: Rookie outfielder **Lane Thomas** cracked his 2nd career homer on Sat. night with a pinch-hit blast in the 9th inning...both of his homers have come as a pinch-hitter (also April 19, 2019 vs. NY Mets)...Thomas is the 7th Cardinals rookie to hit multiple pinch homers in a single season, joining **Jeremy Hazelbaker** (4 in 2016), **Matt Adams** (3, 2013), **José Martínez** (2, 2017), **Joe Mather** (2, 2008), **Chris Duncan** (2, 2006) and **Keith McDonald** (2, 2000).

LOS ANGELES CONNECTIONS

Jack Flaherty was born in Burbank Calif...graduated from Harvard-Westlake High School, where he went 23-0 with an 0.63 ERA over his final two seasons and 35-3 overall throughout his high school career...led Harvard-Westlake to the 2013 state title, pitching a complete-game shutout and driving in the lone run in a 1-0 win in the CIF Championship at Dodger Stadium...resides in Sherman Oaks.

Michael Wacha and **Ross Stripling** pitched together for three seasons (2010-12) and were roommates at Texas A&M University...led the Aggies to the 2011 College World Series...both were selected in the 2012 MLB draft.

Paul Goldschmidt was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 49th round of the 2006 MLB Draft but did not sign...was a teammates of outfielder **A.J. Pollock** in Arizona for parts of seven seasons (2012-18).

Marcell Ozuna's cousin, **Pablo Ozuna**, played in 36 games for the Dodgers in 2008.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** pitched parts of the 1990 (11 games) and 1999 (49 games) seasons with the Dodgers...his younger brother, Hall of Famer **Greg Maddux**, pitched parts of the 2006 and 2008 seasons with the Dodgers.

Third base coach **Ron "Pop" Warner** was born in Alhambra, Calif...graduated from Redlands High School.

Hall of Famer **Lou Brock** served as a baserunning consultant for the Dodgers in 1988.

Assistant hitting coach **Mark Budaska** graduated from Granada Hills High School...played college baseball at Los Angeles Pierce College in nearby Woodland Hills...appeared in the 1991 feature film "Talent for the Game" as a first base coach for the California Angels.

David Freese played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6...recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to the 2012 NL All-Star Game...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood.

Joc Pederson's older brother, **Tyger**, is the current hitting coach for the Palm Beach Cardinals (High-A) in the Florida State League.

Joe Kelly pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14), including 11 games (four starts) in the Postseason...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2009 MLB draft...later traded by the Cardinals with infielder/outfielder **Allen Craig** to Boston for pitchers **Corey Littrell** and **John Lackey** and cash.

Hall of Famer **Bob Gibson's** son, **Chris Gibson**, played in five games for Inland Empire (High-A) in the Dodgers minor league system in 2009.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** worked for the Dodgers for nine years (1998-2006) as Director of Scouting Operations, Director of Baseball Operations and Director of Professional Scouting.

Cardinals Asst. GM/Scouting Director **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched four years at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Cardinals Director of Player Development **Gary LaRocque** worked 19 years with the Dodgers as a minor league coach (1979-80), manager (1981-88), area scout (1989-91) and regional scouting supervisor (1992-97).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** managed both the Cardinals (1990-95) and Dodgers (2008-10)

Dodgers pitching coach **Rick Honeycutt** pitched parts of two years in St. Louis (1996-97).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 35 games over parts of two seasons (1988-89) for the Dodgers between stints with St. Louis...member of 1988 World Series champion Dodgers.

Dodgers broadcaster **Fernando Valenzuela** became the first Mexican to throw no-hitter in MLB history (June 29, 1990 vs. St. Louis)...made five starts for St. Louis in his final pro season (1997).

Cardinals broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** worked for parts of 10 seasons (2008-16) for Dodgers radio and their Spanish website.

FOX Sports Midwest reporter **Erica Weston** graduated from Loyola Marymount University...previously worked in production for Dodgers, Lakers, Galaxy and Sparks telecasts on Spectrum SportsNet and Spectrum SportsNet LA, including as a Dodgers host and reporter (2014-16)...was a member of the Los Angeles Laker Girls (2008-11).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 15th start (20th appearance) of the season, and the 142nd start of his career (156th appearance).
- Needs one win for 60 career wins. His .621 career winning percentage (59-36) ranks 6th all-time among Cardinals with 90 or more decisions.
- Is making his first start since 7/4 at SEA, appearing in relief each of his last three appearances (1-0, 1.93 ERA, 9.1 IP, 7 K).
- Is 5-4 with a 5.05 ERA in 14 starts and 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA in five relief appearances. However, he is 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA in his last four relief appearances following a six-run outing (1.0 IP) in his first relief appearance of the season at PHI (5/29).
- Last appearance at Dodger Stadium was 5/25/17 taking a 7-3 loss while allowing six runs over 4.0 innings.
- Has thrown 3.0 innings or more in each of his last two relief appearances with the most recent tossing 4.2 innings vs. HOU (7/27) holding the Astros to one run on six hits.
- Is 4-3, 4.92 ERA in nine road starts (12 app.) and 2-1, 5.51 ERA in five starts (7 app.) at Busch Stadium in 2019.
- Has returned to the starting rotation twice this season after being sent to the bullpen; first on June 10 at Miami after two appearances out of the bullpen and today after three relief appearances (7/19-27).
- Makes his 10th start since returning from the 10-day Injured List with left knee patellar tendinitis (4/29). Is 4-4 with a 5.57 ERA over 51.2 innings since returning from the IL.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitched a career-high innings for a relief outing with 4.2 vs. Houston on July 27, scattering six hits while allowing one run in a game the Cardinals lost 8-2. Did not walk a batter and struck out five. Lone run came surrendering a grand slam (4th career allowed) to Carlos Correa after entering the game with bases loaded in the 3rd inning.

- Went 2-2 with a 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP) and 17 strikeouts in five June games (four starts). Was the 13th-lowest ERA in the NL and the lowest June ERA in his career.
- Is averaging 6.62 run support average, which would lead St. Louis and rank 6th in the National League, but does not have the qualifying innings.
- Earned the win at CIN (7/19) tossing 1.2 scoreless innings as the Cardinals rallied from a 7-0 deficit with 10 runs in the 6th inning for a 12-11 win. It was his first relief win since 8/19/13 at MIL, and the Cardinals largest comeback win since 2002 (8 runs at CIN).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 innings at SD (6/28) allowing two runs in a 3-1 Cardinals loss at PETCO Park; his longest outing since tossing 8.0 scoreless innings vs. PIT on June 3, 2018 at Busch Stadium after carrying a no-hitter into the 9th inning.
- Allowed one run over 6.0 frames in the Cardinals 5-1 win vs. LAA (6/21). Was his longest home start of the season. Marked his first Interleague win at home since 6/16/15 vs. Minnesota. Earned his 31st career win at Busch Std III, moving past Kyle Lohse into sole possession of 5th place.

- Is a career 1-4, 6.75 ERA career in seven regular season starts vs. the Dodgers, but went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two starts (Games 2 & 6) of the 2013 NLCS vs. Los Angeles, earning NLCS MVP honors.
- Started the final game of a four-game series in St. Louis on 4/11 this season and received a no decision despite allowing a then season-high seven runs on eight hits over 3.2 innings before departing down 7-4 in a game the Cardinals rallied to win 11-7 to complete the sweep.
- Only regular season win vs. LAD came at Dodger Stadium on 6/4/15 tossing 7.0 innings and allowing one run with no walks and five strikeouts in a 7-1 triumph.

- Has drove in a run in two St. Louis losses this season. The Cardinals were 10-0 when he recorded an RBI in his career before this season.
- Both of his multi-hit games have come against the Cubs (7/8/15) at Wrigley Field.
