Road Game No. 49 **BIRDLAND BITES**: Baltimore opens a seven-game post-All-Star break road trip tonight through

Tampa Bay (3 to play) and Cleveland (4 to play)...The O's finished the first half with a six-game homestand, taking two of three from the Mets before dropping two of three to the Marlins.

Oha With Sunday's 11-1 defeat to Miami, Baltimore suffered its third home loss by 10+ runs this season, tied for second most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (4 G).
On Sunday, the Birds saw their franchise-record streak of 172 straight games with a walk come to an end...Since 1954, it was the seventh-longest streak by any club in the majors, including the longest since a 204-game stretch by the San Francisco Giants from 2002-03.

Despite losing each of their final two games headed into the All-Star break, the O's are 22-16 (.579) since June 1, the fifth-best record in baseball behind the Brewers (25-12, .676), and Astros, Blue Jays and Red Sox (all 25-13, .658). The Orioles have won or split five consecutive road series against the Rays, their longest such streak vs. Tampa Bay all time and their longest active streak vs. any single opponent, per *Stats Perform*.

UNCLE CHARLIE: In 11 appearances (8 GS) since May 10, Charlie Morton is 5-0 with a 2.61 ERA (15 ER/51.2 IP) and 60 strikeouts after going 0-7 with a 9.38 ERA (33 ER/31.2 IP) across his first nine appearances (6 GS) to open the 2025 campaign.

(b) His five-decision winning streak since May 26 is his longest since June 18-July 14, 2023 (also 5 G)...He last won six straight decisions in a single season from March 29-June 10, 2019 (8 G).

Since May 10, Morton has limited the opposition to a .180/.268/.240 (18-for-100) clip with a 34.8 percent strikeout rate against in curveball...In his first nine appearances (6 GS) of the year, opponents hit .357/.420/.667 (15-for-42) with an 18.0 percent strikeout rate on the offering.

THE BIRDS AND BRADLEY: The O's have faced right-hander Taj Bradley six times since he debuted in 2023 and have tagged him for 26 runs, slashing .309/.345/.618 (34-for-110) with seven doubles and nine home runs...In two meetings this season, the O's have slashed .424/.444/.697 (14-for-33) with three doubles and two homers against Bradley.

Ryan O'Hearn is 5-for-12 (.417) with two doubles and a homer off Bradley, while Gunnar Henderson is 7-for-17 (.412) with one double and a homer.

RUN AND GUNN: In 33 career games opposite Tampa Bay, Gunnar Henderson is slashing 341/.400/.629 (45-for-132) with five doubles, three triples, nine home runs, and 17 RBI...In seven games this season, he is 10-for-28 (.357) with one double, one triple, one home run, and four RBI.

(b) In 38 games overall since June 1, Henderson is batting .319 (43-for-135) with 14 extrabase hits (9 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR) after hitting .254 (51-for-201) with 20 extra-base hits (11 2B,

2 3B, 7 HR) across his first 50 games.

UNSUNG HERO: In 39 games since May 14, Ramón Laureano is slashing .326/.394/.532 (46-for-141) with 11 doubles, six home runs, 27 RBI, and 14 walks...His .326 batting average during that period ranks third in the AL (min. 140 AB) behind HOU's Jeremy Peña (.346 AVG) and TB's Brandon Lowe (.331 AVG), while his .926 OPS ranks ninth.

① Overall, Laureano owns a .959 OPS against right-handed pitching, the third-highest mark by any right-handed hitter in MLB (min. 150 PA) behind NYY's Aaron Judge (1.151 OPS) and CHC's Carson Kelly (.978 OPS).

② He has hit safely in all six games vs. Tampa Bay this season, going 9-for-20 (.450) with two doubles, two home runs, and nine RBI...He has plated 1+ run in each of his last five games opposite the Rays, the first Oriole to do so since Gunnar Henderson (5 G, 6/2-10/24)...The last Oriole to score 1+ run in six straight games against the Rays was Tim Beckham (6 G, 7/26-8/8/18). MOUNTAIN TIME: Félix Bautista has made 16 appearances since May 31, going 1-0 with an 0.56 ERA (1 ER/16.0 IP), an .059 (3-for-51) opponent average, a 0.69 WHIP, and a 45.8 percent strikeout rate (27 K/59 BF).

He has converted each of his last 11 save opportunities since May 26, the third-longest active run in the majors behind PIT's David Bednar (13 G) and CHC's Daniel Palencia (12 G).

MULLINS' MILESTONE WATCH: Cedric Mullins is one home run shy of 100 for his career...With his next long ball, he would become the third player in team history (since 1954) to hit 100+ home runs and steal 100+ bases (currently at 138 SB), joining Brady Anderson (209 HR, 307 SB) and Paul Blair (126 HR, 167 SB).

NO RISP, NO REWARD: In 26 games since June 15, the O's are batting .304 (63-for-207) with runners in scoring position, tied for the fifth-highest mark in MLB behind the Brewers (.321 AVG), Marlins (.320 AVG), Red Sox (.316 AVG), and Rays (.312 AVG)...Their .208 RISP average entering that stretch was the lowest in MLB, with the White Sox being the next closest (.215 AVG).

FIREMEN: Baltimore relievers own an MLB-best 18.8 percent inherited scored rate (26 IRS/138 IR), ahead of Los Angeles-NL (23.3%)...Keegan Akin (4.2%, 1 IRS/24 IR) and Seranthony Domínguez (5.0%, 1 IRS/20 IR) have the two best inherited runners scored percentage in the majors.

6 Both Akin's and Domínguez's marks would set the single season franchise record (since 1954), currently held by Mark Thurmond (10.5%, 1988)...Since 1974, only five relievers have finished a full season with an inherited scored rate below 5.0 percent during the year (excluding 2020, 1981, 1995, & 1994): SF's Josh Osich in 2016 (4.7%), HOU's Wilton Lopez in 2010 (3.0%), and AZ's Jorge De La Rosa in 2017 (3.0%).

QUICK HITS: Morton is making his 21st appearance (15 GS) of the season...Pitched in his 400th career game on June 19 at Tampa Bay...His 396 career starts are the fourth most among active players behind SF's Justin Verlander (541 GS), TOR's Max Scherzer (462 GS), and LAD's Clayton Kershaw (439 GS)...At 41 years, 142 days old in his home debut, became the oldest Orioles pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (since 1954), per @SlangsOnSports...Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's 2024 NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game...Has been part of World Series Championship teams with Atlanta (2021) and Houston (2017)...Closed out the Astros' title with 4.0 scoreless relief innings in Game 7 on November 1, 2017 at Los Angeles-NL.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 10 (G1) vs. New York-NL after allowing one run on four hits and three walks (1 IBB) with four strikeouts in 6.0 innings...The Mets scored their lone run after a leadoff walk and a double in the fifth inning...Left trailing 1-0, but the Orioles rallied for a 3-1 win...Threw season highs in pitches (104) and strikes (70).

Q3 Held the Mets to 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position...New York-NL had at least one runner in scoring position in four of six innings...Opponents are slashing .170/.221/.260 (17-for-100) with RISP this season.

RAY OF SUNSHINE: Morton is making his 10<sup>th</sup> career appearance, all starts, against Tampa Bay...He is 5-3 with a 2.78 ERA (17 ER/55.0 IP) opposite the Rays in his career... He's allowed two runs or fewer in seven of those nine starts, including one run in 6.0 innings in his last start on June 19, 2025 at George M. Steinbrenner Field..Morton has fanned 11 Rays two different times (6/25/14 at TB and 7/1/18 at TB).

AHEAD OF THE CURVE: Opponents are batting .232 (33-for-142) with a .366 slugging percentage with five doubles, one triple, and four home runs off Morton's curveball this season...Of his 88 strikeouts this season, 48 have come via the curveball (54.5%).

Above Morton used the curveball a season-high 50 times against the Mets in his last start on July 10, using the pitch 48.1 percent of his 104 total pitches thrown...New York-NL hitters were 1-for-12 (.083) off the pitch with the lone hit being a double...He threw the curveball 43 of his 97 pitches (44.3%) in his prior start on July 4 at Atlanta with the Braves going 1-for-12 (.083).

Morton has thrown curveballs on 43.3 percent of his pitches (314-of-725) in eight games, all starts, since May 26 after entering that game having used the pitch 35.1 percent of the time (272-of-776) in his first 12 appearances (6 GS) of the year.

LIKE FINE WINE: In his Orioles debut, at 41 years, 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing **Orlando Peña** (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973 (G1) at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a game in club history is **Jesse Orosco** (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.
