ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles fell to the Rays, 6-1, dropping to 16-25 and 11-11 at home...With two tonight, they have turned 51 double plays; entered tonight leading MLB in double plays turned...Recorded multiple triples in a game for the first time since September 10, 2021 against Toronto (Austin Hays and Kelvin Gutiérrez).
- **RHP Kyle Bradish** suffered the loss, allowing five runs on five hits (two home runs), walking two and striking out five across 5.1 innings...His five strikeouts brings him to 27, tied with Dean Kremer for the most strikeouts by an Orioles pitcher in their first five career games in team history (since 1954)...Threw a career-high 91 pitches, 57 strikes.
- **C Adley Rutschman** made his MLB debut as the starting catcher, batting sixth; finished the night 1-for-3 with a triple, walk, and a strikeout...Tripled in the seventh inning for his first career hit, becoming the ninth Oriole to triple as their first career hit and first since Ryan McKenna on April 11, 2021 against Boston; is the first Orioles catcher to do so since Matt Wieters on May 30, 2009 against Detroit.
- **1B Trey Mancini** (2-for-4, RBI, K) recorded his 14th multi-hit game; entered tonight ranked tied for eighth in MLB and tied for fourth in the AL in multi-hit games...Has reached base safely in a season-long 15 straight games; entered tonight with the fourth-longest active on base streak in the AL.
- **SS Jorge Mateo** helped turn two double plays in the third and seventh inning; entering today, Mateo led MLB in double play conversion rate (31-for-37, 84%), per *Sports Info Solutions.*

RAYS NOTES

- The Rays defeated the Orioles by a score of 6-1, improving to 24-16 and 11-7 on the road...Improved to 10-1 in their last 11 games at Oriole Park...Are now 19-4 when scoring first...Improved to 7-2 when hitting multiple home runs...Have scored at least six runs in four consecutive games, their longest such streak since a seven-game streak from August 6-13, 2021.
- **LHP Jeffrey Springs** earned the win after tossing 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit while walking four and striking out seven...His 5.2 innings pitched, seven strikeouts, and four walks all marked career-highs, with his one hit allowed tying a career-low in a start...Forced a career-high 16 swings and misses; his previous high was 12 (2x, last: 5/9/22 at LAA)...Threw 80 pitches, 50 strikes.
- LF Randy Arozarena (2-for-3, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 2 R, BB) recorded his fifth career multi-homer game and first since July 21, 2021 against Baltimore...Has hit safely in six of his last seven games...Slashing .413/.455/.826 (38-for-92) in 23 career games against the Orioles with 11 home runs, the most he has against any team, and 25 RBI.
- **CF Kevin Kiermaier** (3-for-4, HR, RBI, 2 R, K) has recorded three-straight three-hit games for the first time in his career...Is 9-for-14 (.643) in his last three games with two home runs, a double, four runs scored, and four RBI.
