- **Ketel Marte (2B)** seeks his third career and second straight All-Star bid after being voted as last season's 2024 NL starting second baseman (also started as 2B in 2019).
- **Corbin Carroll (OF)** and **Geraldo Perdomo (SS)** each aim to make their second-career All-Star roster since both being named in 2023.
- **Eugenio Suárez (3B)** looks to make his second All-Star roster (also: 2018 with Reds).

FRIDAY ON APPLE TV+ AND SATURDAY ON FOX: Friday's D-backs matchup vs. Padres will be exclusively featured on Apple TV+ with Alex Faust and Ryan Spilborghs on the call and Tricia Whitaker as field reporter...Saturday's game will be exclusively on FOX with Jason Benetti and Adam Wainwright in the booth...Sunday's finale broadcast will return to DBACKS.TV.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Kevin Ginkel** and RHP **Bryce Jarvis** from Triple-A Reno, selected RHP **Taylor Scott** from Reno, placed RHP **Justin Martinez** (sprained right ulnar collateral ligament) and RHP **Christian Montes De Oca** (right elbow inflammation) on the 15-day injured list, optioned RHP **Jeff Brigham** to Reno following last night's game and transferred **Cristian Mena** to the 60-day injured list (strained right shoulder).

GRAND LAST GAME: **Josh Naylor's** 11th-inning walkoff grand slam sealed the D-backs' 8-4 win and second walkoff victory.

- It was the third walkoff grand slam in franchise history (also: Damion Miller on May 9, 2000 vs. Dodgers and Ryan Roberts on Sept. 27, 2011 vs. Dodgers).
- It was the third walkoff grand slam in the Majors in 2025 (also: Christian Yelich/MIL on May 27 vs. Red Sox and Kyle Stowers/MIA on May 3 vs. Athletics).
- It was **Naylor's** second career walkoff hit (also: 2-run HR on June 29, 2022 vs. Twins in Bot 10).
- **Corbin Carroll** hit his first career first-pitch leadoff homer.
- **Merrill Kelly** went decisionless after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with 4 hits allowed and 7 strikeouts.

IN GRAND FASHION: The D-backs' 7 grand slams lead the Majors, ahead of the Yankees (5)...since 2024, their 18 combined grand slams are the most in the Majors, 6 more than the second-best Brewers (12).

- From 2018-23 (6 seasons), the D-backs combined to hit 15 grand slams.

CARROLL POWER: **Corbin Carroll** is the second D-back since 2001 (also: Paul Goldschmidt, 19 in 2015) and sixth all-time with 19+ homers within the team's first 66 games of a season...others: Luis Gonzalez/26 in 2001, Steve Finley/20 in 2000, Jay Bell/20 in 1999 and Matt Williams/19 in 1999.

LEADOFF HOMERS: Last night, **Corbin Carroll** hit his first *first-pitch* leadoff homer and career-high fifth leadoff homer...his 5 leadoff homers are tied for second in MLB with Zach Neto/LAA, behind Francisco Lindor/NYM (6) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6).

- Carroll became the 17th by a D-back all-time to hit a first-pitch leadoff homer (last: Ketel Marte on Aug. 5, 2024 @ Guardians)...it was the first @ Chase Field since Marte on April 17, 2024 vs. Cubs...**Ketel Marte** (4 times) and Jean Segura (3) are the only D-backs with multiple occurrences.

OPS LEADERS AHEAD IN THE COUNT: Since May 31 when ahead in the count, the D-backs' 1.865 OPS ranks atop the Majors, ahead of the Twins (1.577), Red Sox (1.349) and Brewers (1.310).

RECENT SLUG: Since May 31, the D-backs' 16 homers rank second in the NL, behind the Mets (22), while their .428 SLG is third, behind the Mets (.517) and Dodgers (.459).

10+ WALKS & 10+ HITS: Last night, the D-backs (10 BB, 10 H) became the fifth MLB team in 2025 to tally 10+ hits and 10+ walks in a game (also: Blue Jays on May 30 vs. Athletics, Athletics on May 22 vs. Angels, Reds on April 20 @ Orioles and Cubs on Match 31 @ Athletics).

NL ON-BASE LEADERS SINCE JUNE 1: Since June 1, **Ketel Marte's** 18 times reaching base safely rank second in the NL:
1. Juan Soto/NYM.....22 times
2. **Ketel Marte/AZ.....18 times**
2. Pete Alonso/NYM.....18 times

22 STRAIGHT FOR MARTE: **Ketel Marte's** season-best 22-game on-base streak, since May 13, is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Jose Ramirez/CLE (35 G), Vinnie Pasquantino/KC (24 G) and Ozzie Albies/ATL (24 G)...it is tied for the third longest in his career (also: Aug. 2-29, 2019), behind his 30-gamer (April 26-June 1, 2023) and 24-gamer (June 3-July 1, 2023).

- In the span, Marte is hitting .310 (26-for-84)/1.092 OPS with 2 doubles, 9 homers, 17 RBI, 15 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches.
- Since May 13, his 1.092 OPS is fourth in MLB, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (1.227), Cal Raleigh/SEA (1.153) and Jose Ramirez/CLE (1.1326), while his 9 homers are tied for fourth with Judge and Taylor Ward/LAA, behind Raleigh (13), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (11) and Isaac Paredes/HOU (10).

MARTE LOOKING LIKE AN ALL-STAR: **Ketel Marte** ranks among all active players during their careers in June (min. 300 PA) in AVG (4th, .328) and OPS (7th, .973).

- Marte has reached base safely in 15 consecutive June games, dating back to June 23, 2024, batting .377 (20-for-53)/1.274 OPS with 3 doubles, 6 homers, 16 RBI, 13 walks and 7 strikeouts.

FROM THE DEFENSE END: Over their 7 matchups vs. Mariners since 2023, the D-backs have not committed a fielding error (excl. catcher's interference on April 28, 2024).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (1-3, 6.70)

- Went decisionless in his first start back off the injured list on June 6 @ Reds (ND; 2 ER in 5.0 IP, 6 H, 0 BB, 3 K).
- Has 4 quality starts vs. Mariners in his last 6...won his last on July 14, 2023 with Detroit (2 ER in 5.0 IP, 7 K).

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs.

- On March 29, signed a 5-year contract extension through 2030 (beginning in 2026) with a club option for 2031 and mutual option for 2032.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: His 7 wins are tied with Sonny Gray/STL, Clay Holmes/NYM and Joe Ryan/MIN for fifth-most in the Majors, behind Hunter Brown/HOU (8), Max Fried/NYY (8), Robbie Ray/SF (8) and Carlos Rodón (8)...became the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165) and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season, behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013).

- In 2 starts vs. AL opponents in 2025 (both @ Chase Field), is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP)
- 14th start (seventh home)...the D-backs are 8-5 in his 13 starts.
- In his last 3 home starts vs. AL teams, is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER in 18.0 IP).
- In his last 3 home starts vs. AL West opponents, is 1-0 with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER in 17.2 IP) and 19 strikeouts.

LAST START: Posted a no decision on June 5 @ Braves (5 ER in 3.0 IP) in the D-backs historic comeback with 7 unanswered runs in the ninth inning en route to an 11-10 win @ Braves.

VS. MARINERS: Second career start, second @ Chase Field.

- In 2 career starts, is 0-0 with a 3.86 ERA (5 ER in 11.2 IP) and 14 strikeouts.
- The D-backs are 2-0 in his starts and both games have resulted in 1-run decisions.
- Made his lone start @ Chase Field on July 29, 2023 (3 ER in 5.2 IP).

AMONG BEST OF NL WEST: Since his debut in May 2023, ranks among NL West starting pitchers in innings (3rd, 337.0), starts (3rd, 63), wins (4th, 21) and strikeouts (5th, 326).

FEW FREE PASSES: His 17 walks are tied with Logan Webb/SF for eighth fewest among NL starting pitchers, behind Matthew Liberatore/STL (10), Kyle Freeland/COL (13), Jameson Taillon/CHC (14), Sonny Gray/STL (14), Nick Lodolo/CIN (14) Spencer Schwellenbach/ATL (14) and Nick Martinez/CIN (16).

- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 12 starts without a walk are tied with Nick Martinez/CIN for second in the NL, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (17).

SPRING CLEANING: Among righty NL starters (min. 100 pitches), his 23.4% in-zone whiff on sweepers ranks fourth.

CAREER-HIGH WIN STREAK IN APRIL: Had a career-high 5-game win streak from April 4-April 27.

2024 RECAP: Went 11-10 with a 4.71 ERA (103 R-95 ER in 181.2 IP), opponent .259 AVG (183-for-707), 42 walks and 185 strikeouts over 32 starts in his second season with the D-backs.

- Set career highs in wins (11), starts (32), innings (181.2) and strikeouts (185).
- Became the seventh D-back starting pitcher at age 25 or younger all-time to collect 10+ wins in a season and first since Robbie Ray in 2017 (15).
- Led the team in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts.
- Was 1 of 9 NL pitchers to record 19+ starts of 6.0+ innings.
- Among NL pitching leaders, finished fifth in K/BB ratio (4.405), tied for fifth in starts (32), sixth in BB/9.0 IP (2.081), tied for seventh in innings pitched (181.2), eighth in strikeouts (185) and eighth in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.165).
- Opened with 4.0 no-hit innings twice (April 22 @ Cardinals and May 15 vs. Reds), tied for the second longest of his career, behind his 6.1 innings on Aug. 18, 2023 @ Padres.
- His 5 straight quality starts from April 28-May 21 tied for third-longest by a D-back since 2021...in that stretch, went 1-2 with a 3.19 ERA (14 R-11 ER in 31.0 IP), .220 AVG (26-for-118) and 31 strikeouts.
- Tossed a career-high-tying 7.0 innings 6 times (April 17 vs. Cubs, May 15 vs. Reds, May 28 @ Rangers, July 21 @ Cubs, Aug. 12 vs. Rockies and Sept. 19 vs. Brewers).
- On Sept. 19 @ Brewers, set a career high with 12 strikeouts.

CAREER-BEST SCORELESS INNINGS STREAK: Recorded a career-best 16.2 scoreless-innings streak over 4 starts from July 6-July 27, 2024.

7 STRAIGHT K'S TO MATCH RJ & SCHILLING: On Sept. 19, 2024 @ Brewers, his 7 consecutive strikeouts (Contreras in Bot. 4 to Monasterio in Bot. 6) tied the franchise record from 2001 (Randy Johnson/3x, last on July 18, 2001, and Curt Schilling on July 21, 2001).

2023 RECAP: Went 3-9 with a 5.72 ERA (61 ER in 96.0 IP) in 18 starts.

- Entered the season rated as the D-backs' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline (No. 59 overall) and No. 5 by *Baseball America*.
- Made his Major League debut on May 3 @ Rangers (7 ER in 4.2 IP).
- Got his first Major League win on Aug. 25 vs. Reds (5.1 IP, 2 ER, 5 K).
- Had a trio of career-high 8-strikeout games on Aug. 13 vs. Padres and back-to-back on Sept. 22 @ Yankees and Sept. 27 @ White Sox.
- Had a 12.2-inning scoreless streak spanning 3 starts from Aug. 13 vs. Padres (2nd inning)-Aug. 25 vs. CIN (2nd inning).

2023 POSTSEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Appeared in 5 Postseason games, going 0-1 with a 3.27 ERA (8 ER in 22.0 IP) and 26 strikeouts.

- Second-youngest (24-353) D-back to start a Postseason game in franchise history, behind Daniel Hudson (24-207 on Oct. 2, 2011 @ Brewers) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Third D-backs rookie to start a Postseason game (also: Josh Collmenter/2011 vs. MIL and Micah Owings/2007 @ COL [source: Elias Sports Bureau]).
- Youngest (24-361) D-backs' pitcher to start a home Postseason game (previous: Josh Collmenter (25-239) vs. Brewers on Oct. 4, 2011 in NLDS Game 3) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- First pitcher in MLB history to allow 0 runs and 0 walks in consecutive Postseason starts.
