**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles and Yankees continue a four-game set this afternoon in the Bronx...The clubs meet five times in the next 11 days, as New York travels to Camden Yards for a three-game series from May 11-13...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, having dropped two of three to the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Astros.

Following yesterday's 9-4 defeat, the Birds have suffered three straight losses by 5+ runs for the first time since a three-game skid from July 12-18, 2025...They have not done so in four straight since a four-game skid from June 8-11, 2017.

The O's have been held to five or fewer hits in four straight games opposite the Yankees since September 27, 2025, the second-longest such streak in franchise history (since 1954) behind a five-game stretch from April 20-May 14, 1958.

**Pete Alonso** scored his 600<sup>th</sup> career run yesterday with his solo homer in the fourth frame...He has homered in consecutive games for the first time since a four-game run from September 14-18, 2025.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** **Trey Gibson** is set to become the first Oriole starter in franchise history (since 1954) to make his MLB debut against the Yankees in New York...**Chris Vallimont** was the last O's pitcher to make his major league debut in the Bronx, who did so on July 3, 2023.

Gibson, 23, is rated the No. 3 Orioles prospect by both *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline*, while *Baseball America* tabs him the No. 64 overall prospect in baseball.

**TROUBLESOME TWO'S:** Oriole pitching has allowed opponents to slash .264/.343/.440 (101-for-382) and a .783 OPS with two outs...The .783 OPS is the third-highest mark in the majors ahead of the Astros (.840) and Royals (.802).

Baltimore hurlers own a .578 opponent OPS with two strikes, the second-highest clip in MLB ahead of the Rockies (.607).

Through two games this series, the Yankees are 12-for-27 (.444) with five doubles, two home runs, and nine walks with two outs...In two-strike counts, New York batters own a .670 OPS, adding three doubles, one home run, and four RBI.

**SOUTHPAW SWOON:** The Orioles are 0-7 against opposing left-handed starting pitchers this season, the worst mark in the majors with the next closest club being the Mets (1-7, .125).

The Birds own a .612 OPS against left-handed starters, ranking 23<sup>rd</sup> in MLB, while their .783 OPS off left-handed relievers ranks seventh in MLB.

**Taylor Ward** is slashing .348/.484/.565 (8-for-23) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI, and seven walks against two strikeouts off southpaws in 2026.

The Orioles faced a right-handed starter in a franchise-record 17 straight games to open the season, surpassing the previous record of 14 in 1975.

**FASTBALL FOCUS:** Baltimore hitters own a collective .483 slugging percentage off fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the best mark in the AL and fifth-highest in MLB behind Arizona (.514), Atlanta (.510), Los Angeles-NL (.489), Chicago-NL (.486).

The O's .299 slugging percentage on all other pitches is second lowest in the majors ahead of only the Twins (.288).

**BRONX TALES:** Baltimore has dropped seven straight games at Yankee Stadium since June 21, 2025, its longest losing skid since a franchise-record 12-game losing streak from May 15 (G1), 2019-April 6, 2021...The Birds active seven-game losing streak overall to the Yankees is their longest since a team-record 19-game skid from April 4, 2019-September 4, 2020 (G1).

**Pete Alonso** is slashing .317/.421/.746 (20-for-63) with three doubles, eight home runs, 18 runs, 19 RBI, and 11 walks in his last 18 games opposite the Yankees since July 26, 2022.

**ROAD TRIPPIN':** O's hitters have posted a .623 OPS on the road, the fourth-lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Pirates (.622), Royals (.609), and Phillies (.608)...Their .777 OPS at home ranks ninth highest in MLB.

Baltimore pitching has permitted 10+ hits in five straight road games, its longest streak since a seven-game stretch from June 9-15, 2022.

Overall this season, the O's have given up 10+ hits an MLB-high 19 times, with the next closest team being the Phillies (17 G).

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** has reached base safely 65 times through his first 33 games with the O's (36 H, 28 BB, 1 HBP), the second-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Frank Robinson** (70 TOB, 1966)...The record through 34 games is also held by **Robinson** (72 TOB).

Ward's .428 on-base percentage ranks fourth in MLB behind NYY's **Ben Rice** (.447), HOU's **Yordan Alvarez** (.438), and LAA's **Mike Trout** (.431)...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2<sup>nd</sup>, .410).

His 13 doubles are tied for the MLB lead with TOR's **Ernie Clement** and ATL's **Matt Olson** Ward has reached safely in 30 of the last 32 games since March 28 while slashing .305/.439/.441 (36-for-118) with 13 doubles, one homer, 19 runs scored, 12 RBI, 28 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

**GARCIA'S GREATNESS:** **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.66 ERA (1 ER/13.2 IP) with 15 strikeouts across 15 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's **Michael Massey** on April 21.

His .024 (1-for-42) opponent average and 0.37 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's **John King** (.048, 2-for-42) and SEA's **Matt Brash** (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

**'PEN PALS:** **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 32.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 37.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

The O's 11.9 percent inherited runners scored rate (5 IRS/42 IR) lead MLB, ahead of the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Gibson is set to make his major league debut this afternoon, becoming the third Oriole to do so win 2026, joining **Cameron Foster** (4/16 at CLE) and **Anthony Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN)...Gibson is rated the No. 3 Orioles prospect by both *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline*, while *Baseball America* tabs him the No. 64 overall prospect in baseball...Signed by the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on August 9, 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt the loss on April 26 vs. Memphis after allowing five runs (1 ER) on three hits and one walk with two strikeouts in 2.2 innings...The outing tied for the shortest start of his career (2x, last: 5/11/24 at KAN)...Threw 46 pitches, 33 strikes.

**EMPIRE STATE:** Gibson is set to become the first Orioles starter in franchise history (since 1954) to make his MLB debut at Yankee Stadium and the eighth to make his major league debut vs. New York-AL, joining **Dean Kremer** (9/6/20), **Wei-Yin Chen** (4/10/12), **Jake Arrieta** (6/10/10), **Koji Uehara** (4/8/09), **John Parrish** (7/24/00), **John O'Donoghue** (6/27/93), and **Charlie Beamon** (9/26/56).

**PITCH MIX:** Opponents are batting .185 (5-for-27) on his sinker with zero extra-base hits and .188 (3-for-16) on his curveball, which is generating a 37.5 percent whiff rate through six starts this season at Triple-A Norfolk...Eight of his 25 strikeouts have come on his four-seam fastball (40.0 K%) and five have come on his slider, which batters are hitting .250 (4-for-16) against with a 30.0 percent whiff rate.

🏆 Gibson was tabbed by *Baseball America* as having the Best Curveball and Best Slider in the Baltimore organization in its Best Tools survey last season.

**K ARTIST:** Gibson has struck out 11.73 batters per 9.0 innings since making his professional debut in 2024, the fifth-highest mark in the minors during that stretch (min. 200.0 IP), trailing NYM's **Jonah Tong** (13.36), MIA's **Thomas White** (12.95), BOS' **Connelly Early** (11.91), and STL's **Quinn Mathews** (11.82).

🏆 His 166 strikeouts in 2025 tied for fourth most in all of Minor League Baseball (12.42 K/9.0 IP).

**BEST OF THE BEST:** Gibson was named the 2025 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year, going 5-8 with a 4.26 ERA (57 ER/120.1 IP) and 166 strikeouts in 26 appearances (25 GS) over three levels of the Orioles system...Ranked among Orioles minor leaguers in strikeouts (1<sup>st</sup>), WHIP (2<sup>nd</sup>, 1.21), starts (T-2<sup>nd</sup>), opponent average (3<sup>rd</sup>, .224), ERA (4<sup>th</sup>), and innings (4<sup>th</sup>).

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Gibson began last season with High-A Aberdeen and made nine appearances (8 GS), striking out 67 batters across 38.2 innings...Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on June 3 and made 10 starts with the Baysox, going 3-2 with a 1.55 ERA (9 ER/52.1 IP) and 68 strikeouts...Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on August 12 and made seven starts to close the year, tallying 31 strikeouts over 29.1 innings.

🏆 Named Orioles Minor League pitcher of the Month for July, going 2-1 with a 1.23 ERA (3 ER/22.0 IP) and 28 strikeouts in four starts.

🏆 Finished the season ranked the No. 3 Orioles prospect by *Baseball America* and the No. 9 Orioles prospect by *MLB Pipeline*.
