**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Cleveland over the weekend, followed by a loss on Monday night and a win last night at Detroit...today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Comerica Park against the Tigers...after today's game, they will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Royals for three over the weekend.  
✦ The Twins enter today 3-9 in rubber games...Twins have lost each of their last eight rubber games...Minnesota's last win in a rubber match was on May 4 at Boston, a 5-4 victory.

**TWINS GREET AN OLD FRIEND:** The Twins beat the Tigers and former teammate Chris Paddock last night at Comerica Park by a score of 6-3...Zebby Matthews (3-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...Justin Topa earned the save with a scoreless ninth inning, his first of the season and fourth of his career (1st since 2023)...the offense recorded nine hits, as Ryan Jeffers (2), Kody Clemens (3), Luke Keaschall (2) and Trevor Larnach (2) each had multi-hit games...Keaschall hit his first career home run and Larnach hit his 15th of the season.

**MOTOWN SHOWDOWN:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the ninth of 13 games this season...Twins are 3-5 against Detroit in 2025, going 1-2 at Target Field and 2-3 at Comerica Park...they will wrap the season-series with four games at Target Field August 14-17.  
✦ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 143, 32 ahead of Cleveland (111)...67 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 27 times in their last 19 games at Comerica and 18 times in their last 11 here.  
✦ Royce Lewis is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with three doubles, two home runs, seven walks, nine RBI and a .939 OPS in 15 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 15 career games vs. the Tigers...at Comerica Park, he is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with two home runs and a .959 OPS in eight career games.  
✦ Former Tiger Kody Clemens is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with three doubles, two RBI and a .977 OPS in five career games against his former team.

**KEA TO SUCCESS:** After going 2-for-4 with his first career home run last night, Luke Keaschall has now hit safely in each of his first seven games with an at-bat to start his career...also has reached base safely in all eight...below are Twins (since 1961) best on-base streaks to begin their career (above) and best hitting streaks to begin their career (below):

**AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF:** Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in eight-straight, tying his season-high of eight, done twice previously, from April 26-May 6 and July 5-21...his career-high is 14, done July 15-August 9, 2023...the high for a Twin this season was Brooks Lee's 19 (May 28-June 20).  
✦ Over his last 20 games, Jeffers is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with six doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks, a .382 on-base percentage, a .514 slugging percentage and an .895 OPS.

**CHEERS TO BROOKS KRISKE, A REAL SON OF A GUN!:** Yesterday, the Twins claimed right-handed pitcher Brooks Kriske off waivers from the Cubs...Kriske, who was designated for release or assignment on Saturday, appeared in four games for the Cubs this season, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings of relief, allowing two hits, five walks and four strikeouts...the 31-year-old has pitched in parts of four major league seasons with the Yankees (2020-21), Orioles (2021), Royals (2023) and Cubs (2025)...he will be active for today's game and wear uniform number 61.

**SERIES DISCUSSIONS:** With a win today, the Twins will earn their 15th series victory this season and their first since taking two of three from Pittsburgh at Target Field from July 11-13, leading into the All-Star break...Minnesota is 14-20-2 in series play, going 9-7-2 at home and 5-13-0 on the road.  
✦ Minnesota has lost each of their last two series vs. the Tigers — both this season...their last series win against Detroit came July 26-28, 2024, taking two of three at Comerica Park.

**YO ADRIANI!** Low-A Fort Myers Mighty Mussels right-hander Adrian Bohorquez has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Month for July...he went 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA in five outings (3 starts) and allowed two earned runs on eight hits with five walks in 20.0 innings pitched...he led the league in ERA (0.90), and ranked second in WHIP (0.65), batting average against (.118), hits allowed-per-nine innings (3.9), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.0) and strikeouts-per-nine innings (9.00)...Bohorquez did not allow a hit in his first 8.0 innings pitched in July and was promoted to High-A Cedar Rapids on August 4...the 20-year-old was signed by Minnesota as an international free agent out of La Victoria, VZ, on January 15, 2023.

**HEART & HUSTLE:** The Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA) yesterday announced the 30 preliminary winners of the 2025 Heart and Hustle Award...this esteemed award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game of baseball and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game...the Heart and Hustle Award is also the only award in Major League Baseball that is voted on by former players...the Twins winner/nominee is Byron Buxton...the 2025 All-Star and clubhouse leader has played in 85 games this season, slashing .282/.343/.561 (.905 OPS) with 23 home runs, 59 RBI, 68 runs scored and 17 stolen bases (0 caught stealing)...he is currently on the 10-day IL with left ribcage inflammation but is with the club in Detroit...this marks the second time for Buck to win the award, also having done so in 2017 and 2019.

⚔ Did not pitched more than 4.0 innings in any of his outings...his shortest outing of the season was 1.2 IP (AA) on May 18.

Right-hander Joe Ryan is set to start Friday night's series opener against the Royals at Target Field...last pitched on August 1 at Cleveland but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-3, 10-inning walk-off loss; allowed two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...is facing Kansas City for the 10th time in his career and the second time this season; in nine career starts, is 7-0 with a 1.30 ERA (55.1 IP, 8 ER), three home runs allowed, 11 walks and 59 strikeouts.

- Began 2021 season on Double-A Wichita's 7-day Injured List with a right shoulder impingement; during rehab assignment, made two appearances with Low-A Fort Myers, going 1-0 while allowing no runs with one walk and 10 strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...reinstated on April 25.
- Named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 1...in two appearances, went 1-0-1 with no runs allowed on three hits over 7.0 innings, with one walk and eight strikeouts.
- In 13 appearances (2 starts) with the Wind Surge, went 4-1-1 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1 IP, 9 ER), two home runs, four walks and 23 strikeouts...did not allow a run in eight of his 13 outings.

- Ranked first among all Twins minor league pitchers in innings pitched (127.1), tied for first in wins (9), tied for third in strikeouts (115) and tied for fourth in games started (21)...was one of four Twins minor league pitchers to throw a complete game.
- Spent duration of 2022 at Low-A Fort Myers...in 20 appearances (18 starts), went 6-7 with a 3.53 ERA (91.2 IP, 36 ER), five home runs, 13 walks and 101 strikeouts...led the team in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts...recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts on July 9 at Tampa.
- Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 21 and the Florida State League Pitcher of the Month for August...that month, went 2-1 with a 1.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 4 ER), a 0.81 WHIP and 26 strikeouts.
