TWINS GREET AN OLD FRIEND: The Twins beat the Tigers and former teammate Chris Paddack last night at Comerica Park by a score of 6-3...Zebby Matthews (3-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts... Justin Topa earned the save with a scoreless ninth inning, his first of the season and fourth of his career (1st since 2023)...the offense recorded nine hits, as Ryan Jeffers (2), Kody Clemens (3), Luke Keaschall (2) and Trevor Larnach (2) each had multi-hit games...Keaschall hit his first career home run and Larnach hit his 15th of the season.

MOTOWN SHOWDOWN: The Twins and Tigers are playing the ninth of 13 games this season...

Twins are 3-5 against Detroit in 2025, going 1-2 at Target Field and 2-3 at Comerica Park...
they will wrap the season-series with four games at Target Field and 2-3 at Comerica Park...

▼ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 143, 32 ahead of Cleveland (111)...67 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 27 times in their last 19 games at Comerica and 18 times in their last 11 here.

▼ Royce Lewis is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with three doubles, two home runs, seven walks, nine RBI and a .939 OPS in 15 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 15 career games vs. the Tigers...at Comerica Park, he is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with two home runs and a .959 OPS in eight career games.

◆ Over his last 20 games, Jeffers is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with six doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks, a .382 on-base percentage, a .514 slugging percentage and an .895 OPS.

CHEERS TO BROOKS KRISKE, A REAL SON OF A GUN!: Yesterday, the Twins claimed right-handed pitcher Brooks Kriske off waivers from the Cubs...Kriske, who was designated for release or assignment on Saturday, appeared in four games for the Cubs this season, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings of relief, allowing two hits, five walks and four strikeouts...the 31-year-old has pitched in parts of four major league seasons with the Yankees (2020-21), Orioles (2021), Royals (2023) and Cubs (2025)...he will be active for today's game and wear uniform number 61.

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: With a win today, the Twins will earn their 15th series victory this season and their first since taking two of three from Pittsburgh at Target Field from July 11-13, leading into the All-Star break...Minnesota is 14-20-2 in series play, going 9-7-2 at home and 5-13-0 on the road.

The Minnesota has lost each of their last two series vs. the Tigers — both this season...their last series win against Detroit came July 26-28, 2024, taking two of three at Comerica Park.

YO ADRIAN!: Low-A Fort Myers Mighty Mussels right-hander Adrian Bohorquez has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Month for July...he went 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA in five outings (3 starts) and allowed two earned runs on eight hits with five walks in 20.0 innings pitched...he led the league in ERA (0.90), and ranked second in WHIP (0.65), batting average against (.118), hits allowed-per-nine innings (3.9), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.0) and strikeouts-per-nine innings (9.00)...Bohorquez did not allow a hit in his first 8.0 innings pitched in July and was promoted to High-A Cedar Rapids on August 4...the 20-year-old was signed by Minnesota as an international free agent out of La Victoria, VZ, on January 15, 2023.

HEART & HUSTLE: The Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA) yesterday announced the 30 preliminary winners of the 2025 Heart and Hustle Award...this esteemed award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game of baseball and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game...the Heart and Hustle Award is also the only award in Major League Baseball that is voted on by former players..the Twins winner/nominee is Byron Buxton...the 2025 All-Star and clubhouse leader has played in 85 games this season, slashing .2827.3437.561 (.905 OPS) with 23 home runs, 59 RBI, 68 runs scored and 17 stolen bases (0 caught stealing)...he is currently on the 10-day IL with left ribcage inflammation but is with the club in Detroit...this marks the second time for Buck to win the award, also having done so in 2017 and 2019.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his second road appearance at the major league level this season... in four games (3 starts) at home in Triple-A this season, Ohl went 0-0 with a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER), one home run, two walks and 15 strikeouts, compared to 0-1 with a 6.14 ERA (7.1 IP, 5 ER), one home run, three walks and eight strikeouts in three road appearances (no starts).

© In 46 home games (34 starts) in his minor league career, Ohl is 12-12 with a 3.70 ERA (201.2 IP, 83 ER), 20 home runs allowed, a 5.15 strikeout-to-walk ratio (175/34), a .253 opponent batting average and a 1.15 WHIP.
