**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue their final homestand before the All-Star break against the Yankees (1-1, 1 to play) and Guardians (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field... have lost four of their last five games...are 2-11 in their last 13 games against AL East opponents after a 9-7 start...they are 11-18 against division rivals and 34-29 against all other clubs...in order to enter the All-Star break with a winning record for a franchise-record seventh consecutive season (excl. 2020), Tampa Bay must win each of its next four contests...since 2008, the club has held a winning record at the All-Star break in 13 of 15 seasons (2014, 2016)...the Rays have the hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .535 (Elias).

- ★ The Rays were held to 0-for-10 with RISP and left 12 men on base in last night's 2-1 loss to the Yankees...they collected 10 hits, their most in a game in which they plated one or zero runs since July 19, 2023 at Texas (1R, 10H).
- ★ Tampa Bay has not scored first in five consecutive games, matching its longest streak of the season (4x, last: June 7-11)...over its last 30 games since June 7, the club is 4-9 when yielding the first run and 10-7 when scoring first.
- ★ Since a 10-8 win at Kansas City on July 4, the Rays have plated 11 runs in their last four games (2.8 R/G), going 4-for-24 (.167) with RISP.
- ★ The Rays rotation has turned in a 3.01 ERA (93.0IP, 31ER) since June 23, third lowest in the majors behind the Royals (2.93) and Mets (3.00)...Rays starters have allowed two runs or fewer in 12 of 15 games during that timeframe.
- ★ Tampa Bay is 6-3 in its last nine home games on the heels of a 5-14 stretch.
- ★ The Rays own the second-best record in the majors in both one-run games (16-9/.640) and games decided by two runs or fewer (31-15/.674).
- ★ Tonight, **RHP Shane Baz** makes his first start at Tropicana Field in 744 days, when he took a no-decision against the Brewers on June 28, 2022 (5.2IP, 3H, ER, 2BB, 6SO), this marks his 11th career start, three of which will have come against the Yankees.

### WHAT'S AT STAKE

- ★ With a win tonight, the Rays would:
  - ★ Improve to 6-1-0 in their last seven series.
  - ★ Claim their fourth consecutive home series win, which would mark their longest streak since winning six straight from Aug. 11-Sept. 10, 2023.
  - ★ Win their seventh straight rubber game dating back to May 30 vs. Oakland, which would mark the third-longest streak in club history, trailing a pair of eight-game streaks, per Elias (July-Sept. 2018; June-Sept. 2008).
  - ★ Earn their first series win over the Yankees since Aug. 25-27, 2023, snapping a two-series skid.
  - ★ Record their first series victory over an AL East opponent since May 17-19 at Toronto and first at home since Sept. 4-6, 2023 vs. Boston.
  - ★ Improve to 17-13 in series finales, including 10-3 in their last 13 since May 30.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS**—The Rays are 15-8 (.625) against left-handed starters, the fourth-best mark in the majors behind the Guardians (20-6/.769), Dodgers (24-10/.706) and Twins (16-8/.667)...they are 10-3 in their last 13 such games since the calendar flipped to May...the Rays are averaging 4.7 runs per game in 23 contests opposed by LH starters and 3.7 in 69 games vs. RH starters...Tampa Bay is an MLB-best 39-19 (.672) when opposed by left-handed starters since the beginning of last season.

- ★ **Yandy Diaz** is 7-for-13 (.538) with 3 2B and 1 HR against left-handers over his last 15 games and 14-for-34 (.412) since June 1...on the season, his .330 (44-for-142) average vs. LHP ranks 10th in the AL.
- ★ **Amed Rosario** is batting .361 (13-for-36) against lefties since the start of June, going 4-for-7 (.571) in July.
- ★ **Brandon Lowe** is 9-for-23 (.391) off southpaws since the beginning of June...on the season, his .333 (9-for-27) average vs. LHP as a LH hitter ranks third in the AL (min. 25AB) behind **CLE Steven Kwan** (.405) and **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (.342).
- ★ Since June 20, the Rays rank among MLB leaders vs. LHP in several categories:

**RISP BUT NO REWARD**—After going 0-for-10 last night, the Rays are now on a 0-for-15 skid with runners in scoring position, with their last hit being **Isaac Paredes**' three-run homer in the 1st inning of Tuesday's series opener...Tampa Bay is 4-for-34 (.118) with RISP over its last five games and 13-for-79 (.165) in its last 10 since June 29, lowest in the majors over that span...on the season, their .231 RISP average ranks 13th in the AL/25th in MLB and signals their lowest mark before the All-Star break since 2015 (.220).

- ★ Over the Rays last 24 games since June 13, **José Caballero** (0-for-14) and **Jose Siri** (1-for-19) are a combined 1-for-33 (.030) with RISP.
- ★ The Rays have left 10+ men on base in four of their last seven games since July 3, totaling 59 LOB, second most in the AL over that span behind the Twins (64)...on the season, their 14 games with 10+ LOB are tied with the Astros and Yankees for second most in the AL behind the Orioles (15).

**WALK THE WALK**—After drawing a career-high-tying three walks last night, **Isaac Paredes** has walked in seven of his last 10 games June 29, collecting an MLB-leading 11 walks in that span while drawing free passes at a 24.4 pct. clip...despite a .226 (7-for-31) average in his last nine games, Paredes has produced a club-leading 1.060 OPS in that span, adding a .415 on-base pct., .645 slugging pct., 6 XBH and 10 walks.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR**—It was announced on Sunday that **3B Isaac Paredes** will represent the Rays at the 2024 MLB All-Star Game in Arlington, Texas...Paredes leads Tampa Bay in on-base pct. (.363), slugging pct. (.467), OPS (.830), home runs (15), RBI (50), extra-base hits (33), walks (42) and total bases (148)...he joins **Evan Longoria** (2008-10) as the only players in franchise history to earn All-Star selections as third basemen... is the 12th Ray (17th instance) to earn the honor in their age 25 season or younger.

- ★ He is the second Mexican-born third baseman to be selected to an All-Star Game, joining **Vinny Castilla** (1995 & 1998 with COL)...overall, he is the 14th Mexican-born player (25th instance) to be named an All-Star...over the last 44 seasons since 1981, Paredes, Castilla and **TOR Alejandro Kirk** (2022) are the only Mexican-born position players to earn All-Star selections.

**EMPIRE STATE OF MIND**—Tampa Bay and New York continue their 13-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field, with New York holding a 5-3 advantage...the Yankees took two of three games in the Bronx from April 19-21 before winning a three-game set in St. Petersburg from May 10-12...in order to win the season series for the second straight year and fourth time in the last five seasons, the Rays need to win at least four of the final seven matchups...six of the eight meetings this season have been decided by two runs or fewer.

- ★ **Brandon Lowe** has hit safely in seven of his last nine games against the Yankees since May 13, 2023, batting .355 (12-for-31) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 10 RBI and 4 BB.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 29 of 30 games opposite New York dating to June 21, 2022...during that stretch, he is slashing .322/.409/.539 (37-for-115) with 7 2B, 6 HR, 21 RBI, 14 BB and 20 SO...Diaz is batting .400 (12-for-30) with 4 2B, 3 HR and only 2 SO in his career vs. **LHP Nestor Cortes**, his highest average against any pitcher in his career (min. 20AB).

- ★ **OF Richie Palacios**, a Brooklyn native, went 2-for-4 with 1 2B, 1 HR and 1 HBP in his first career game at Yankee Stadium earlier this season on April 19.
- ★ The Yankees have two Sunshine State natives on their active roster: **LHP Carlos Rodón** (Miami) and **RHP Luke Weaver** (DeLand)... Weaver played collegiately at Florida State University.
- ★ **C Ben Rortvedt** appeared in 32 games for the Yankees last season and spent Spring Training with them before being traded to the Rays on March 27.
- ★ **LHP Nestor Cortes** made his Yankees debut vs. the Rays on May 11, 2019 (2.0IP, 4H, 3ER, 3SO, 1HR).
- ★ **OF Randy Arozarena** homered in Games 1-3 of the 2020 ALDS against the Yankees, becoming the third Ray to homer in three consecutive postseason games, joining **Evan Longoria** (4) and **Carlos Peña** (3) in 2008.
- ★ From June 21-22, 2022, **INF Isaac Paredes** became the second player in the expansion era (since 1961) to homer in four straight at-bats against the Yankees, joining **KC/CWS Bo Jackson** (4) from July 17, 1990/April 9, 1993.
- ★ A three-game set between the Rays and Yankees, originally scheduled at Tropicana Field, was moved to Citi Field in Sept. of 2017 due to Hurricane Irma.
- ★ Bally Sports Sun announcer **Dewayne Staats** was the Yankees lead play-by-play announcer from 1990-94.
- ★ **INF Oswaldo Cabrera** made his MLB debut vs. Tampa Bay on Aug. 17, 2022 (0-for-4, 2SO)...he hit his first career HR vs. the Rays that season on Sept. 11 off **Calvin Faucher**.
- ★ **Yankees P.A. announcer Paul Olden** was a member of the Devil Rays radio broadcast crew from 1998-2004.

**TONIGHT'S START**—The right-hander is scheduled to make his first start at Tropicana Field since June 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee, 744 days ago...underwent Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28, 2022 in Dallas, Texas, performed by Dr. Keith Meister...Baz has made 10 career big league starts, going 3-3 with a 4.08 ERA (46.1IP, 21ER) and 54 strikeouts against 13 walks while limiting opponents to a .226 (40-for-177) average.

**ALL THE ACCOLADES**—Despite missing nearly two years of MLB action, Baz was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 96 overall prospect in the game in its July 3 updated rankings...following the 2023 season, Baz was tabbed by the publication as having the best slider among Rays prospects for the sixth consecutive year...after the 2022 season, he was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 32 overall prospect in baseball and the top-ranked farmhand in the Rays system.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Made his third career quality start in his season debut at Texas on July 5, but was saddled with the loss...worked a career-high-tying 6.0 IP, allowing three runs on seven hits and one walk with six strikeouts.

- Retired the side in order in both of the first two innings, including strikeouts of **Corey Seager** and **Jonah Heim**.
- Allowed each of his three runs in the 3rd frame on five hits, including four straight by **Jonathan Ornelas** (1B), **Marcus Semien** (1B), Seager (2B) and **Nathaniel Lowe** (1B)...it marked the second time he has allowed 5+ hits in an inning (6H, 3rd inn., July 10, 2022 at CIN).
- Retired nine of the final 12 batters he faced, working around two singles in the 4th frame and a walk in the 5th.
- His four-seam fastball topped out at 99.1 mph, and he threw five fastballs at 98.0+ mph...four of his six strikeouts came via the fastball while recording one on his slider and another on his curve.

**NEW YORK, NEW YORK**—Baz has not factored into either of his two career starts opposite the Yankees, posting a 2.45 ERA (7.1IP, 2ER) with 10 strikeouts against four walks...faced New York at Tropicana Field on June 22, 2022, allowing one run on four hits and two walks with six strikeouts across 4.2 innings.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS**—In four career starts at Tropicana Field, Baz is 2-0 with a 1.71 ERA (21.0IP, 4ER)...tonight's start marks his first in St. Petersburg since June 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee (ND, 5.2IP, 3H, 1ER, 2BB, 6SO).

- Min. 20.0 IP, it marks the lowest home ERA by a Rays starter in their first four starts with the club in franchise history, outpacing **Zach Eftin** (1.96 in 2023).

**THE ROAD BACK**—Baz began his rehab assignment with Triple-Durham on May 5...in 10 starts with the Bulls, he went 3-3 with a 4.12 ERA (39.1IP, 18ER) and 44 SO against 23 BB...in five June starts, however, he went 3-0 with a 1.57 ERA (23.0IP, 4ER) and 35 SO.

- Baz was slowed early in spring due to two bouts with oblique soreness, one coming as the result of picking up a weight, and the other after experiencing soreness following a simulated game appearance.

**THE ARSENAL**—In 2022, he primarily featured a four-seam fastball (40.1%) and slider (37.2%), while mixing in a curveball (14.4%) and changeup (8.3%)...he threw the four-seamer at an average of 96.0 mph, while the slider sat 87.7 mph.

- The slider was his most effective offering, limiting opponents to a .200 (9-for-45) average...this, compared to a .289 (11-for-38) mark on his fastball...of his 30 strikeouts in 2022, 19 came via the slider...in limited action during the 2021 campaign, opponents went 1-for-13 (.077) with 3 SO against his slider.

**CAREER RUNDOWN**—Baz made six starts in 2022, going 1-2 with a 5.00 ERA (27.0IP, 15ER) with 30 strikeouts and nine walks...in four starts from June 17–July 3, he went 1-0 with a 1.21 ERA (22.1IP, 3ER) and 26 strikeouts...the four-start run was bookended by two outings (June 11 at MIN & July 10 at CIN) in which he went a combined 0-2 with a 23.14 ERA (4.2IP, 12ER).
