THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, winning a three-game series 2-1 in Detroit over the weekend, followed by consecutive losses in Queens to the Mets over the last two nights...today, the Twins will complete the series and trip with the three-game series finale against the Mets at Citi Field...after today's game, they will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the White Sox for three over the weekend.

LOST IN NEW YORK: The Twins were shut out by the Mets last night at Citi Field, losing by a score of 2-0, suffering their sixth shutout loss of the season...David Festa (1-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded just two hits, walked twice, struck out 13 times and went 0-for-3 with runners in scoring position...Carlos Santana and Brooks Lee each singled for the two Minnesota hits.

AUGUST RUSH: The Twins will wrap the July portion of their schedule this afternoon...a win today and Minnesota will secure its fourth consecutive winning month (16-13 in March/April, 16-12 in May, 15-12 in June...below are the hitting (top) and pitching (bottom) comparisons this season:

TALKIN' NEW YORK: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 28th time in their history today...Minnesota is 10-17 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 2-8 at Citi Field, 2-6 at Target Field.

◆ Twins are just 1-7 in their last eight games at Citi Field since June of 2010...their only win in that span was a 14-8 victory on April 9, 2019...in that game, the Twins hit five home runs, three coming off Jacob deGrom (2 from Mitch Garver).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart on the 15-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain...Stewart, who was reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on July 24 (right shoulder tendinitis), recently appeared in three games for the Iwins over the past week, allowing eight runs on seven hits in 2.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...overall this season, the 32-year-old has appeared in 16 games for Minnesota, posting a 5.17 ERA (15.2 IP. 9 ER) with eight walks and 20 strikeouts...daking the 26-man roster spot vacated by Stewart will be right-handed pitcher Irevor Richards, who was acquired in a trade with the Toronto Blue Jays yesterday affernoon.

**PRIChards, 31, has appeared in 45 games (2 starts) for the Blue Jays this season, going 2-1, 4.64 ERA (52.1 IP, 27 ER), seven holds, 24 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .189 (36-for-190) BAA...lefties have slashed .175/.256/.250 against him and righties have slashed .200/.294/.391...he has posted an XBA of .202 this season, ranking in the 91st percentile in MLB...additionally, since the start of last season, he has posted an 11.09 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio (154 K/125.0 IP), the eighth best in the AL (min. of 100.0 IP).

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 12-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia and 0-2 at New York-NL...their next IL series will be in Chicago at Wirgley Field from Monday-Wednesday.

Byron Buxton is hitting 315 (29-for-92) with three doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI, a .576 slugging percentage and a .942 OPS in 25 games against the NL this season...his OPS and batting average both rank sixth-best among AL players (min. 100 PA).

TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALLNER: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on July 7, Matt Wallner has hit 359 (14-for-39) with four doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .457 on-base percentage, a .769 slugging percentage and a 1.226 OPS in 14 games...since that date, he ranks fourth in baseball in average exit velocity at 99.6 mph (minimum of 250 pitches seen) and seventh in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage at 17.1%.

In this last 33 games between St. Paul and Minnesota combined, he has slashed .364/.440/.754 (1.194 OPS).

LET'S NOT DO THAT: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the seventh time in 2024...their previous six sweeps were April 4-6 vs. Cleveland (2 games - PPD/weather-shortened series). April 15-17 at Baltimore (3 games), May 14-16 vs. New York-AL (3 games), May 17-19 vs. Cleveland (3 games), June 4-6 at New York-AL (3 games) and July 20-21 vs. Milwaukee (2 games).

◆ Iwins are looking to avoid being swept by the Mets for the first time since losing both in a two-game series from July 16-17, 2019... the last time the Twins were swept in three games by the Mets came in Citi Field from September 16-18, 2016.

TWINS GET THEIR ROLL ON WITH CULPEPPER: Yesterday afternoon, the Twins signed their first round selection (21st overall) shortstop Kaelen Culpepper...the 6-foot, 195-pound infielder hit 328 (80-for-244) with 15 doubles, six triples, 11 home runs, 59 RBI, 35 walks, 17 stolen bases, a .419 on-base percentage and a .993 OPS in 61 games for Kansas State University in 2024, earning a spot on the All-Big 12 Second Team...over three seasons at Kansas State, the Memphis, TN native hit .314 (176-for-561) with 32 doubles, six triples, 26 home runs, 122 RBI, 27 stolen bases, 63 walks, 109 runs scored, a .402 on-base percentage and a .934 OPS in 152 games.

◆ Minnesota has now signed 20 of its 22 selected players from the 2024 First-Year Player Draft.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1989, the Twins traded the previous season's AL Cy Young Award winner, Frank Viola, to the Mets for five players, including pitchers Rick Aguilera, David West and minor leaguer Kevin Tapani...Viola became the first Cy Young Award winner to be traded during the following season, while Aguilera (42 saves), West (4 wins) and Tapani (16-9, 2.99 ERA) all helped the Twins win the 1991 World Series.
