## Sundays

The Braves are 17-5 (.773) on Sundays this season, tied for the best record in the majors on the day...The Dodgers are also 17-5.
Atlanta has won each of its last three Sunday games, and six of the last eight...The Braves last lost on a Sunday on August 4 vs. Cincinnati, falling 6-4 in 10 innings.


TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and White Sox conclude a three-game series tonight with the third of three games between the teams this season...This marks the teams' first meeting since 2016 in Chicago, where the Braves won two-of-three games.

A This series marks Chicago's second trip to Atlanta in franchise history and they have yet to win a game here after last night's 11-5 loss...The White Sox visited Turner Field in 2002, and got swept in three games...The Braves outscored the White Sox, $27-5$, over those three games.

A RH Julio Teheran has made just one career start against Chicago, allowing nine hits and five runs over 6.0 innings to take the loss on July 9, 2016 at U.S. Cellular Field...Teheran is winless in three starts against the American League this season, going 0-2 with a 2.87 ERA (5 ER/15.2 IP).

A RH Lucas Giolito makes his second career appearance against Atlanta and his first start... Pitched 3.1 innings of relief on September 7, 2016, allowing five hits and two runs at Nationals Park while he was with Washington.
29 OVER: With last night's 11-5 win, the Braves moved to 83-54 and a season high 29 games over $.500 \ldots$ Atlanta has the fifth-best record in baseball, and the second-best mark in the National League.

A This matches Atlanta's high-water mark for the last six seasons...The last time the Braves were 29 games or better over .500 was 2013, when that club finished the season 96-66 (30 games over).
SURGING: The Braves have won 14 of their last 18 games and 11 of 13 after last night's win over Chicago.
A Over their last 13 games, the Braves have compiled a 2.54 ERA ( $34 \mathrm{ER} / 120.1 \mathrm{IP}$ ) and allowed just nine home runs.
INTERLEAGUE: The Braves are set to play their 16th interleague game of the season tonight, and they are 9-6 so far against the American League...The Braves are in the middle of a seven-game stretch against the American League.
A The Braves have not had a winning record against the AL since going 11-9 in 2013.
A Atlanta has four games remaining against the American League after tonight, including a twogame set against Toronto that begins tomorrow... The Braves will travel to Kansas City for a twogame series, September 24-25.

A Prior to the start of this series against Chicago, the Braves had won just two series in Atlanta against the American League over the previous five seasons, with both coming against Detroit...They won two-of-three to close out Turner Field over the Tigers in 2016, before beating them two-ofthree, May 31-June 2 of this season...Overall, the Braves were 13-32 against the AL in Atlanta over this stretch, and went 2-11-5 in series play.

ROSTER ADDITIONS: The Braves today made four roster moves, the first day of September roster expansions...Atlanta reinstated C Brian McCann from the 10-day injured list, and recalled INF Johan Camargo, RHP Chad Sobotka and RHP Jeremy Walker from Triple-A Gwinnett.
A McCann was placed on the injured list on August 21 and missed 10 games with a left knee sprain.
A Camargo was optioned to Gwinnett on August 16 and batted $.483 / .531 / .690$ in 14 games with the Stripers, with eight extra-base hits and 15 RBI.

WINNING AT HOME: The Braves have won seven straight in Atlanta after last night's 11-5 victory over Chicago (AL), which tied their longest home winning streak of the season...They also took seven straight at SunTrust Park, June 1-June 14.
A The Braves have held the opposition to 21 total runs in these six games (18 earned runs/2.57 ERA), while striking out 71 , converting three saves and collecting eight holds.

40-30?: 1B Freddie Freeman collected his 30th double of the season Friday night and is now four home runs away from a 40 -home run, 30 -double season...Only three Braves players have ever reached those marks in a single season.

A Each of the three did it only once, and each is in the Hall of Fame: Eddie Mathews ( 47 home runs $/ 31$ doubles in 1953), Hank Aaron (44 home runs/30 doubles in 1969) and Chipper Jones ( 45 home runs/41 doubles in 1999).
RUNS: The Braves scored double digits last night, beating Chicago (AL), 11-5...Yesterday was the 17th time the Braves have scored at least 10 runs this season, which is the most such games in the National League.
A The Braves have scored 736 times this season, the second-highest run total in the National League.. Only Los Angeles has more with 751.

A The Braves have 30 runs in their last three games... They had 18 over their previous six.

BIG FIRST: The Braves sent 11 hitters to the plate in the first inning last night, with six of them scoring...It was Atlanta's highest-scoring first inning since May 17, 2017 against Toronto, when the Braves also scored six in the first inning.
A Opposing starter Reynaldo López faced only nine batters and allowed six runs last night, getting just two outs before being removed from the game.. The six runs allowed were the most an opposing starter has given up against the Braves in less than 1.0 inning since April 7, 2015, when Miami's Mat Latos allowed seven runs on six hits in 0.2 innings.
A On the season Atlanta has 82 first-inning runs, seventh most in the National League.

## Tonight's Game

A Makes his 29th start of 2019...Is the 225th appearance of his career, and his 222nd start.
A Has made just one career start against Chicago, allowing nine hits and five runs over 6.0 innings ( 7.50 ERA) to take the loss on July 9,2016 at U.S. Cellular Field.

A Is winless in three starts against the American League this season, going 0-2 with a 2.87 ERA ( 5 ER/15.2 IP) against Cleveland, Detroit and Kansas City.

A In 27 career Interleague starts, is 6-14 with a 5.10 ERA (88 ER/155.1 IP)... Among all active pitchers with at least 20 Interleague starts, Teheran's 5.10 ERA is sixth highest in baseball.
t Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in his last start, August 26 at Colorado, his 16th start this season allowing one or fewer earned runs.
A The 16 starts allowing one earned run or fewer are tied for most in the majors among traditional starters...The Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu also has 16.
A Ryne Stanek had 25 such starts while opening for the Rays.
A The Atlanta-franchise record for such starts is 20 , set by Greg Maddux in 2002
A Set for his 14th start at SunTrust Park this season, and is $4-4$ with a 3.00 ERA (23 ER/69.0 IP) over his first 13 turns...Atlanta is $8-5$ when Teheran starts at home.

A His ERA 0.72 points better at home than on the road...H Has a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts on the road.

A Over the first two seasons at SunTrust Park ('17-'18), he pitched to a 4.89 ERA (104 ER/191.1 IP) in his home park...Had a 3.02 career ERA at Turner Field.

## 2019 Recap

A Made his fifth start of the season against Miami, 8/21, and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings...Allowed just one earned run in 32.0 innings ( 0.28 ERA) against the Marlins on the season.
$\mathcal{A}$ The 32.0 innings marked the most such innings in a season by a Braves pitcher against a single opponent allowing one earned run or less...Pat Jarvis held the previous record, holding Houston to one run over 31.1 innings in 1971.

A Became the 11th pitcher in the live-ball era to allow one or fewer runs in at least that many innings against a single opponent in a season...The last to do so was Chicago-AL's Britt Burns, who did not allow a run in 32.0 innings against the Indians in 1985
A Started against the Mets on $8 / 15$ at SunTrust Park and allowed eight hits and six runs over just 1.1 innings, the shortest start of his career.
A Was his 219th career start, which passed Rick Mahler for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...Only Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363) and Tim Hudson (243) have started more games for Atlanta.

A Started against the Marlins, 8/9, and allowed five hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
A Allowed a home run leading off the seventh inning to snap a 24 -inning scoreless streak against Miami to open the season.

A Pitched exactly 6.0 scoreless innings in each of his three starts against the Marlins to open the season...Teheran's run was just the fourth time since 1908 that a Braves starter had three straight such starts against one opponent in a single season...Warren Spahn first did so against Cincinnati in 1947, before Pete Smith did it against the Cubs in 1988...John Smoltz matched them in 2006 with three straight such starts against San Diego.
E Beat Washington, July 30, for his 73 rd career win... Moved into sole possession of 10th place in Atlanta franchise history, passing Steve Avery (72).
A Since Teheran's first full season in 2013, no pitcher has made more starts for a single team than he has for Atlanta.
Allowed eight hits and six earned runs, $6 / 18$ vs. NYM...The outing stopped a streak of eight straight starts in which he allowed one earned run or less.
$\mathcal{A}$ His run of one-run starts spanned from May 5 to June 13, during which he ranked second in the majors with a 0.81 ERA (4 ER/44.2 IP)...Trailed just Hyun-Jin Ryu of the Dodgers ( 0.53 ERA)

A Teheran's eight-game streak was tied for the longest in the majors by a traditional starter this season, mathing a run by his rotation-mate Mike Soroka...TB's Ryne Stanek has a 14-game run while opening for the Rays.
( Made his 200th career start, $4 / 30$ vs. SD...Allowed five hits and four runs over a season-most 7.0 innings.
A Became the ninth Braves pitcher to make 200 starts for the club since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Joins Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363), Tim Hudson (243), Rick Mahler (218), Ron Reed (203) and Steve Avery (201).

Stole his 30 th base on $8 / 23$ at NYM...Along with his 36 homers, became second player in baseball history to have 30 homers and 30 steals in a season prior to turning 22... Mike Trout is the other ( 30 HR and 49 SB in 2012 as a 20 -year-old)...Only three other Braves have gone $30 / 30$ at any age (R. Gant, 1990 and 1991; D. Murphy, 1983; H. Aaron, 1963). Leads the NL in runs scored (107)...Became third-quickest Brave, by team games, in the modern era to reach 100 runs...Did so in Atlanta's 121st game...Tommy Holmes (1945, 115 team games) and Dale Murphy (1983, 114 team games) were the only ones quicker Is the first player in major league history to have two home run streaks of four or more games prior to turning $22 \ldots$ Had a four-game streak this month, $8 / 6-9$, and a franchise record-tying five-game streak last season, also in August, from 8/11-14. Hit 50th career home run on $7 / 21$ vs. WSH...At 21 years, 215 days old, became fourth youngest player to reach the 50 -homer milestone (M. Ott, T. Conigliaro and A. Jones). Agreed to terms, $4 / 2$, on an eight-year, $\$ 100$ million contract extension with Atlanta.

$$ Recorded his fifth career four-hit game Friday, including his fourth this month...Also had four-hit games on $8 / 6,8 / 7$ and $8 / 9 \ldots$ Prior to that stretch, had one such game in his first 328 career games...Is only the third Brave since 1908 to have three four-hit games in a span of four games...The others were Marcus Giles in 2006 and Kenny Lofton in 1997. Has 158 hits this season, tied with teammate Ronald Acuña Jr. for fourth in the National League...Has 46 multi-hit games, tied with teammate Freddie Freeman for third in the NL...In 15 of those games, has at least three hits...That is also tied for third in the NL...In his career, has 33 games with at least three hits, the second most by a Braves player prior to his 23 rd birthday...Hank Aaron has the most with 36 .

Hit fourth career grand slam on $7 / 27$ at PHI ...One of five players in baseball history with four grand slams before his 23 rd birthday (K. Griffey Jr., E. Mathews, G. Stanton,T.Williams). Signed a seven-year, $\$ 35$ million contract extension with Atlanta on $4 / 11$, that will keep him in Atlanta through 2025...Has club options for the 2026 and 2027 seasons.
