TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies finish a four-game set tonight with the 16th of 19 meetings between the clubs this season...The teams will conclude the season series with three games in Atlanta next week, September 17-19.

The Braves need to win tonight to split the 10 games in Philadelphia this season and avoid losing the season set here at Citizens Bank Park for the third consecutive season and for the fourth time in the last five years...They went 5-4 in nine games here during the 2016 season.

After getting swept in a season-opening, three-game series here in Philadelphia, the Braves have won eight of the last 12 games with the Phillies, outscoring their division rival 94-51 over the stretch.

RHP Julio Teheran is set to face the Phillies for the 25th time in his career, for the 24th time as a starter and for the second time this season...The righty is 9-7 with a 3.71 ERA (59 ER/143.0 IP) in his career against Philadelphia, having lost his only start this season...He went 5.0 innings and allowed three runs, earned, here on Opening Day in a 10-4 loss.

LHP Drew Smyly has faced the Braves one previous time, pitching in relief on April 27, 2013 as a member of the Detroit Tigers...The lefty struck out the only two batters he faced in a 7-4 win...Since joining the Phillies, Smyly is 3-1 with a 3.93 ERA (22 ER/50.1 IP) in nine games, all starts.

91 WINS: The Braves earned their 91st win of the season last night, surpassing their total of last season when they won the National League East division title...The 91 wins are the club's most since going 96-66 in 2013.

The win also reduced the Braves' magic number to clinch the division to eight...They hold a 9.5-game lead over second-place Washington.

The Braves have won 22 of their last 28 games and are on pace for 100 victories this season... They need to go 9-6 or better in their final 15 games to reach the ninth triple-digit win season in franchise history...The 1998 team had the most regular season wins going 106-56 (.654) on their way to a loss in the NLCS to San Diego.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today returned LHP Grant Dayton from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 60-day IL, while placing LHP A.J. Minter on the 60-day IL with left shoulder inflammation.

Dayton missed 56 games with a fractured right great toe...He appeared in 10 games with Atlanta, allowing three runs, two earned, with 11 strikeouts (2.16 ERA) before going to the IL on July 11.

Dayton appeared in seven games with Triple-A Gwinnett during his rehabilitation, allowing six runs.

FREDDIE AT 30: 1B Freddie Freeman turns 30 years old today, and is set to play for the 10th time on his birthday.

Freeman is hitting .471 (16-for-34) with two home runs and nine RBI on his birthday, and carries an eight-game birthday hitting streak into tonight's game.

He homered on this day in 2017 at Washington and at Miami.

Freeman played the fourth most games (1,334) in franchise history prior to turning 30, trailing only the trio of Andruw Jones (1,625), Hank Aaron (1,511) and Eddie Mathews (1,482), while his 1,446 hits also trailed the same trio (Aaron, 1,898; Jones, 1,570; Mathews, 1,548).

Overall, Freeman's 1,446 hits are already 12th most in franchise history, while his 317 doubles rank fifth...His 227 homers are seventh, while his 801 RBI are 10th.

FLOWERS: C Tyler Flowers hit a three-run home run last night to score all of the Braves' runs in a 3-1 win over Philadelphia...The Braves improved to 13-2 in Flowers' last 15 starts.

Overall, the Braves are 42-25 (.627) when Flowers starts this season.

HOME RUNS: C Tyler Flowers drove a 2-2, fourth-inning pitch out to left field last night, Atlanta's 231st home run as a team this season.

The Braves' 231 home runs this season are the sixth most in baseball and are the second most in the National League...The Braves are now four home runs away from tying the single-season mark, set by the 2003 team.

MARTIN-GREENE-MELANCON: RHP Chris Martin, RHP Shane Greene, and RHP Mark Melancon each tossed a scoreless inning last night to help the Braves to a 3-1 victory over Philadelphia.

The trio, acquired in July trades, have combined to compile 11 saves, 13 holds and a 2.82 ERA (12 ER/38.1 IP) over the Braves' last 28 games...The club is 22-6 over this stretch.

SPRING TRAINING TIMES: The Braves have announced game times for their 2020 spring training schedule, Atlanta's first at CoolToday Park in North Port, Fla.

Atlanta's 33-game slate will begin on Saturday, February 22, with a home game against the Baltimore Orioles at 1:05 p.m.

Thirteen of Atlanta's 17 home games will start at 1:05 p.m., with the remaining four - March 2 vs. PHI, March 9 vs. BOS, March 14 vs. BAL and March 21 vs. PIT - slated for 6:05 p.m. first pitches.

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 31st start of 2019...Is the 227th appearance of his career, and his 224th start.
- A* Set for his 24th career start against the Phillies, his second, this season, and his 25th career appearance...Is 9-7 with a 3.71 ERA (59 ER/143.0 IP) over his first 24 turns.
- A* Made his only start of the season against them on Opening Day, March 28 here at Citizens Bank Park...Allowed four hits and three runs over 5.0 innings to take the loss.
- A* In 13 intradivision starts this season, is 6-3 with a 2.96 ERA (23 ER/70.0 IP)...Among pitchers to make at least 10 starts against the NL East this season, Teheran's 2.96 ERA is sixth lowest, trailing just Jacob deGrom (2.65), Patrick Corbin (2.75), Mike Soroka (2.76), Max Scherzer (2.84) and Stephen Strasburg (2.96).
- A* Allowed three hits and one run in his last turn, September 7 vs. Washington, his 17th start this season allowing one or fewer earned runs.
- A* The 17 starts allowing one earned run or fewer are the most in the majors among traditional starters...Houston's Gerrit Cole and the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu each have 16 such starts.
- A* Ryne Stanek had 25 such starts while opening for the Rays.
- A* The Atlanta-franchise record for such starts is 20, set by Greg Maddux in 2002.
- A* Since July 1, has gone 5-2 with a 2.36 ERA (18 ER/68.2 IP) over 12 starts, while Atlanta is 8-4 in his starts.
- A* Since that date, Teheran's ERA is seventh lowest in the majors, and fourth best in the National League...Only Jack Flaherty (1.19), Sonny Gray (1.66) and Jacob deGrom (1.91) have been better in the NL since July.
- A* In 18 starts to open the season, from Opening Day through June 30, Teheran went 5-6 with a 3.99 ERA (42 ER/94.2 IP).

2019 Recap

- A* Made his 30th start of the season, 9/7 vs. WSH, and allowed three hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his 10th win.
- A* Has made at least 30 starts in each of the last seven seasons dating to 2013, and is the only pitcher in the majors to do so...Mike Leake (29 starts this season), Jon Lester (28), Max Scherzer (24) and José Quintana (28) are the only other pitchers to make at least 30 starts in every season from 2013-2018.
- A* Made his fifth start of the season against Miami, 8/21, and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings...Allowed just one earned run in 32.0 innings (0.28 ERA) against the Marlins on the season.
- A* The 32.0 innings marked the most such innings in a season by a Braves pitcher against a single opponent allowing one earned run or less...Pat Jarvis held the previous record, holding Houston to one run over 31.1 innings in 1971.
- A* Became the 11th pitcher in the live-ball era to allow one or fewer runs in at least that many innings against a single opponent in a season...The last to do so was Chicago-AL's Britt Burns, who did not allow a run in 32.0 innings against the Indians in 1985.
- A* Started against the Mets on 8/15 at SunTrust Park and allowed eight hits and six runs over just 1.1 innings, the shortest start of his career.
- A* Was his 219th career start, which passed Rick Mahler for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...Only Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363) and Tim Hudson (243) have started more games.
- A* Started against the Marlins, 8/9, and allowed five hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
- A* Allowed a home run leading off the seventh inning to snap a 24-inning scoreless streak against Miami to open the season.
- A* Pitched exactly 6.0 scoreless innings in each of his three starts against the Marlins to open the season...Teheran's run was just the fourth time since 1908 that a Braves starter had three straight such starts against one opponent in a single season.
- A* Allowed eight hits and six earned runs, 6/18 vs. NYM...The outing stopped a streak of eight straight starts in which he allowed one earned run or less.
- A* His run of one-run starts spanned from May 5 to June 13, during which he ranked second in the majors with a 0.81 ERA (4 ER/44.2 IP)...Trailed just Hyun-Jin Ryu of the Dodgers (0.53 ERA).
- A* Teheran's eight-game streak was tied for the longest in the majors by a traditional starter this season, mathing a run by his rotation-mate Mike Soroka...TB's Ryne Stanek has a 14-game run while opening for the Rays.
- A* Made his 200th career start, 4/30 vs. SD...Allowed five hits and four runs over a season-most 7.0 innings.
- A* Became the ninth Braves pitcher to make 200 starts for the club since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Joins Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363), Tim Hudson (243), Rick Mahler (218), Ron Reed (203) and Steve Avery (201).

- A* Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

- Is 0-0 with 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP) in 10 appearances with ATL this season...Has struck out 11.
- Went 0-1 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) in 22 games with the Stripers this season, and fanned 41 batters while walking just four...In seven games with the Stripers during his rehab assignment, allowed six runs.
- Made his first appearance with Atlanta 4/30 vs. SD...Was his first major league appearance since 6/24/17 vs. MIN with Los Angeles (NL)...Was with Atlanta from 4/29-5/7 and 6/17 to 6/23...Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 7/4, for his third stint with Atlanta before being placed on the IL.

- Is 0-1 with a 4.19 ERA (9 ER/19.1 IP) in 21 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.20 ERA (14 ER/57.1 IP) in 59 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
